- Tickets are available by calling 800.49SPORT or on PurdueSports.com for just \$10. Tickets will also be available on game day at Mackey Arena. All proceeds will benefit the Greater Houston Community Foundation, the UNIDOS Disaster Relief & Recovery Program to support Puerto Rico and the Florida Disaster Fund, areas that were ravaged by deadly hurricanes during the last few

▶ Inside the Series

- · Announced Oct. 19 after both Purdue and Indiana State received a waiver from the NCAA to play an extra exhibition game, the Boilermakers will tip off the 2017-18 season Saturday in Mackey Arena.
- · Purdue owns a 29-4 all-time record against Indiana State, having last played the Sycamores in Dec. 2010 (win, 65-52).
- Purdue is 6-3 against Indiana State in its last nine games dating to Nov. 1977. Prior to that, Purdue was 23-1 against the Sycamores.
- Purdue is 62-7 (.899) all-time in exhibition games and since 1991-92, owns a 48-3 (.941) mark.
- · Head coach Matt Painter is 22-0 in exhibition games, winning by an average of 26.0 points per game.
- Purdue has scored at least 85 points in five straight exhibition games.
- Purdue hasn't allowed more than 63 points in any of the last five exhibition games.

▶ #BoilerNotes

- · Purdue's 38 Big Ten wins are the second most in the league since 2014-15 (Wisconsin - 40).
- Purdue's 46 home wins are the second most in the league during that span (Maryland - 47).
- During the 2017-18 season, Purdue needs 15 home wins to match the school record for most wins at Mackey Arena during a fouryear span. The classes of 2010 and 2011 have 61 home victories.
- Head coach Matt Painter is the only Big Ten coach to have won at home and on the road of every current Big Ten school.
- With the Paint Crew in attendance in games at Mackey Arena, Purdue has won 32 of its last 33 games (loss to Villanova; Nov. 14, 2016).
- Purdue's 79.7 points per game last year were the most since the 1997-98 season (83.7).
- · The Boilermakers set a school record for 3-pointers made in a season (315). Purdue finished ninth nationally in 3-point percentage and 45th nationally in 3-pointers per game.

▶ Exhibition Success

- The Boilermakers own a 62-7 (.899) record all-time against exhibition foes having won 27 straight games.
- Since 1991-92, Purdue is 48-3 (.941) in exhibition games and 25-0 all-time against collegiate teams in exhibition games.
- Under **Matt Painter**, Purdue is 22-0 in exhibition games, winning by an average of 26.0 points per game (573 points in 22 games).
- In nine of the 11 seasons that Purdue won its exhibition opener by 30 or more points, Purdue reached the NCAA Tournament at the end of the season, including during the 2015-16 season.

▶ November Reign

- Purdue has dominated the opposition at home during the month of November, going 40-2 (.952) under head coach Matt Painter. The Ione setbacks were on Nov. 9, 2012, to Bucknell (70-65), and Nov. 14, 2017, to defending national champion Villanova (79-76). Ironically, Villanova's head coach Jay Wright graduated from Bucknell.
- Going back further, Purdue is 75-8 (.904) all-time at Mackey Arena during the month of November.
- Painter owns a 56-15 (.789) record during the month of November.

▶ Boilers Hot at Home

- Purdue will enter the 2017-18 season having won seven straight games at Mackey Arena, the eighth-longest streak during the Painter era.
- With eight non-conference home games on the slate, an undefeated non-conference schedule will give Purdue 15 straight home wins, which would be the fifth-longest home winning streak in Mackey Arena history.

▶ Three Straight NCAA Tournament Berths

- Purdue has earned three straight NCAA Tournament berths. The streak is the third-longest among Big Ten teams (Michigan State 20; Wisconsin 19; Purdue 3; Maryland 3).
- Over the last 11 years, Purdue's nine NCAA appearances rank third in the Big Ten (Wisconsin 11; Michigan State 11) and 15th nationally.

▶ Regional Dominance

- Purdue went 12-3 a year ago against teams from Indiana and surrounding states. The lone losses were to Louisville and Michigan (twice)
- Since the start of the 2015-16 season, Purdue is 22-8 against Indiana and bordering states.

▶ The Limit is 60

• Purdue is 125-4 when under Painter when holding foes to 59 or fewer points. Three of the four losses came during the 2012-13 season.

▶ Usually Automatic

- Purdue is 60-4 since the start of the 2014-15 season when attempting more free throws than its opponents.
- The four losses have come to Iowa (Jan. 12, 2017), Louisville (Nov. 30, 2016), Indiana (Feb. 20, 2016) and Michigan State (March 13, 2016).

▶ Snipers Return

 Purdue is the only school in America that returns four players that attempted over 100 3-pointers while making 40.0 percent. Bucknell, Loyola (III.), Marquette and Samford all return three such players.

- With a trio of Sweet 16 appearances, nine NCAA Tournament berths, Big Ten regular-season and tournament titles and an international gold medal on his résumé, 13th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest minds in all of college basketball.
- Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in March of 2011, agreeing to a new eight-year contract that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2018-19 season. He then followed that up in August of 2016, signing a three-year extension good through the 2021-22 year.
- Painter has averaged over 22 wins per season during his tenure at the helm of the Purdue program, including at least 25 victories in six seasons.
- Painter's tenure has seen Purdue basketball restore its status among the upper echelon of college basketball programs. The last 10 years have seen six 25-win seasons and eight NCAA Tournament berths, three Sweet 16 appearances, two regular-season Big Ten titles and a Big Ten Tournament crown.
- The three winningest classes in program history are the classes of 2011, 2012 and 2010, respectively, and five of the 10 winningest individual players Purdue has ever seen have come from the Painter ranks. Success, however, didn't happen overnight.
- Painter officially became the 18th head men's basketball coach in Purdue history on April 1, 2005, and immediately set about laying the groundwork for a dramatic reversal in the program's fortunes.
- The Boilermakers were at their best during the 2009 postseason run, rattling off double-digit victories over Penn State and Illinois to reach the Big Ten Tournament final, where they dispatched Ohio State, 65-61, to earn the first conference tournament crown in program history.
- Painter has been named Big Ten Coach of the Year three times, earning the consensus award in 2008 and 2011, and winning the coaches' vote in 2010. He is one of only six men to win the award more at least three times since its inception in 1974.
- Painter has seen a total of 26 players earn a combined 49 Academic All-Big Ten honors during his tenure as head coach. Painter has also mentored
 a pair of Academic All-Americans in E'Twaun Moore (2010) and Caleb Swanigan (2017)
