THE OPENING TIP

- The No. 1-ranked Purdue Boilermakers face its first test as the nation's top-ranked team when it travels East to face Rutgers at 7 p.m. ET, at Jersey Mike's Arena. The Boilermakers are looking to snap a three-game skid to Rutgers and are looking to win at Rutgers for the first time since Feb. 3, 2018. The three-game losing streak to Rutgers is the third-longest active losing streak to a Big Ten opponent.
- The Boilermakers are 8-0 for the first time since the 2015-16 season, while Rutgers enters the contest with a 4-4 record.
- The contest will be televised on BTN with **Brandon Gaudin** and **Robbie Hummel** on the call. On the radio waves, **Rob Blackman** and **Bobby Riddell** will be courtside on the 22-station Purdue Radio Network and online on the Varsity Sports Network (app). Live stats will be provided on PurdueStats.com and updates will be provided on Purdue's official Twitter account (@BoilerBall).

THE NOTES TO KNOW

- 1) Purdue is 8-0 for just the third time under head coach **Matt Painter**. A win over Rutgers would give Purdue just its fifth 9-0 start since 1940, joining the 1992-93, 1993-94, 2009-10 and 2015-16 seasons. The best start in school history is 14-0 (1993-94 and 2009-10).
- 2) Purdue's No. 1 ranking is its first in school history. Purdue had been ranked in 379 previous AP Top 25 polls without a No. 1 ranking – the second-most appearances in the country (Maryland - 423).
- 3) Purdue enters Thursday's contest as one of 12 unbeaten teams left in the country. Minnesota (pending Wednesday's MSU game) is one of them.
- 4) Purdue has outscored its opponents by 77 points at the free throw line, the top total in the country (Portland, Providence are +73). Over the last three games, Purdue has outscored foes by 37 points at the free throw line, being whistled for just 32 fouls to opponents' 60.
- 5) Purdue is 1-of-2 teams nationally to shoot at least 50.0 percent from the field, 40.0 percent from 3-point range and 75.0 percent from the free throw line (Colorado State).
- 6) Eight of Purdue's 10 regulars shoot at least 40 percent from 3-point range (Thompson - .609; Morton, Gillis, Williams - .500; Stefanovic - .460; Furst - .455; Newman - .405; Ivey - .400).
- 7) Purdue has trailed for just 27 minutes, 10 seconds this season. If you throw out Villanova, Purdue has trailed for just 7 minutes, 16 seconds.
- 8) **Matt Painter** (363) needs one win to tie **Branch McCracken** and **Bo Ryan** (364) for sixth on the list for overall career wins by Big Ten coaches. He needs one win to tie **Jud Heathcote** (182) for seventh on the list for career wins in Big Ten games only.

THE SERIES WITH THE SCARLET KNIGHTS

- Thursday's contest marks the 17th all-time between the Purdue and Rutgers with the Boilermakers owning a 12-4 series lead.
- However, Rutgers has gotten the better of Purdue lately, winning the last three games in the series by a combined 15 points. The three-game streak snapped a 10-game winning streak by Purdue that spanned 37 years.
- Purdue has held Rutgers under 70 points just once in the last six meetings.

SURGING START TO THE SEASON

- Including this season, Purdue has started 3-0 or better in 21 of the last 42 seasons dating to the 1979-80 campaign. Nineteen of those 20, 3-0 starts have resulted in a postseason tournament, 16 of which were NCAA Tournament trips.
- Purdue's 8-0 start is the best start since the 2015-16 season (11-0) and marks just the third 8-0 start of the Painter era (2009-10) and the fifth 8-0 start since the 1938-39 campaign.

STARTING 2-0 IN LEAGUE PLAY....

- Purdue is looking for its first 2-0 start in Big Ten play since the 2017-18 season. The Boilermakers have started 2-0 in Big Ten play under Coach Painter just five times in his previous 16 years.

