A CLOSER LOOK AT THE BOILERMAKERS

- Purdue owns a 5-1 non-conference record this season ... the Boilermakers are 44-16 in non-conference duals with 19 bonus point victories (7 MD, 2 TF, 10 F) ... they have outscored those opponents 179-65 ... four different lineups have been used in the six non-conference duals.
- Duke will be Danny Sabatello's 60th and final dual of his career ... his next win will be his 40th career dual victory ... Tyler Kral's next match will be the 60th of his career ... Luke Welch's next match will be the 50th of his career ... Doug Welch is two wins shy of 60 in his career, Luke Schroeder two shy of 40.
- Seventeen of C. Welch's 25 wins this season are with bonus points (9 MD, 2 TF, 6 F) ... eight of his 11 dual victories have also been with bonus points (5 MD, 1 TF, 2 F) ... he wrestled in five of the non-conference duals, winning four bouts with bonus points (1 MD, 1 TF, 2 F).
- Kyle Ayersman is second on the team with nine bonus point wins (2 MD, 3 TF, 4 F) ... Drake Stein is third with eight (1 MD, 1 TF, 6 F).
- Purdue wrestlers have combined record of 241-190 (.559) ... 128 matches have been won via decision, 37 by major decision, 19 technical falls have been registered and they have pinned 43 opponents.

- The Boilermakers have combined to outscore their opponents 2,374 to 2,155 (+219) in 431 matches this season ... they are averaging 5.5 points/match while the opposition is averaging 5.0.
- Purdue scores first in nearly half of its matches (.494) ... the Boilermakers own scoring advantages in all three periods and overtime ... they are +63 (862-799) in the first and +13 in the second period (614-601) ... the third is their most offensive at +79 (724-645) ... in overtime matches they are +18 with a record of 14-7.
- Among wrestlers that have 20-or more matches this season, L. Welch leads the way by scoring first 76 percent of the time ... he has scored the first points in 19 of his 25 matches.
- The Boilermakers have shutout 35 opponents ... 13 of those shutouts have come in dual action ... Purdue has only been held scoreless in five dual bouts and 15 times overall throughout the season.
- C. Welch is the only wrestler to surpass 200 total points scored, which is a career best ... he is averaging 6.8 points/match ... two other non-first year wrestlers listed as probables have set career highs ... L. Welch with 127 points for a 5.1 average and Tanner Lynde with 107 points and also a 5.1 points/match average.
- Lynde is posting career highs across the board this season, including dual and Big Ten dual victories, bonus point victories, pins, takedowns, total points scored and dual points scored.

When it comes to duals...

- C. Welch leads the team in dual points scored with 46 ... the top-five dual point scorers are rounded out by Lynde (39), D. Welch (38), Morrissey (35) and Griffin (33).
- Although eight different lineups have been used, the starters at 141 and 157 have not changed with Sabatello and D. Welch, respectively ... Sabatello and D. Welch have started 33 consecutive duals for the Boilermakers since the start of the 2014-15 season ... during the stretch, Sabatello has posted a 23-10 dual record and D. Welch is 25-8.
- Thirteen of the 15 duals have started at 125 ... the lowa dual started at 157 and Rutgers at 133.
- The Boilermakers have put 30 points on the board in six duals and they have won at least one bout with bonus points 13 times.
- The Welch Trio (Luke 133; Doug 157; Chad 165) have started 21 duals together dating to last season ... they have won together six times this season and eight times overall.
- Purdue concluded the Big Ten dual season with a combined record of 39-51 with five different lineups ... 22 matches were won via decision, eight by major decision, four by technical fall and three by fall ... half of the starting lineup finished with winning or even records: C. Welch (6-3), Griffin (5-2), Lynde (5-4), D. Welch (5-4), Morrissey (4-3) and L. Welch (4-4).

