• Purdue looks to continue its unbeaten start on Saturday night when Patriot League favorite Lehigh comes to town for a visit. Tip is slated for 7 p.m. ET from Mackey Arena (14,846) in West Lafayette.

• The contest will be streamed online on ESPN3.com with **Wayne Randazzo** and **Rich Zvosec** calling the action courtside.

• On the radio waves, **Larry Clisby**, **Rob Blackman** and **Ralph Taylor** will handle the call on the 27-station Purdue Sports Network. Coverage begins with the Purdue Basketball pregame show one hour before tip.

• Live stats will be available via Gametracker on PurdueSports.com, and StatBroadcast will provide media stats (password protected) at bit.ly/PurdueLiveStats. As always, Twitter updates will be provided on the official Purdue basketball account, @BoilerBall.

Scouting Purdue

• The No. 16-ranked Boilermakers are 5-0 for the fifth time in 11 years under **Matt Painter** after winning the Hall of Fame Tipoff Classic in Connecticut last weekend.

• The Boilermakers are sizzling on both sides of the floor, ranking in the top 50 nationally in scoring offense (33rd), field goal percentage (24th) and 3-point percentage (24th), while also ranking in the top 50 in scoring defense (15th), field goal percentage defense (7th) and rebound margin (11th).

• Purdue has used a balanced attack to jump out to a 5-0 record as eight regulars average at least 6.2 points per game. The Boilermakers are shooting 50.5 percent from the field and 41.8 percent from long distance.

• **Isaac Haas** (13.2), **Rapheal Davis** (11.6), **A.J. Hammons** (11.0), **Vince Edwards** (10.8) and **Caleb Swanigan** (10.2) all average in double figures. Haas and Swanigan have both recorded a pair of double-doubles.

Scouting Lehigh

• One of the top mid-major programs in the country, Lehigh made waves a few years ago after defeating Duke in the NCAA Tournament thanks to the rise of current Portland Trailblazer **C.J. McCollum**.

• The Mountain Hawks are one of the favorites to win the Patriot League, but have started 0-5 with losses to Syracuse (57-47), Canisius (98-89), Yale (79-67), Columbia (88-61) and Virginia (80-54).

• Leading Lehigh is the 2015 Patriot League Player of the Year, center **Tim Kempton** (16.6 PPG, 7.4 RPG). Last year's Rookie of the Year, **Kahron Ross**, averages 9.0 points and 5.4 assists per game.

• As a team, Lehigh is getting outrebounded by a 9.8 per game margin.

The Coaches

• **Matt Painter** (Purdue, 1994) is in his 11th year at Purdue, owning a 217-125 record. Painter is one of six coaches in Big Ten history to win three Big Ten Coach of the Year awards and his 217 wins are the third most by a Purdue coach in school history.

• **Dr. Brett Reed** (Eckerd, 1995) is in his ninth year at Lehigh, owning a 145-110 record with the Mountain Hawks. Reed owns a Ph.D. in instructional technology with a cognate in sports administration.

- Inside the Series**
- This marks the first meeting against the Mountain Hawks.
 - Purdue is 5-1 all-time against teams from the Patriot League, but actually lost its last meeting with a school from the league. The Boilermakers dropped a 70-65 decision to Bucknell in the 2012-13 season opener.
 - The loss to Bucknell is the only home loss during the month of November under **Matt Painter**.
 - Purdue is 1-0 against Army, 2-0 against Boston University, 1-0 vs. Colgate, 1-0 vs. Lafayette and 0-1 against Lafayette.
 - **Matt Painter** is 0-1 against Patriot League schools, falling to Bucknell in the above-mentioned game.
 - Lehigh is the 12th team from the state of Pennsylvania that Purdue will have faced. The Boilermakers are 50-24 all-time against teams from the state of Pennsylvania.
 - Purdue is 7-3 all-time on November 28, including 2-2 under Painter.

■ Painter Moving Up the Charts

- **Matt Painter** has moved into third place on the school's career games coached list, leading his squad into his 343rd game in his 11th season on Saturday against Lehigh.
 - Painter owns a 217-125 (.635) record, the third-most wins for a head coach in school history.
 - With the 5-0 start, Painter has moved into fifth place on the school's career winning percentage list with a .635 winning percentage.

- Since the **Ray Eddy** era began in 1950, Purdue has had just six head coaches in 66 years, and just eight head coaches in the last 99 years.

■ Tournament Champs

- With Sunday's win over Florida, Purdue won its first tournament title since November 2009 when it won the Paradise Jam. The tournament title was its 12th preseason / non-conference tournament championship all-time and the second of **Matt Painter's** career at Purdue.

■ Winning Margins

- Through games played on Thursday, Purdue and Cincinnati are the only teams in America to have 5-0 records and win each game by at least 15 points.

