• Ross Learnard has pitched 24 1/3 consecutive scoreless innings dating back to Feb. 25. He has recorded the final out in nine of Purdue's 13 consecutive wins, earning eight saves.

#### - AROUND THE HORN -

• Purdue is riding a 13-game win streak, the longest active streak in the country and tied for the longest single-season streak in program history. The 1993 and 2001 teams also won 13 straight games. The Boilermakers are one of 12 teams nationally to win at least 13 consecutive games in 2018.

• Purdue has swept four Big Ten series in one season for the first time ever (never had swept three before). The nine-game win streak in Big Ten play in one short of the program's single-season record from 2001. With win streaks of six and eight straight games this year, the Boilermakers have posted a pair of win streaks of at least six games in consecutive years for the first time ever.

• Purdue's 13-game win streak has featured 119 innings. The Boilermakers have held the lead in 85 of those innings. They did not trail for 50 consecutive innings from April 22 to May 4. However, Purdue has rallied to win in the seventh inning or later four times during the streak.

• The Boilermakers scored five times in the ninth inning Wednesday at Ball State. Harry Shipley hit a game-tying three-run inside the park homer.

**BIG TEN PITCHER OF THE WEEK**

- Feb. 20, 2017
- March 6, 2017

- Joined all-time strikeouts leader Matt Bischoff (2008-10) as the only Purdue pitchers this century to start three straight season openers.
- Helped lead Purdue to a 18-8 record on Fridays dating back to the start of 2017.
- Matched his season high with nine strikeouts, a career high in Big Ten play, in the series-opening win at Maryland. Struck out UMD's 3-4-5 hitters in order in the 7th.
- Purdue has won each of his last 5 starts on the road in Big Ten play.
- Lost a 1-0 pitchers duel at Tulane to open the spring break trip, keeping the home team off the scoreboard until a two-out single in the eighth inning.
- Has worked a combined 13 2/3 innings of one-run ball in the last two season-opening wins, surrendering just seven hits while registering 18 strikeouts vs. one walk.
- Helped lead Purdue to a 10-5 record on Fridays as a junior.
- Recorded seven official quality starts in 2017, including three of his last four outings after a tough stretch in April; had four outings in which he did not allow a run.
- Struck out a career-high 10 over 7 2/3 shutout innings at Santa Clara in 2017, the most Ks by a Purdue pitcher since March 2012.
- Retired 27 of the 32 batters he faced in complete-game shutout at SEMO.
- Struck out nine over seven innings while retiring 21 of 24 batters faced at Texas State while leading Purdue to its first season-opening win since 2013.
- In 2017, became Purdue's first Big Ten Pitcher of the Week honoree since May 2012 and only the fifth Boilermaker to win the award twice in the same season.
- Pitched in a team-high 21 games in 2016, starting the opener of each of the first five weekends; Purdue's first non-freshman since 2011 to make his first start on a weekend.
- Excelled as a reliever in 2016, compiling a 1.34 ERA & .168 average against over 14 appearances, surrendering only 24 hits while striking out 32 in 40 1/3 innings.
- Made five of his seven appearances in Big Ten play as a freshman in 2015 despite not making his collegiate debut until April 11.
- Team MVP in football, basketball and baseball each of his upperclassman years at Tippecanoe Valley High School; all-state defensive back & wide receiver, area player of the year and second team all-state performer in basketball.

