### GAMEDAY STORYLINES

► **SCENE SETTER:** The 21st-ranked Purdue Boilermakers wrap up a two-game roadswing out west with a trip to "The Barn" and a Wednesday tilt with Minnesota, tipping at 9 p.m. ET. **Cory Provus** and **Bob Wenzel** will provide expert commentary for the Big Ten Network (BTN), while **Larry Clisby** and **Rob Blackman** will do the same on the radio dial for the Purdue Radio Network. Live stats will be provided on StatBroadcast.com and as always, Twitter updates will be available on Purdue basketball's official account (@BoilerBall).

► **ROAD WARRIORS:** Purdue is 3-2 in "true" road games with wins over Pittsburgh, Wisconsin and Rutgers and losses at Illinois and Iowa. The Boilermakers are 44-45 in true road games since the 2007-08 season, posting the third-most wins in the Big Ten on the road during that span (Wisconsin - 56; Michigan State - 55). A win would give Purdue four "true" road wins, already equaling the most for the program since winning five road games during the 2011-12 season (2014-15 and 2012-13 also won four road games). After Wednesday, Purdue has four road games left.

► **UNDERCLASSMEN LEADING THE WAY:** Purdue's freshmen and sophomores have combined to score 994 of Purdue's 1,651 points, accounting for 60.2 percent of the Boilermakers' scoring. Over the last five games, the group has scored 276 of Purdue's 397 points (69.5 percent). In each of the last six games, the talented sophomore class has scored at least 32 points in each game, including 41 points against Penn State and 40 against Rutgers.

► **BENCH PRODUCTION:** Purdue's bench production has been sensational this year, as the group has outscored the opposing bench by an insane 416 points, an average of 19.8 points per game while outscoring the opposing bench in 20-of-21 games this year (Ohio State). The group is averaging 35.1 points per game and is shooting 46.9 percent from the field and 37.0 percent from 3-point range, while boasting an assist-to-turnover ratio of 164:85 (1.93). In Big Ten play, the group has scored 269 of Purdue's 608 points (44.2 percent of the scoring).

► **GLASS EATERS:** Purdue has dominated the glass this year, leading the country in rebound margin at 12.2 rebounds per game. The Boilermakers are the only team in America to out rebound every opponent and just four opponents (Vermont, Pittsburgh, Butler and Iowa) have been outrebounded by five or fewer rebounds. The Boilermakers are averaging 17.8 offensive rebounds per game over the last four outings. Just two Big Ten opponents have grabbed at least 10 offensive rebounds (Iowa, Ohio State).

► **THE STRETCH RUN:** Purdue closes out the first half of Big Ten play on Wednesday night and if Purdue is going to make a push in the standings, it will need its seniors to step up. After scoring a season-high 43 points against Michigan (Jan. 7), the senior group has averaged just 21.0 points while shooting 40-of-97 (41.2) from the field and 23-of-35 (.657) from the free throw line with 22 assists against 23 turnovers.

► **THE AGGRESSOR:** Sophomore **Vince Edwards** has scored in double-figures in four straight games and has had at least 10 field goal attempts in three straight games. Prior to this stretch, Edwards had had 10 or more field goal attempts in just five of his first 51 career games.

► **POLL POSITION:** The Boilermakers entered this week ranked No. 21 in the AP Top 25 poll. It marks the 320th week (11th straight) that Purdue has been ranked in the AP poll and with its No. 9 ranking on Dec. 14, Purdue has been ranked in the top 10 in 116 weeks all-time.

► **ABOUT MINNESOTA:** Minnesota enters the contest with a 6-14 overall record and a hard-luck 0-8 in Big Ten standings. Minnesota has lost three straight games by a combined 17 points against Indiana (7), Michigan (5) and Illinois (5 in overtime). The Gophers are led by **Nate Mason** at 13.3 points per game and 4.2 assists per game. Sharpshooter **Joey King** averages 12.8 points and has made 46-of-103 (.447) of his 3-point tries.

