#### ▶ The Scene Setter Between the Boilermakers and the Nittany Lions

- No. 3-seeded and No. 8-ranked Purdue looks to advance to its second Big Ten Tournament championship in the last three years as it battles Penn
  State in the semifinals at Madison Square Garden. The contest will be televised by CBS with Jim Nantz, Bill Raftery, Grant Hill and Tracy
  Wolfson on the call, tipping at approximately 4:30 p.m. ET. The other semifinal pits Michigan State vs. Michigan.
- Purdue advanced to the semifinals for the third time in the last four years with an 82-75 win over Rutgers at raucous MSG in Friday's nightcap. The Boilermakers shot 54.0 percent from the field and made 13-of-30 3-pointers in the victory. The Boilermakers overcame a slow start, falling behind 19-12 with just over eight minutes to play in the opening half, outscoring the Scarlet Knights 70-56 over the final 28 minutes.
- Purdue's 13 3-pointers tied for the Boilermakers' most in Big Ten Tournament history. The 13 3-pointers tied for the second most in Big Ten Tournament history by any team (14 Illinois, 2016).
- Purdue started the game just 2-of-10 from the field and 0-of-7 from 3-point range. The Boilermakers finished 25-of-40 (.625) from the field and 13-of-23 (.565) from long distance.
- Purdue's 27 wins are tied for the fifth most in a season in school history. The 54 wins since start of last year are just two off the most in school history.
   Purdue owns a 36-12 all-time record vs. Penn State, having won six games in a row and 10 of its last 11 against the Nittany Lions. Purdue is 20-3 against Penn State in its last 20 meetings, dating to lan. 6, 2007.
- Purdue defeated Penn State 76-73 on Feb. 18, 2018, in Mackey Arena. Purdue played without **Vincent Edwards**, who suffered a sprained ankle the day before the game with the Nittany Lions. (BOX SCORE FOUND LATER IN PACKET)
- In two games at Madison Square Garden since the start of last year, Purdue is 28-of-57 (.491) from long distance. Purdue went 15-of-27 vs. Arizona State in December 2016 in the Jimmy V Classic.
- Purdue is now 6-2 as a No. 3 seed in the Big Ten Tournament. Purdue won the championship as a No. 3 seed in 2009.
- Purdue's senior class has now accounted for 4,944 career points, 2,005 career rebounds and 1,145 career assists. The quartet has made 562 3-ptrs.
- During Purdue's current four-game winning streak, Purdue is averaging 83.8 points per game while shooting 53.1 percent from the field and 43.9
  percent from long distance. Purdue has 61 assists to 36 turnovers during that span.
- Purdue's five losses this year have come by a grand total of 15 points, the lowest average margin of defeat in the country.
- Purdue's senior class now owns a 101-35 career record, needing six wins to tie the school record for most wins by a class (107 2011).
- Purdue is 80-22 since the start of the 2015-16 season, needing just two wins to tie the record for most victories in a three-year span.
- Purdue is 20-0 this year when shooting 48.0 percent or better from the field (37-2 since start of last year; 134-14 under **Matt Painter**).
- Purdue has 311 3-pointers on the season. The school record is 315 set last year.
- Carsen Edwards and Vincent Edwards became the first teammates in Big Ten Tournament history to each score at least 25 points in a game during the win over Rutgers. They both had 26 points, combining to go 16-of-28 from the field, 8-of-17 from long distance and 12-of-13 from the free throw line. Their 26-point performance marked the fourth-most points by a Purdue player in a Big Ten Tournament game.
- Carsen Edwards is averaging 27.8 points per game over his last four games, including 23.5 points per game since February 1.
- Carsen Edwards' 589 points this year are tied for the fifth most by a Purdue sophomore in school history (**Rick Mount** 683; **Glenn Robinson** 676; **Caleb Swanigan** 646; **Terry Dischinger** 605).
- Carsen Edwards needs 51 points to become the seventh player in school history to score 1,000 points in his first two seasons at Purdue.
- Carsen Edwards has scored in double figures in 15 straight games, including 13-plus points in nine straight games.
- Vincent Edwards needs one assist to become the third player in school history to have 90 assists in four years (**Eugene Parker** 1975-78; **Bruce Parkinson** 1973-74; 1976-77).
- Vincent Edwards is 19th on the career points list (1,580), 9th in rebounds (744), 11th in 3-pointers made (169), 3rd in games started (121), 12th in assists (391) and 7th in minutes played (3,797).
- Purdue is now 16-1 during his career when Vincent Edwards scores 20 or more points.
- Dakota Mathias needs three points for 400 this season. Should he reach that, Purdue will have four 400-point scorers for the third time in school history (1987-88, 1997-98).
- Dakota Mathias needs two 3-pointers to tie E'Twaun Moore for the most career trifectas in school history (243).
- Dakota Mathias' 87 3-pointers are the fifth most in a season in school history. Carsen Edwards' 81 are the eighth most.
- Dakota Mathias needs one assist for 400 in his career. He will become the second player in school history with 1,000-400-400 (E'Twaun Moore).
- Isaac Haas became the 23rd player in school history to score over 1,500 career points with 12 points against Rutgers.
- Isaac Haas has scored in double-figures in each of his last seven games (14.6 PPG, 6.0 RPG).

#### ▶ Head Coach Matt Painter

#### ▶ **Record at Purdue:** 292-147 (.665) / 13th year | **Career Record:** 317-152 (.676) / 14th year

- With a trio of Sweet 16 appearances, nine NCAA Tournament berths, Big Ten regular-season and tournament titles and an international gold meda on his résumé, 13th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest minds in all of college basketball.
- Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in March of 2011, agreeing to a new eight-year contract that will keep him in West Lafayette
  through at least the 2018-19 season. He then followed that up in August of 2016, signing a three-year extension good through the 2021-22 year.
- Painter has averaged over 22 wins per season during his tenure at the helm of the Purdue program, including at least 25 victories in seven seasons.
- Painter's tenure has seen Purdue basketball restore its status among the upper echelon of college basketball programs. The last 11 years have seen seven 25-win seasons and nine NCAA Tournament berths, three Sweet 16 appearances, two regular-season Big Ten titles and a Big Ten Tournament crown.
- •The four-winningest classes in program history are the classes of 2011, 2012, 2010 and 2018, respectively, and five of the 10 winningest individual players Purdue has ever seen have come from the Painter ranks. Success, however, didn't happen overnight.
- Painter officially became the 18th head men's basketball coach in Purdue history on April 1, 2005, and immediately set about laying the groundwork for a dramatic reversal in the program's fortunes.
- •The Boilermakers were at their best during the 2009 postseason run, rattling off double-digit victories over Penn State and Illinois to reach the Big Ten Tournament final, where they dispatched Ohio State, 65-61, to earn the first conference tournament crown in program history.
- Painter has been named Big Ten Coach of the Year three times, earning the consensus award in 2008 and 2011, and winning the coaches' vote in 2010. He is one of only six men to win the award more at least three times since its inception in 1974.
- Painter has seen a total of 26 players earn a combined 49 Academic All-Big Ten honors during his tenure as head coach. Painter has also mentored
  a pair of Academic All-Americans in E'Twaun Moore (2010) and Caleb Swanigan (2017)