**BIG TEN PITCHER OF THE WEEK**

- April 24, 2017

- Has struggled with his command at times in 2018 due in part to a cracked finger nail on the index finger of his pitching hand; Purdue has still won 7 of his 10 starts.
- Almost didn't get out of the first inning at PSU, but went on to put together a quality start.
- Third Team All-Big Ten in 2017, Purdue's first all-conference pitcher since 2012.
- Limited Minnesota to 6 singles over 7 innings in the win that clinched Purdue's 2017 Big Ten Tournament berth.
- Was Purdue's top pitcher after start of Big Ten play last year, working a team-high 63 innings with a 2.43 ERA and .224 average against from March 25 to May 19.
- Threw a complete game 2-hitter vs. Illinois in 2017, retiring 27 of 29 batters faced to win Big Ten Pitcher of the Week honors.
- Delivered a much-needed quality start in the game two win at Ohio State, retiring 13 of the first 14 batters & working 7 2/3 innings of one-run ball.
- Appeared in 21 games, making 12 starts and recording 67 strikeouts in 70 innings pitched as a freshman at Coffeyville Community College in Kansas.
- Helped the Wisconsin Rapids Rafters win the 2016 Northwoods League title, recording five wins and 55 strikeouts over 60 innings pitched; also worked 4 1/3 innings of one-run ball, striking out six, in his playoff start.
- His high school did not sponsor baseball so he ran track in the spring while also playing football and basketball; played legion baseball in the summer, helping his team win the class C Nebraska state title in 2014.
- All A honor roll student and homecoming king.
- His mother Deb played volleyball at the University of Nebraska at Kearney.

## HEAD COACH MARK WASIKOWSKI

Mark Wasikowski, an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at the Universities of Oregon, Arizona, Florida as well as Southeast Missouri State during his career, was hired as the head coach of Purdue baseball in June 2016.

Wasikowski has played and coached in the College World Series. He helped lead teams to 14 NCAA Tournament appearances during a successful 20-year run as an assistant coach. He also won an NCAA championship as the starting third baseman and a captain on Pepperdine's 1992 College World Series team.

Wasikowski (pronounced WOZ-uh-COW-ski) played for and worked under three-time national Coach of the Year Andy Lopez for a combined 18 years. He was part of Lopez's coaching staffs at both Florida (1999-2001) and Arizona (2002-11) before joining George Horton's staff at Oregon in the summer of 2011, spending five seasons with Horton in Eugene. Wasikowski was an assistant coach on Arizona's 2004 College World Series team, the same year that Horton led Cal State Fullerton to the national title.

Wasikowski led the Boilermakers to a 19-win improvement in his first season. It ranked as the greatest turnaround in program history and tops nationally entering the week of the conference tournaments around the country. Purdue returned to the Big Ten Tournament for the first time since 2012 after winning 10 more games in league play. Wasikowski's team joined the 2007 Boilermakers as the only Big Ten teams since 1988 to post a 10-win improvement in conference play.

Purdue posted a pair of seven-game win streaks in 2017 and recorded 10-plus victories in both March and April. The Boilermakers won seven weekend series after having only six such successful weekends from 2013 to 2016. Purdue was 8-3 in one-run games after having a 2-13 record in similar contests the year before. The Boilermakers' 18 true road wins were tied with Minnesota for the most in the Big Ten.

Wasikowski is the 20th head coach in Purdue's 129-year history, but only the Boilermakers' fourth full-time skipper since 1978.

Wasikowski has coached 120 players that have been selected in the Major League Baseball Draft, a list highlighted by 29 big leaguers. During his 10 seasons at Arizona, Wasikowski coached 59 Major League Baseball draft picks and 22 future big leaguers. As the recruiting coordinator, he assembled the Wildcats' 2012 national championship team, leaving for Oregon before the start of the 2011-12 school year. Oregon was one of only three teams nationally to win 40-plus games every year from 2012 to 2014. During his five seasons in Eugene, the Ducks had 23 players drafted.

Wasikowski was a two-time All-West Coast Conference honoree at Pepperdine after spending his first two collegiate seasons at Hawaii and Rancho Santiago Junior College. He was selected by the Milwaukee Brewers in the 1993 MLB Draft, but opted to remain at Pepperdine to finish his bachelor's degree in business administration while serving as a student assistant under Lopez during the 1994 season. He also has a master's of business administration from Southeast Missouri.

Wasikowski was inducted into the Pepperdine Athletics Hall of Fame along with all of his teammates from the 1992 national championship team. He led the Waves in doubles as a junior and hits as a senior, guiding Pepperdine back to the NCAA Tournament in 1993.

Wasikowski and his wife, Lori Jo, are the parents of two daughters, Joelle and Kelsey.

As a player, I left Arizona much better than when I arrived. He was very good at the mental part of the game and pushing us to get to places we didn't know we could go. I still talk to Waz about once every three months. He is very loyal, and I would trust his character to run my program."