► **SERIES HISTORY:** The Boilermakers lead the series with Minnesota by a 100-82 margin, and have won five of their last seven meetings with the Gophers. The series has been hotly-contested as of late. In the last four meetings, the margins have been three, three, four and four points with both teams scoring 286 points. Purdue is 1-3 in its last four meetings at "The Barn" with the losses coming by four, three and three points.

**■ PURDUE BASKETBALL HISTORY**

- Purdue is in its 118th season of basketball, owning a 1,729-990 (.636) all-time record. The Boilermakers rank 19th all-time in victories (1,729) and their 63.6 winning percentage is 20th all-time.
- Purdue has had just two head coaches, **Gene Keady** and **Matt Painter**, since the start of the 1980-81 season, a span of 35 years.
- Since the **Ray Eddy** era began in 1950, Purdue has had just six head coaches in 66 years and just eight head coaches in the last 99 years.

**■ HAWKEYES CAP OFF SEASON SWEEP OF PURDUE**

- Purdue is now 87-75 all-time against Iowa, but has lost four of the last five meetings.
- Iowa's 83 points equaled the most the Hawkeyes scored against Purdue during the Painter era.
- Purdue led Iowa at halftime of both meetings, but was outscored by a 100-62 margin in the second half. Iowa shot 33-of-53 (.623) from the field in the second half of both meetings combined.
- Purdue shot a season-low 53.3 percent (8-of-15) from the free throw line. In two games against Iowa, Purdue shot just 17-of-30 (.567) from the free throw line. Purdue entered the game ranked 20th in the country in free throw percentage (.750).
- In two games against Iowa, Purdue had 31 turnovers that turned into 46 points. Purdue was outscored by the Hawks in the "points off turnovers" category by a total of 25 points against the Hawkeyes. Purdue lost the two games by a combined 19 points.
- Purdue's underclassmen scored 51-of-71 points, including 40 points coming from the sophomore class.
- P.J. Thompson** and **Vince Edwards** went a combined 14-of-24 (.583) from the field. The rest of the team went 13-of-40 (.325).
- Purdue lost for the first time this season when **Vince Edwards** scores in double-figures (now 9-1).
- P.J. Thompson** set a new career high with 16 points and four 3-pointers.

**■ INSIDE THE NUMBERS**

- Purdue has won at least 17 games through its first 21 games for the 10th time in school history, and for the first time since 2010-11 (started 17-4).
- Purdue has scored 70 or more points in six straight Big Ten games for the first time since Jan. 18 - Feb. 14, 1998 (8 games).
- Purdue is now 9-1 on the season when making nine or more 3-pointers. The Boilermakers were 9-of-23 (.391) from long distance against Iowa.
- In games played on weekends, Purdue is just 6-4. In games played on weekdays, the Boilermakers are 11-0.
- Purdue has trailed by double-digits in just three games this year.
- Sixteen of Purdue's 17 wins this year have been decided by at least 11 points (61-55 win over Wisconsin on Dec. 29).
- Eighteen of Purdue's 21 games this year have been decided by at least 11 points (Iowa, Butler, Wisconsin).
- When Purdue is outscored in the paint this year, the Boilermakers are 4-1 (wins over Vermont, Florida, Pittsburgh, Ohio State; loss to Butler).
- Purdue's bench has outscored the opposing bench in 20-of-21 games (Ohio State).
- Purdue's sophomore class has scored at least 32 points as a group in each of the last six games.
- Purdue's two primary point guards, **P.J. Thompson** and **Johnny Hill**, have made a combined 24 free throws in a row.
- Purdue is 9-6 since the start of last year when trailing at halftime. The Boilermakers are 2-1 when trailing at halftime (wins over Vanderbilt, Ohio State).
- Purdue is 14-2 this year when leading at halftime. Both losses have come to Iowa.