■ Lots of Points

- Purdue is averaging 86.0 points per game to rank third in the Big Ten in scoring and 33rd nationally. The highest Purdue has ever finished under **Matt Painter** in scoring offense nationally was 69th in the 2010-11 season.

■ Defense Lives Here

- Purdue has posted some ridiculous defensive efforts so far this year, leading the Big Ten in scoring defense (57.8) and ranking 15th nationally.
- Purdue is seventh nationally in field goal percentage defense (.325) through Wednesday's games. Foes are making just 35.2 percent of its shots inside the 3-point line, good for ninth nationally.
- In 1,646 games this year played by Division I teams (through Thursday), there have been five games where a Division I team held another Division I team to 40 or fewer points. Purdue has done it twice.

■ The Word According to Ken Pomeroy

- We here at Purdue like to follow statistician **Ken Pomeroy** and his numbers paint a pretty picture for the Boilermakers.
- Purdue ranks 14th in adjusted offensive efficiency (112.6 / 100 possessions) and 10th in adjusted defensive efficiency (92.3).

- Purdue has started 5-0 or better in 13 of the last 36 seasons dating to the 1979-80 campaign.
- Purdue has now started 5-0 or better in five of **Matt Painter's** 11 seasons at Purdue. Purdue's last 6-0 start came with during a 14-0 start to begin the 2009-10 season.

■ Sizzling From 20 Feet, 9 Inches

- A year after shooting just 32.7 percent from 3-point range and with many questions entering the season about perimeter play, Purdue has quieted those discussions at least for now.
- The Boilermakers connected on a school-record 18 3-pointers in the win over Vermont on November 15, one game after making 12 in the season opener against North Carolina A&T.
- The Boilermakers are shooting 41.8 percent (56-of-134) from 3-point range to rank 24th nationally, one year after ranking 239th.
- In addition, Purdue ranks sixth nationally in 3-pointers per game, making 11.2 trifectas per game.
- Of teams that rank in the top 25 nationally in 3-point percentage, Purdue's 11.2 3-pointers per game are the third most behind North Florida (12.8 per game) and Portland (12.2 per game).
- Seven different players have made at least two 3-pointers in a game this year (Cline, Davis, Edwards, Mathias, Stephens, Swanigan, Thompson). Four different players (Cline, Edwards, Mathias, Stephens) have made at least four trifectas in a game this year.
- Last season, Purdue had just seven players make at least 10 3-pointers for the entire season. This year, Purdue has seven players averaging at least 1.0 3-pointer per game, a rate that would give the Boilermakers seven players with at least 30 3-pointers this year.
- Purdue's 18 3-pointers against Vermont are tied for the most nationally in a game this season.

■ Gimme All The Points

- Purdue is averaging 1.20 points per possession to rank 16th nationally, while defensively, the Boilermakers are allowing just 0.78 points per possession to rank sixth nationally.
- Purdue is one of five teams (Purdue, Louisville, Cincinnati, West Virginia, Houston) to rank in the top 20 nationally in points per possession on both sides of the ball.

■ November Reign

- Purdue has dominated the opposition at home during the month of November, going 36-1 (.973) under head coach **Matt Painter**. The lone loss was on Nov. 9, 2012, to Bucknell (70-65). The average margin of victory in those games is 25.5 points (918 points).
- Going back further, Purdue is 71-7 (.910) all-time at Mackey Arena during the month of November.
- Painter owns a 50-13 overall record during the month of November.

■ Large Margins

- The 28-point halftime lead (44-16) against North Carolina A&T was tied for the 16th-largest margin in school history.
- The 41-point victory (81-40) against North Carolina A&T was tied for the 15th-largest margin of victory in Mackey Arena history.
- Purdue has won its first five games by 15 or more points for the second time in school history (2010-11).

■ Win When Shooting More

- Purdue has won 22 straight games when shooting more free throws than its opponent, including four times this year.

■ Boilermakers Hot at Home

- Purdue enters Saturday's game against Lehigh having won nine straight games at Mackey Arena. Purdue has won the nine straight games by a combined 149 points (16.6 PPG).
- With nine non-conference home games on the slate, an undefeated non-conference schedule will give Purdue 15 straight home wins, which would tie for the sixth-longest home winning streak in Mackey Arena history.
- A win on Saturday would give **Matt Painter** his fifth double-digit home winning streak in his 11 years at Purdue.

■ The Swat Club

- Purdue blocked 13 shots against Incarnate Word on Nov. 18, the second most in a game nationally this season and the third most in a game in school history.
- Purdue has blocked 33 shots, the eighth most nationally so far this year and its 6.6 per game average is 17th nationally.