## LEARNARD FINISHING OFF NEARLY EVERY VICTORY

• **Ross Learnard** has closed out nine of Purdue's 13 consecutive wins. He enters the weekend riding a consecutive scoreless innings streak of 24 1/3, which is the second longest active run in the country behind only Duke's Jack Labosky. The Blue Devils' closer has not allowed a run all season (25 2/3 innings). Learnard's 0.61 career ERA in 73 1/3 innings is believed to be the lowest in the nation among pitchers that have worked at least 60 career innings.

• With 11 career saves in Big Ten play, Learnard has established a Purdue record. His 11 overall saves this season are tied for second in program history.

## DALESANDRO A MULTI-DIMENSIONAL WEAPON AT CATCHER

- **Nick Dalesandro** reached base safely 14 times for the week and caught all 27 innings of the series sweep of Rutgers (April 27-29), earning Big Ten Player of the Week honors after Purdue went 5-0. He's the first catcher to be recognized as Big Ten Player of the Week this season.
- Dalesandro recorded a pair of three-hit games during a 10-for-18 week, posting a .636 on-base percentage. He hit safely in all five wins and reached base safely in nine of his 13 plate appearances in the weekend sweep.
- Behind the plate, Dalesandro worked with a Purdue pitching staff that surrendered just eight runs in five games. The Boilermakers blanked Rutgers on both Friday and Sunday, registering a pair of shutout wins in a Big Ten series for the first time since May 1992.
- Along with being one of the top throwing catchers in the Big Ten, Dalesandro is also the fastest. He has thrown out 18 base stealers to lead the league entering the weekend. He's the only catcher among the top 15 in the Big Ten in stolen bases as a runner. Dalesandro is believed to be tops nationally for stolen bases among catchers. He's just the 11th Boilermaker to register 20 steals in a season.

## McGOWAN POWERS EXTRA-INNINGS WIN AT MARYLAND

- **Jacson McGowan** connected for solo home runs to left field in the ninth and 11th innings, powering Purdue to a 4-3 win in comeback fashion April 21 at Maryland. The Boilermakers went on to sweep the series. Purdue is 10-0 this year when McGowan has homered.
- McGowan led off the ninth inning with a towering blast to tie the game. With another long ball two frames later, he lifted the Boilermakers to their second extra-innings victory of the week and third of the season. They rallied to win after trailing entering the ninth inning for the third time this year.
- McGowan hit the first go-ahead or game-tying home run by a Boilermaker in the ninth inning since Sean McHugh in May 2014 at Minnesota. But the Gophers went on to win that game in the 10th. McHugh also accounted for the last game-tying shot in the ninth of a Purdue win, hitting a pinch-hit homer against Indiana State in May 2012 in the final game at Lambert Field. The Boilermakers went on to win on a 10th-inning walk-off.
- With his 10th and 11th homers, McGowan has joined Kyle Wood as the only Boilermakers to post a double-figure home run total in the BBCOR bat era (2011-present).
- Entering the week, Purdue had not won in extra innings in a true road game since April 2014 at Michigan State. The April 17 win at Indiana State came in 10 innings. The Boilermakers have two such wins in the same season for the first time since 2010. Purdue has three extra-innings wins of any kind for the first time since 2012.
- The Boilers have eight wins when tied or trailing after six innings. They're 21-1 when leading after six.

