THE SCENE SETTER BETWEEN THE BOILERMAKERS AND THE SUN DEVILS

• The No. 17-ranked Purdue men's basketball team looks for its third straight neutral-site victory when it travels to the Big Apple to face an explosive Arizona State team in the Jimmy V Classic, tipping off Tuesday at 7:04 p.m. ET from Madison Square Garden ... the game will be televised by ESPN with **Dave O'Brien, Jay Bilas** and **Maria Taylor** on the call ... on the radio dial, the game will be available on the Purdue Sports Network and **TuneIn.com** as **Larry Clisby** and **Rob Blackman** provide brilliant commentary, beginning with the Purdue Basketball pregame show one hour before tip. It will also be available on ESPN National Radio ... live stats will be available at StatBroadcast.com.

#BOILERNOTES

- Purdue is ranked No. 17 in the Associated Press top-25 poll, up two spots from last week ... the Boilermakers have been ranked in the AP Top 25 in each of the last 24 polls, the eighth-longest active streak nationally ... Purdue is ranked 19th in the coaches poll, down three from last week.
- Purdue's two losses have come by teams ranked first (Villanova) and seventh (Louisville on the road) in the latest **KenPom.com** rankings.
- The Boilermakers have made 62 trifectas over the last five games and now rank 13th nationally in 3-pointers per game (10.5) ... Purdue is now shooting 43.3 percent from long distance during the season, good for fifth nationally and first in the Big Ten ... over the last five games, Purdue is shooting 62-of-127 (.488) from long distance during that span.
- The Boilermakers committed a season-low nine turnovers in the win over Morehead State, while dishing out a season-high 27 helpers ... Purdue ranks seventh nationally in assists per game (19.8) and has had at least 20 assists in five-of-eight games.
- Purdue has recorded assists on 69.9 percent of its made field goals, ranking third nationally in assist rate (A / FGM).
- Purdue has been outrebounded already twice this year (Georgia State, Louisville) ... a year ago, Purdue was the last team nationally to be outrebounded, coming Feb. 13, against Michigan.

A WIN WOULD...

- Be Purdue's third straight victory at neutral sites after winning the Cancun Challenge during Thanksgiving week.
- Snap a three-game losing streak in Madison Square Garden dating to the 2008 NIT Season Tipoff.
- Be Purdue's first win over a Pac-12 team since the 2009 NCAA Tournament, a 76-74 victory over Washington to advance to the Sweet 16.

- Purdue improved to 19-0 all-time against the Ohio Valley Conference ... Purdue's average margin of victory in the wins is 24.8 points per game.
- Purdue's nine turnovers were a season low.
- Purdue had 27 assists on 34 made field goals ... the Boilermakers had four players with at least five assists (Swanigan, C. Edwards, V. Edwards, Thompson) ... the 27 assists were a season high ... Purdue is now assisting on 69.9 percent of its made field goals (3rd nationally) and averaging 19.8 assists per game.
- Purdue improved to 271-29 (.903) against unranked, non-conference foes all-time at Mackey Arena ... Matt Painter improved to 158-33 (.827) in Mackey Arena.
- Purdue's 15 made 3-pointers tied for the fourth most in a game in school history ... over the last five games, Purdue is 62-of-127 (.488) from 3-point range and is now shooting 43.3 percent from deep for the season.
- Purdue has now won 83 straight games when scoring 90 or more points, dating to Nov. 24, 1987.
- Purdue had two more runs of 10-0 or longer and now have had seven runs of 10-0 or longer this year ... opponents have had one.
- Morehead State shot zero free throws, the first time in school history that an opponent has had zero free throw attempts.
- Purdue was also whistled for just eight fouls, the third fewest in a game in school history.
- Purdue had five players in double figures for the third time in eight games already.
- Carsen Edwards tallied 16 points and a career-high five assists while going 4-of-7 from long distance ... over the last four games, Edwards is averaging 16.3 points per game and has made 12-of-25 (.480) from long distance.
- Caleb Swanigan tallied 13 points with nine rebounds and a career-high six assists ... he has led the team in rebounding every game this year ... however, Swanigan saw his five-game double-double streak end.
- Vincent Edwards tallied a career-high tying eight assists.
- Dakota Mathias grabbed a career-high tying six rebounds ... Mathias is shooting 22-of-40 (.550) from 3-point range this year.
- Ryan Cline is now 6-of-8 from 3-point range over the last two games.

