THE NOTES TO KNOW

- The No. 1-ranked Boilermakers will open Big Ten play Friday night at the place that handed Purdue its last loss as the top-ranked team when the Boilermakers held to Evanston, Illinois, to face Northwestern. This marks the first of two meetings in the 2023-24 season as the Wildcats will visit Mackey Arena on Jan. 31, 2024.
- Purdue owns an 11-4 overall record as the No. 1 team in the country after defeating Texas Southern 99-67 on Tuesday night. One of the losses came a year ago on Super Bowl Sunday when the Wildcats rallied for a physical, 64-58 victory over Purdue. The Boilermakers are looking to avenge that loss and start 1-0 in Big Ten play, while winning their sixth game in their last seven trips to Welsh-Ryan Arena.
- Purdue owns a 13-5 record in Big Ten openers under **Matt Painter**, including a 58-44 win over Northwestern in the 2019-20 opener. Purdue has won four straight league openers and is 5-1 in its last six conference openers on the road.
- Purdue's 65 wins since the start of the 2021-22 season are the fourth most in the country (Houston - 72, Kansas - 68, Arizona - 67, **Purdue - 65**, Duke - 64, Gonzaga - 64, UCLA - 62). Among Big Ten teams, Iowa (50) and Wisconsin (50) are next on the list.
- Purdue was voted No. 1 in the AP Top 25 poll on Monday, the third straight year that the Boilermakers have been ranked No. 1. Prior to the 2021-22 season, Purdue had never been ranked No. 1. Purdue is the first Big Ten program to be ranked No. 1 in three straight seasons.
- Since the start of the 2021-22 season, Purdue has spent nine weeks ranked at No. 1, tied for the most in the country with Gonzaga.
- With its No. 1 ranking this week, Purdue has been ranked in the top 5 of the AP poll for 20 straight weeks, the longest-active streak in America by 11 weeks (Kansas - 9). It has been ranked in the top 3 in 15 of those 20 weeks.
- Matt Painter** ranks fifth on the Big Ten's list for career wins with 420, needing just one victory to tie Illinois legend **Lou Henson** for fourth (421). On the Big Ten games-only chart, Painter is seventh (209 wins), needing one win to tie Indiana's **Branch McCracken** (210).
- Zach Edey** was named the Big Ten Player of the Week on Monday for the seventh time in his career. It ties a school record set by **Glenn Robinson** and now trails just Ohio State's **Evan Turner** (10) and Michigan State's **Cassius Winston** (8) on the career list.
- Lance Jones** will return home to play a game in Evanston for the first time since his high school days. The grad transfer from Southern Illinois is enjoying a big season (10.3 PPG, 2.6 RPG, 2.9 APG). He expects to have at least 30 family and friends in attendance Friday.
- Braden Smith** is off to an outstanding start and has firmly planted himself in early All-America discussions. Smith dished out his 200th career assist (in just 42 games) on Tuesday and leads the nation's sophomores (or younger) in career assists. He has flirted with a pair of triple-doubles and is the nation's only underclassman (soph. or younger) to average at least 13.0 PPG, 6.0 APG and 5.0 RPG.
- Over the last two games, Purdue is 23-of-46 (.500) from 3-point range and now ranks fourth nationally in 3-point percentage (.428).
- Purdue has outscored its opponents by 73 points at the free throw line, the second-highest margin in the country (Weber State; +75). A year ago, Purdue led the country in free throw margin (+249) by 58 points (Texas A&M; +191).
- A year ago, Purdue became the first team since Wisconsin in 2015 to win an outright Big Ten regular-season title and the Big Ten Tournament title in the same season. Purdue became the first team in Big Ten history to win the regular-season title by at least three games and win the Big Ten Tournament in the same season. No team since Michigan State (1999, 2000) has won consecutive Big Ten Tournament and outright regular-season championships.
- Purdue is in search for its 26th Big Ten Championship, already owning the most Big Ten titles in league history. Should Purdue win the Big Ten title in 2024, it will mark its fourth title in the last eight seasons and back-to-back titles for the first time since 1994-95-96.

►►► BIG TEN OPENERS

- Purdue owns a 72-46 (.610) all-time record in Big Ten Conference openers, but is 13-5 (.722) under head coach **Matt Painter**.
- After starting 1-3 in Big Ten openers, Painter is 12-2 in his last 14 conference openers. The two losses came to teams ranked in the nation's top 10 at the time.
- This marks Purdue's first Big Ten opener on the road since the 2018-19 season. Purdue is 5-3 in openers on the road, but having won five of its last six league openers on the road.

►►► THE TEXAS SOUTHERN RECAP

- Purdue improved to 7-0 with a 99-67 victory over Texas Southern in front of the 61st consecutive sellout at Mackey Arena.
- After going 10-of-21 from deep against Marquette, the Boilermakers went 13-of-25 from long range against Texas Southern. Purdue is now 23-of-46 (.500) from 3-point range in the last two games.
- Purdue had five players in double figures for the first time since Dec. 4, 2022, vs. Minnesota.
- **Zach Edey** scored in double-figures for the 58th straight game with 15 points, 6 rebounds and 3 blocks in just 21 minutes. He attempted just four field goals, making all of them.
- **Trey Kaufman-Renn** scored a season-high 12 points with five rebounds in just 17 minutes.

►►► HOT STARTS

- Purdue has now started the last three seasons 8-0, 13-0 and now 7-0. It marks the fifth time under Painter that Purdue has started at least 7-0 (2023-24; 2022-23; 2021-22; 2015-16; 2009-10).
- Since the 1979-80 season, Purdue has started the season 7-0 or better nine times including this year.

►►► SUCCESS FROM DEEP AND THE STRIPE

- Purdue became the first Big Ten team since at least the 2010-11 season to make 13, 3-pointers and attempt 40 free throws in a game when it did so against Texas Southern.
- Purdue is the third team to do it nationally since the 2018-19 season. Purdue has never done that previously in school history.

• With six Sweet 16 appearances, 15 NCAA Tournament berths, four Big Ten regular-season championships, two Big Ten Tournament titles, an Elite Eight and an international gold medal on his résumé, 19th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest young minds in all of college basketball.

• He was voted by his peers as the NABC National Coach of the Year after leading a team that started with a 6-5 record to the 2019 Elite Eight.

• Painter was named the 2019 Big Ten Coach of the Year and has led Purdue to eight straight NCAA Tournaments – the fourth-longest active streak in America. Included in that stretch are Sweet 16 appearances (and beyond) in four of the last six tournaments.

• Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in October of 2018, agreeing to a two-year extension that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2023-24 season. The deal features five, one-year extensions that go into effect through the 2028-29 season. Following the 2029 season, Painter will still only be 58 years old.

• Painter will enter the 2022-23 season second on the school's all-time wins list (413) behind legendary mentor **Gene Keady** and ahead of **Ward “Piggy” Lambert**, both of whom have been inducted into the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame.

• Has averaged almost 23 wins a season in his 18 years at Purdue. If you don't include the first transitional year (9-19 record), the average balloons to 23.5 wins per year over the last 17 seasons.

• Has won at least 25 games in 11 of his 19 seasons as a collegiate head coach.

• Painter has averaged 11.6 wins per year in conference play, the fourth-best average in Big Ten Conference history.

• Coach Painter's 15 NCAA Tournaments are the most for a coach nationally under the age of 55 (as of April 1, 2024 – Painter is 53 years old).

• Purdue has finished first, second or third in Big Ten play in 10 of the last 16 years, including in seven of the last nine years.
