HEAD COACH JEFF BROHM

- Is now 53-37 in his eighth year as a head coach overall
- Is now 23-27 in his fifth year as Purdue's head coach
- Is now 16-20 in Big Ten Conference play
- Is now 9-11 in road games as Purdue's head coach
- Is now 7-9 in Big Ten road games
- Is now 4-7 against top-25 opponents
- Is now 4-1 against Iowa as Purdue's head coach

PURDUE RECORDS

- Is now 624-581-48 in its 134th season
- Is now 219-322-21 in road games all-time
- Is now 50-39-3 all-time against Iowa

SERIES HISTORY VS. IOWA

- Purdue leads the all-time series 50-39-3
- Purdue is 21-22-2 in road contests
- Purdue is 5-11 against a ranked Iowa team
- Purdue has won two in a row and four of the last five in the series, and the Boilermakers are 3-2 at Kinnick Stadium since 2012
- Today snapped a four-game streak of games decided by nine or fewer points, and the last three had been one-score contests

PURDUE TEAM NOTES

- Purdue improves to 6-10 all-time against teams ranked No. 2 in the AP poll, and the Boilermakers have won two in a row, including a 49-20 win against second-ranked Ohio State on October 20, 2018
- The Boilermakers have 16 wins over top-five opponents when they are unranked, the most in the country
- The win is Purdue's first against a top-2 foe on the road since a 31-20 win at Notre Dame on September 28, 1974
- The Boilermaker defense had four interceptions, the most since a four-INT game against Boston College on September 22, 2018, and the four takeaways is the team's most since it had four at Wisconsin on November 23, 2019
- Coming into the game, Purdue had two takeaways on the season
- Iowa was held to 271 total yards offensively, 76 rushing and 195 passing, and the Boilermaker defense had 10 tackles-for-loss with four sacks

A LOOK AHEAD

- Purdue returns home next weekend to host Wisconsin on Saturday, October 23, with kickoff at Ross-Ade Stadium at 3 p.m. ET
- The game, which will be air on the Big Ten Network, is a sell-out
- Purdue is 29-50-8 all-time against Wisconsin and 16-22-3 at home in a series that began with a 34-6 home victory in 1892
- The Boilermakers have won three of the last four meetings
- The two teams met every year from 2009-2019 before last season's meeting was cancelled

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

OFFENSE

David Bell

- Led the team with 240 receiving yards on 11 catches with one touchdown and a season-long reception of 60 yards
- ... 240 receiving yards in a game is second-most in team history, behind only Chris Daniels' 301 vs. Michigan State on October 16, 1999
- ... Is the eighth Boilermaker to have 200-plus receiving yards in a game and the first since Rondale Moore had 220 vs. Vanderbilt on September 7, 2019
- ... 60-yard reception is the longest play from scrimmage for the Boilermakers this season
- Has 14 career games with 100-plus yards receiving, tied for the most in program history
- ... Joins John Standeford with the Purdue record
- Has 2,339 career receiving yards, eighth-most in team history
- ... Moves up three spots from 11th, and sits between DeAngelo Yancey's 2,344 from 2013-16 and Dave Young's 2,316 from 1977-80
- Has 177 career receptions, ninth-most in Purdue history
- ... Moves up two spots from 11th, and is between Rondale Moore's 178 from 2018-20 and Vinny Sutherland's 176 from 1997-2000
- Has 19 career touchdowns, which continues to be No. 8 all-time
- ... Is one shy of DeAngelo Yancey's 20 touchdowns from 2013-16
- Has had at least 100 receiving yards in 14 of his 22 career games and has reached triple digits in 11 of the last 13 games
- ... His 14 career 100-yard receiving games is the most by an active player in the country since 2019

Aidan O'Connell

- Was 30-for-40 for 375 yards with two passing touchdowns, a rushing touchdown and no interceptions
- ... Rushing touchdown was the first of his career
- ... Two passing touchdowns ties a season-best
- ... Has four career 300-yard passing games and two consecutive
- Has 287 career completions, 17th-most in school history, and 96 this season
- ... Moves up three spots from 20th, and is between Brandon Kirsch's 292 from 2002-05 and Caleb TerBush's 283 from 2009-12
- Has 21 career touchdown passes and six this season
- Has 3,135 career passing yards, No. 18 in team history, and 1,118 this season
- ... Moves into the top-20, and is between Dale Samuels' 3,161 from 1950-52 and Caleb TerBush's 3,077 from 2009-12
- Has 440 career passing attempts and 140 this season

King Doerue

- Rushed for a team-best 48 yards on XX attempts

TJ Sheffield

- Had eight catches for 48 yards with a touchdown catch
- ... Eight receptions doubles his career-best, 48 yards is a career high and one touchdown ties a personal-best, set achieved twice before
- Added one kick return for 20 yards

DEFENSE

Jaylan Alexander

- Led the team with 10 tackles, eight solo, with one tackle for loss

Marvin Grant

- Finished second on the team with a career-high-tying eight tackles, five solo, with a pass breakup

Kydran Jenkins

- Recorded six tackles, four solo, with one sack and 2.5 tackles for loss
- ... Six tackles doubles previous career high
- ... Sack and tackles for loss were the first of his career

Dedrick Mackey

- Had five tackles, all solo, with a tackle for loss and an interception
- ... Sack is the fourth of his career and first since November 23, 2019, at Wisconsin

Branson Deen

- Notched five tackles, two solo, with 1.5 sacks
- ... Five tackles and 1.5 sacks both are career-bests, topping four tackles and one sack, both achieved twice

Cam Allen

- Had two interceptions and four tackles, two solo
- ... Two interceptions is a career-best, the fifth and sixth of his career

Kieren Douglas

- Had an interception with two tackles, both solo
- ... Interception is the first of his career

George Karlaftis

- Registered one sack

SPECIAL TEAMS

Jack Ansell

- Punted four times, with one inside the 20, and registered an average distance of 35.3 yards with a long of 38

Mitchell Fineran

- Scored six points, three on a field goal and three on PATs
- Was one-for-two on field goal attempts, and is 10-for-12 this season
- Was a perfect three-for-three on PAT attempts, and is 16-for-16 this season
