Academic Tutor Integrity Statement Student Support Services

Extra Benefit – I agree not to provide a student-athlete, or a student-athlete's relatives or friends, any benefit that is not authorized by NCAA legislation.

Services – I agree to provide no services to the student-athlete other than academic tutoring.

Complimentary Admissions – I will not offer or arrange for a student-athlete to receive payment from any source for his or her complimentary admissions, or exchange or assign them for any item of value, or barter for services.

Gambling Statement – I will not solicit or accept a bet on any intercollegiate competition for any item (e.g., cash, shirt, dinner) that has tangible value. I will not provide information to individuals involved in gambling activities concerning intercollegiate athletic competition.

Academic Fraud Statement – If I have knowledge of a student-athlete who is submitting work that is not his or her own, or is submitting test or examination materials that are not his or her own, I understand that it is my responsibility under terms of employment with the Purdue University Division of Intercollegiate Athletics to report this activity to the Associate Athletics director for Student Services and/or the Assistant Athletics Director for Compliance.

Buckley Amendment – I agree not to disclose to any party information regarding a student-athlete's:

- 1. Results of NCAA drug tests;

- 6. Academic progress, information regarding coursework and/or tutoring sessions, except to institutional representatives.