SCOUTING THE COUGARS

- Friday will be the final dual of the season for SIU Edwardsville ... the Cougars won their last two duals to finish fourth in the SoCon at 3-3, which is their best regular season finish in the league.
- SIU Edwardsville is 1-2 against Big Ten teams this season ... the Cougars defeated Northwestern 28-18 (12/13) ... they lost to No. 9 Illinois 41-3 (11/15) and Indiana 25-12 (12/5).
- They are 0-9 when wrestling road or neutral duals.
- Nate Higgins (165) and Derek Nagel (184) are the only two Cougars to have winning dual records at 7-4 and 8-7, respectively ... overall, Nagel leads the way with five pins and three majors ... John Fahy's three technical falls are the most for SIU Edwardsville ... Fahy also has three majors, as does John Muldoon at 141 for a three-way tie.
- Two weights feature previous meetings, both of which occurred at last season's dual ... Purdue's Doug Welch defeated Erik Travers 5-1 and Tyler Kral defeated Chris Johnson 4-3.

SCOUTING THE BLUE DEVILS

- Duke will face back-to-back Big Ten opponents in its final dual weekend ... the Blue Devils wrestle at Northwestern on Friday before traveling to West Lafayette for the season's dual finale ... they are 5-5 in road and neutral duals.
- Duke finished sixth in the ACC at 1-4 ... the win came on the road at No. 13 North Carolina 21-17 on Feb. 10 ... the Blue Devils closed out their conference schedule with a 31-9 loss to No. 8 Virginia Tech on Saturday.
- They have forfeited at 133 the last three duals, giving up six points before sending a wrestler to the mat ... they are 1-2 in those three duals.
- Two of Duke's starters, Mitch Finesilver and Conner Hartmann, sport 13-0 dual records ... Finesilver has scored 46 dual points at 149 ... he has four bouts resulting in bonus points ... Hartmann has 59 dual points, including eight bonus point victories.

- Hartmann is a two-time All-American for the Blue Devils at 197 pounds ... his one loss on the season was a 4-3 decision to fifth-ranked Brett Pfarr of Minnesota at the Southern Scuffle on Jan. 2 ... Hartmann has a dozen bonus point victories and he's the team leader in pins with six ... his four major decisions are second and he has a pair of technical falls.
- No. 18 Jake Faust has five wins over ranked opponents, three of which are against Stanford's Jim Wilson ... he also has decisions over No. 9 John Michael Staudenmayer of North Carolina and No. 12 David McFadden of Virginia Tech.
- Head coach Glen Lanham and assistant coach Ben Wissel have roots in Purdue wrestling ... Lanham was an assistant coach for the Boilermakers from 2007 to 2010 ... Wissel is one of the most decorated wrestlers in program history ... Wissel was a two-time All-American at 184 (2005, 2006) and a four-time NCAA qualifier ... he is second in career takedowns (406), tied for fifth in career wins (115) and tied for 16th in career reversals (31) ... in 2006 he set the season record with 188 takedowns ... his 38 wins in 2006 is tied for fifth and the .864 winning percentage he had as a senior ranks 12th (38-6).

- Wrestling in his first dual for the Boilermakers, redshirt freshman Kyle Ayersman ignited a crowd celebrating 100 years of Purdue wrestling with a fall at 133 pounds. Key decisions were registered by No. 17 Braden Atwood in a battle of ranked wrestlers and Brandon Nelsen rallied late for a win in sudden victory.

