THE SCENE SETTER BETWEEN THE BOILERMAKERS AND THE FIGHTING IRISH

• The No. 15-ranked Purdue men's basketball team heads to Indianapolis for the sixth-annual Crossroads Classic, this time coming against No. 21-ranked Notre Dame, tipping at 2 p.m. ET ... the game will be streamed televised on ESPN2 with **Dave Flemming** and **Dick Vitale** on the call ... on the radio dial, the game will be available on the Purdue Sports Network and Tuneln.com as **Larry Clisby** and **Rob Blackman** provide brilliant commentary, beginning with the Purdue Basketball pregame show one hour before tip ... live stats will be available at StatBroadcast.com.

#BOILERNOTES

- Purdue is ranked No. 15 in the Associated Press top-25 poll, up three spots from last week ... the Boilermakers have been ranked in the AP Top 25 in each of the last 25 polls, the seventh-longest active streak nationally ... Purdue is ranked 16th in the coaches poll, also up three from last week.
- Purdue's two losses have come by teams ranked second (Villanova) and seventh (Louisville on the road) in the latest KenPom.com rankings.
- Purdue ranks sixth nationally in effective field goal percentage (.598) ... among NCAA ranks, Purdue is 12th nationally in field goal percentage (.504).
- The Boilermakers are fourth nationally in 3-point percentage (.441) ... over the last seven games, Purdue is 86-of-178 (.483) from long distance.
- Purdue is shooting 55.2 percent from long distance away from Mackey Arena, but just 36.9 percent at home.
- Purdue ranks third nationally in assists at 20.2 assists per game and has had 71 assists over its last three games (23.7 APG).
- Purdue has recorded assists on 69.2 percent of its made field goals, ranking fourth nationally in assist rate (A / FGM).
- Purdue has five players averaging in double figures and two more that average at least 7.8 points per game ... already twice this year, Purdue has had six players reach double figures in a game (Auburn, Arizona State).
- Over the last three games, six players are averaging in double figures (Haas, Mathias, V. Edwards, C. Edwards, Cline, Swanigan).
- Purdue has three players averaging at least 10.0 points, 4.0 rebounds and 3.0 assists per game (Swanigan, Mathias, V. Edwards) ... in Purdue history before this year, just five players have done that in school history.
- Purdue has out rebounded its last two opponents by 13.0 rebounds per game (Arizona State, Cleveland State).
- In the last three first halves vs. Morehead State, Arizona State and Cleveland State, foes are averaging just 22.0 points and shooting 30.8 percent from the field (28-of-91) ... Purdue has trailed a combined 35 seconds over the last three games (24 seconds vs. Morehead State; 11 seconds vs. ASU).
- Purdue is 6-0 when outscoring foes in the paint ... Purdue is 8-1 when outscoring foes in second-chance points.

SERIES HISTORY

- Purdue and Notre Dame will meet for the 43rd time in Saturday's Crossroads Classic in Indianapolis ... the Irish own a 22-20 series lead over the Boilermakers, having won three straight games, all by double-figures ... it marks just the fourth meeting between the two intrastate rivals in the last 50 years.
- The contest marks the first time that both teams enter the contest nationally ranked in the AP poll ... Purdue is ranked 15th, while Notre Dame is ranked 21st.
- It also marks the first game in 43 meetings that a ranked Purdue team will face Notre Dame.

THE STATE OF BASKETBALL

- Saturday's Crossroads Classic will feature four ranked teams for the first time in the six-year history of the event.
 - All four teams are ranked in the nation's top 21 (Indiana - 9th; Purdue - 15th; Butler - 18th; Notre Dame - 21st).
 - The four teams have a combined five losses that have come to Villanova (twice), Louisville and in-state opponents IPFW and Indiana State.
- BOILERMAKER RECORDS**
- Purdue is 277-37 (.882) all-time against non-conference foes in Mackey Arena, including a 272-29 (.904) record vs. unranked, non-conference foes.
 - **Matt Painter** is 87-8 (.916) at Mackey Arena against non-conference opposition.
 - Purdue is 28-2 in its last 30 games at Mackey Arena with losses to Maryland (Jan. 2015) and Iowa (Jan. 2016).
 - Since the start of the 2015-16 season, Purdue is 34-11 (.756) in all games played, including 20-4 (.833) vs. non-conference foes.
 - Purdue needs to win 16 more games this year to have 50 wins in back-to-back seasons for just the eighth time in school history.