**■ WINNING / LOSING NUMBERS**

- Purdue is 12-0 when winning or tied in the "points off turnovers" battle; the Boilermakers are 5-4 when losing the "points off turnovers" battle.
- Purdue is 12-1 when having a run of 10 points or longer (loss to Iowa); the Boilermakers are 5-3 when not having a 10-point run.
- Purdue is 10-2 when the sophomore class combines for at least 30 points.
- Purdue is 12-0 when the senior class combines for at least 21 points; 5-4 when it scores 20 or fewer points.
- Purdue is 11-0 when it makes between 0-4 3-pointers or 10-plus trifectas; when it makes between 5-9 3-pointers, Purdue is 6-4.
- Purdue is 8-0 when shooting at least 48.0 percent from the field; 9-4 when it shoots under 48.0 percent.
- Purdue is 14-1 when it has 15 or fewer turnovers (loss to Iowa); when it has 16 or more turnovers, Purdue is 3-3.
- Purdue is 14-0 when holding foes to 69 or fewer points; when it allows 70 or more points, Purdue is 3-4.
- Purdue is 10-0 when four or more players score in double-figures; just 7-4 when having three or fewer players in double figures.
- Purdue is 9-0 this year when **Rapheal Davis** scores 10 or more points; the Boilermakers are 8-4 when Davis scores nine or fewer points.
- Purdue is 11-0 this year when **Isaac Haas** scores in double-digits; just 6-4 when he doesn't.
- Purdue is 8-0 when **A.J. Hammons** leads the team in scoring; but it is 9-4 when he doesn't.

**■ PAINTER ERA WINNING / LOSING NUMBERS**

- Purdue is 91-11 under Painter when shooting at least 48.0 percent; Purdue is 14-54 when opponents shoot at least 48.0 percent.
- Purdue is 190-30 under Painter when shooting a higher field goal percentage than its opponent; Purdue is 39-99 when opponents shoot better.
- Purdue is 165-32 under Painter when attempting more free throws than its opponent, including 14-0 this year.
- Purdue is 89-8 under Painter when winning both the rebound and turnover battles.
- Purdue is 132-30 under Painter when scoring at least 70 points; Purdue is 31-83 under Painter when allowing 70 or more points.
- Purdue is 114-4 under Painter when holding foes to 59 points or less (losses to Michigan State [2010], Eastern Michigan, Iowa, Nebraska [2013]).

**■ PAINTER ERA STARTS IN BIG TEN PLAY**

- With a win on Wednesday against Minnesota, Purdue will wrap up the first half of Big Ten play with a 6-3 league mark and an 18-4 overall mark. The Boilermakers have started 6-3 or better four times during the Painter era (2010-11, 2009-10, 2008-09, 2007-08).

**CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD**

- Purdue has dominated the glass all season long, outrebounding all 21 foes this year and leading the country in rebound margin (+12.2).
- Purdue outrebounded Rutgers by a 63-23 margin, the largest rebound margin in school history (+40). This year's Boilermakers have now boasted the top-two rebound margin totals in school history (+37 vs. Incarnate Word).
- Purdue had more rebounds (63) than Rutgers had points (57).
- Purdue had more offensive rebounds (27) than Rutgers had rebounds (23). Purdue's 27 offensive rebounds were the second most in a game in school history and the most for a team against a Division I foe this year.
- In Big Ten play only, Purdue leads the league in defensive rebounding percentage (.801) and offensive rebounding percentage (.384).
- The Boilermakers have held six of their eight Big Ten opponents to single-digit offensive rebounds (Iowa 11, Ohio State 10). Four of the last five opponents had five or fewer offensive rebounds (Illinois, Penn State, Rutgers, Iowa).
- The Boilermakers are allowing just 9.2 offensive rebounds per game in all 21 games and just 6.8 offensive rebounds in Big Ten play.
- Purdue leads the country in total rebounds (907) and is third in rebounds per game (43.2).

**BALANCED ATTACK**

- Purdue has five players averaging between 8.6 and 13.3 points, led by **A.J. Hammons** at 13.3 points per game.
- Purdue has four players averaging at least 4.4 rebounds per game.
- Purdue has six players averaging between 2.0 and 2.8 assists per game and two more players averaging at least 1.0 assists per game.
- Purdue has five players with at least 20 3-point field goals. It marks the fifth time in school history that Purdue has had five players make at least 20 trifectas (first since 2007-08).