MAKING HISTORY

- After 379 weeks in the AP Top 25 poll, Purdue finally ascended to the top spot on Monday, being voted No. 1 unanimously by the 61 Associated Press voters.
- The 379 appearances in the AP poll were the second most by any team without a No. 1 appearance (Maryland - 423).
- Purdue's 1,863 games won are the most victories for a program earning its first AP No. 1 ranking.
- The Boilermakers became the first team in at least the last 30 years to be a unanimous selection for No. 1, in its first appearance as the top-ranked team.
- **Zach Edey** will become the tallest starter for a No. 1-ranked team since **Ralph Sampson** (also 7-4) for Virginia in 1982.

IVEYS ENJOYS FIRST TIME AT NO. 1

- **Niele Ivey** has long been **Jaden Ivey's** No. 1 fan, and now the mother-son duo has made history at their respective institutions.
- Notre Dame women's basketball earned their first No. 1 ranking in school history on Jan. 22, 2001, when **Niele Ivey** was a senior at Notre Dame, eventually leading the Irish to the 2001 national title.
- **Jaden Ivey** helped Purdue men's basketball to its first No. 1 ranking in school history on Dec. 6, 2021.

POLL POSITION

- Since the start of the 2015-16 season, Purdue has been ranked in 79 of 119 of the Associated Press Top 25 polls. The total is the 11th most in the country.
- Purdue's eight straight weeks being ranked is the ninth-longest active streak in America.
- Purdue has been ranked in one poll in every season for seven consecutive years, the second-longest streak in school history (eight; 1968-75).

FIRST "REAL" ROAD TRIP

- Thursday's contest Rutgers marks the first "true" road trip for eight players that will be playing their first game in a true road venue filled with fans.

HOME-COURT ADVANTAGE

- Over its last 101 games at Mackey Arena, Purdue is 91-10.
- Purdue has won 11 straight games at Mackey Arena.
- With the Paint Crew in attendance, Purdue is 78-8 at Mackey Arena since the 2014-15 season.

ELITE SHOOTING AT ALL LEVELS

- Through Tuesday's games, Purdue is one of two teams nationally to shoot over 50.0 percent from the field, 40.0 percent from 3-point range and 75.0 percent from the free throw line.
- Over the course of an entire season, no team has shot 50-40-75 since South Dakota State during the 2018-19 season and just five teams have done that since the 2010-11 campaign.

90-POINT FACTS

- Purdue opened the season scoring 90 or more points in its first four games, the longest streak to start a season in school history.
- Purdue has only had two streaks of scoring 90 or more points in four straight games, the other time being in 1969, when it did so in five straight games. The Boilermakers made the Final Four that season.

BALANCING ACT

- Purdue's big three of **Trevion Williams**, **Jaden Ivey** and **Zach Edey** are well known across the country, but it's been Purdue's other players that have risen up and served notice.
- The other seven players in the rotation are averaging 45.9 points, 17.4 rebounds and 11.9 assists per game, while shooting 112-of-236 (47.5) from the field and 68-of-150 (45.3) from 3-point range.

BUT THAT TRIO IS PRETTY GOOD, THOUGH...

- But the Edey, Ivey, Williams trio is pretty good too, averaging 43.8 points, 21.6 rebounds and 7.0 assists per game, while shooting a sizzling 132-of-219 (.603) from the field and 70-of-98 (.714) from the free throw line.

DUO DOMINATES THE GLASS

- Through Tuesday's games, **Zach Edey** and **Trevion Williams** rank 4th and 12th nationally in offensive rebounding percentage. Just one other team (Temple) has two players ranking in the top 60 (Temple's players are 45th and 56th).

MORE ANALYTICS FROM KENPOM

- No. 1 in offensive efficiency.
- No. 1 in effective field goal percentage.
- No. 7 in 2-point field goal percentage.
- No. 9 in offensive rebound percentage.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE TIMES 3

• In the win over Wright State, Purdue had three players (**Zach Edey, Caleb Furst, Trevion Williams**) record double-doubles. It marked the first time since Nov. 21, 1977, that three players recorded double-doubles in the same game (**Walter Jordan, Wayne Walls, Joe Barry Carroll**). It has now happened 19 times in school history.

• In the win over North Carolina, Purdue had three players score at least 20 points in the same game for the first time since Nov. 24, 1997. **Sasha Stefanovic** had 23 points, **Jaden Ivey** had 22 points and **Trevion Williams** tallied 20 points.