PURDUE RANKINGS NOTES

- The Boilermakers retained their No. 23 position on the USA Today/NWCA Division I Coaches Poll ... they have appeared on nine of the 15 polls issued this season ... the team ranking is the 16th while under the direction of head coach Tony Ersland.
- The next edition of the USA Today/NWCA Division I Coaches Poll will be the last of the season.
- Purdue gained one spot on FloWrestling's and WIN Magazine's dual rankings to 18 and 21, respectivley ... InterMat dropped the Boilermakers from No. 21 to 24 this week.
- InterMat moved Chad Welch to No. 8 in its 165-pound rankings this week ... it is his 10th consecutive appearance among the top 10, which stands as the longest a Purdue wrestler has been ranked among the top 10 since Cashé Quiroga, who was ranked among the top 10 at 133 for the entire 2011-12 season ... C. Welch's career-best ranking of No. 5 in the Jan. 4 edition from InterMat was the highest individual since A.J. Kissel was listed fifth at 184 on Nov. 23, 2010.
- Thanks to a pair of upsets the past month, Luke Welch has earned his first-ever ranking from FloWrestling ... L. Welch defeated No. 8 Johnni DiJulius of Ohio State 3-1 (1/31) and No. 19 Anthony Giraldo of Rutgers 3-1 (TB1) (2/14) ... Gregg Henry has included L. Welch on its last three editions of top-33 rankings.
- When ranked, Purdue wrestlers are 20-9 vs. unranked competition and 6-3 vs. ranked opponents ... 10 wins have come in unranked Purdue wrestlers vs. ranked opponents, four of which are against top-10 competition.
- Of the Boilermakers 16 wins vs. ranked competition, five have come from C. Welch ... his 2:25 pin of No. 4 Cooper Moore of Northern Iowa (12/4) stands as the highest ranked opponent a Purdue wrestler has defeated this season ... Danny Sabatello has defeated a trio of ranked foes, including a 15-4 major decision over Nebraska's 17th-ranked Anthony Abidin at Midlands (12/29) ... L. Welch, Alex Griffin and Doug Welch also have a pair of wins over ranked opponents.

NCAA Wrestling Coaches' Panel, RPI Information

- On Feb. 11, the NCAA released its second of four coaches' panel rankings and the first RPI ... the third set of coaches' panel rankings and second RPI are scheduled to be released Feb. 25.
- Pre-allocation numbers, based off a measurement of Division I winning percentage at the weight class, RPI ranking and coaches ranking, are scheduled to be released Feb. 25.
- The NCAA Wrestling coaches' rankings are compiled by a vote of coaches representing each qualifying tournament ... in order to be eligible for the rankings, wrestlers must have participated in at least five matches against Division I opponents in the weight class and have wrestled within the last 30 days.
- To be eligible for an RPI ranking, a wrestler must have a minimum of 17 Division I matches at a given weight class.
- The final rankings and RPI are expected to be released March 7 and are two of the tools used as part of the selection process to determine the qualifiers and seeding for the NCAA Championships.

RECORD MAKERS & CHASERS

Career Falls

- Drake Stein landed on the list with a 27-second stick of Rutgers' Hayden Hrymack ... he shares the No. 18 spot with four others: Calvin Vande Hoef (1985-88), Chris Fleeger (2002-06), Doug Withsandley (2002-06) and Jason Cook (2004-07).
- Chad Welch's next pin will earn him a spot on the list ... he has pinned six opponents this season, which is a career best, pushing his career total to 16.

Career Takedowns

• With three takedowns, Sabatello took over at No. 15 on the career record list with 244, surpassing Oscar Santiago (2000-03), who had 243 ... Sabatello's next bench mark is 254, held by Tony Vaughn (1993-96) ... he has 49 takedowns in 27 matches (1.8/match) ... his season high takedown total came in 2013-14 when he had 73 and averaged 1.4 per match.

Career Reversals

• Doug Welch is tied for the team lead in reversals with six ... he is two shy of earning a spot on the list with 29.

Career Back Points

- Sabatello moved up one spot to No. 12 with a four-point nearfall vs. Billy Rappo of Maryland ... he now has 140 career back points ... he can quickly climb the ranks as only eight points separate him from cracking the top 10 (148).
- C. Welch is right behind him in the No. 13 spot with 139 ... he has a team- and career-high 64 back points this season (6 2N, 13 4N).
- Alex Griffin bypassed Jason Cook (2004-07) for No. 14 spot with a four-point nearfall of Indiana's Luke Blanton ... he now has 138 in his career and 52 this season (6 2N, 10 4N).

