GAME 12: The Facts

• Purdue looks for just its fifth 12-0 start or better in 118 seasons of basketball on Saturday when the ninth-ranked Boilermakers face No. 17-ranked Butler at the Crossroads Classic in Indianapolis.

• The contest will be televised by the Big Ten Network (BTN) with **Cory Provus** and **Jon Crispin** calling the game courtside at Bankers Life Fieldhouse, beginning at 5 p.m. ET.

• On the radio waves, **Larry Clisby** and **Rob Blackman** will handle the call on the 27-station Purdue Sports Network as well as SIRIUS (Ch. 135) and XM (Ch. 195) satellite radio. Coverage begins with the Purdue Basketball pregame show one hour before tip.

• Live stats will be available on StatBroadcast.com. As always, Twitter updates will be provided on the official Purdue basketball account, @BoilerBall.

Scouting Purdue

• The No. 9-ranked Boilermakers are 11-0 and the only team in America to be undefeated and win all of its games by double-digits.

• The Boilermakers lead the country in field goal percentage defense (.333) and are seventh in scoring defense (57.5) and rebound margin (+13.2).

• Purdue ranks in the top 50 in 12-of-17 NCAA statistical categories.

• Purdue has 10 players averaging between 14.9 and 27.2 minutes per game. Those 10 players average between 4.9 and 13.5 points per game.

• **Isaac Haas** (13.5), **A.J. Hammons** (12.6) and **Rapheal Davis** (11.6) all average in double figures. **Caleb Swanigan** chips in at 9.9 points per game and leads the team in rebounding (9.2 rpg).

• Seven different players average at least 1.7 assists per game. Purdue is shooting 48.5 percent from the field and 37.3 percent from long range.

Scouting Butler

• The best team on Purdue's schedule to date, Butler enters Saturday's contest with an 8-1 record and a 3-1 mark in the Crossroads Classic.

• The Bulldogs are one of the top offensive teams in the country, averaging 91.7 points per game and shooting 51.4 percent from the field. The Bulldogs outrebound their opponents by a 9.3 per game average and commit just 10.1 turnovers per game.

• All-Big East performer **Kellen Dunham** leads five players in double-figures at 19.1 points per game, while making 38-of-40 (.950) free throws. This week's Big East Player of the Week, **Kelan Martin**, averages 14.8 points and **Roosevelt Jones** contributes 13.1 points and 7.4 rebounds.

The Coaches

• **Matt Painter** (Purdue, 1994) is in his 11th year at Purdue, owning a 223-125 record. Painter is one of six coaches in Big Ten history to win three Big Ten Coach of the Year awards and his 223 wins are the third most by a Purdue coach in school history.

• **Chris Holtmann** (Taylor, 1994) is in his second year at Butler, posting a 31-12 mark entering Saturday. He led the Bulldogs to the NCAA Round of 32 a year ago, losing to Notre Dame in an overtime thriller.

■ **Painter Moving Up the Charts**

- **Matt Painter** has moved into third place on the school's career games coached list, leading his squad into his 349th game in his 11th season on Saturday against Butler.
- Painter owns a 223-125 (.641) record, the third-most wins for a head coach in school history.
- With the 11-0 start, Painter has moved into fifth place on the school's career winning percentage list with a .639 winning percentage.

■ **Program Stability**

- Purdue has had just two head coaches, **Gene Keady** and **Matt Painter**, since the start of the 1980-81 season, a span of 35 years.
- Since the **Ray Eddy** era began in 1950, Purdue has had just six head coaches in 66 years, and just eight head coaches in the last 99 years.

■ **Reaching Double-Figures**

- During the NCAA Tournament era (since 1938), Purdue has started 11-0 or better just three times including this season. In the previous two years that Purdue started at least 11-0 (1993-94, 2009-10), the Boilermakers set a school record for victories with 29 and own a combined 58-11 record (.841).
- With a win against Butler, Purdue will start 12-0 for just the fifth time in school history (1990-01, 1911-12, 1993-94, 2009-10).

■ **Winning Margins**

- Through games played on Monday, there are eight remaining undefeated teams. Of those eight teams, Purdue is only school in America to have won all its games by double-digits.
- This year's team became the first team in school history to win 10 straight games by double-digits following its 38-point win over Howard.

