THE SCENE SETTER

- The Purdue men's basketball team faces one of its most-challenging weeks of the season, beginning Wednesday at Ohio State. Winners of three straight games, the Boilermakers look to keep the momentum going against a Buckeyes' squad looking to snap a four-game skid.
- The contest will be televised on BTN with **Kevin Kugler** and **Seth Davis** calling the action courtside. On the radio waves, the contest will be available on the Purdue Radio Network and Tuneln.com with **Larry Clisby** and **Rob Blackman** on the call, beginning with the Purdue Basketball pregame show at 6 p.m. ET.
- Live stats will be provided on PurdueSports.com, and Twitter updates will be available on Purdue's official account (@BoilerBall).

THE MAIN TALKING POINTS

- 1) Purdue is looking for its second straight road win, with both of the games coming in two of the most-difficult arenas in the conference. The last time Purdue won at both Wisconsin and Ohio State in the same season was in 1996, before either Wisconsin's and Ohio State's arenas were built.
- 2) Purdue is looking for consecutive road wins at Ohio State for the first time since Feb. 15, 1996, and Feb. 7, 1998 (def. OSU 76-75 on Jan. 5, 2017).
- 3) Purdue has played the sixth-most difficult schedule in America, according to KenPom, having played nine top-40 foes (4-5 record).
- 4) Purdue is looking to start 6-2 in Big Ten play for the third straight year. Purdue is 13-1 in January over the last two seasons.
- 5) Purdue continues to excel on the offensive end, ranking sixth nationally in offensive efficiency. Purdue and Duke are the only teams to rank in the top 10 in offensive efficiency in 2017-18 and 2018-19. Purdue finished second a year ago behind National Champion Villanova.
- 6) Under **Matt Painter**, Purdue has been one of the best offensive teams in America. The Boilermakers have ranked in the nation's top 25 in offensive efficiency in six of the last nine seasons (lone years not in top 25: 2014-15, 2013-14, 2012-13).
- 7) Purdue is averaging just 10.7 turnovers per game, the fewest for the program since 2012 (8.7). Over the last nine games, Purdue is averaging just 8.6 turnovers per game and has an assist / turnover ratio of 1.79.
- 8) **Carsen Edwards** ranks fourth nationally in scoring (24.6 PPG). Since the 1992-93 season, just two other Big Ten players (Purdue's **Glenn Robinson** 2x, Michigan State's **Shawn Respert** 2x) have averaged at least 24.0 points per game in a season.
- 9) **Carsen Edwards** needs 11 points for 1,500 points and eight rebounds for 300 in career. He would become sixth player in school history with 1,500 points, 300 rebounds, 200 assists and 100 career steals.
- 10) With its win over Indiana, Purdue has now won 10 straight home games against in-state foes (last loss: Jan. 30, 2013).

THE SERIES

- Wednesday's meeting will be the 177th meeting between the Boilermakers and the Buckeyes. OSU leads the all-time series 90-86 and has won 26 of the last 35 meetings between the teams (26-9).
- Ohio State is the only Big Ten team to own a winning record against the Boilermakers.
- Purdue, however, has won three of the last five meetings with the Buckeyes to improve Coach Painter's record to 8-17 against Ohio State. Purdue was 5-15 in his first 20 meetings with the Buckeyes.
- Purdue is just 2-13 at Value City Arena, for a winning percentage of .133. Purdue's next worst winning percentage in a Big Ten arena is .273 at Indiana's Assembly Hall (12-32).

NO VALUE IN VALUE CITY

- Purdue hasn't had much success in Value City Arena, boasting a 2-13 record in the facility since its opening before the 1998-99 season.
- When a ranked Purdue team visits Value City Arena against an unranked Ohio State team, Purdue is just 1-3 in the building, winning the 2017 meeting by a 76-75 margin.
- Purdue's 13 losses at Value City Arena have come by an average of 11.7 points, including six losses by double-digits.
- Purdue's winning percentage of .133 (2-13) is easily the lowest in a Big Ten arena.

ONE OF THE NATION'S TOUGHEST SCHEDULES

- Purdue has played one of the nation's most-difficult schedules to date and could rise even higher thanks to a rigorous Big Ten slate.
- Purdue's schedule currently ranks as the sixth-hardest nationally behind Kansas, Penn State, Oklahoma, Illinois and Eastern Michigan.
- In Big Ten play only, Purdue will face a team that was ranked at the time of the game or ranked in the Dec. 31, poll in eight of its first nine league games.
- Purdue has played 13 teams ranked in the KenPom top 100, posting a 7-6 overall record.
- The strength of schedule has helped Purdue to a No. 15 NET rating. The next closest six-loss team not in the Big Ten is Florida (35th; 10-7).
- During the Painter era, the highest that a schedule has ever been ranked (KenPom) is eighth in 2012; the lowest is 2008 (62nd).

EFFICIENT OFFENSE

- Purdue is one of just two teams to currently boast a top-10 offense in each of the last two seasons.