**ASSISTING WITH THE BEST**

- Purdue has several players boasting impressive assist-to-turnover ratio this year.
- P.J. Thompson** leads the way with a 58:11 (5.27) assist-to-turnover ratio, a ratio that would smash the school record of 3.12, set by **Mack Gadis** in 1986. Thompson's ratio is second in the country for a player averaging at least 20.0 minutes per game (Stephen F. Austin's **Trey Pinkney**; 66:12 -- 5.50).
- Dakota Mathias** owns a 3.85 ratio (50:13), a number that would rank second in the single-season assist-to-turnover ratio chart.
- Ryan Cline** owns a 4.57 (32:7) ratio, a number that would rank first on the Purdue freshman list. Cline likely won't have enough assists (min. 75) to qualify for the single-season chart.
- The three of them have combined for a 140:31 (4.52) ratio between them in 1,137 minutes. The trio averages a turnover every 36.7 minutes.

**DIALING LONG DISTANCE**

- Over the last six games, Purdue has connected on 48-of-130 (.369) of its 3-point attempts.
- Purdue has made at least 10 3-pointers in seven games this year, the most since having 10 games of double-digit 3-pointers in the 2011-12 season.
- In Big Ten play, Purdue's three sophomores (**Vince Edwards**, **Dakota Mathias** and **P.J. Thompson**) are a combined 32-of-68 (.471).

**TURNING IT OVER...**

- Purdue has had an issue with turnovers in its losses coming to Butler, Iowa (twice) and Illinois. If the Boilermakers can solve those issues, a special season could be on the horizon.
- In Purdue's four losses, the Boilermakers have had 65 turnovers, resulting in 91 points. The losses have come by a combined 39 points.
- Purdue had 18 (Butler), 14 (Iowa), 16 (Illinois) and 17 (Iowa) turnovers during its four losses.
- Purdue has been outscored by 43 points in the "points off turnovers" category in those three games, clearly making a huge difference in the outcome of those contests.
- Purdue has won the turnover battle just five times this year (Vermont, IUPUI, Howard, Rutgers, Ohio State). The Boilermaker have had 15 or more turnovers six times this year, including in all four of its losses.

**DEFENSE LIVES HERE**

- The Boilermakers have held 17 of a possible 20 opponents under their pregame scoring average.
- The Boilermakers are 11th in the country in scoring defense (62.0), fifth in field goal percentage defense (.372).
- Purdue is seventh in Ken Pomeroy's adjusted defensive efficiency, fourth in effective field goal percentage defense and fourth in 2-point pct. defense (.399).
- Purdue has forced 10 shot clock violations already this year, one year after forcing 19 in 34 games. If you're counting, that 29 in 55 games.

**SHARING IS CARING**

- Purdue ranks 11th in the country in assists per game at 17.8 per contest. The Boilermakers have dished out at least 20 assists in a game.
- Purdue has assisted on 64.7 percent of its made field goals this year, a percentage that ranks 12th nationally in assist rate.
- Purdue's 26 assists against Michigan were its most in a Big Ten game since having 29 against Minnesota on Feb. 19, 2000.
- Purdue's seven "wing" players (not including Haas, Hammons, Swanigan) all have assist-to-turnover ratio better than 1.00.
- Purdue has posted the third- (Vermont), fourth- (Rutgers) and fifth- (Howard) best assist-to-turnover ratios in a single game already this year.

**ON FIRE FROM THE LINE**

- Purdue ranks 27th nationally in free throw percentage, a significant improvement over the last four years where the Boilermakers ranked 275th (2012), 291st (2013), 261st (2014) and 213th (2015).
- Purdue has won 32 straight games when shooting more free throws than its opponent, including 14 times this year.
- Four of Purdue's 10 rotation players are shooting above 80.0 percent from the free throw line.

