THE OPENING TIP

• Purdue (2-2) hosts Jacksonville State (1-2) on Saturday night at Mackey Arena, tipping off at 8 p.m. ET. The contest will be televised on the Big Ten Network and streamed on the FOX Sports App with **Chris Vosters** and **Shon Morris** on the call. On the radio, **Rob Blackman**, **Larry Clisby** and **Ralph Taylor** will have the call courtside on the Purdue Radio Network and Tuneln.com. There will be no pregame show Saturday due to contractual obligations with the Purdue Football broadcast vs. Wisconsin. Live stats will be available at PurdueStats.com.

• This will be the first meeting between the two teams. The Gamecocks are the only first-time opponent on this Purdue's schedule this year.

• It marks the fourth straight year that Purdue has faced an opponent from the Ohio Valley Conference. Purdue defeated Belmont (73-62) last year, SIU Edwardsville (105-74) to start the 2017-18 season and Morehead State (90-56) in December 2016.

• Purdue is 22-0 all-time against current members of the Ohio Valley Conference, including 9-0 under **Matt Painter**.

• The contest comes after a seven-day layoff between games and from Nov. 17, to Nov. 28, Purdue will play just one game (Saturday vs. Jacksonville State).

• The matchup marks a home game in the Emerald Coast Classic. The Boilermakers will travel to Destin, Florida, on Wednesday to face VCU (Friday) and either Tennessee or Florida State (Saturday). The tournament is considered one of the strongest Thanksgiving tournaments in America. Purdue is 17-4 during in-season tournaments since 2014-15.

• Purdue is looking to gain some momentum as it enters a gauntlet through Christmas. The Boilermakers' next eight (possible) games come against teams that posted a combined 206-104 (.665) record, won a combined 10 NCAA Tournament games with two teams (Tennessee OR Florida State) reaching the Sweet 16 and Virginia winning the national title.

• Purdue has shown balanced scoring through its first four games this season as four different players have led the team in scoring. In 36 games last season, just four different players led the team in scoring.

• Purdue has outrebounded all four opponents this season, including by a total of 43 rebounds in three home games. Purdue is outrebounding its foes by a 66 to 33 margin on the offensive end, while outscoring its opponents by a 66-27 margin in second-chance points.

• Combined with second-chance points and points off turnovers, Purdue is outscoring its opponents 132 to 63 in "extra possessions". Over the last two games, Purdue has scored 91 points to opponents' 28 points in extra possession categories.

• Entering the year, Purdue was one of four teams nationally to rank in the nation's top 25 in assist / turnover ratio in each of the last four years. Purdue has picked up where it left off, ranking 29th early on this year with a ratio of 1.53.

• Purdue has won 99 straight games when scoring 90 or more points in a game. Its last loss came on Nov. 24, 1987, vs. Iowa State (104-96).

• **Aaron Wheeler** has made a 3-pointer in nine straight games dating to last year.

• **Jahaad Proctor** has scored in double-figures in 20 straight games dating to last year at High Point.

THE SERIES WITH JACKSONVILLE STATE

This will be the first meeting with Jacksonville State, a school located in Jacksonville, Alabama.

- **Rachel Coleman Haas**, the mother of former Purdue great **Isaac Haas**, works in the admissions department at Jacksonville State.
- The Gamecocks will be playing a Big Ten team for the second straight season and third time in the last four years. Penn State defeated Jax State a year ago (76-61) while Maryland defeated the Gamecocks in Dec. 2016 (92-66).
- Jacksonville State has also faced Illinois (Nov. 10, 2013; Loss, 86-62), Nebraska (Dec. 18, 2012; Loss, 59-55) and Michigan State (Dec. 28, 2002; Loss, 76-52) in its program history.

ABOUT THE GAMECOCKS

- Jacksonville State posted a 24-9 record a year ago, losing to a **Ja Morant** buzzer-beater in the Ohio Valley Conference Tournament semifinals. The Gamecocks were 15-3 in league play, sweeping both Murray State and Belmont during the regular season. Both of those teams reached the NCAA Tournament.
- However, the Gamecocks lost several key players from last year's squad including four of their top-five scorers.
- Head coach **Ray Harper** is one of the most-respected coaches in America, having won a pair of NCAA Division II National Championships with four D-II runner-up finishes to his name at Kentucky Wesleyan, all coming in a six-year span from 1998 to 2003. He was then the head coach at Western Kentucky for five years before taking over at Jacksonville State, where he led the Gamecocks to the 2017 NCAA Tournament.

