#BOILERNOTES**Team Notes**

- Entering 42nd season of competition, entering the year with exactly 800 wins in program history
- Return five of the team's top-six scorers and 69.1 percent of its total scoring from 2015-16
- Two starters back which averaged double-figure scoring in the previous season (Morrisette, Perry) for the first time since 2013-14 (Moses, Houser)
- Return three starters with a combined 92 starts from last season; in years that Versyp returns at least three starters and over 60 starts, Purdue has averaged 24.1 wins per year and has made the NCAA Tournament every time
- Fifteen of the team's 20 wins in 2015-16 came by double-digits
- Set school records for fewest turnovers per game (14.5) and fouls per game (16.0) in 2015-16
- Turned in the seventh-most single-season blocks in program history, turning away 158 shots
- The 2016-17 senior class (Morrisette, Perry) looks to become the 10th duo in school history to each score 1,000 points

Exhibition Notes

- Purdue is 42-3 all-time in exhibition games, winning 37 straight entering Sunday
- The Boilermakers' last exhibition loss came against the U.S. National Team in 1999
- Purdue's single-game scoring record in an exhibition game is 120 points against Moldavia in 1993
- Senior Bridget Perry has led the team in scoring in each of Purdue's last two exhibitions, scoring 13 against Findlay in 2014 and posted 17 points and 13 rebounds against Marian in 2015
- The Boilermakers have surrendered an average of 32.0 points per game to their last four exhibition opponents, including a program-record low 25 to Findlay in 2014

Head Coach Sharon Versyp

- Heads into her 11th year as the Boilermakers' head coach, giving her the longest tenure of any coach in program history
- Winningest Purdue women's basketball head coach, earning 214 to date and 331 for her career, and second in program history in Big Ten Conference wins with 101
- Purdue's eight NCAA Tournament appearances under Versyp are the most under any head coach in program history
- Starred for the Boilermakers from 1985-88, scoring the 13th-most points in program history and was the fourth-fastest player at Purdue to reach 1,000-career points (77 games)
- One-of-2 Big Ten head coaches to lead her alma mater (Amy Williams, Nebraska)

#1 Ashley Morrisette

- 2015-16 Honorable Mention All-Big Ten
- Enters the season 187 points shy of 1,000 for her career, looking to become the 31st player in school history to hit the mark
- Has made a 3-pointer in 12 straight games entering 2016-17, trailing Katie Gearlds' program record of 22 straight set in 2006
- Ranked 16th in school history in 3-point field goals, netting 112 in her career
- Two assists shy of 200 for her career, currently ranked 27th in program history
- Hit four game-tying or winning shots in 2015-16 (Louisville, Dayton, Michigan and Penn State)
- Hometown of Twinsburg, Ohio is only 16.5 miles from exhibition opponent Ursuline College, both located east of Cleveland

#2 Abby Abel

- First and only walk-on player in Versyp's 10 seasons at the Boilermakers' head coach
- Served as a volunteer with Special Olympics for several years, including the 2015 Special Olympics World Summer Games in Los Angeles
- Attended the World Youth Summit in 2015, the USA Youth Summit in 2014 and the North American Youth Summit in 2013
- Brought the Special Olympics' "Play Unified" movement to the Purdue campus in April of 2016, hosting an event with various student-athletes and fraternities in Cardinal Court
- One-of-two boy/girl twins on the roster, along with Bridget Perry, and both siblings attend Purdue as well

#3 Tiara Murphy

- Her top freshman performance came on the biggest stage, posting six points, five rebounds and two assists in the NCAA Tournament First Round vs. Oklahoma, despite having the flu for the 48 hours leading up to the game
- Shot 47.6 percent from 3 on the season
- Hails from the same high school (South Bend Washington) as Notre Dame All-American and WNBA player Skylar Diggins

#5 Miracle Gray

- Earned honorable mention honors for the 2015 Naismith Award, awarded to the top high school players in the nation, after leading Stephenson High School to the Georgia AAAAA State Championship
- Younger sister of associate head coach Nadine Morgan
- Sister, Angel Gray was a four-year letterwinner at Florida State and now works as a reporter for the Atlanta Dream (WNBA) and Fox Sports 1

