THE SCENE SETTER

- The Purdue men's basketball team resumes its season after final exams with the eighth annual Crossroads Classic in Indianapolis on Saturday.
- The contest will be televised on CBS with **Brad Nessler, Bill Raftery** and **Jamie Erdahl** calling the action courtside, beginning at 1:30 p.m. ET.
- On the radio waves, the contest will be available on the Purdue Radio Network and Tuneln.com, with **Rob Blackman** and **Ralph Taylor** on the call, beginning with the Purdue Basketball pregame show at 12:30 p.m.
- Live stats will be provided on PurdueSports.com, and as always, Twitter updates will be available on Purdue's official account (@BoilerBall).
- Purdue is looking for its third straight win in the annual event and is looking to end its non-conference slate on a high note.
- Following Notre Dame, Purdue will return home for its final two non-conference games, beginning with Ohio on Dec. 20.

THE TWO TEAMS

- Purdue enters Saturday's Crossroads Classic with a 6-4 record having lost four of its last six games, all coming away from Mackey Arena, including three games on the road.
- The latest setback was a 72-68 loss at Texas, despite a career-high 40 points from junior guard **Carsen Edwards**.
- The Boilermakers had just six turnovers, but went just 9 of 32 from 3-point range in the loss. The Longhorns took advantage by having one of their best shooting days of the year, going 11 of 25 from deep and 15 of 16 from the free throw line.
- **Carsen Edwards** continues to play at a high level, averaging 25.5 points and 3.8 assists per game. He ranks sixth in the country in scoring and seventh in 3-pointers made (39).
- **Ryan Cline** averages 13.3 points per game and is 30th nationally in 3-pters made (32).
- Notre Dame is 6-3 having lost its last two games to Oklahoma and UCLA by a combined eight points.
- **T.J. Gibbs** leads the Irish in scoring (13.7 PPG).

THE TALKING POINTS

- Purdue is aiming for its third straight win in the Crossroads Classic on Saturday. It would match the longest winning streak in event history (Notre Dame, Butler).
- Purdue hadn't scored more than 70 points in the first five Crossroads Classic games. It has averaged 84.0 points in the last two games.
- A win over the Irish would even the all-time series between the two teams at 22 wins each. It would also even the Crossroads Classic series to two wins apiece.
- Purdue has won nine straight games against in-state foes dating to Feb. 20, 2016. Five of the wins have been away from Mackey Arena.
- Purdue's duo of **Carsen Edwards** (39) and **Ryan Cline** (32) have made 71 3-pointers between them, the fourth most nationally.
- Purdue is 0-2 this year against the Atlantic Coast Conference, having lost to Virginia Tech (89-83) and Florida State (73-72).
- Graduate manager **Joey Brooks** played at Notre Dame under head coach **Mike Brey** from 2010-12.

THE SERIES

- Saturday's contest marks the 44th meeting all-time between the two Indiana rivals that are just 109 miles apart.
- The two squads haven't played on campus in a regular-season game since Jan. 1966. But it hasn't been without effort.
- When **Gene Keady** was hired at Purdue in 1980, he had a goal to play in-state teams more frequently. Notre Dame and its national schedule made it difficult to face the Irish. **Digger Phelps** also previously and famously stated there are "no roads that lead from South Bend to West Lafayette", thus ending an on-campus series that was played essentially every year from 1942-66.
- Two years ago, Purdue got its first win in the Crossroads Classic with an 86-81 victory over the Irish. Purdue trailed by 17 late in the first half, but **Carsen Edwards'** defense on **Matt Ferrell** turned the tide and **Caleb Swanigan** scored 26 points with 10 rebounds and four blocks to rally Purdue to the victory.

MEET ME AT THE CROSSROADS

- Purdue owns just a 2-5 record in the Crossroads Classic, but has won its last two games by a combined 20 points.
- Purdue is the only school in the event to currently own a two-game winning streak. A win over Notre Dame will match both Butler (2011-13) and Notre Dame (2012-14) for the longest winning streaks in Crossroads Classic history.

THE GAUNTLET

- Seven of Purdue's 10 opponents during this grueling stretch from Nov. 28 to Jan. 11 are ranked in the NCAA Net's top 40. The 10 teams own a combined 75-19 (.798) record.
- So far this year, Purdue's losses have come in true road games to teams ranked 4 (Michigan), 14 (Florida State) and 37 (Texas) and a neutral-site game to No. 11 Virginia Tech in the KenPom rankings.
- According to KenPom, Purdue has played the seventh-most difficult schedule in the country, second among high majors (Wisconsin).

ROAD WARRIORS

- Since the start of the 2007-08 season, Purdue owns a 60-56 record, the third-most wins in the Big Ten during that span. Only four teams (Wisconsin, Michigan State, Ohio State, Purdue) have even won at least 40.0 percent of their road games during that span (not counting Maryland).
- Over the last 12 years, there have been just 10, 8-win road seasons by all the teams in the Big Ten (MSU - 3; Wisc. - 3; Purdue - 2; OSU - 1; Md. - 1).

HEAD COACH MATT PAINTER

► **Record at Purdue:** 301-153 (.663) / 14th year | **Career Record:** 326-158 (.674) / 15th year

- With four Sweet 16 appearances, 10 NCAA Tournament berths, two Big Ten regular-season championships, a Big Ten Tournament title and an international gold medal on his résumé, 14th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest young minds in all of college basketball.
- Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in October of 2018, agreeing to a two-year extension that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2023-24 season. The deal features five, one-year extensions that go into effect through the 2028-29 season. Following the 2029 season, Painter will still only be 58 years old.
- Painter entered the 2018-19 season third on the school's all-time wins list (295) behind legendary mentors, Gene Keady and Ward "Piggy" Lambert, both of whom have been inducted into the College Basketball Hall of Fame.
- Has averaged almost 23 wins a season in his 13 years at Purdue. If you don't include the first transitional year, the average balloons to 23.8 wins per year over the last 12 seasons.
- Has won at least 25 games in eight of his 14 seasons as a collegiate head coach.
- Painter's three Big Ten Coach of the Year honors are the fourth most in league history (Gene Keady - 7; Bobby Knight - 5; Bo Ryan - 4).
- Painter has averaged 10.9 wins per year in conference play, the fifth-best average in Big Ten Conference history.
- Is one of just three active coaches to have won a Big Ten championship.
- Painter's 10 NCAA Tournaments in the last 12 years are the ninth most in the country.