■ **At the Crossroads**

- While it may be the state's marquee college basketball event, Purdue has not performed well at the Crossroads Classic. The Boilermakers enter Saturday's game with Butler with an 0-4 record in the event.

■ **Most Among Non-Conference Teams**

- Saturday's game with Butler marks the 56th meeting between the two teams, the most meetings against a non-conference foe. Notre Dame is next at 42 games.
- Saturday's meeting will mark the first time in the 56 meetings that both teams enter the contest ranked in the AP top 25 poll.

■ **Trying For a Win**

- Purdue has lost four straight games to Butler, the fifth-longest active losing streak against a single opponent.
- Purdue has lost eight straight games to North Carolina and UCLA, seven to Michigan State, five to Xavier and four to Butler, Cincinnati, Memphis and Wisconsin.

■ **Something Big Happening in West Lafayette**

- Both teams that occupy space in Mackey Arena are having strong starts to their 2015-16 season. The Purdue men's and women's teams have combined for a 19-2 record for the eighth-best combined record in America.
- Purdue's 19 combined wins are tied for the most in the country.
- Four of the top 11 combined records hail from the Big Ten, showcasing where the best basketball is played.

■ **Purdue Winning Streaks**

- Purdue has won 11 straight games and is nearing the top-10 list for the longest winning streak in school history. The school record for consecutive wins is 16 set twice.

■ **Gameday Adjustments**

- Last year, Purdue went 0-4 when being outscored in the paint. Already this year, Purdue has won three games when being outscored in the paint (Vermont, Florida, Pittsburgh).

■ **Win When Shooting More**

- Purdue has won 26 straight games when shooting more free throws than its opponent, including eight times this year.

■ **Making More Than They Shoot**

- The goal of all good teams is to make more free throws than their opponents shoot and through 11 games this year, Purdue is doing that.
- The Boilermakers have made 184 free throws while opponents have shot just 175 free throws. Purdue is one of 18 teams to make more free throws than their opponents have shot.

■ Boilermakers Hot at Home

- Purdue enters next Tuesday's game against Vanderbilt having won 14 straight games at Mackey Arena.
- Since the start of last year, Purdue is now 22-3 at home and its 14-game winning streak is tied for the 14th-longest streak in the country and the second-longest winning streak in the Big 10 (Maryland - 19).
- Matt Painter** now owns five double-digit homecourt winning streaks in his 11 years at Purdue, and the current 14-game homecourt winning streak is tied for the seventh-longest streak in Mackey Arena.

■ Before the Calendar Turns

- Purdue is 77-6 (.928) under **Matt Painter** at Mackey Arena against non-conference foes before the calendar turns to January.

■ The Word According to Ken Pomeroy

- Purdue is one of eight teams to rank in the top 20 of both offensive and defensive efficiency. The Boilermakers allow 89.1 points / 100 possession on the defensive end and score 113.2 points / 100 possessions on the offensive end.

- Purdue's effective field goal percentage defense of 37.5 percent leads the country (Oklahoma is second at 38.8 percent).

- The Boilermakers are 13th nationally in assist rate (assists / FGM) at 67.6 percent.

- Lastly, Purdue is 18th nationally in defensive free throw attempts / field goal attempts at 25.7 percent. That means foes are shooting 25.7 free throws for every 100 field goal attempts, which shows Purdue does an excellent job of not fouling and sending teams to the free throw line.

■ Sharing is Caring

- Purdue recorded 28 assists against Howard, the most since having 30 against Alcorn State on Nov. 17, 2010, then followed it up with 26 assists in the win over Youngstown State.
- Over the last two games, Purdue has had 54 assists against 16 turnovers for an assist-to-turnover ratio of 3.38.
- Purdue has had assists on 54 of its 67 (.806) field goals made in the last two games.
- Purdue's 54 assists in the last two games equal the most in a two-game span in school history.
- Purdue now ranks 10th nationally in assists per game (19.4). Six different players have led the team in assists this year and seven different players have had at least five assists once this year.
- The Boilermakers have seven players averaging at least 1.7 assists per game.