MIDSEASON ADDITION

• NJCAA All-American Jeremy Golding joined the Purdue wrestling team at the semester break ... Golding was a two-time NJCAA 149-pound qualifier while wrestling at North Idaho College ... Golding was an ASICS/Vaughn Greco-Roman All-American at 140 in 2011 ... three-time Washington Interscholastic Activities Association state champ (2010: 125; 2011: 135; 2012: 145) ... he also placed eighth at 119 as a freshman in 2009.

#BOILERNOTES

Rutgers

- It was the first meeting between Purdue and Rutgers as Big Ten opponents ... it was the final Big Ten dual of the season ... the Boilermakers finished with a 3-6 conference record, the same as 2014-15.
- Peter Andreotti and Jacob Aven wrestled in the first Big Ten matches of their careers ... Andreotti wrestled for the first time at 174 ... both redshirt freshman wrestled against Shippensburg (11/21).
- Luke's Schroeder's 4-1 decision over Sean McCabe at 125 was his first dual victory since Dec. 18, 2011.
- Luke Welch registered his second 3-1 upset in as many weeks ... defeated No. 8 Johnni DiJulius of Ohio State 3-1 on Jan. 31.
- After going winless against Big Ten competition his first two seasons, Lynde turned in a 5-4 conference record with a 5-4 showing against Anthony Pafumi.
- Drake Stein's 27-second pin of Hayden Hrymack was the fastest of his career and his second-ever coming under a minute ... it pushed his season fall total to six, which matches a season best from 2011-12 ... it was also his 80th career match.

Michigan

- Jeremy Golding and Kirk Johnson made their dual debuts at 149 and 174 pounds, respectively ... it was the seventh different lineup used this season and the fourth in Big Ten duals.
- Eight bouts resulted in bonus points ... 125-157 were all major decisions, three for Michigan and two for Purdue.
- Danny Sabatello registered career win No. 75 ... it was also the 10th major decision of his career ... 35 percent of Sabatello's career wins are with bonus points (10 MD, 7 TF, 9 F).
- Chad Welch started his 60th career dual and picked up his 35th career dual victory ... Doug Welch wrestled his 95th career match and picked up career win No. 58.

Indiana

- Purdue won its sixth straight in the series, which is the longest winning streak for the Boilermakers all-time in the series ... it was the 102nd all-time meeting ... they have now won three straight in Bloomington ... it was their fourth win in the series when it's contested on Feb. 7.
- The upset of Indiana is the Boilermakers' first win over a ranked opponent since Jan. 16, 2015, when they beat No. 19 Northwestern 22-17.
- Chad Welch won career match No. 75 and wrestled the 125th match of his career ... Doug Welch wrestled in the 40th and Tanner Lynde the 30th dual matches of their respective careers.
- The Boilermakers claimed six bouts via decision, including five in-a-row from 133 to 165 ... it was just the second dual this season without a bonus point win.

Ohio State

- A critical call in the second period after a Luke Welch takedown proved to be the deciding factor in a 3-1 upset of No. 8 Johnni DiJulius ... a scramble situation and shot attempt by DiJulius with less than a minute to go in the second period saw L. Welch come out on top with a takedown ... DiJulius popped out, came around and was awarded a reversal, but as time expired, the officials reversed the call and it was a 2-1 lead for L. Welch heading into the third.
- DiJulius stands as the highest-ranked opponent L. Welch has defeated in his career and is his first top-10 upset ... with the win, he avenged an 8-3 loss to Buckeye, who was ranked fifth, at the Cliff Keen Collegiate Wrestling Invitational in Las Vegas in December.

- Luke Schroeder (125) made his first dual start since Feb. 7, 2014.
- •Alex Griffin registered his second technical fall of the season and the ninth of his career ... Drake Stein and Jacob Morrissey each picked up the 30th win of their careers.

Minnesota

- Chad Welch's major decision was his fourth straight, making him the first Purdue grappler to win three or more straight matches by major decision since A.J. Kissel in November 2010
- Both of Jacob Morrissey's technical falls this season have come in Big Ten duals ... two of Tanner Lynde's four falls this season have been in Big Ten duals.
- Alex Griffin recorded the biggest upset of his career, beating ninth-ranked Jake Short 4-2 in sudden victory ... it was the third win of his career over a ranked opponent.
- The dual started at 157 pounds ... it was the first time this season the starting weight had been drawn.