■ Blocked Shot University

- In six of the last seven years, Purdue has had the Big Ten's top shot-blocker as **A.J. Hammons** led the league in blocked shots for the third straight season (2.78 BPG) a year ago.
- Hammons' 2.78 blocks per game were the most for a Big Ten player since Ohio State's **Greg Oden** averaged 3.44 BPG in the 2006-07 season. It's the second-best average since the 2001-02 season (behind Oden).
- Hammons became the third player in Big Ten history to lead the league in blocked shots at least three times (2013-15). Penn State's **Calvin Booth** led the league in blocks four times from 1996-99, while Purdue's **JaJuan Johnson** led the league from 2009-11.
- Prior to 2009, no Purdue player had ever led the league in blocked shots.
- Purdue's 177 blocks were the most in a season in school history and the 5.21 blocked shots per game were the second-highest average in school history behind last year's average of 5.25 blocks per game.

■ Gameday Adjustments

- Last year, Purdue went 0-4 when being outscored in the paint. Already twice this year, Purdue has won two games when being outscored in the paint (Florida and Vermont).

■ Balancing Act

- Most impressive of Purdue's offensive attack this year has been Purdue's balance. The Boilermakers have had nine players record double-figure scoring games this year and five different players have led the team in scoring.
- In four of Purdue's five games this year, it has had at least five players score in double figures and no Purdue player has scored more than 18 points in a game.
- In its five games, Purdue has had 25 double-figure scoring efforts.
- All told, Purdue has six players averaging between 9.8 and 13.2 points per game and 10 players averaging between 12.0 and 26.8 minutes per contest.

■ Terrific Thompson

- P.J. Thompson** came off the bench to spark Purdue to its 15-point win over Florida last Sunday, tallying career highs in points (15), rebounds (5) and assists (4).
- Even more impressive about Thompson is his ability to take care of the ball. Thompson has zero turnovers in the first five games this year, spanning 103 minutes of playing time.

■ Hammons Continues His Climb

- A.J. Hammons** now ranks second on the Purdue career blocked shots list with 266, needing 83 to tie **Joe Barry Carroll** for first on the Purdue list (349).
- Hammons' 266 blocks are the second most for an active player nationally behind Austin Peay's **Chris Horton** (270).

■ Painter Joins Big Ten's 100-Win Club

- With Purdue's 92-85 win over Rutgers on Feb. 26, **Matt Painter** became the 20th coach in Big Ten history to win 100 Big Ten games. Painter is averaging over 10 wins a year in league play.
- Matt Painter** coached his 337th game in his 10th season at Purdue and his 367th career game in his 11th season. Painter ranks third on the career wins list at Purdue (212) and is one of six coaches in Big Ten history to have won three or more Big Ten Coach of the Year accolades.
- Painter's winning percentage of .629 ranks sixth among all Purdue coaches with a minimum of 40 games coached. **Fred Schaus** (1973-78) is fifth with a .634 winning percentage.

• With a pair of Sweet 16 appearances, six NCAA Tournament berths, Big Ten regular-season and tournament titles and an international gold medal on his résumé, 10th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest minds in all of college basketball.

• Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in March of 2011, agreeing to a new eight-year contract that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2018-19 season.

• Painter has averaged over 21 wins per season during his tenure at the helm of the Purdue program, including at least 20 victories in six of those seasons.

• Painter's tenure has seen Purdue basketball restore its status among the upper echelon of college basketball programs. The last eight years have seen six 20-win seasons and NCAA Tournament berths, two Sweet 16 appearances, a regular-season Big Ten title and a Big Ten Tournament crown.

• The three winningest classes in program history are the classes of 2011, 2012 and 2010, respectively, and five of the 10 winningest individual players Purdue has ever seen have come from the Painter ranks. Success, however, didn't happen overnight.

• Painter officially became the 18th head men's basketball coach in Purdue history on April 1, 2005, and immediately set about laying the groundwork for a dramatic reversal in the program's fortunes.

• The Boilermakers were at their best during the 2009 postseason run, rattling off double-digit victories over Penn State and Illinois to reach the Big Ten Tournament final, where they dispatched Ohio State, 65-61, to earn the first conference tournament crown in program history.

• Painter has also resurrected Mackey Arena as one of the country's best home-court advantages, piling up a 140-31 (.819) record at home over the last nine seasons, including a remarkable 76-7 (.916) record against non-conference opponents.

• Painter has been named Big Ten Coach of the Year three times in the last six seasons, earning the consensus award in 2008 and 2011, and winning the coaches' vote in 2010. He is one of only six men to win the award more at least three times since its inception in 1974.

• Painter has seen a total of 21 players earn a combined 40 Academic All-Big Ten honors during his tenure as head coach. Painter has also mentored an Academic All-American, as Moore earned second-team honors during the 2009-10 season.