MOST CONSECUTIVE WEEKS IN AP RANKINGS

- Purdue has been ranked in 25 consecutive polls, now the seventh-longest active streak in America ... Purdue was 1-of-11 teams nationally to be ranked in all 19 Associated Press polls a year ago.
- The school record for most consecutive weeks ranked is 64 from the 13th poll of the 2007-08 season to the final poll of the 2010-11 campaign.

P BIG TEN SUCCESS UNDER PAINTER

• Since the 2006-07 season, the Purdue basketball team under **Matt Painter** has been one of the most-successful teams in the Big Ten.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE MACHINES

- Purdue's **Caleb Swanigan** (15.9 PPG, 11.2 RPG, 3.4 APG) and Notre Dame's **Bonzie Colson** (16.5 PPG, 10.8 RPG, 2.1 APG) rank in the top 10 nationally in double-doubles and are two of the 11 players nationally to average at least 15.0 points, 10.0 rebounds and 2.0 assists per game.
- Swanigan has seven double-doubles to rank tied for fifth nationally and Colson has six to rank tied for eighth nationally.

NOTRE DAME & PURDUE HAVE PLAYED THE BEST

- Two of the three losses between Purdue and Notre Dame have come to the No. 1 team in the country, Villanova, by a combined 11 points.
- Purdue shot 49.1 percent against Villanova, while Notre Dame shot 46.6 percent ... Purdue outrebounded the Wildcats by three, Notre Dame was outrebounded by eight.

CROSSROADS MISERY

- Purdue is looking for its first win in the Crossroads Classic, posting an 0-5 record in the event.

LARGE MARGINS

- Purdue has won three straight games by at least 24 points and six of its eight wins this year have come by at least 21 points ... the two games that Purdue did not win by at least 21 points were against Georgia State (8) and NJIT (11).

SIZZLING FROM DEEP

• The story of Purdue's offensive resurgence lately has been the Boilermakers' success from beyond the 3-point line. Through Tuesday's games, here is where Purdue ranks nationally and in the Big Ten in the major 3-point categories.

• Over the last seven games, Purdue is shooting 86-of-178 (.483) from 3-point range ... prior to the Cancun Challenge (just three games), Purdue was shooting 32.8 percent from long distance.

• Purdue has made a 3-pointer in 974-of-980 games since the 3-point line was introduced before the 1986-87 season, including 122 straight.

• Purdue has made at least two 3-pointers in 949-of-980 games, including 111 straight games.

• Based on a 32-game season, Purdue is on pace for 346 3-pointers ... the current school record is 284 (2011-12 season).

• Over the last seven games, Purdue has posted three of the top six single-game 3-pointers made totals in school history.

BENCH PRODUCTION

• Over the last six games, Purdue's bench is averaging 29.0 points and shooting 45.5 percent from 3-point range (30-of-66) ... in the first four games, the group averaged 15.5 points per game, while shooting 37.5 percent from the field and 19.2 percent from long distance.

• Purdue's bench has scored at least 23 points in each of the last six games, after doing so once in the first four (30 vs. McNeese State).

SHARP-SHOOTING

• Purdue has shot over 48.0 percent from the field in seven games this year, including three straight ... last year, Purdue shot over 48.0 percent in 15-of-35 games, but in just five of the first 10 outings.

• Purdue is 103-13 under **Matt Painter** when shooting 48.0 percent or better from the floor.

• Purdue has already had eight 20-point performances by four different players this year ... Purdue had 13, 20-point showings all of last year.