Maryland

- Five bonus point victories and an upset by Doug Welch highlighted the 32-6 win ... the Boilermakers registered three major decisions, a technical fall and had a pin at 197 pounds.
- The win was the first for Purdue in three meetings vs. Maryland ... it was the first time the two teams met as Big Ten Conference opponents.
- Purdue held a 19-7 takedown advantage and scored first in six of the bouts ... the Boilermakers tallied 30 back points with a trio of two-point nearfalls and six four-point nearfalls ... the five bonus point wins tied a season high in a dual.
- Alex Griffin registered the 10th major decision of his career ... redshirt sophomore Cody Pae made his first career dual start at 133.
- Chad Welch and Alex Griffin won both of their weekend matches with bonus points ... C. Welch had two major decisions ... Griffin had a technical fall and a major decision.

Michigan State

- Purdue won seven bouts, including three with bonus points, in a 27-15 dual victory over Michigan State ... was the Boilermakers' fifth straight and 26th overall win in the series ... it was also their 12th win in East Lansing.
- The Boilermakers had a 14-5 takedown advantage ... they scored 20 back points with a pair of two-point nearfalls and four four-point nearfalls.
- Alex Griffin won his 40th career match with the eighth technical fall of his career ... he has now held 11 opponents scoreless in his three seasons ... it was his third bonus point win of the season.

Penn State

• Redshirt junior Tyler Kral won his first Big Ten dual match with a 7-4 decision over Jan Johnson for the Boilermakers' only win in the dual ... Danny Sabatello made his 50th career and 38th consecutive dual start.

53rd Ken Kraft Midlands Championships

- Chad Welch became Purdue's second-ever Midlands Championships titlist and the program's first since Dave Gibson in 1963 ... Welch is the third 165-pound Boilermaker to place at Midlands and the first since Luke Manuel's back-to-back eighth-place finishes in 2007 and 2008 ... Welch is the sixth Purdue wrestler to make the Midlands' finals, marking the seventh time a Boilermaker has been in the title match.
- Welch outscored his competition 47-8 in five matches, including points scored in his two pins ... his other wins included one decision, one major decision, one tech and he received one medical forfeit.

- Ben Thornton became Purdue's first 125-pounder to place at Midlands, upsetting 11th-seeded Brandon Jeske of Old Dominion with a 6-4 decision for seventh place ... the seventh-place showing is the sixth overall for the Boilermakers at the tournament ... it's the second tournament placing for Thornton in his redshirt freshman season, he also placed fifth wrestling unattached at the Michigan State Open.
- With two Boilermakers placing, Purdue now has 36 placewinners in the 53-year history of the Ken Kraft Midlands Championships ... it is the first time since 2011 Purdue has had multiple placewinners ... the Boilermakers have now sent at least one wrestler to the podium in each of the last three seasons.
- Purdue totaled 54.5 points to finish 11th in the team standings ... last year the Boilermakers were 16th with 33 points and one medalist.

Cliff Keen Las Vegas Collegiate Wrestling Invitational

- Chad Welch was Purdue's first Cliff Keen Las Vegas Collegiate Wrestling Invitational finalist since Logan Brown at 197 pounds in 2010 ... since 2002, six Boilermakers have advanced to the finals ... C. Welch became the 26th Purdue wrestler to have placed in the tournament ... the last 165-pounder to place for Purdue was Luke Manuel with a fourth-place finish in 2008.
- Ninth-seeded Alex Griffin (149) bounced back from his first loss of the season, a 6-5 decision to the No. 8 seed, Geordan Martinez of Boise State, by shutting out Virginia Tech's third-seeded and 13th-ranked Sal Mastriani with an 8-0 major decision ... it was the second dominating upset of his career ... last year he posted an 8-1 upset of No. 11 Alexander Richardson of Old Dominion in dual action.
- Doug Welch, who was seeded second at 157, advanced to the quarterfinals, but was edged by seventh-seeded Russell Parsons of Army 6-4 ... D. Welch went 2-2 with a fall and a decision.
- Purdue finished the tournament with a combined mark of 20-18 ... nine bouts were won with bonus points and the Boilermakers won two matches by injury default.
- Danny Sabatello picked up career win No. 70 with his 4:12 pin of Jake Velarde from Boise State ... Luke Welch posted his first career major decision with a 12-4 showing against Jordan Gurrola of San Francisco State ... Ben Thornton recorded his first technical fall, a 19-1 match vs. Patrick Kearney of The Citadel that ended at 6:57.