INSIDE MORE NUMBERS

- Purdue is 128-15 since the start of the 2014-15 season when attempting more free throws than its opponents.
- Purdue is 162-7 when under Painter when holding foes to 59 or fewer points. Three of the seven losses came during the 2012-13 season.
- Purdue is 135-12 under Painter when scoring at least 80 points, including 49-2 (losses to Notre Dame and Virginia Tech in 2018-19 season) since the start of the 2017-18 season.
- Purdue is 256-50 under Painter when scoring at least 70 points.
- Purdue is 44-5 since the start of the 2017-18 season when making 10 or more 3-pointers in a game, winning 14 straight games.
- Purdue is 133-14 under Painter when winning the rebound and turnover battles in the same game.
- Purdue has won 24 straight games when shooting a higher field goal percentage than its opponent.
- Purdue has won 12 straight non-conference home games.

BEST THING ABOUT FRESHMEN IS THEY BECOME SOPHOMORES

• Purdue sophomores **Jaden Ivey** and **Zach Edey** have taken a massive leap this season after good freshman campaigns.

THE CENTER OF EFFICIENCY

• Purdue's two-headed center monster of **Zach Edey** and **Trevion Williams** is averaging 27.9 points, 15.9 rebounds, 3.4 assists and 2.0 blocked shots per game, in 37.6 minutes per game.

• Over the last two games, Purdue's centers have "struggled", averaging just 19.5 points and 17.5 rebounds per game while shooting 16-of-32 (.500) from the field and 6-of-12 (.500) from the free throw line.

IVEY SHOWS PLAYMAKING ABILITIES

- One area that many people wanted to see **Jaden Ivey** expand his role was his playmaking abilities.
- Ivey averaged 16.0 points, 8.5 rebounds and 6.5 assists per game in Connecticut, while only accounting for two turnovers.
- And don't look now, but he is 11-of-23 from long distance in his last four games after starting the year 3-of-12.
- Ivey is one of two players nationally to average 15.0 points, 5.5 rebounds, 3.5 assists and shoot 50.0 percent from the field and 40.0 percent from 3-point range.

► **Record at Purdue:** 363-184 (.664) / 17th year | **Career Record:** 388-189 (.674) / 18th year

- With five Sweet 16 appearances, 12 NCAA Tournament berths, three Big Ten regular-season championships, a Big Ten Tournament title, an Elite Eight and an international gold medal on his résumé, 17th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest young minds in all of college basketball.
- He was voted by his peers as the NABC National Coach of the Year after leading a team that started with a 6-5 record to the 2019 Elite Eight.
- Painter was named the 2019 Big Ten Coach of the Year and has led Purdue to six straight NCAA Tournaments – the seventh-longest active streak in America. Included in that stretch are Sweet 16 appearances (and beyond) in three of the last four tournaments.
- Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in October of 2018, agreeing to a two-year extension that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2023-24 season. The deal features five, one-year extensions that go into effect through the 2028-29 season. Following the 2029 season, Painter will still only be 58 years old.
- Painter enters the 2021-22 season third on the school's all-time wins list (355) behind legendary mentors, Gene Keady and Ward "Piggy" Lambert, both of whom have been inducted into the College Basketball Hall of Fame.
- Has averaged almost 23 wins a season in his 16 years at Purdue. If you don't include the first transitional year (9-19 record), the average balloons to 24.0 wins per year over the last 15 seasons.
- Has won at least 25 games in nine of his 17 seasons as a collegiate head coach.
- Painter's four Big Ten Coach of the Year honors are the third most in league history (**Gene Keady - 7; Bobby Knight - 5; Bo Ryan - 4**).
- Painter has averaged 11.3 wins per year in conference play, the fifth-best average in Big Ten Conference history.
- Painter's 12 NCAA Tournament appearances in the last 14 events are the eighth most in the country.
- Coach Painter's 13 NCAA Tournaments are the most for a coach nationally under the age of 55 (as of April 1, 2022 – Painter is 51 years old).
- Purdue has finished first or second in Big Ten play in seven of Painter's last 14 years.
- Has had 68 Academic All-Big Ten honorees in his 16 previous years at Purdue.
- Lastly, the five winningest classes in school history have come during the Painter era (2019, 2018, 2012, 2011, 2010).