BOILERMAKER QUICK HITTERS

- Purdue is 276-37 (.882) all-time against non-conference foes in Mackey Arena, including a 271-29 (.903) record vs. unranked, non-conference foes.
- Matt Painter is 86-8 (.915) at Mackey Arena against non-conference opposition.
- Since the start of the 2015-16 season, Purdue is 32-11 (.744) in all games played, including 18-4 (.818) vs. non-conference foes.
- Purdue needs to win 23 games this year to have 50 wins in back-to-back seasons for just the eighth time in school history.
- Purdue's 62 trifectas over the last four games are the most in a five-game span in school history ... Purdue is shooting 62-of-127 (.488) in that span ... though early, Purdue is on pace for 336 3-pointers (32-game schedule), which would smash the existing school record (284 in 2011-12).
- Purdue is shooting just 36.8 percent from long distance in four home games this year ... away from Mackey, Purdue is shooting 55.1 percent.
- Purdue's 17 3-pointers made against Auburn were the second most in school history and its 15 triples vs. Morehead State tied for the fourth most in a game in school history.
- Purdue has made a 3-pointer in 972-of-978 games since the 3-point line was introduced before the 1986-87 season, including 120 straight ... Purdue has made at least two 3-pointers in 947-of-978 games, including 109 straight games.
- Purdue made 10 trifectas against Louisville, the first time Purdue has lost when making double-digit 3-pointers since March 4, 2015, vs. Michigan State, a span of 11 games ... Purdue is 40-9 under Coach Painter when making 10 or more 3-pointers.
- Purdue is 101-13 under Matt Painter when shooting 48.0 percent or better from the floor ... the Boilermakers are 5-0 this year when holding foes under 48.0 percent shooting.
- Purdue has won 83 straight games when scoring 90 or more points, dating to Nov. 24, 1987, vs. Iowa State (L, 104-96).
- When Purdue holds foes to 59 or fewer points under Painter, the Boilermakers are 118-4 ... three of the losses (Eastern Michigan, Iowa, Nebraska) came during the 2012-13 season.
- The Boilermakers have recorded at least 20 assists in 5-of-8 games this year, ranking seventh nationally in assists per game (19.8) ... eight of Purdue's nine regulars average at least 1.0 assist per game ... Purdue had four players with at least five assists in the win over Morehead State.
- Purdue has already had eight 20-point performances by four different players this year ... Purdue had 13, 20-point showings all of last year.
- Purdue ranks 329th (out of 347 teams) in blocked shots per game (1.4 per game) ... in the last four years with A.J. Hammons roaming the paint, Purdue ranked 59th, 29th, 17th and 41st nationally in blocked shots.
- Purdue is 17th nationally in offensive efficiency and 21st in defensive efficiency, according to KenPom.com ... the Boilermakers are 1-of-10 teams to rank in the nation's top 21 in both categories.
- Over the last four games, Purdue's bench is averaging 25.5 points and shooting 41.9 percent from 3-point range (18-of-43) ... in the first four games, the group averaged 15.5 points per game, while shooting 37.5 percent from the field and 19.2 percent from long distance.
- Purdue has made 127 free throws this season, while opponents have shot just 104 ... Purdue is outscoring opponents by an average of 6.6 points per game from the free throw line ... the last time that Purdue made more free throws than opponents have shot for an entire season came in the 1997-98 campaign (made 657; opponents shot 572).
- Morehead State had zero free throw attempts on Saturday, the first time in school history that a foe had zero attempts ... since the 2010-11 season, it has happened just 16 times in Division I play and three times by a Big Ten team.
- With Carsen Edwards starting Saturday against Morehead State, head coach Matt Painter has had a freshman in the starting lineup in 132 of the last 143 games, dating to the start of the 2012-13 season.
- Caleb Swanigan has grabbed 30.9 percent of all of Purdue's rebounds (92-of-298).
- Isaac Haas (9.1) ranks fourth nationally in fouls drawn per 40 minutes.
- Dakota Mathias is 18-of-31 (.581) from 3-point range over the last six games.

BIG TEN SUCCESS UNDER PAINTER

- Since the 2006-07 season, the Purdue basketball team under Matt Painter has been one of the most-successful teams in the Big Ten.

