GAME 10: The Facts

• Purdue looks for just its third 10-0 start or better in the last 75 years on Wednesday when Howard visits West Lafayette for the second meeting all-time between the two schools.

• The contest will be televised from Mackey Arena on ESPN at 7 p.m. ET, with **Jim Barber** and **Sean Harrington** calling the action court-side.

• On the radio waves, **Larry Clisby**, **Rob Blackman** and **Ralph Taylor** will handle the call on the 27-station Purdue Sports Network as well as SIRIUS (Ch. 134) and XM (Ch. 201) satellite radio. Coverage begins with the Purdue Basketball pregame show one hour before tip.

• Live stats will be available via Gametracker on PurdueSports.com. As always, Twitter updates will be provided on the official Purdue basketball account, @BoilerBall.

Scouting Purdue

• The No. 11-ranked Boilermakers are 9-0 and one of three teams nationally to have won all of its games by double-digits.

• Purdue is coming off an 80-53 win over IUPUI on Monday night, breaking open a tight game by outscoring the Jaguars 31-12 in the final 13 minutes of the contest.

• Purdue shot 57.7 percent from the floor in the second half and made 13-of-17 (.765) shots from inside the 3-point line in the final 20 minutes to pull away late in the contest.

• Five players scored in double figures, led by **A.J. Hammons** (14) and **Kendall Stephens** (13). **Caleb Swanigan** recorded his third double-double of the season with 11 points and 14 rebounds.

• Isaac Haas leads the Boilermakers in scoring at 14.1 PPG while shooting 66.7 percent from the free throw line. The Boilermakers outrebound foes by 12.8 rebounds per game and hold foes to 33.0 percent shooting.

Scouting Howard

• Howard is 6-3 overall and coming off a thrilling 71-69 last-second win over North Carolina Central on Monday night, snapping the Eagles' 32-game homecourt winning streak.

• The Bison are led by the country's leading scorer in junior guard **James Daniel III**. The 5-11 junior is averaging 28.4 points per game and made 7-of-9 3-point attempts in Monday's win.

• Starting five juniors, Howard also gets 12.7 points per game from forward **Damon Collins**. Center **Marcel Boyd** (6-10, 230) leads the team in rebounding at 9.4 per game.

• Howard averages 80.7 points per game and allows 73.0 per game.

The Coaches

• **Matt Painter** (Purdue, 1994) is in his 11th year at Purdue, owning a 220-125 record. Painter is one of six coaches in Big Ten history to win three Big Ten Coach of the Year awards and his 220 wins are the third most by a Purdue coach in school history.

• **Kevin Nickelberry** (Va. Wesleyan, 1984) is in his sixth year at Howard, turning around a strong program in the nation's capital. The Bison won 16 games last year and are among the favorites to win the MEAC this year.

■ **Painter Moving Up the Charts**

- **Matt Painter** has moved into third place on the school's career games coached list, leading his squad into his 347th game in his 11th season on Wednesday against Howard.
- Painter owns a 221-125 (.638) record, the third-most wins for a head coach in school history.
- With the 9-0 start, Painter has moved into fifth place on the school's career winning percentage list with a .638 winning percentage.

- Since the **Ray Eddy** era began in 1950, Purdue has had just six head coaches in 66 years, and just eight head coaches in the last 99 years.

■ **Unbeaten Through Nine Games**

- During the NCAA Tournament era (since 1938), Purdue has started 9-0 or better five times including this season. In the previous four years that Purdue started 9-0 or better, the Boilermakers combined to post a 94-23 record (.784). Sadly, the 1938 team was snubbed from an NCAA Tournament berth with a stellar 18-2 record.
- In two of the seasons that Purdue started at least 9-0, that team set a school record for victories with 29 (1993-94, 2009-10).
- Purdue has now started 9-0 or better twice during **Matt Painter's** 11 seasons at Purdue (2009-10).
- With a win against Howard, Purdue will start 10-0 for just the third time in the last 75 years (1993-94; 2009-10).

■ **Winning Margins**

- Through games played on Monday, there are 12 remaining undefeated teams nationally with records of 5-0 or better. Of those 12 teams, Purdue, Houston and Saint Mary's are the only teams to have won all of its games by double-digits.
- This year's team became the first team in school history to open the season with nine straight double-digit wins.
- With a double-digit win over Howard on Wednesday, this team will become the first team in Purdue history win 10 straight games by double-digits at any point during the season.

■ **Gameday Adjustments**

- Last year, Purdue went 0-4 when being outscored in the paint. Already twice this year, Purdue has won three games when being outscored in the paint (Vermont, Florida, Pittsburgh).