Bloomsburg, Shippensburg, Lock Haven

- The Boilermakers have put 30-or more points on the board in five of their first six duals this season ... the 2006-07 season saw Purdue score 30+ in five duals during the season ... the season with the most duals where the Boilermakers scored 30+ was in 2002-03 with 10.
- The 37-12 win in their first-ever trip to Bloomsburg was the Boilermakers' third straight in the series.
- Purdue won in Lock Haven for the third time in the series ... the last win in Lock Haven came in 1958, which was also the last time the Boilermakers were a true road team in the series ... it had been nearly 23 years since Purdue last met the Bald Eagles ... the 23 years since the last meeting is Purdue's third longest stretch among all-time, active Division I opponents ... the Boilermakers last faced West Virginia in 1954, a span of 61 years, and Virginia Tech in 1965, a span of 50 years.
- Firsts / Redshirt freshman Ben Thornton recorded the first major decision of his career with a 16-4 outing vs. Jon Haas of Bloomsburg ... fellow redshirt freshmen Peter Andreotti (165), Blake Reid (174) and Jacob Aven (285) all won with bonus points in their dual debuts vs. Shippensburg ... it was the first-ever meeting with NCAA Division II Shippensburg ... the Raiders were the 148th all-time opponent in program history.

Eastern Michigan Duals

- Purdue made its first-ever trip to Ypsilanti, Michigan ... the last time the Boilermakers began the season at a dual tournament was in 2010 at the Edinboro Duals.
- Purdue's 30-9 win over Northern Illinois was its 20th in the series (20-8-1) ... Boilermakers extended their winning streak against Eastern Michigan (30-13) to seven straight.
- Of the Boilermakers' 19 wins, four came by fall, two were major decisions, there was one technical fall and one injury default was received ... three of the wins were upsets, two of which came in head-to-head matchups between ranked wrestlers ... the other was an unranked Purdue grappler sticking the nation's 13th-ranked 197-pounder.
- C. Welch posted three-straight bonus point victories (MD, TF, F) ... it's the first time in his career he won three in a row with bonus points ... his 15-0 tech fall marked the third time in four career tech falls he shut his opponent out ... he totaled 14 back points in three matches.
- Drake Stein won his 12th career match by fall ... Ben Thornton and true freshman Jon Morales wrestled their first dual matches at Purdue.

TONY ERSLAND

Head Coach / Second Season

During his 18 years as a Division I wrestling coach, Tony Ersland has played an integral role in developing student-athletes that are accomplished on the mat and nationally recognized. He has had 94 wrestlers qualify for the NCAA Championships, with 28 earning All-America honors and four finishing at the top of the podium. Two of his pupils, Jordan Burroughs and Jake Herbert, earned the highest honor a collegiate grappler can receive in the Dan Hodge Award. Ersland continued to develop

Burroughs on the international stage as he claimed the 2011 and 2013 World titles at 74 kg. In 2012, Burroughs claimed Olympic gold in London.

In his first season at Purdue, Ersland qualified eight to the 2015 NCAA Championships, the most among 13 Division I coaches that were spending their first season at the helm of their respective program. Five of his wrestlers earned a spot on the podium at the Big Ten Championships. His squad spent seven weeks on the USA Today/NWCA Division I Coaches Poll, finishing the season ranked 23rd. Five of his grapplers were ranked by InterMat during the course of the 2014-15 season, two of which pushed into the top 10 at their respective weight.

