■ GAME 07: The Facts

- Purdue puts two different six-game streaks on the line in Tuesday's Big Ten / ACC Challenge against Pittsburgh. The Boilermakers are 6-0 on the young season and have won their last six Challenge games.
- The contest will be televised at 9 p.m. from the Petersen Events Center on ESPN2 with Bob Wischusen and LaPhonso Ellis calling the action courtside.
- On the radio waves, Larry Clisby, and Rob Blackman will handle the call on the 27-station Purdue Sports Network. Coverage begins with the Purdue Basketball pregame show one hour before tip.
- Live stats will be available via Gametracker on PurdueSports.com. As always, Twitter updates will be provided on the official Purdue basketball account, @BoilerBall.

■ Scouting Purdue

- The No. 11-ranked Boilermakers are 6-0 for the second time in 11 years under Matt Painter after topping Lehigh on Saturday night, 77-55.
- The Boilermakers are suffocating on the defensive end of the floor, Time / Result | ranking in the top 20 nationally in field goal percentage defense (1st), scoring margin (6th), scoring defense (9th), blocked shots (8th), rebound margin (9th) and 3-point percentage defense (17th).
 - Offensively, Purdue is 37th nationally in scoring offense and 41st in field goal percentage.
 - The Boilermakers are led by sophomore Isaac Haas (15.0 PPG, 75.6 FG pct.), Rapheal Davis (11.6 PPG) and Vince Edwards (10.5 PPG, 5.8 RPG, 3.3 APG). Three other players average at least 9.0 PPG.
 - Purdue's sophomore class has combined to average 38.7 points, 17.5 rebounds and 8.8 assists per game, while shooting 75-of-131 (.573) from the field. The group has just 15 turnovers between them.

► THE PROBABLE LINEUPS

■ Scouting Pittsburgh

- Consistently one of the top teams in the country, Pittsburgh is off to a strong start, posting a 4-0 record and winning its games by an average of 27.5 points per game.
- The Panthers take care of the ball, averaging just 10.3 turnovers per game while ranking second nationally in assist-to-turnover margin at
- Forward Michael Young leads the Panthers in scoring (18.0 PPG), rebounding (8.0 RPG) and assists (4.8 APG). Jamel Artis contributes 15.3 PPG and is shooting 59.0 percent from the field.
- Pitt is averaging 89.2 points per game while allowing 61.8.

■ The Coaches

- Matt Painter (Purdue, 1994) is in his 11th year at Purdue, owning a 218-125 record. Painter is one of six coaches in Big Ten history to win three Big Ten Coach of the Year awards and his 218 wins are the third most by a Purdue coach in school history.
- Jamie Dixon (TCU, 1987) is in his 13th year at Pittsburgh, owning a 311-111 record at the school. Under Dixon, Pittsburgh has reached the NCAA Tournament in 10 of the 12 previous seasons.

▶ THE BIG NUMBER

Purdue leads the country in field goal percentage defense. Over the last four games, opponents are shooting just 82-of-271 (.303) from the field.

■ Painter Moving Up the Charts

- Matt Painter has moved into third place on the school's career games coached list, leading his squad into his 344th game in his 11th season on Tuesday against Pittsburgh.
- Painter owns a 218-125 (.636) record, the third-most wins for a head coach in school history.
- With the 6-0 start, Painter has moved into fifth place on the school's career winning percentage list with a .636 winning percentage.

■ Success in the Challenge

- Purdue has had tremendous success in the Big Ten / ACC Challenge, posting an 8-6 record, the best mark of any team in the Big Ten excluding Maryland, which was 10-5 as a member of the ACC and is now 10-6 overall.
- The Boilermakers are 7-3 under **Matt Painter** in Big Ten / ACC Challenge games and are 2-4 on the road in the event.

• Purdue is also second in the country in 2-point percentage defense (.349) and 14th in the country in 3-point percentage defense (.250). Gonzaga, Oklahoma and Purdue are the only teams in America to rank in the top 15 of both of the above categories.