■ **Boilermakers Hot at Home**

- Purdue enters Wednesday's game against Howard having won 12 straight games at Mackey Arena. Purdue has won the 12 straight games by a combined 210 points (17.5 PPG).
- Since the start of last year, Purdue is now 20-3 at home and its 12-game winning streak is the 17th-longest streak in the country and the second-longest winning streak in the Big 10 (Maryland - 18).
- **Matt Painter** now owns five double-digit homecourt winning streaks in his 11 years at Purdue, including the current 12-game streak, which is the third longest of his coaching tenure.

■ **Win When Shooting More**

- Purdue has won 25 straight games when shooting more free throws than its opponent, including four times this year.

■ **The Word According to Ken Pomeroy**

- Purdue's effective field goal percentage defense is first nationally (37.1 percent). Oklahoma is second (37.1) and Vanderbilt is third (38.8).
- The teams listed in the top 20 of both offensive and defensive efficiency are a who's-who of college basketball this season.

• Purdue ranks first nationally in field goal percentage and that comes even without the Big Ten's top defensive player in **Rapheal Davis** being in the lineup in each of the last four games.

• Purdue leads the country in 2-point percentage defense (.358) and is 13th in the country in 3-point percentage defense (.266). Purdue and Oklahoma are the only teams in America to rank in the top 25 of both 2-point and 3-point percentage defense.

• Purdue has held four of its nine opponents under 30.0 percent shooting. In the first half, and four opponents have been held under 25.0 percent shooting from the field.

• The Boilermakers have held six-of-nine foes to 59 points or less on the season, including four straight. When doing so during the Painter era, the Boilermakers are a combined 109-4.

• Purdue is fourth in the country in scoring defense and is the only team in America to rank in the top 15 in field goal percentage defense (2nd), scoring defense (4th), rebound margin (8th) and 3-point percentage defense (15th). West Virginia joins Purdue when the chart expands to top 20.

• Purdue is second in the country (behind West Virginia) in defensive points per possession at 0.78. West Virginia is at 0.76.

■ Without the Captain

• Over the last four games, Purdue has held all four foes to 59 points or less, accomplishing that without the league's best defensive player, **Rapheal Davis**. Davis has been sidelined the last four games with a minor knee injury.

• Don't get us wrong, we can't wait until he comes back. But as the numbers bear out, Purdue's defense has been just as strong.

■ Hot From 20 Feet, 9 Inches

• A year after shooting just 32.7 percent from 3-point range and with many questions entering the season about perimeter play, Purdue has quieted those discussions at least for now.

• The Boilermakers connected on a school-record 18 3-pointers in the win over Vermont on November 15, one game after making 12 in the season opener against North Carolina A&T.

• Eight different players have made at least two 3-pointers in a game this year (Cline, Davis, Edwards, Hammons, Mathias, Stephens, Swanigan, Thompson). Four different players (Cline, Edwards, Mathias, Stephens) have made at least four trifectas in a game this year.

• Purdue has made at least 10 3-pointers in four games this year. The school record for most games with at least 10 3-pointers in a season was in 2011-12 (10 in 35 games).

• Purdue has outscored its foes by 108 points from beyond the arc.

• However, Purdue has cooled down from deep over the last two games, connecting on 10-of-43 (.233) from long distance.

■ Before the Calendar Turns

• With last Saturday's win over Lehigh concluding the month of November, **Matt Painter** is now 37-1 (.974) at home during the month. The lone loss was on Nov. 9, 2012, to Bucknell (70-65).

• In December, Purdue is 38-5 (.884) at home under Coach Painter against non-conference opponents.

• Including December, the Boilermakers are 75-6 (.926) against non-conference foes at home.

■ Notes From the Lead

• Purdue has trailed in just six of its nine games (360 minutes) this year and for a grand total of 15 minutes, 36 seconds. When it trailed by 6:37 against New Mexico on Saturday, that was the longest stretch it has trailed in a game this season.

• Over the last eight games (320 minutes), Purdue has trailed for a total of 9 minutes, 55 seconds.

• Purdue's largest deficit of the season has been four points, which came when North Carolina A&T took a 4-0 lead two minutes into the season opener and then in the second half against New Mexico (39-35).

• When the Boilermakers trailed Pittsburgh for 47 seconds in the second half last Tuesday night, it marked the first time all season Purdue trailed in the second half.

■ Purdue's Bench a Real Advantage

• Purdue has outscored its opponents' bench by a total of 325-115 so far this year, an average of 36.1 to 12.8 per game.

• Purdue's bench has accounted for 44.6 percent of its scoring (325-of-729 points).