BEATING RANKED, NON-CONF. FOES OUTSIDE OF MACKEY ARENA

• Purdue is looking for its first win over a ranked, non-conference foe away from Mackey Arena since beating No. 24-ranked Saint Mary's in the 2012 NCAA Tournament ... Purdue has lost six straight games against ranked, non-conference foes outside of Mackey Arena (Kansas, Notre Dame, Oklahoma State, Notre Dame, Butler, Louisville).

LIMIT TURNOVERS AND THE SKY IS THE LIMIT

• Purdue has been restrained early in the season by turnovers, ranking 269th nationally, and 13th in the Big Ten, in turnovers per game ... the Boilermakers are 256th nationally in turnover margin, while ranking 12th in the Big Ten.

• Purdue has had at least 15 turnovers in six games this year, including five of the last six outings ... foes have scored almost 25 percent (152-of-647; 23.5 percent) of its points directly off Purdue turnovers ... contrast that to Purdue, which has scored just 17.9 percent of its points (150-of-837) off opponents' mistakes.

DEFENSE LIVES HERE

• One of the big question marks entering the year was how Purdue would be defensively after losing the league's best interior (**A.J. Hammons**) and perimeter (**Rapheal Davis**) defenders.

• Over the last three games, Purdue has held its three foes to 57.7 points per game, 34.7 percent shooting from the field and 26.4 percent from 3-point range.

• When Purdue holds foes to 59 or fewer points under Painter, the Boilermakers are 119-4 ... three of the losses (Eastern Michigan, Iowa, Nebraska) came during the 2012-13 season.

PLAY WITHOUT FOULING

• Purdue ranks 21st in the country in fewest personal fouls per game, averaging just 15.8 whistles per game.

• When Cleveland State shot a free throw with 12:02 left in the second half last Saturday, it marked the first time in the last 68 minutes, 15 seconds that a foe had shot a free throw at Mackey Arena ... Morehead State did not shoot a free throw on Dec. 3.

• In the last five games, Purdue has had 20 fouls called in the first half.

• Notre Dame shoots 86.4 percent from the free throw line ... Purdue ranks fifth nationally in FTA / FGA defense (.211) behind UCF, Clemson, Villanova and Nevada.

- ▶ **Record at Purdue:** 246-136 (.644) / 12th year | **Career Record:** 271-141 (.658) / 13th year
- With a pair of Sweet 16 appearances, eight NCAA Tournament berths, Big Ten regular-season and tournament titles and an international gold medal on his resumé, 12th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest minds in all of college basketball.
 - Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in March of 2011, agreeing to a new eight-year contract that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2018-19 season. He then followed that up in August of 2016, signing a three-year extension good through the 2021-22 year.
 - Painter has averaged over 21 wins per season during his tenure at the helm of the Purdue program, including at least 20 victories in eight seasons.
 - Painter's tenure has seen Purdue basketball restore its status among the upper echelon of college basketball programs. The last eight years have seen six 20-win seasons and NCAA Tournament berths, two Sweet 16 appearances, a regular-season Big Ten title and a Big Ten Tournament crown.
 - The three winningest classes in program history are the classes of 2011, 2012 and 2010, respectively, and five of the 10 winningest individual players Purdue has ever seen have come from the Painter ranks. Success, however, didn't happen overnight.
 - Painter officially became the 18th head men's basketball coach in Purdue history on April 1, 2005, and immediately set about laying the groundwork for a dramatic reversal in the program's fortunes.
 - The Boilermakers were at their best during the 2009 postseason run, rattling off double-digit victories over Penn State and Illinois to reach the Big Ten Tournament final, where they dispatched Ohio State, 65-61, to earn the first conference tournament crown in program history.
 - Painter has been named Big Ten Coach of the Year three times in the last six seasons, earning the consensus award in 2008 and 2011, and winning the coaches' vote in 2010. He is one of only six men to win the award more than once since its inception in 1974.
 - Painter has seen a total of 24 players earn a combined 44 Academic All-Big Ten honors during his tenure as head coach. Painter has also mentored an Academic All-American, as Moore earned second-team honors during the 2009-10 season.