- Purdue has held four of its opponents under 30.0 percent shooting and in the first half, four opponents have been held under 25.0 percent shooting from the field.
- Purdue is ninth in country in scoring defense (57.3), holding three of its foes to 55 points or less.
- Purdue also ranks eighth in the country in blocked shots per game (6.7), third in defensive rebounds per game (34.5) and ninth in rebound margin (+13.7).
- In 2,028 games this year played by Division I teams (through Sunday), there have been six games where a Division I team held another Division I team to 40 or fewer points. Purdue has done it twice.

■ The Word According to Ken Pomeroy

- We here at Purdue like to follow statistician **Ken Pomeroy** and his numbers paint a pretty picture for the Boilermakers.
- \bullet Purdue ranks 16th in adjusted offensive efficiency (112.5 / 100 possessions) and ninth in adjusted defensive efficiency (91.8).
- Purdue's effective field goal percentage defense is first nationally (35.7 percent). Oklahoma is second (36.2) and Villanova is third (37.2).
- The teams listed in the top 20 of both categories are a who's-who of college basketball this season.

■ Large Margins

- The 28-point halftime lead (44-16) against North Carolina A&T was tied for the 16th-largest margin in school history.
- The 41-point victory (81-40) against North Carolina A&T was tied for the 15th-largest margin of victory in Mackey Arena history.
- Purdue has won its first six games by 15 or more points for the first time in school history.

■ Quick Starts Are the Key

- Since the 1950-51 season, Purdue has started 6-0 or better eight times, including this season. In the previous seven years that Purdue started 6-0 or better, the Boilermakers combined to post a 163-57 record with three Sweet 16 appearances.
- Purdue has now started 6-0 or better twice of **Matt Painter's** 11 seasons at Purdue. Purdue's last 7-0 start came with during a 14-0 start to begin the 2009-10 season.

■ Win When Shooting More

• Purdue has won 23 straight games when shooting more free throws than its opponent, including four times this year.

■ Sizzling From 20 Feet, 9 Inches

- A year after shooting just 32.7 percent from 3-point range and with many questions entering the season about perimeter play, Purdue has quieted those discussions at least for now.
- The Boilermakers connected on a school-record 18 3-pointers in the win over Vermont on November 15, one game after making 12 in the season opener against North Carolina A&T.
- The Boilermakers are shooting 39.2 percent (60-of-153) from 3-point range to rank 54th nationally, one year after ranking 239th.
- In addition, Purdue ranks 24th nationally in 3-pointers per game, making 10.0 trifectas per game.
- Seven different players have made at least two 3-pointers in a game this year (Cline, Davis, Edwards, Mathias, Stephens, Swanigan, Thompson). Four different players (Cline, Edwards, Mathias, Stephens) have made at least four trifectas in a game this year.
- Last season, Purdue had just seven players make at least 10 3-pointers for the entire season. This year, Purdue has seven players averaging at least 1.0 3-pointer per game, a rate that would give the Boilermakers seven players with at least 30 3-pointers this year.

■ Gimme All The Points

- Purdue is averaging 1.18 points per possession to rank 16th nationally, while defensively, the Boilermakers are allowing just 0.77 points per possession to rank sixth nationally.
- Purdue is one of six teams (Purdue, Louisville, West Virginia, Grand Canyon University, Houston, Baylor) to rank in the top 20 nationally in points per possession on both sides of the ball.

■ November Reign

- With Saturday's win over Lehigh concluding the month of November, **Matt Painter** is now 37-1 (.974) at home during the month. The lone loss was on Nov. 9, 2012, to Bucknell (70-65). The average margin of victory in those games is 25.4 points (940 points).
- Going back further, Purdue is 72-7 (.911) all-time at Mackey Arena during the month of November.
- Painter will carry a 51-13 overall record during the month of November into next season.