The 2014-15 dual season saw Ersland's Boilermakers win 10 duals, including six at home and three over ranked teams. The six duals won in Holloway Gymnasium were the most since the 2005-06 season.

Ersland came to Purdue after serving as an assistant coach at Nebraska for eight seasons. While on staff, the Huskers tallied a 102-41-2 dual record, recorded seven top-20 team finishes at the NCAA Championships and grapplers earned 17 All-America honors.

Prior to his post at Nebraska, Ersland coached the Cyclone Wrestling Club in Ames, Iowa. Ersland worked with Iowa State NCAA champions Trent Paulson (157) and David Zabriskie (285) among other multiple NCAA qualifiers and All-Americans.

His familiarity with the Big Ten extends beyond his time at Nebraska. From 2000-05, Ersland was the head assistant wrestling coach at Northwestern, and he also served as a coach and board member for the Wildcat Wrestling Club.

He was the head assistant wrestling coach at Northern Illinois in 1999 and 2000 after getting his start as a graduate assistant at Central Michigan from 1997 to 1999.

On the mat, Ersland wrestled for the University of Iowa under legendary coach Dan Gable and was a part of three-straight NCAA team championships (1995-97) and four Big Ten Championships (1994-97). During his senior season in 1997, Ersland finished one match shy of All-America honors at 177 pounds.

The Humboldt, Iowa, native excelled in the classroom as a four-time Academic All-Big Ten selection and Board of Control Athletics Award winner, and was bestowed with lowa wrestling's J. Donald McPike Award, given to the senior on the team with the highest grade-point average.

Ersland earned his Bachelor of Arts degree in psychology from Iowa (1997) and a Master of Arts in athletic administration from Central Michigan (1999).

Ersland and his wife, Carolyn, have twin sons, Mason and Jaxon.

During his first season as an assistant coach, Zach Tanelli coached eight Boilermakers to the 2015 NCAA Championships and five to podium finishes at the Big Ten Championships. Purdue spent seven weeks on the USA Today/NWCA Division I Coaches Poll, finishing the season ranked 23rd. Individually, five Boilermakers were ranked by InterMat during the course of the 2014-15 season, two of which pushed into the top 10 at their respective weight.

The 2014-15 dual season saw Purdue win 10 duals, including six at home and three over ranked teams. The six duals won in Holloway Gymnasium were the most since the 2005-06 season.

Tanelli joined the Boilermaker wrestling program after a five-year coaching stint at Hofstra. During his tenure, Tanelli worked his way up the coaching ranks and most recently served as interim head coach. He was the head assistant coach for the two previous seasons after spending his first three years as an assistant coach with the Pride.

The former Badger made an impact throughout Hofstra's lineup, particularly in the lower weights. Tanelli coached four All-Americans in Steve Bonanno (125), Lou Ruggirello (133), Justin Accordino (149) and P.J. Gillespie (165). The Pride won threestraight Colonial Athletic Association (CAA) team titles (2011-13) before moving to the Eastern Intercollegiate Wrestling Association (EIWA) in 2013-14, where they placed fourth with two finalists, including the 165-pound champion, Joseph Booth.

While in the CAA, seven Hofstra grapplers claimed tournament crowns under the guidance of Tanelli, including a pair of two-time champs in Bonanno and 184-pounder Ben Clymer. Jamie Franco (133), Luke Vaith (141), Gillespie (165), Ryan Patrovich (174) and Paul Snyder (HWT) were also titlists for Tanelli.

Tanelli wrestled the first three years of his Badger career at 133 pounds and bumped up to 141 for his senior campaign in 2009. He was a two-time NCAA qualifier at 133 and earned a spot on the 141 podium with a fourth-place finish for All-America accolades. During his senior season, Tanelli went on a blaze, owning a 31-6 record. including a spotless 7-0 mark against Big Ten foes. He was ranked No. 1 at his weight for the second half of the 2008-09 season after winning the 141-pound Midlands Championships title and was bestowed with the Champion of Champions Award.