- After starting the season 38-of-59 (.644) from the free throw line in the first two games, Purdue has turned it around at the charity stripe.
- The Boilermakers are 294-of-388 (.758) from the free throw line during the last 18 games.
- Purdue has had seven games this year where it has made 80.0 percent or better from the free throw line. Last year's team had just four games all season of 80 percent or better.
- The school record for free throw percentage in a season is 78.2 percent during the 1968-69 season. This year's average (.743) ranks seventh.

**■ SEEING DOUBLE**

- Purdue has already recorded 14 double-doubles through 20 games, which is the most since the 2009-10 season (15).

**■ NOT WAITING FOR THE WEEKEND**

- In games played on Saturday and Sunday this year, Purdue is just 6-3. In games played on weekdays, the Boilermakers are 11-0.

**■ SHOW A LITTLE CLASS**

- In the classroom, the Boilermakers had an outstanding fall semester, registering a cumulative 3.04 GPA as a team. Eleven players boasted semester GPAs of 3.00 or better during the fall.

**■ BOILERMAKERS HOT AT HOME**

- Purdue saw its 15-game home winning streak come to an end on Jan. 2, 2016, against Iowa. It marked Purdue's first loss since a 69-60 setback to Maryland on Jan. 10, 2015. The 15-game homecourt winning streak was tied for the sixth-longest streak in Mackey Arena.
- Since the start of last year, Purdue is now 26-4 at home, having won 19 of its last 20 games at Mackey Arena (lone loss to Iowa on Jan. 2).
- Purdue is outscoring opponents by 21.9 points per game in 13 home games this year.
- Purdue has now won at least 12 home games for 10 straight years.

**■ LET'S GO FOR A RUN**

- Purdue has had 62 runs this year of 7-0 or longer, compared to just 19 for its opponents.
- Purdue has had 21 runs of 10-0 or longer, compared to just two for its opponents (Iowa -- 13-0 run; Illinois -- 10-0 run).

**■ HAMMONS IN ELITE COMPANY**

- **A.J. Hammons** is having a terrific senior season and has worked his way into Big Ten Player of the Year and All-America consideration.
- He has blocked a shot in 14 straight games and his 305 blocks are the most for an active player nationally.
- Hammons is one of four Big Ten players in league history to have 1,300 points, 800 rebounds and 300 blocks and is the first player in 23 years to do so (Iowa's **Acie Earl**, Ohio State's **Herb Williams**, Purdue's **Joe Barry Carroll**).

### #1 - Johnny Hill

- ▶ Has started the last 6 games; averaging 6.2 PPG, 3.2 RPG and 2.2 APG (14-of-25 FGs) in that span.
- ▶ Narrowly missed a double-double with 9 points and 9 rebounds against Rutgers.
- ▶ Has scored 12 points with four rebounds and four assists in 32 minutes over the last two games.
- ▶ His 7 offensive rebounds against Rutgers were tied for the 8th most in a game in school history.
- ▶ Been on #5CTop10 twice this year; #7 vs. Michigan (dunk), #4 vs. IUPUI (blocked shot).
- ▶ Grabbed his 100th career steal (in his 103rd career game) in the loss to Iowa.
- ▶ Pursuing a graduate degree in Technology and Leadership Innovation.

### #3 - P.J. Thompson

- ▶ Averaging 9.5 PPG and 2.3 APG over the last six games off the bench (17-of-32 FGs; 11-of-20 3Ps).
- ▶ Second in the country in offensive rating, according to **Ken Pomeroy** (140.9).
- ▶ Over last two games, is averaging 14.0 points and 2.0 assists in 25.0 minutes (8-of-13 FGs, 6-of-10 3Ps).
- ▶ In games coming off the bench (11 games), has 26 assists against one turnover (215 minutes).
- ▶ Has just one turnover in the last six games (129 minutes).
- ▶ Ranks second nationally in assist-to-turnover ratio (5.27) among players to average 20.0 minutes.
- ▶ Owns a career 3.03 (91:30) assist-to-turnover ratio; the school record is 2.70.
- ▶ Only player in America with 55 or more assists and 11 or fewer turnovers.