■ Gameday Adjustments

• Last year, Purdue went 0-4 when being outscored in the paint. Already twice this year, Purdue has won two games when being outscored in the paint (Florida and Vermont).

■ Boilermakers Hot at Home

- Purdue enters Saturday's game against New Mexico having won 10 straight games at Mackey Arena. Purdue has won the 10 straight games by a combined 171 points (17.1 PPG).
- With nine non-conference home games on the slate, an undefeated non-conference schedule will give Purdue 15 straight home wins, which would tie for the sixth-longest home winning streak in Mackey Arena history.

• Matt Painter now owns five double-digit homecourt winning streaks in his 11 years at Purdue.

■ The Swat Club

- Purdue blocked 13 shots against Incarnate Word on Nov. 18, the second most in a game nationally this season and the third most in a game in school history.
- Purdue has blocked 40 shots, the seventh most nationally so far this year and its 6.7 per game average is eighth nationally.

■ Blocked Shot University

- In six of the last seven years, Purdue has had the Big Ten's top shotblocker as **A.J. Hammons** led the league in blocked shots for the third straight season (2.78 BPG) a year ago.
- Hammons' 2.78 blocks per game were the most for a Big Ten player since Ohio State's Greg Oden averaged 3.44 BPG in the 2006-07 season.
 It's the second-best average since the 2001-02 season (behind Oden).
- Hammons became the third player in Big Ten history to lead the league in blocked shots at least three times (2013-15). Penn State's **Calvin Booth** led the league in blocks four times from 1996-99, while Purdue's **JaJuan Johnson** led the league from 2009-11.
- Prior to 2009, no Purdue player had ever led the league in blocked shots.
- Purdue's 177 blocks were the most in a season in school history and the 5.21 blocked shots per game were the second-highest average in school history behind last year's average of 5.25 blocks per game.
- This year's team is on pace for 233 blocks (35-game season).

■ Balancing Act

- Most impressive of Purdue's offensive attack this year has been Purdue's balance. The Boilermakers have had 10 players record doublefigure scoring games this year and five different players have led the team in scoring.

• With a pair of Sweet 16 appearances, six NCAA Tournament berths, Big Ten regular-season and tournament titles and an international gold medal on his résumé, 10th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest minds in all of college basketball.

- Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in March of 2011, agreeing to a new eight-year contract that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2018-19 season.
- Painter has averaged over 21 wins per season during his tenure at the helm of the Purdue program, including at least 20 victories in six of those
- Painter's tenure has seen Purdue basketball restore its status among the upper echelon of college basketball programs. The last eight years have seen six 20-win seasons and NCAA Tournament berths, two Sweet 16 appearances, a regular-season Big Ten title and a Big Ten Tournament crown.
- The three winningest classes in program history are the classes of 2011, 2012 and 2010, respectively, and five of the 10 winningest individual players Purdue has ever seen have come from the Painter ranks. Success, however, didn't happen overnight.
- Painter officially became the 18th head men's basketball coach in Purdue history on April 1, 2005, and immediately set about laying the groundwork for a dramatic reversal in the program's fortunes.
- •The Boilermakers were at their best during the 2009 postseason run, rattling off double-digit victories over Penn State and Illinois to reach the Big Ten Tournament final, where they dispatched Ohio State, 65-61, to earn the first conference tournament crown in program history.
- Painter has also resurrected Mackey Arena as one of the country's best home-court advantages, piling up a 141-31 (.820) record at home over the last nine seasons, including a remarkable 77-7 (.917) record against non-conference opponents.
- Painter has been named Big Ten Coach of the Year three times in the last six seasons, earning the consensus award in 2008 and 2011, and winning the coaches' vote in 2010. He is one of only six men to win the award more at least three times since its inception in 1974.
- Painter has seen a total of 21 players earn a combined 40 Academic All-Big Ten honors during his tenure as head coach. Painter has also mentored an Academic All-American, as Moore earned second-team honors during the 2009-10 season.
