#### THE OPENING TIP

- The No. 7-ranked Purdue Boilermakers face one of their stiffest challenges of the season on Martin Luther King Jr. Day, when it makes the short trip West to face No. 25-ranked Illinois in a late morning tilt (local time) that will have Big Ten title implications. The Boilermakers are looking to end a three-game losing skid to the Illini and record their first win in Champaign since the 2017-18 season.
- The Boilermakers enter with a 14-2 overall record, while Illinois is 13-3 having won six games in a row – all by double-digits.
- The contest will be televised on FOX with Joe Davis and Stephen Bardo on the call. On the radio waves, Rob Blackman and Bobby Riddell will be courtside on the 22-station Purdue Radio Network and online on the Varsity Sports Network (app). Live stats will be provided on StatBroadcast.com and updates will be provided on Purdue's official Twitter account (@BoilerBall).

#### THE NOTES TO KNOW

- The Boilermakers will wear special Martin Luther King Jr., shooting shirts for Monday's game against Illinois. The players will then autograph the shirts and auction them off online, with proceeds going to Purdue's Black Cultural Center on campus.
- Purdue's 14-2 start is the fifth 14-2 start (or better) during the Matt Painter era (2009-10, 2010-11, 2015-16, 2017-18). A win over Illinois would match the best 17-game start of the Painter era (2010-11, 2017-18).
- Since Feb. 1, of last season, Purdue and Loyola Chicago are the only teams without a double-digit loss. Purdue's six losses since Feb. 1, of last year have come by 1, 3, 9 (ot), 9 (ot), 2 and 5 points.
- Purdue has scored 90 or more points in eight games this season, tied with Gonzaga for the most 90-point games in the country.
- Purdue is looking for its third straight road win against ranked teams dating to last year (Michigan St. - Jan. 8, 2021; Ohio State - Jan. 19, 2021).
- Purdue's seven wins by 25 or more points are the third most in the country and most in the Big Ten (Gonzaga, Kentucky - 10).
- Purdue's bench has scored at least 25 points in 11 straight games and in 14-of-16 games this season (Indiana State, Villanova).
- Over the last four games, Purdue's sophomore class has averaged 51.0 points per game, accounting for 60.2 percent of Purdue's scoring.
- Zach Edey, Jaden Ivey and Trevion Williams were named to the Wooden Award midseason watch list. Purdue was the only school with three players named (Duke, Gonzaga, UCLA had two).
- Matt Painter needs two wins to tie Ward "Piggy" Lambert (371) for second place on the Purdue career victories list.

**REACHING THESE LEVELS MEANS A VICTORY**

- Purdue has won 48 straight games when shooting at least 50.0 percent from the field, 40.0 percent from 3-point range and 72.0 percent from the free throw line, last losing to Illinois on March 3, 2004 (81-79; ot).
- Coach Painter is 45-0 when reaching the three shooting levels.

**DUO DOMINATES THE GLASS**

- Through Saturday's games, **Zach Edey** and **Trevion Williams** rank 1st and 4th nationally in offensive rebounding percentage.
- As a team, Purdue is sixth in offensive rebound percentage.

**AND MORE ABOUT THAT OFFENSIVE EFFICIENCY NUMBER**

- Purdue's adjusted offensive efficiency number is 124.1, meaning Purdue averages 124.1 points per 100 possessions, a number that is now second in the country behind Gonzaga.
- In the KenPom era (2002-22), that number currently ranks 15th, and is the third-best Big Ten offense in the last 20 years.

**PURDUE'S BIG THREE MAKING BIG IMPACT**

- Purdue's big three of **Jaden Ivey**, **Trevion Williams** and **Zach Edey** are making a huge impact this season.
- The group is averaging 44.9 points, 21.1 rebounds, 7.3 assists, 2.6 blocks and 2.6 steals per game, shooting 274-of-458 (.598). The trio accounts for 52.5 percent of Purdue's scoring.
- The trio were all named to the Wooden Award midseason top-25 watch list, the only school with three players named.

**DOUBLE-DOUBLE TIMES 3**

- In the win over Wright State, Purdue had three players (**Zach Edey**, **Caleb Furst**, **Trevion Williams**) record double-doubles. It marked the first time since Nov. 21, 1977, that three players recorded double-doubles in the same game (**Walter Jordan**, **Wayne Walls**, **Joe Barry Carroll**). It has now happened 19 times in school history.