## LEARNARD IS LEAGUE'S FIRST RELIEVER TO BE PITCHER OF THE WEEK SINCE 2015

- **Ross Learnard** was on the mound when the final out was recorded of all four of Purdue's wins the week of April 17 to 22, earning the closer Big Ten Pitcher of the Week honors as the league's first reliever recognized since March 2015. Learnard retired 18 of 22 batters faced over 6 1/3 innings of two-hit relief. He earned the save in all three games of the series at Maryland.
- Learnard is the first reliever to be named Big Ten Pitcher of the Week since Illinois' Tyler Jay in March 2015. Jay went on to earn Big Ten Pitcher of the Year that season before being selected sixth overall in the MLB First-Year Player Draft.
- Learnard is the first Boilermaker to record three saves in one weekend series since at least the beginning of the 2000 campaign. Scott Helmer established a Purdue single-season record with 13 saves in 2000, but did not have three in one weekend. Helmer did record a save in three consecutive games twice that year, but both times it was against three different opponents -- Penn State, Ball State, Iowa (April 2-7) and Notre Dame, Valparaiso, Indiana (April 11-14).
- Learnard is the Boilermakers' first reliever to be named Big Ten Pitcher of the Week since Nick Wittgren in March 2012. Wittgren closed out two of Purdue's three wins at a tournament hosted by Auburn, tying the program's all-time saves record in the process.
- Learnard led the way as the Purdue bullpen worked 26 1/3 innings of four-run ball the week of April 16 to 22, recording 25 strikeouts vs. six walks. **Trevor Cheaney** (3 App, 4 2/3 IP, 2 H, 0 BB, 7 K) was the only other Boilermaker to appear in at least three of the five games.
- **Dalton Parker** was the last Purdue reliever to record a pair of saves in a weekend series, closing out consecutive contests in the four-game sweep at Santa Clara in March of last season.
- Joe Eichmann (April 2015 vs. Iowa) was the last player to pitch in all three games of a weekend series.

## NISLE HOMERS TWICE IN OPENER WITH MINNESOTA

- **Ben Nisle** homered twice in the April 13 series opener with Minnesota, posting the first multi-homer game by a Boilermaker in over two years (March 2016). It was only the third multi-homer game by a Purdue player at Alexander Field. He joined **Alec Olsund** as the team's only freshmen to post multi-homer games in the BBCOR bat era (2011-present) and became the first freshman since 2010 to go deep twice in a Big Ten game.
- Nisle also connected for a solo homer in the fourth inning of the series finale at Maryland. It was his sixth home run, three coming in Big Ten play. He's the first Purdue freshman with six since Kyle Wood in 2013 and the first true freshman to hit at least six in the BBCOR bat era.

## MCGOWAN TAKING HIS WALKS

- Since hitting a two-run homer, his ninth of the year at the time, in the April 6 series-opening win at Indiana, **Jacson McGowan** has drawn 29 free passes (25 walks, 4 HBP) in 93 plate appearances. The opposition's reluctance to pitch to Purdue's top power hitter helped limited him to just one extra-base hit and six RBI over an eight-game stretch from April 7 to 20. However, he has posted a .516 on-base percentage over Purdue's last 20 games since the Friday win in Bloomington. Rutgers walked him six times in 13 plate appearances the weekend of April 27 to 29.
- Purdue is 22-6 when he has an RBI this season and 7-10 when he does not.
- McGowan leads the Boilermakers with a .465 on-base percentage and has more walks (39) than strikeouts (33), a unique feat for a power hitter with over 200 plate appearances.

## LEARNARD EVEN BETTER THIS YEAR?

- **Ross Learnard** has been charged with a run in just four of his 49 career appearances as a Boilermaker. After earning second team All-America honors from the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association in 2017 for posting a program-record 0.58 ERA over 46 1/3 innings, he has excelled again this season despite a higher profile role as the team's closer. The only runs he has given up this season came on a two-run homer Feb. 24 vs. Notre Dame. Additionally, he's allowed only two of 14 inherited runners to score in 2018.
- From March 28 through April 17, Learnard recorded 10 of his 12 outs via strikeouts in the final inning of the four Purdue victories he closed out. He had two wins and two saves during that stretch, working 6 1/3 innings of four-hit relief. He struck out the side again May 9 at Ball State.
- Learnard has a 0.61 ERA in 73 1/3 career innings. He needs to pitch just one and two-thirds additional innings to be eligible for Purdue's career ERA leaderboard (minimum 75 innings). He eclipsed Steve Krull's minimum 30 innings ERA record (0.60) last year that had stood since 1965. Krull (1.46) also owns the program's all-time ERA records for 75 and 125 innings.
- Learnard has pitched 24 1/3 consecutive scoreless innings since giving up the home run on Feb. 24. A year ago he had a streak of 35 2/3 consecutive scoreless innings from March 11 through May 14.
