THE SCENE SETTER

• The Purdue men's basketball team opens Big Ten play Saturday as it travels to Ann Arbor to face one of America's hottest teams in Michigan.
 • The contest will be televised on ESPN with **Dan Shulman**, **Dan Dakich** and **Kris Budden** calling the action courtside, beginning at 3:30 p.m. ET.
 • On the radio waves, the contest will be available on the Purdue Radio Network and Tuneln.com, with **Rob Blackman** and **Nate Barrett** on the call, beginning with the Purdue Basketball pregame show at 2:30 p.m.
 • Live stats will be provided on PurdueSports.com, and as always, Twitter updates will be available on Purdue's official account (@BoilerBall).
 • Purdue is looking to bounce back after a one-point setback in the ACC / Big Ten Challenge on Wednesday night.
 • Following this game, Purdue returns to Mackey Arena for the first time in 13 days when it hosts Maryland on Dec. 6.

THE TWO TEAMS

• Purdue is 5-2 after falling late to No. 15-ranked Florida State 73-72 on Wednesday in Tallahassee. The Seminoles ended the game on a 9-0 run after Purdue had led 72-64 with 3:43 to play.
 • **Carsen Edwards** led Purdue with 24 points and four assists while **Ryan Cline** added a career-high 21 points on seven 3-pointers.
 • Purdue is averaging over 83 points per game, using a strong outside attack. The Boilermakers are sixth nationally in 3-pointers per game (12.0).
 • Purdue has outrebounded every foe this year, outrebounding foes by 10.1 per game.
 • Purdue will have to go against America's best defense in Michigan, which is allowing foes to score just 51.0 points per game. While playing one of the country's slowest paces, the Wolverines have held every team its played under 70 points.
 • Freshman **Ignas Brazdeikis** leads Michigan at 16.9 PPG, while **Charles Matthews** averages 15.4 PPG.

THE TALKING POINTS

• Purdue is 9-4 under **Matt Painter** in Big Ten openers, having won eight of its last nine league openers.
 • Purdue's last seven regular-season losses have come by three, four, one, three, four, six and one point -- a combined 22 points.
 • Purdue is sixth in offensive efficiency. Michigan is first in defensive efficiency.
 • Purdue is the only team in the country to have two players make at least 25 3-pointers this year. Both **Ryan Cline** and **Carsen Edwards** have 28 triples this year.
 • The seven 3-pointers made by both Edwards (Fairfield) and Cline (Florida State) are the fourth most in a game in school history. Cline set a Big Ten / ACC Challenge record with his seven triples.
 • Purdue has made at least 11 3-pointers in five straight games.
 • **Ryan Cline** is 24 of 48 (.500) from 3-point range in the last five games.
 • **Carsen Edwards** has six 20-point outings in seven games this year.

THE SERIES

- Purdue leads the all-time series with the Wolverines 88-70, but the two teams have split the last 10 meetings (5-5) and 20 meetings (10-10).
- The last four meetings (2-2) have been decided by a total of 18 points, with the margins being just four, one, four and nine points.
- The two teams have knocked each other out of each of the last three Big Ten Tournaments (Purdue d. Michigan in 2016; Michigan d. Purdue in 2017, 2018).
- Crisler Center is one of six Big Ten arenas that Purdue has a winning record in (Illinois, Maryland, Michigan, Northwestern, Penn State, Rutgers).
- The two teams played a pair of memorable regular-season contests a year, both won by Purdue (70-69 and 92-88).

PURDUE IN BIG TEN OPENERS

- Purdue owns a 68-45 (.602) record in Big Ten openers, having won four straight league openers. The Boilermakers are 30-25 in league openers on the road.
- Purdue is opening on the road in league play for the eighth time under **Matt Painter**, posting a 5-2 record with five straight wins.
- This marks the first time during the Painter era that it will open Big Ten play on the road against a ranked opponent.

TRIPLES COME IN BUNCHES

- Purdue has opened the season by making 84 3-pointers in the first seven games, the most in the first seven games in school history
- Based on a 35-game schedule, Purdue is on pace to make 420 3-pointers. The Big Ten record is 361 set by Michigan in each of the last two seasons.
- A deeper dive reveals that Purdue has taken 50.3 percent of its field goal attempts from behind the arc, good for 10th nationally and second among power schools (Villanova).
- Purdue leads the Big Ten and ranks sixth nationally in 3-pointers per game (12.0).

BUT SUCCESS FROM DEEP IS NOTHING NEW

- Since the start of the 2016-17 season, Purdue has had major success from long distance. Consider the following:
- Purdue's is 752 of 1839 from 3-point range since the start of 2016-17, good for the second-best percentage in the country.

- Purdue's 752 3-pointers are the 11th most nationally in that span.
- Purdue has shattered the single-season 3-pointer school record in each of the last two seasons. Prior to 2017, the record was 284 (2012). Two years ago, the Boilermakers made 315. Last year's team eclipsed the record with 353 made trifectas.
- Over the last five games, Purdue is 63 of 155 (.406) from deep.

- With four Sweet 16 appearances, 10 NCAA Tournament berths, two Big Ten regular-season championships, a Big Ten Tournament title and an international gold medal on his résumé, 14th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest young minds in all of college basketball.
- Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in October of 2018, agreeing to a two-year extension that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2023-24 season. The deal features five, one-year extensions that go into effect through the 2028-29 season. Following the 2029 season, Painter will still only be 58 years old.
- Painter entered the 2018-19 season third on the school's all-time wins list (295) behind legendary mentors, Gene Keady and Ward "Piggy" Lambert, both of whom have been inducted into the College Basketball Hall of Fame.
- Has averaged almost 23 wins a season in his 13 years at Purdue. If you don't include the first transitional year, the average balloons to 23.8 wins per year over the last 12 seasons.
- Has won at least 25 games in eight of his 14 seasons as a collegiate head coach.
- Painter's three Big Ten Coach of the Year honors are the fourth most in league history (Gene Keady - 7; Bobby Knight - 5; Bo Ryan - 4).
- Painter has averaged 10.9 wins per year in conference play, the fifth-best average in Big Ten Conference history.
- Is one of just three active coaches to have won a Big Ten championship.
- Painter's 10 NCAA Tournaments in the last 12 years are the ninth most in the country.
- Purdue's four Sweet 16 appearances in the last 10 years are the ninth most nationally.
- Painter's 324 wins are the third most nationally for a coach nationally in under 15 years of coaching.
- Coach Painter's 11 NCAA Tournaments are the most for a coach nationally under the age of 55 (as of Nov. 1, 2018 -- Painter is 48 years old).
- Has produced draft picks in each of the last three years, one of only six programs nationally that can say that.

- Purdue has finished first or second in Big Ten play in six of Painter's last 11 years.

- Lastly, the four winningest classes in school history have come during the Painter era (2018, 2012, 2011, 2010).