THE TURNING POINT

- Purdue's turning point may have been the Notre Dame game. The Boilermakers fell 88-80 in Indianapolis and sat with a 6-5 record.
- Since that game, Purdue is 6-1 with the lone loss at Michigan State.

BOILERS TAKING CARE OF THE BALL

- Purdue has taken care of the ball this year, averaging just 10.7 turnovers per game, which would rank as the third-lowest average in school history (2012, 2011).
- However, over the last nine games, Purdue is averaging just 8.6 turnovers per game, while boasting an assist/turnover ratio of 1.79.
- Purdue is 21st nationally in turnover percentage (15.8 percent) and 17th nationally in turnovers per game (10.8).
- Over the last nine games, Purdue has a plus-5.33 turnover margin.

SHOOTING WINS

- Purdue is 142-15 under Painter when over 48.0 percent shooting, including 6-1 this season. The lone loss came to Virginia Tech (50.8 percent). It was Purdue's first loss when shooting 48-plus percent from the field since a Feb. 2017, loss to Michigan, a streak of 27 straight victories.

THE EXTRA POSSESSION GAME

- During the Painter era, Purdue is 110-9 when committing fewer turnovers and outrebounding its opponents in the same game.
- Since the start of the 2014-15 season, Purdue is 26-4 when that happens, having won 26 of its last 27 games when doing so (lone loss: Notre Dame).

USUALLY AUTOMATIC

- Purdue is 90-9 since the start of the 2014-15 season when attempting more free throws than its opponents.

SURGING FRESHMEN

- Matt Painter also really likes this freshman class, but it took a little bit of time to get them going. The group scored a season-high 39 points in the win over Rutgers, and has scored at least 10 points in each of the last eight games (five times in first 10 games).

► ROAD WARRIORS

- Since the start of the 2007-08 season, Purdue owns a 61-58 record, the third-most wins in the Big Ten during that span. Only four teams (Wisconsin, Michigan State, Ohio State, Purdue) have even won at least 40.0 percent of their road games during that span (not counting Maryland).
- Over the last 12 years, there have been just 10, 8-win road seasons by all the teams in the Big Ten (MSU - 3; Wisc. - 3; Purdue - 2; OSU - 1; Md. - 1).

ANALYTICS ABOUT THE MATCHUP

- Purdue ranks sixth in offensive efficiency according to KenPom.com; Ohio State is 26th in defensive efficiency.
- Ohio State is 55th in offensive efficiency; Purdue is 62nd nationally in defensive efficiency.
- Otherwise, nothing really stands out between this meeting, at least from an analytical standpoint.

- Purdue ranks in the top 50 nationally in five team categories (3-pointers per game - 10th; turnovers per game - 17th; assist / turnover ratio - 25th; turnover margin - 33rd; offensive rebounds per game - 46th).

HEAD COACH MATT PAINTER

- With four Sweet 16 appearances, 10 NCAA Tournament berths, two Big Ten regular-season championships, a Big Ten Tournament title and an international gold medal on his résumé, 14th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest young minds in all of college basketball.
- Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in October of 2018, agreeing to a two-year extension that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2023-24 season. The deal features five, one-year extensions that go into effect through the 2028-29 season. Following the 2029 season, Painter will still only be 58 years old.
- Painter entered the 2018-19 season third on the school's all-time wins list (295) behind legendary mentors, Gene Keady and Ward "Piggy" Lambert, both of whom have been inducted into the College Basketball Hall of Fame.
- Has averaged almost 23 wins a season in his 13 years at Purdue. If you don't include the first transitional year, the average balloons to 23.8 wins per year over the last 12 seasons.
- Has won at least 25 games in eight of his 14 seasons as a collegiate head coach.
- Painter's three Big Ten Coach of the Year honors are the fourth most in league history (Gene Keady - 7; Bobby Knight - 5; Bo Ryan - 4).
- Painter has averaged 10.9 wins per year in conference play, the fifth-best average in Big Ten Conference history.
- Is one of just three active coaches to have won a Big Ten championship.
- Painter's 10 NCAA Tournaments in the last 12 years are the ninth most in the country.
- Purdue's four Sweet 16 appearances in the last 10 years are the ninth most nationally.
- Painter's 324 wins are the third most nationally for a coach nationally in under 15 years of coaching.
- Coach Painter's 11 NCAA Tournaments are the most for a coach nationally under the age of 55 (as of Nov. 1, 2018 -- Painter is 48 years old).
- Has produced draft picks in each of the last three years, one of only six programs nationally that can say that.
- Purdue is one of five teams to have a Naismith position award finalist in each of the last three years.
- Purdue has finished first or second in Big Ten play in six of Painter's last 11 years.
- Purdue has led the Big Ten in scoring in each of the last two years, only the second team this century to do so.
- Has had 54 Academic All-Big Ten honorees in his 13 previous years at Purdue.
- Lastly, the four winningest classes in school history have come during the Painter era (2018, 2012, 2011, 2010).
