

Purdue Football Postgame Notes

Indiana 44, Purdue 41 (2OT)

Nov. 30, 2019 – Ross-Ade Stadium, West Lafayette, Indiana (55,338)

Head Coach Jeff Brohm

- is now 47-31 in his sixth year as a head coach.
- is now 17-21 in his third year at Purdue.
- is now 13-13 in day games at Purdue.
- is now 12-15 against Big Ten opponents.
- is now 2-1 vs. Indiana.
 - ... won 31-24 in West Lafayette (Nov. 25, 2017)
 - ... won 28-21 in Bloomington (Nov. 24, 2018)
 - ... lost 44-41 (2OT) in West Lafayette (Nov. 30, 2019)

Purdue Records

- is now 618-575-48 all-time.
- is now 335-406-32 in Big Ten play.
- is now 71-42-6 all-time vs. Indiana.

Team Notes

- Purdue is 74-42-6 all-time against Indiana and 38-23-4 at home, while the Boilermakers hold a 61-32-3 advantage since the Old Oaken Bucket was introduced in 1925.
- Today was the second overtime game in the all-time series and first since 2010 (L, 34-31 in West Lafayette).
- Today's game was the 22nd in the all-time series decided by three or fewer points.
- Purdue's five team sacks were its most since it had six on Sept. 8, 2018, against Eastern Michigan.
- Purdue is 5-10 all-time in overtime games.
- Purdue had a 200-yard passer, a 100-yard rusher and a 100-yard receiver in the same game for the first time since Oct. 20, 2018, against Ohio State (Aidan O'Connell, 408 yards passing, Zander Horvath, 164 yards rushing, Brycen Hopkins, 142 yards receiving, David Bell, 136 yards receiving).
- Today was the third game this season where Purdue had multiple 100-yard receivers (most since at least 1997).
- Purdue finished with a season-high 589 yards of total offense (408 pass, 181 rush); it's only game with at least 400 passing yards and 181 rushing yards since at least 1997.

Zander Horvath

- Had career-highs with 23 carries, 146 yards and two touchdowns.
- Had a team season-long 48-yard rush in the second quarter.
- Had 239 all-purpose yards, the most by a Purdue running back since Raheem Mostert had 270 in 2014 at Minnesota.

Brycen Hopkin

- Tallied eight receptions for 142 yards and two touchdowns and also scored the game-tying two-point conversion late in the fourth quarter.
- Had a team season-long 72-yard reception on a touchdown catch in the second quarter.
- Is now 21st in program history in career receptions (130).
- Is now 12th in program history in career receiving yards (1,945).

David Bell

- Hauled in nine receptions for 136 yards and a touchdown.
- Finished the season with 86 receptions, 1,035 yards and seven touchdowns through the air.
- Tied for eighth in receptions and 12th in receiving yards in a single season in program history.
- Had 81 catches in Big Ten games, which ties Rondale Moore (2018) for the second-most in a conference season in Big Ten history.

Derrick Barnes

- Recorded 10 tackles (nine solo), including career-highs of 2.5 sacks and 3.5 TFL.

George Karlaftis

- Recorded five tackles, including 1.5 sacks.
