MEET INFORMATION

TEAM ENTRY PROCEDURE:

Entry into meets are hosted by Purdue University at Lambert Fieldhouse in West Lafayette, IN are by invitation only. Teams and individuals granted an invitation to compete will be given access to enter online at DirectAthletics.com. When entering, please submit marks that were achieved during the 2020 or 2021 seasons only.

INDIVIDUAL ENTRY PROCEDURE:

A limited number of open and unattached entries will be accepted upon the approval from meet management. Individuals interested must request an invitation by emailing Bree Bennett at bbennett@purdue.edu. Please include: (1) the event(s) for which you are requesting entry and (2) your performances in those event(s) from 2020 or 2021. Approved athletes will be sent an email with further entry instructions.

ENTRY DEADLINE:

All entries are due online at DirectAthletics.com by 12:00pm on Tuesday, **November 30, 2021**.

ACCEPTED ENTRIES:

A list of accepted entries will be sent to coaches by 12:00pm on **TBA**.

Entry fees are \$400 per team. (\$200/men; \$200/women; \$10/individual). All entry fees must be paid in full on Direct Athletics before the close of entries (unless waived). Please note that entries cannot altered once fees are paid. Please wait to complete the payment process until all entries are entered online. Once entry fees are paid, no refunds will be given.

SCHEDULE OF EVENTS:

The time schedule will be revised based upon entries received. The final schedule will be sent to coaches and placed on our website at purduesports.com on **Thursday, December 2, 2021**.

PRACTICE TIMES:

Practice times will be **Friday, Dec. 3 from 4:00-7:00pm** in Lambert Fieldhouse.

TRACK SPECIFICS:

4-lane 200m oval, 8-lane dash track; Beynon surface including HJ, PV, TJ and LJ; ***Raised LJ/TJ and Pole Vault Runways***; Shot/Weight ring is smooth concrete; Starting blocks will be furnished (may use your own). Time conversation sheet attached.

SPIKES:

Athletes may only use pyramid 1/4 spikes. Spikes will be checked and those not meeting regulations must be replaced. No pin/needle/Christmas tree spikes will be allowed on the competition track.

COMPETITION AREA:

Only competing athletes and track & field officials are allowed in the competition area. Medical personnel are allowed to enter the competition area in the event of an injury or illness to provide medical assistance. Coaches are not permitted into the competition area at any time. Coaching locations will be indicated surrounding the track.

WARM-UP AREAS:

No warm-ups will be permitted on the competition track at any time. Athletes should use the warm-up gym upstairs (signs will be posted) or warm-up outside of the venue. No spikes on gym floor will be allowed. Jumps and throws will have a 30-minute flight warm-up time.

PACKETS:

Coaches may pick up team packets at the clerk's table on December 4 from 9:00-10:00am. We will distribute the packet to the first coach who arrives at the packet pick-up area.

RESULTS:

Results will be posted on www.pttiming.com or on the program's home page at www.purduesports.com.

SPORTS MEDICINE:

Athletic Trainers and athletic training facilities will be available 60 minutes prior to the start of the meet, during and 30 minutes after the competition. They will be set up on the Lambert Fieldhouse floor located in the southwest corner of the facility.