#10 Andreona Keys

- Switched numbers from #24 to #10 to start her junior season
- Keys is the 17th player in program history to change her number during her career and the first since Shayla Potter from the 1997 to 1998 seasons
- Had played in 63 consecutive games since stepping on campus, starting 42 contests
- Her 968 minutes played last season were the ninth-most in program history by a sophomore
- Became the fourth player in Purdue history to shoot 100 percent from the floor with at least seven FG attempts, hitting 7-of-7 in the season opener against Jacksonville State
- She is 1-of-21 underclassman in Purdue women's basketball history to ever be named a team captain
- Boilermakers were 14-3 last season when Keys grabbed at least five rebounds

#11 Dominique Oden

- Scored more than 2,000 career points in high school
- Named First Team All-State (Georgia) in 2016 and Second Team All-State in 2015 by the Atlanta Journal Constitution
- Attended the same high school (Marist) as 2013 Purdue honorable mention All-American Drey Mingo

#12 Nora Kiesler

- Blocked 31 shots last season, seventh-most by a freshman in program history
- Tied a 27-year old freshman record at Purdue with seven blocks at Penn State (Jan. 30)
- At 6'6", she's tied as the tallest player in program history, matching the recorded marks for Summer Erb and Michele VanGorp

#13 Bridget Perry

- Two-time Academic All-Big Ten honoree and biomedical engineering major
- Enters the season 340 points shy of 1,000 for her career, looking to become the 31st player in school history to hit the mark
- One-of-12 players in school history to open a season with a double-double, posting 14 points and 10 rebounds against Jacksonville State in 2015
- 2016 Barner Burner Trophy game MVP
- Owns a team-most six career double-doubles
- One-of-two boy/girl twins on the roster, along with Abby Abel, and both siblings attend Purdue as well

#20 Dominique McBryde

- First Purdue freshman to score 20 points in a game since Courtney Moses in 2011, topping the mark twice in 2015-16
- One-of-2 Purdue freshman to post five blocks in a game twice (Camille Cooper)
- Her 37 blocks were fourth-most by a Purdue freshman in program history
- Ranked 11th in the Big Ten in field goal percentage, hitting 52.4 percent from the floor, and posted the fifth-highest shooting percentage in conference play, dropping in 54.8 percent
- Tied for ninth in the conference with 1.2 blocked shots per game

#22 Bree Horrocks

- 2016 Academic All-Big Ten and a 2016 Big Ten Distinguished Scholar
- Became the fifth player in Purdue history (second Boilermaker in 2015-16) to shoot 100 percent from the floor with at least seven FG attempts, hitting 7-of-7 against Incarnate Word, scoring a career-high 15 points
- Finished second on the team in field goal percentage, hitting 50 percent from the floor
- Posted Purdue's fewest turnovers per minutes played in 2015-16, committing just 10 in 452 minutes on the year

#32 Ae'Rianna Harris

- Ranked as the No. 20 recruit in the nation in 2016 by ESPN Hoop Gurlz
- High school teammates with fellow Boilermaker freshman Lamina Cooper
- AP Second Team All-State (Indiana) in 2016

#40 Lamina Cooper

- Ranked as the No. 44 recruit in the nation in 2015 by ESPN Hoop Gurlz
- High school teammates with fellow Boilermaker freshman Ae'Rianna Harris
- AP Second Team All-State (Indiana) in 2015

Opponent Notes

- Ursuline had its best season in program history in 2015-16, posting a 25-4 record and reaching the NCAA Division II Tournament
- The Arrows return all five starters and six players who averaged more than 20 minutes per game in 2015-16
- Laney Lewis was the 2015-16 Great Midwest Athletic Conference Player of the Year, averaging 12.8 points and 11.2 rebounds per game
- Camryn Hill is Ursuline's returning leading scorer, posting 14.2 points per game
- Ursuline suffered a narrow loss to Cleveland State in its first exhibition game, 77-72