**20 TIMES 3**

- In the win over North Carolina, Purdue had three players score at least 20 points in the same game for the first time since Nov. 24, 1997. **Sasha Stefanovic** had 23 points, **Jaden Ivey** had 22 points and **Trevion Williams** tallied 20 points.

**BEST SHOOTING PROGRAM IN THE COUNTRY?**

- Purdue can lay claim to perhaps being the best 3-point shooting program in the country over the last few years.
- Since the 2016-17 season, Purdue is one of six teams in America to have made 1,600 trifectas and shoot at least 37.5 percent from long range.

- During the same time frame, Purdue has had 23 games of 14 or more 3-pointers. Among Big Ten teams, Michigan and Iowa are next with 11.

**TOUGHER SLEDDING IN LEAGUE PLAY**

- Purdue is 3-2 in Big Ten play, in part because of career performances by two players. In the loss to Rutgers, **Ron Harper** scored a career-high 30 points and hit a 40-foot runner at the buzzer. In Monday's loss to Wisconsin, **Johnny Davis** scored 37 points to score half of Wisconsin's points in a win over the Boilermakers.

**INSIDE MORE NUMBERS**

- Purdue is 133-16 since the start of the 2014-15 season when attempting more free throws than its opponents.
- Purdue is 164-7 when under Painter when holding foes to 59 or fewer points. Three of the seven losses came during the 2012-13 season.
- Purdue is 138-12 under Painter when scoring at least 80 points, including 52-2 (losses to Notre Dame and Virginia Tech in 2018-19 season) since the start of the 2017-18 season.
- Purdue is 262-50 under Painter when scoring at least 70 points.
- Purdue is 47-5 since the start of the 2017-18 season when making 10 or more 3-pointers in a game, winning 18 straight games.
- Purdue is 135-15 under Painter when winning the rebound and turnover battles in the same game.
- Purdue has won 30 straight games when shooting a higher field goal percentage than its opponent.
- Purdue has won 17 straight games when leading at halftime and since the start of the 2016-17 season, Purdue is 109-12 when leading at the intermission.
- Purdue has won 110 straight games when scoring 90 or more points, dating to Nov. 24, 1987 -- a span of 12,474 days.

**BEST THING ABOUT FRESHMEN IS THEY BECOME SOPHOMORES**

- Purdue sophomores **Jaden Ivey** and **Zach Edey** have taken a massive leap this season after good freshman campaigns.

► **Record at Purdue:** 369-186 (.665) / 17th year | **Career Record:** 394-191 (.674) / 18th year

- With five Sweet 16 appearances, 12 NCAA Tournament berths, three Big Ten regular-season championships, a Big Ten Tournament title, an Elite Eight and an international gold medal on his résumé, 17th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest young minds in all of college basketball.
- He was voted by his peers as the NABC National Coach of the Year after leading a team that started with a 6-5 record to the 2019 Elite Eight.
- Painter was named the 2019 Big Ten Coach of the Year and has led Purdue to six straight NCAA Tournaments – the seventh-longest active streak in America. Included in that stretch are Sweet 16 appearances (and beyond) in three of the last four tournaments.
- Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in October of 2018, agreeing to a two-year extension that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2023-24 season. The deal features five, one-year extensions that go into effect through the 2028-29 season. Following the 2029 season, Painter will still only be 58 years old.
- Painter enters the 2021-22 season third on the school's all-time wins list (355) behind legendary mentors, Gene Keady and Ward "Piggy" Lambert, both of whom have been inducted into the College Basketball Hall of Fame.
- Has averaged almost 23 wins a season in his 16 years at Purdue. If you don't include the first transitional year (9-19 record), the average balloons to 24.0 wins per year over the last 15 seasons.
- Has won at least 25 games in nine of his 17 seasons as a collegiate head coach.
- Painter's four Big Ten Coach of the Year honors are the third most in league history (**Gene Keady - 7; Bobby Knight - 5; Bo Ryan - 4**).
- Painter has averaged 11.3 wins per year in conference play, the fifth-best average in Big Ten Conference history.
- Painter's 12 NCAA Tournament appearances in the last 14 events are the eighth most in the country.
- Coach Painter's 13 NCAA Tournaments are the most for a coach nationally under the age of 55 (as of April 1, 2022 – Painter is 51 years old).
- Purdue has finished first or second in Big Ten play in seven of Painter's last 14 years.
- Has had 68 Academic All-Big Ten honorees in his 16 previous years at Purdue.
- Lastly, the five winningest classes in school history have come during the Painter era (2019, 2018, 2012, 2011, 2010).
