- Carsen Edwards led four players in double figures with 30 points, while Ryan Cline (13), Eric Hunter Jr. (10) and Evan Boudreaux (10) all joined him.
- The Boilermakers shot over 54.0 percent from the field and outrebounded the Stags by 15 to fuel the rout.
- Purdue made 14 3-pointers, the most in a season opener in school history.
- · Ball State enters with a 1-0 record after blowing out Indiana State 86-69 in the opener in Muncie. Tahjal Teague scored 21 points with seven rebounds and Tayler Persons added 16 points and five assists.
- Ball State was picked second in the MAC West division preseason poll.
- · Ball State, which won at Notre Dame last year, has eight players from the state of Indiana on its roster.

- Purdue has won eight straight games against in-state foes, as well as eight straight home games against in-state opposition.
- Purdue has won 15 straight games at home against non-conference foes. The last loss came to Villanova on Nov. 14, 2016.
- · When the Paint Crew has been in attendance, Purdue has won 45 of its last 47 home games (Villanova, Ohio State).
- Purdue has won 26 straight games when shooting 48.0 percent or better from the field.
- Purdue is ranked No. 24 in the preseason AP Poll. Purdue has been ranked in four straight AP preseason polls for the first time in school history.
- With the ranking, Purdue has been ranked in 57 of the last 58 AP polls (since start of 2015-16 season), the fourth-highest total nationally (Villanova, North Carolina, Kansas -- 58; every poll).
- Purdue's 84 wins since the start of the 2015-16 season are the ninth most nationally, and the most in the Big Ten.

THE SERIES

- Purdue owns a 9-2 record all-time against Ball State, including a 4-0 mark under head coach Matt Painter. The two teams haven't met since Dec. 18, 2012, a 66-56 Purdue in Mackey Arena.
- Tonight's color analyst, **Robbie Hummel**, went 3-0 against the Cardinals, averaging 13.3 points, 8.0 rebounds and 4.0 assists in the three games with Ball State.
- Purdue is 54-16 all-time against current members of the Mid-American Conference (MAC), but hasn't played a MAC team since Dec. 7, 2013, a 69-64 win over Eastern Michigan. Ball State will be the first of two MAC opponents this year (Ohio; Dec. 20, 2018).

LAST TIME OUT

- Purdue improved to 1-0 with a 90-57 win over Fairfield in the season opener. Purdue has won six straight season openers, the last five coming by a combined 189 points (37.8 ppg).
- Purdue is now 100-21 all-time in season openers, including 13-1 under head coach Matt Painter.
- Purdue has scored 90-plus points in each of its last three season
- Purdue went 14 of 30 from long range, equaling the most 3-pointers in a season opener in school history (Nov. 11, 2011, vs. Northern Illinois). Five different players made 3-pointers in
- Purdue is now 14-0 all-time against the MAAC.

MARGINS MATTER

- With the 33-point win over Fairfield, Purdue has won by at least 25 points in 11 of Matt Painter's 14 season openers.
- In each of the previous 10 seasons that Purdue won by at least 25 points or more, the Boilermakers advanced to the NCAA Tournament.
- Going even further back, in the last 15 occurrences dating back to the 1982-83 opener that the Boilermakers won their opener by 25 or more points, Purdue reached the NCAA Tournament.

NOVEMBER REIGN

- Purdue has dominated the opposition at home during the month of November, going 45-2 (.957) under head coach Matt Painter.
- Going back further, Purdue is 80-8 (.909) all-time at Mackey Arena during the month of November.
- Painter owns a 63-17 (.788) record during the month of November.

BEFORE THE CALENDAR TURNS

- Purdue has won 17 straight home games before the calendar turns to the new year, dating to a 79-76 loss to defending national champion Villanova on Nov. 13, 2016.

THE THREE LEVELS

- In the win over Fairfield, Purdue shot at least 54.0-45.0-80.0 percent from the three levels while making double-digit 3-pointers for just the third time since the 2010-11 season.
- It has now happened three times in the last 17 games.

MORE ON C-BOOGIE'S 30

- Carsen Edwards scored 30 points in the season-opening win over Fairfield, while making seven 3-pointers, which was tied for the fourth most in a game in school history.
- Dating to last year's Sweet 16 loss to Texas Tech, Edwards became the first player since The Big Dog (9 straight in 1994) to score 30 points in consecutive games.
- He became the first Purdue player since Roy Hairston in the 1995-96 season opener to score 30 points.

- Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in October of 2018, agreeing to a two-year extension that will keep him in West Lafave through at least the 2023-24 season. - Painter's three Big Ten Coach of the Year honors are the fourth most in league history (Gene Keady 7; Bobby Knight 5; Bo Ryan 4).
- Painter has averaged 10.9 wins per year in conference play, the fifth-best average in Big Ten Conference history.
- Is one of just three active coaches to have won a Big Ten championship.
- Painter's 10 NCAA Tournaments in the last 12 years are the ninth most in the country.
- Purdue's four Sweet 16 appearances in the last 10 years are the ninth most nationally.
- Painter's 320 wins are the third most nationally for a coach nationally in under 15 years of coaching.
- Coach Painter's 11 NCAA Tournaments are the most for a coach nationally under the age of 55 (as of Nov. 1, 2018 -- Painter is 48 years old).
- Has produced draft picks in each of the last three years, one of only six programs nationally that can say that.
- Purdue is one of five teams to have a Naismith position award finalist in each of the last three years.
- Purdue has finished first or second in Big Ten play in six of Painter's last 11 years.
- Purdue has led the Big Ten in scoring in each of the last two years, only the second team this century to do so.
- Has had 54 Academic All-Big Ten honorees in his 13 previous years at Purdue.
- Lastly, the four winningest classes in school history have come during the Painter era (2018, 2012, 2011, 2010).