### #11 - Stephen Toyra

- ▶ Has already graduated from Purdue, earning his management degree in August.
- ▶ Owns his own real estate business called Family Realty Groups and became a licensed real estate agent at the age of 21.
- ▶ Made headlines after the Vanderbilt game when he proposed to his high school girlfriend, **Taylor Vauters**, on the sideline.

### #12 - Vince Edwards

- ▶ Has scored in double-figures in last four games, averaging 15.5 points and 7.0 rebounds per game.
- ▶ Has had 10 or more FGAs in each of the last three games; did so just once in the first 18 games.
- ▶ His four 3-pointers without a miss against Penn State were the fourth most without a miss in Purdue history.
- ▶ In games this year he has scored double-figures, Purdue is 9-1; 16-4 when doing so in his career.
- ▶ Has started 50-of-54 career games, Purdue is 36-14 in games that he starts.
- ▶ Spent part of the summer trying out for the USA Under-19 National Team.
- ▶ Became just the sixth freshmen in NCAA Tournament history to reach 14 points, eight rebounds and seven assists in a game (**Derrick Rose**, **Carmelo Anthony**, **Jameer Nelson**, **Kenny Anderson**, **Gene Banks**).

### #14 - Ryan Cline

- ▶ Called the best shooter Coach Painter has ever recruited, Cline needs two 3-pointers to move into the ninth on the Purdue freshman 3-pointers made list (has 27; **Vince Edwards** had 29).
- ▶ Is just 10-of-34 from 3-point range in his last 10 games, but is 6-of-14 (.429) in last three games.
- ▶ Hit a big trifecta in the second half against Ohio State that gave Purdue the lead for good.
- ▶ Owns a 4.57 (32:7) assist-to-turnover ratio; no turnovers in the last four games (58 minutes).
- ▶ Only player in America with at least 30 assists and 7 turnovers or fewer.
- ▶ Has improved his defensive skills significantly since arriving on campus.
- ▶ Won the high school 3-point shooting championship during Final Four weekend.
- ▶ Name is in the Basketball Hall of Fame after winning the Elks Free Throw National Championship as a 12-year old.

### #20 - A.J. Hammons

- ▶ **All-American candidate.**
- ▶ **Named Big Ten Player of the Week on Dec. 7 and Dec. 28.**
- ▶ Wooden and Abdul-Jabbar Award candidate.
- ▶ Averaging just 10.7 points, 7.7 rebounds and 1.3 blocks in last three games (11-of-28 FGs).
- ▶ Only active player with 1,300 points, 800 rebounds and 300 blocks.
- ▶ Purdue is 8-0 this year when he leads the team in scoring.
- ▶ Has scored in double-figures in 13 of last 15 games (Howard, Rutgers).
- ▶ Dominated in the second half against Pittsburgh in the Big Ten / ACC Challenge, finishing the game with 24 points and 12 rebounds; had 17 points and eight rebounds in the second half.
- ▶ Had 24 points in a the Big Ten-opening road win at Wisconsin.
- ▶ Trying to become the second player in Big Ten history to lead the league in blocked shots four times (Penn State's **Calvin Booth**).

### #21 - Kendall Stephens

- ▶ Missed Iowa game due to personal reasons following the death of a close friend and high school teammate.
- ▶ Was the first game of his career that he missed.
- ▶ A streaky shooter, Stephens is 7-of-30 (.233) from long distance in his last seven games, breaking a hot streak of 12-of-26 (.462) from 3-point range in previous four contests.
- ▶ Averaging just 10.0 minutes and 2.7 points per game over his last three contests (2-of-8 3Ps).
- ▶ Has 30 career games (out of 86 games) of three or more 3-pointers (24-6 record).
- ▶ Father, Everette, was one of the Three Amigos in the late 80s at Purdue and played in 38 games in the NBA (Indiana, Milwaukee) from 1988-91.