• Over the last three games, Purdue's bench has scored 120 of the team's 224 points, or 53.6 percent of the team's scoring.

• According to **Ken Pomeroy**, Purdue's bench has played 43.0 minutes this year, the eighth-highest percentage of any team in America and the highest percentage for a power-conference school.

• In research done by Florida Gulf Coast SID **Jason MacBain**, Purdue is one of seven teams in America to have had 10 players score in double-figures at least once this year.

• Purdue's players have accounted for 37 double-figure outputs this year and nine of the 10 players have at least two double-figure scoring games this year.

• The Boilermakers have had five (of nine games) outings this year where five or more players scored in double figures. That equals the total of the last two years combined (66 games).

• After starting the season 38-of-59 (.644) from the free throw line in the first two games, Purdue has turned it around at the charity stripe.

• The Boilermakers are 114-of-146 (.781) from the free throw line during the last seven games.

• Opponents have shot 145 free throws on the season, while Purdue has made 152 free throws.

• Purdue ranks 53rd nationally in free throw percentage, a significant improvement over the last four years where the Boilermakers ranked 275th (2012), 291st (2013), 261st (2014) and 213th (2015).

• Purdue has allowed just 95 offensive rebounds (10.6 per game), ranking fourth in the Big Ten in defensive rebound percentage (.757).

• Purdue held New Mexico to just three offensive rebounds, tied for the fewest in a game by an opponent since the category started being recorded during the 1986-87 season.

• Purdue was +23 on the glass against New Mexico and has outrebounded every opponent this season.

• Purdue ranks eighth nationally and second in the Big Ten in rebound margin (+12.9).

• Purdue's +37 (56-19) rebound margin against Incarnate Word is the second-best margin nationally in a game this season.

■ Hammons Flexes Muscles, Inside and Out

• **A.J. Hammons** had a monster game off the bench with 24 points and 12 rebounds in last Tuesday's win over Pittsburgh, then followed it up with a 16-point, 11-rebound showing against New Mexico for his second straight double-double.

• For his efforts, he was named the Big Ten Player of the Week on Monday after averaging 20.0 points and 11.5 rebounds per game in the two victories. He shot 17-of-25 (.680) from the field.

• In the second half of the last three games against Pittsburgh, New Mexico and IUPUI, Hammons has scored 41 points with 18 rebounds and five blocks in just 39 minutes of action, while shooting 17-of-20 (.850) from the field.

• Hammons was 6-of-6 from the floor against IUPUI, the 11th-most field goals made without a miss in a game in school history. His 14 points were the eighth-most points in a perfect shooting performance.

• Hammons' double-doubles have come against an impressive list of teams, 13 of which have come against Big Ten opposition and 16 against power-conference schools.

• With a pair of Sweet 16 appearances, six NCAA Tournament berths, Big Ten regular-season and tournament titles and an international gold medal on his résumé, 11th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest minds in all of college basketball.

• Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in March of 2011, agreeing to a new eight-year contract that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2018-19 season.

• Painter has averaged over 21 wins per season during his tenure at the helm of the Purdue program, including at least 20 victories in six of those seasons.

• Painter's tenure has seen Purdue basketball restore its status among the upper echelon of college basketball programs. The last eight years have seen six 20-win seasons and NCAA Tournament berths, two Sweet 16 appearances, a regular-season Big Ten title and a Big Ten Tournament crown.

• The three winningest classes in program history are the classes of 2011, 2012 and 2010, respectively, and five of the 10 winningest individual players Purdue has ever seen have come from the Painter ranks. Success, however, didn't happen overnight.

• Painter officially became the 18th head men's basketball coach in Purdue history on April 1, 2005, and immediately set about laying the groundwork for a dramatic reversal in the program's fortunes.

• The Boilermakers were at their best during the 2009 postseason run, rattling off double-digit victories over Penn State and Illinois to reach the Big Ten Tournament final, where they dispatched Ohio State, 65-61, to earn the first conference tournament crown in program history.

• Painter has also resurrected Mackey Arena as one of the country's best home-court advantages, piling up a 143-31 (.822) record at home over the last 11 seasons, including a remarkable 79-7 (.919) record against non-conference opponents.

• Painter has been named Big Ten Coach of the Year three times in the last six seasons, earning the consensus award in 2008 and 2011, and winning the coaches' vote in 2010. He is one of only six men to win the award more at least three times since its inception in 1974.

• Painter has seen a total of 21 players earn a combined 40 Academic All-Big Ten honors during his tenure as head coach. Painter has also mentored an Academic All-American, as Moore earned second-team honors during the 2009-10 season.