■ Defense Lives Here

- Purdue leads the country in field goal percentage and that comes even without the Big Ten's top defensive player in **Rapheal Davis** being in the lineup for a four-game span and senior shot-blocker A.J. Hammons out of the lineup for two games.
- Purdue's 33.3 field goal percentage defense comes on the heels of leading the Big Ten (league games only) in field goal percentage defense a year ago (.393). Over the last 32 games (24-8 record), Purdue has held foes to 37.2 percent shooting (681-of-1,831).

- Purdue leads the country in 2-point percentage defense (.359) and is 16th in the country in 3-point percentage defense (.275). Purdue, Louisville, Vanderbilt, Michigan State, Washington, Oklahoma, Nevada are the only teams in America to rank in the top 40 of both 2-point and 3-point percentage defense.

- Purdue has held four of its 11 opponents under 30.0 percent shooting and seven of its 11 foes to 59 points or less.

- When holding foes under 59 points during the Painter era, the Boilermakers are 110-4.

- Purdue is fourth in the country in scoring defense and is the only team in America to rank in the top 20 in field goal percentage defense (2nd), scoring defense (7th), rebound margin (7th) and 3-point percentage defense (19th).

- Purdue leads the country in defensive points per possession at 0.78. West Virginia is second at 0.80 points per possession.

■ Efficient Offense

- Purdue ranks 17th nationally in **Ken Pomeroy's** offensive adjusted efficiency rankings and 23rd in effective field goal percentage. When the Boilermakers miss shots, it rebounds 35.8 percent of its misses, good for 50th nationally.

- In the NCAA rankings through games played on Tuesday, Purdue is in the nation's top 50 in 12-of-17 categories. The improvement from last year is staggering.

- Purdue is 3-0 this year away from Mackey Arena and has been impressive in doing so.
- In three games, the Purdue defense has held foes to 56.0 points per game and 32.8 percent shooting from the field to post its 3-0 record away from Mackey Arena.
- The Boilermakers beat Old Dominion by 22 (61-39), Florida by 15 (85-70) and Pittsburgh (72-59) in the Big Ten / ACC Challenge.

- Purdue has allowed just 113 offensive rebounds (10.3 per game), ranking second in the Big Ten in defensive rebound percentage (.763).

• With a pair of Sweet 16 appearances, six NCAA Tournament berths, Big Ten regular-season and tournament titles and an international gold medal on his résumé, 11th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest minds in all of college basketball.

• Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in March of 2011, agreeing to a new eight-year contract that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2018-19 season.

• Painter has averaged over 21 wins per season during his tenure at the helm of the Purdue program, including at least 20 victories in six of those seasons.

• Painter's tenure has seen Purdue basketball restore its status among the upper echelon of college basketball programs. The last eight years have seen six 20-win seasons and NCAA Tournament berths, two Sweet 16 appearances, a regular-season Big Ten title and a Big Ten Tournament crown.

• The three winningest classes in program history are the classes of 2011, 2012 and 2010, respectively, and five of the 10 winningest individual players Purdue has ever seen have come from the Painter ranks. Success, however, didn't happen overnight.

• Painter officially became the 18th head men's basketball coach in Purdue history on April 1, 2005, and immediately set about laying the groundwork for a dramatic reversal in the program's fortunes.

• The Boilermakers were at their best during the 2009 postseason run, rattling off double-digit victories over Penn State and Illinois to reach the Big Ten Tournament final, where they dispatched Ohio State, 65-61, to earn the first conference tournament crown in program history.

• Painter has also resurrected Mackey Arena as one of the country's best home-court advantages, piling up a 145-31 (.824) record at home over the last 11 seasons, including a remarkable 81-7 (.920) record against non-conference opponents.

• Painter has been named Big Ten Coach of the Year three times in the last six seasons, earning the consensus award in 2008 and 2011, and winning the coaches' vote in 2010. He is one of only six men to win the award more at least three times since its inception in 1974.

• Painter has seen a total of 21 players earn a combined 40 Academic All-Big Ten honors during his tenure as head coach. Painter has also mentored an Academic All-American, as Moore earned second-team honors during the 2009-10 season.