### #23 - Jacquil Taylor

- ▶ After missing most of last year with injuries, Taylor received a medical hardship and is considered a freshman for the 2015-16 season.
- ▶ Recorded his first career double-double with 12 points and 10 rebounds in just 14 minutes vs. Rutgers.
- ▶ Gives the Boilermakers added depth in the frontcourt.
- ▶ Suffered a Lisfranc fracture in the summer of 2013 (junior year), which hampered his recruiting.
- ▶ Brother, Maurice, is a sophomore forward at Niagara.
- ▶ Aspires to be a filmmaker.

### #24 - Grady Eifert

- ▶ A walk-on that gives a good effort every time on the floor.
- ▶ Brother of Cincinnati Bengals' tight end Tyler Eifert.
- ▶ Father, Greg, played basketball at Purdue from 1980-84, appearing in 115 games with 56 starts.
- ▶ Spent last season at Don Bosco Prep in Crown Point, Indiana.

### #31 - Dakota Mathias

- ▶ Scored 12 points vs. Rutgers; his first double-figure scoring game since scoring 17 vs. Vermont (Nov. 15).
- ▶ Averaging 2.0 points, 0.0 rebounds and 2.5 assists over the last two games (2-of-6 FGs, 0-of-4 3Ps).
- ▶ Leads the team in assists (23) during Big Ten play; shooting 18-of-36 (.500) from the field in Big Ten play.
- ▶ Has 18 assists against just four turnovers over the last six games (110 minutes).
- ▶ Can slide over and play the point guard position.
- ▶ Hit a pair of huge 3-pointers in the final 1:18 of the Big Ten-opening win over Wisconsin after Badgers had cut lead to three and four points.
- ▶ Owns a 3.85 (50:13) assist-to-turnover ratio this year; 2.49 (97:39) for his career.

### #35 - Rapheal Davis

- ▶ Needs 102 points for 1,000 in his career.
- ▶ Named to the NABC Good Works Team in early December and 1-of-30 candidates for Senior Class Award.
- ▶ Has a two-year old daughter, Kyndal.
- ▶ Brother, Richard, is a barber in Indianapolis who cuts both Purdue and Indiana players' hair.

### #44 - Isaac Haas

- With a pair of Sweet 16 appearances, six NCAA Tournament berths, Big Ten regular-season and tournament titles and an international gold medal on his résumé, 11th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest minds in all of college basketball.
- Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in March of 2011, agreeing to a new eight-year contract that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2018-19 season.
- Painter has averaged over 21 wins per season during his tenure at the helm of the Purdue program, including at least 20 victories in six of those seasons.
- Painter's tenure has seen Purdue basketball restore its status among the upper echelon of college basketball programs. The last eight years have seen six 20-win seasons and NCAA Tournament berths, two Sweet 16 appearances, a regular-season Big Ten title and a Big Ten Tournament crown.
- The three winningest classes in program history are the classes of 2011, 2012 and 2010, respectively, and five of the 10 winningest individual players Purdue has ever seen have come from the Painter ranks. Success, however, didn't happen overnight.
- Painter officially became the 18th head men's basketball coach in Purdue history on April 1, 2005, and immediately set about laying the groundwork for a dramatic reversal in the program's fortunes.
- The Boilermakers were at their best during the 2009 postseason run, rattling off double-digit victories over Penn State and Illinois to reach the Big Ten Tournament final, where they dispatched Ohio State, 65-61, to earn the first conference tournament crown in program history.
- Painter has also resurrected Mackey Arena as one of the country's best home-court advantages, piling up a 148-32 (.822) record at home over the last 11 seasons, including a remarkable 82-7 (.921) record against non-conference opponents.
- Painter has been named Big Ten Coach of the Year three times in the last six seasons, earning the consensus award in 2008 and 2011, and winning the coaches' vote in 2010. He is one of only six men to win the award more at least three times since its inception in 1974.
- Painter has seen a total of 21 players earn a combined 40 Academic All-Big Ten honors during his tenure as head coach. Painter has also mentored an Academic All-American, as Moore earned second-team honors during the 2009-10 season.