A BOILERMAKER WIN WOULD...

- ... improve Purdue to 3-2 on the season, heading into a crucial stretch.
- ... improve Purdue to 34-2 at home since the start of 2017-18.
- ... improve Purdue's record to 23-0 all-time against the OVC.
- ... be **Matt Painter's** 349th career victory in his 16th season.

- When Chicago State packed in a zone in last Saturday's contest, Purdue let it fly. The Boilermakers attempted a school record-tying 36 3-pointers, making 11 of them.
- Purdue has attempted at least 30 3-pointers in 31 games all-time, with 28 of those games coming under Coach Painter.

- The narrative of Purdue being a slow, plodding team is simply outdated. Since the 2017-18 season, only two power-conference schools have made more 3-pointers than Purdue.

- **Jahaad Proctor** has been a pleasant addition for the Purdue men's basketball team, leading the team in scoring while scoring in double-figures in all four games this year. Proctor has scored at least 10 points in 20 straight games dating to last year at High Point.

THE EXTRA POSSESSION GAME

- Purdue has always stressed winning the extra-possession game and it did so in impressive fashion Saturday against Chicago State.
- The Boilermakers became the first team in America this year to out-rebound their opponent by 25 or more rebounds (48-22) and have nine or more fewer turnovers (8-17) than its opponent.
- It marks the first time since Dec. 10, 1983, vs. Tampa that Purdue has achieved those marks in the same game.

UNUSUAL START

- Purdue is off to an unusual start under **Matt Painter**, posting a 2-2 record through four games. Here is a look at Painter-era starts.

► **Record at Purdue:** 323-161 (.667) / 15th year | **Career Record:** 348-166 (.677) / 16th year

- With five Sweet 16 appearances, 11 NCAA Tournament berths, three Big Ten regular-season championships, a Big Ten Tournament title, an Elite Eight and an international gold medal on his résumé, 15th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest young minds in all of college basketball.
- He was voted by his peers as the NABC National Coach of the Year after leading a team that started with a 6-5 record to the 2019 Elite Eight.
- Painter was named the 2019 Big Ten Coach of the Year and has led Purdue to three straight Sweet 16 appearances.
- Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in October of 2018, agreeing to a two-year extension that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2023-24 season. The deal features five, one-year extensions that go into effect through the 2028-29 season. Following the 2029 season, Painter will still only be 58 years old.
- Painter enters the 2019-20 season third on the school's all-time wins list (321) behind legendary mentors, Gene Keady and Ward "Piggy" Lambert, both of whom have been inducted into the College Basketball Hall of Fame.
- Has averaged almost 23 wins a season in his 14 years at Purdue. If you don't include the first transitional year (9-19 record), the average balloons to 24.0 wins per year over the last 13 seasons.
- Has won at least 25 games in nine of his 15 seasons as a collegiate head coach.
- Painter's four Big Ten Coach of the Year honors are the third most in league history (Gene Keady - 7; Bobby Knight - 5; Bo Ryan - 4).
- Painter has averaged 11.3 wins per year in conference play, the fifth-best average in Big Ten Conference history.
- Is one of just two active coaches to have won a Big Ten championship.
- Painter's 11 NCAA Tournaments in the last 13 years are the eighth most in the country.
- Purdue's five Sweet 16 appearances in the last 11 years are the ninth most nationally.
- Through last year, Painter's 346 wins were the second most nationally for a coach nationally in under 15 years of coaching.
- Coach Painter's 12 NCAA Tournaments are the most for a coach nationally under the age of 55 (as of April 1, 2020 -- Painter is 49 years old).
- Has produced draft picks in each of the last four years, one of only four programs nationally that can say that.
- Purdue is one of five teams to have a Naismith position award finalist in each of the last four years.
- Purdue has finished first or second in Big Ten play in seven of Painter's last 12 years.
- Has had 58 Academic All-Big Ten honorees in his 14 previous years at Purdue.
- Lastly, the five winningest classes in school history have come during the Painter era (2019, 2018, 2012, 2011, 2010).