SERIES HISTORY

- Purdue and Arizona State will meet for the sixth time Tuesday with Purdue owning a 3-2 series lead ... it marks the first meeting since the 2002-03 season ... in three of the six meetings, Purdue has been ranked in the nation's top 17 ... Purdue is looking for its first win over a Pac 12 team since the 2009 NCAA Tournament (Washington).
- The two teams made a combined 33 3-pointers in their last respective games (ASU - 18; Purdue - 15) ... the game features 10 players that average at least 10.0 points per game and two players (Swanigan & Oleka) that average double-doubles.

IN THE GARDEN

- Purdue has lost three straight games in Madison Square Garden, dating to the 2008 NIT Season Tipoff ... losses have come to Oklahoma (2008), Villanova (2012) and Oregon State (2012) ... the Boilermakers are 12-9 all-time in Madison Square Garden ... MSG will be the host of the 2018 Big Ten Tournament.

MOST CONSECUTIVE WEEKS IN AP RANKINGS

- Purdue has been ranked in 24 consecutive polls, now the eighth-longest active streak in America ... Purdue was 1-of-11 teams nationally to be ranked in all 19 Associated Press polls a year ago.
- The school record for most consecutive weeks ranked is 64 from the 13th poll of the 2007-08 season to the final poll of the 2010-11 campaign.

- Against Villanova, Purdue had 26 assists on 28 made field goals for an assist rate of 92.9 percent, the second-best rate in school history.
- Purdue has had at least 20 assists in five-of-eight games this year, ranking seventh nationally in assists per game (19.7).

JUNIORS LEAD THE WAY

- Head coach **Matt Painter** knew that the junior class would be key in its resurgence and through eight games, the class has not disappointed.
- The group has scored a combined 378 points (47.3 points per game), accounting for 56.7 percent of the team's scoring ... during the two games in Cancun, the group scored 120 of Purdue's 181 points, accounting for 66.3 percent of the Boilermakers' scoring.

THE LEGEND OF BIGGIE

- Caleb Swanigan** is off to a strong start to his sophomore season and may have been the player of the month of November nationally.
- His five straight double-doubles were the most for a Purdue player since **John Garrett** in 1974-75 ... the streak ended vs. Morehead State.

- Swanigan is 10th in the country in rebounding (11.5) and is 1-of-2 players nationally this year to average 17.0 points, 10.0 rebounds and 3.0 assists per game ... of note since 1993-94, just six players in NCAA history have averaged 17.0 points, 10.0 rebounds and 3.0 assists per game in a season (**Tim Duncan**, **David West** and **Ben Simmons** are notable players).

- Swanigan has also shown a much-improved 3-point stroke. Last year as a freshman, he shot 21-of-72 (.292) from long distance ... his shot selection has been much better and it has shown as he is now 7-of-11 (.636) from deep this year ... through the first eight games last year, Swanigan was 6-of-21 (.286) from deep.

- With a pair of Sweet 16 appearances, eight NCAA Tournament berths, Big Ten regular-season and tournament titles and an international gold medal on his résumé, 12th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest minds in all of college basketball.
- Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in March of 2011, agreeing to a new eight-year contract that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2018-19 season. He then followed that up in August of 2016, signing a three-year extension good through the 2021-22 year.
- Painter has averaged over 21 wins per season during his tenure at the helm of the Purdue program, including at least 20 victories in eight seasons.
- Painter's tenure has seen Purdue basketball restore its status among the upper echelon of college basketball programs. The last eight years have seen six 20-win seasons and NCAA Tournament berths, two Sweet 16 appearances, a regular-season Big Ten title and a Big Ten Tournament crown.
- The three winningest classes in program history are the classes of 2011, 2012 and 2010, respectively, and five of the 10 winningest individual players Purdue has ever seen have come from the Painter ranks. Success, however, didn't happen overnight.
- Painter officially became the 18th head men's basketball coach in Purdue history on April 1, 2005, and immediately set about laying the groundwork for a dramatic reversal in the program's fortunes.
- The Boilermakers were at their best during the 2009 postseason run, rattling off double-digit victories over Penn State and Illinois to reach the Big Ten Tournament final, where they dispatched Ohio State, 65-61, to earn the first conference tournament crown in program history.
- Painter has been named Big Ten Coach of the Year three times in the last six seasons, earning the consensus award in 2008 and 2011, and winning the coaches' vote in 2010. He is one of only six men to win the award more at least three times since its inception in 1974.
- Painter has seen a total of 24 players earn a combined 44 Academic All-Big Ten honors during his tenure as head coach. Painter has also mentored an Academic All-American, as Moore earned second-team honors during the 2009-10 season.