Tanelli was a three-time Big Ten Championships placewinner and improved upon his finish each year. As a sophomore, he placed eighth at 133, followed by a fifth-place finish as a junior. Tanelli then took second at 141 as a senior.

During his career at Wisconsin, Tanelli compiled an 88-31 record with a blistering .967 winning percentage. He won 44 percent of his matches with bonus points, registering 15 major decisions, 13 falls and 11 technical falls.

A native of Millburn, New Jersey, Tanelli earned his Bachelor of Arts degree in Sociology from Wisconsin in 2009 and his master's degree in higher educational leadership and policy studies from Hofstra in 2012.

Tyrel Todd brings a standard of excellence into the Boilermaker wrestling room. The decorated collegiate wrestler with high caliber national and international freestyle experience enters his second season as an assistant coach at Purdue.

During his first season on staff, Todd coached eight Boilermakers to the 2015 NCAA Championships and five to podium finishes at the Big Ten Championships. Purdue spent seven weeks on the USA Today/NWCA

Division I Coaches Poll, finishing the season ranked 23rd. Individually, five Boilermakers were ranked by InterMat during the course of the 2014-15 season, two of which pushed into the top 10 at their respective weight.

The 2014-15 dual season saw Purdue win 10 duals, including six at home and three over ranked teams. The six duals won in Holloway Gymnasium were the most since the 2005-06 season.

Todd came to Purdue after serving as an assistant coach at Cal Poly (2010-11) and Arizona State (2013-14). While on staff at Cal Poly, Todd coached four NCAA qualifiers (141, 157, 165, 197), including a runner-up finish from Borislav Novachkov at 141. The following season Ryan DesRoches earned All-America honors at 174.

In July 2013, Todd was named an assistant coach at Arizona State where he worked hands on daily with the upper-weights, including Blake Staffer, who earned All-America honors at 184 pounds with a third-place finish at the 2015 NCAA Championships. Todd's work at ASU focused on recruiting, coordinating practices, developing training schedules and organizing team travel.

From August 2011 - July 2013, Todd trained alongside his former teammates, while also mentoring and aiding in their individual development, at the Cliff Keen Wrestling Club in Ann Arbor, Michigan. His position allowed him to spend extensive time training alongside the top freestyle wrestlers in the country and to tour and compete in Russia, Chechnya and Ukraine.

A three-time All-American and 2009 Big Ten champion at Michigan, Todd made his mark on the Wolverine program wrestling at 184 and 197 pounds. In his first three seasons at 184, Todd posted an 82-24 record while placing fifth, third and second at the Big Ten Championships and earning as many trips to the NCAA Championships. Todd earned a spot on the podium his sophomore and junior campaigns, placing fifth and third, respectively.

Bumping up to 197 pounds in his final season, Todd registered a 25-3 record en route to a Big Ten title and a fourth-place showing at the NCAA Championships. He finished with a career record of 121-30, with his 121 wins ranking 16th all-time at Michigan. In four NCAA appearances, Todd compiled a 16-7 mark, which ranks seventh in program history. He is also tied for third all-time with a 13-4 career record at the Big Ten Championships.

Todd's pursuit of excellence extended beyond the mat and into the classroom. He was an All-Big Ten Academic selection and Athletic Academic Achievement Award winner in 2006, received the Snip Nalan Scholarship for Wrestling in 2008-09 and was named the team's Distinguished Scholar in 2009.

Todd also found success wrestling freestyle at 84 kg. He took fifth at the 2007 ASICS U.S. National Championships, eighth in 2008 and was seventh in 2011. In 2008, Todd placed fourth at the Olympic Trials, narrowly missing a bid for the Olympic Games in Beijing.

Todd is a native of Bozeman, Mont., and hails from a six-generation dairy farming operation. He received his bachelor's degree in secondary education from Michigan in 2009, majoring in history and minoring in psychology. He and his wife, Loni, have a daughter, Jacy Clair.
