### THE NOTES TO KNOW

- The No. 16-ranked Purdue basketball team faces its stiffest challenge of the season on Saturday, facing off against No. 2-ranked Auburn in the Battle in Birmingham in Legacy Arena. It will be Purdue's final game before the Holiday break and only the third game in a 14-day span entering the break. It marks just the fourth (of five) games during the month of December for the Boilermakers.
- Four of Purdue's 11 non-conference games will come against the SEC, already defeating No. 2-ranked Alabama (87-78) and No. 17-ranked Ole Miss (80-78). The Boilermakers fell to No. 12-ranked Texas A&M (70-66).
- Auburn will be the fifth non-conference ranked team that the Boilermakers will have faced, setting a school record (and leading the country) in non-conference ranked teams. In addition to the four ranked SEC teams, Purdue also fell to Marquette, which is currently ranked No. 9 in the AP Top 25 poll. The Boilermakers will have faced five of the top-17 ranked teams in this week's AP Top 25 poll. Nine of Purdue's 22 non-conference opponents since the start of last season have been ranked in the AP Top 25 poll at the time of the game.
- This marks Purdue's first trip to Birmingham and Legacy Arena since the 2003 NCAA Tournament, when the Boilermakers topped LSU in the opening round, before falling to top-seeded Texas in the round of 32. It was the final NCAA tournament game of **Gene Keady's** illustrious coaching career.
- Purdue's schedule currently ranks 10th nationally (KenPom), but is expected to move up after playing Auburn on Saturday. A year ago, Purdue played the nation's second-toughest schedule.
- In the last six games, Purdue is 97-of-127 (.764) from the free throw line. In the first five games, Purdue was just 79-of-116 (.681).
- In eight wins, Purdue averages 10.1 turnovers per game, while forcing 10.5. In the three losses, it averages 18.3 turnovers, while forcing 13.3.
- Since the start of the 2021-22 season, Purdue is 40-2 (.952) in regular-season, non-conference play. Kansas (43-6) owns the next best non-conference, regular-season record at 43-6 (.878).
- Purdue has won 25 straight games when holding its opponent under 70 points. The last loss came to Fairleigh Dickinson in the first round of the 2023 NCAA Tournament.
- Purdue is 7-15 all-time against teams ranked No. 2 in the AP poll, but has won six of its last 12 games against teams ranked second, including an 87-78 win over Alabama earlier this year. **Matt Painter** is 3-4 against teams ranked No. 2 in the AP poll.
- In the last four years, Purdue has defeated teams ranked No. 1 (Arizona), No. 4 (Marquette), No. 5 (Villanova), No. 6 (Wisconsin, Tennessee, Gonzaga), No. 7 (Tennessee) and No. 8 (Duke) away from Mackey Arena.
- Purdue is now 100-22 since the start of the 2021-22 season, recording the second-most wins in the country (Houston - 103) during that span. The senior class of **Caleb Furst** (only senior) became the seventh class in school history with 100 career victories.
- The starting backcourt of **Braden Smith** and **Fletcher Loyer** are 71-14 since their arrival at Purdue, starting every game of their tenure. The duo has combined for 1,890 points, 593 rebounds and 721 assists during their careers, shooting 263-of-657 from deep (.400).
- Matt Painter** and **Bruce Pearl** are both in their 21st years of being a head coach, combining for 935 victories and averaging almost 45 wins a year between the two.
- Purdue, Duke, Gonzaga and Houston are the only programs in America to have made at least a Sweet 16, Elite 8 and Final Four during their last five NCAA Tournament appearances. Purdue reached the Sweet 16 in 2022, the Elite 8 in 2019 and the Final Four in 2024.
- Braden Smith** needs 45 points to be the first Big Ten player to have 1,000 points, 500 assists and 400 rebounds by the end of his junior year.

## ►►► SERIES WITH THE TIGERS

- Purdue leads the all-time series with Auburn by a 2-1 margin, last meeting the Tigers in the finals of the 2016 Cancun Challenge, won by Purdue 96-71. **Carsen Edwards** (21 points) led six players in double-figures in the victory, while the late **Caleb Swanigan** added 14 points and 10 rebounds.
- This is the first game of a two-game series between Purdue and Auburn, as the Tigers will come to Indy next season for the 2025 Indy Classic in mid-December.

- During the **Matt Painter** era, Purdue is 13-5 against teams that were in the Southeastern Conference (SEC) at the time of the game.

- Matt Painter has not shied away from playing the best as once again the 2024-25 schedule is elite.
- The Boilermakers will play their fifth nationally-ranked team in their first 10 non-conference games on Saturday when it battles Auburn. The five regular-season, non-conference games are the most in school history and will be tied for the most in the country entering the Holiday break. ## ►►► WHO DOES NO. 2 WORK FOR?

- Saturday's game with Auburn mark the second time already this season that Purdue will face the No. 2-ranked team, already defeating No. 2 Alabama earlier this year. In true rivalry fashion, Auburn now can hold claim to the No. 2 ranking over the Crimson Tide after Purdue knocked them off that perch.

- Purdue is 7-15 all-time against the No. 2-ranked team, but is 6-6 in its last 12 games against teams ranked No. 2.

## ►►► PURDUE'S SCHEDULE IS ONE OF THE BEST

- Purdue's schedule already ranks 10th in the country according to KenPom and will almost assuredly move up after playing No. 2-ranked Auburn on Saturday.
- Including last year, nine of Purdue's 22 non-conference games will come against nationally-ranked teams (Gonzaga, Tennessee, Marquette twice, Arizona, Alabama, Ole Miss, Texas A&M, Auburn).
- The Boilermakers are currently 6-2 since the start of last season against ranked, non-conference teams (not including postseason).
- Last year's schedule ranked No. 2 in the country in all metrics. This year's schedule ranks 10th overall early on.

- Purdue is 13-7 all-time on December 21, including 5-1 under head coach **Matt Painter**.

## ►►► TURNOVERS TELL THE STORY

- One stat determines Purdue's success - turnovers
- Since the 2021-22 season, when Purdue has five or more turnovers than its opponent, Purdue is 20-15 (.571). In all other games, Purdue is 80-7 (.920).
- In Purdue's three losses this season, Purdue has recorded 55 (18.3 / game), resulting in 72 points off turnovers (24.0 / game). In the three games, Purdue has been outscored by 34 points (72-38), losing the three games by a combined 33 points.
- In Purdue's eight losses since the start of last season, Purdue has turned the ball over 54 more times than its opponent (+6.8 / game).
- In Purdue's 14 losses since the start of the 2022-23 season, Purdue is plus-80 in turnover margin (+5.7 / game).
- Since the 2021-22 season, Purdue is 49-5 when forcing 10 or more turnovers in a game. When Purdue has single-digit turnovers, Purdue owns a 35-2 record in that span.

- Since the start of last year, Purdue is 6-7 when having a turnover percentage of 20.0 percent or higher. It is 36-1 when under 20 percent.
- Purdue has played eight teams that ranked in the top 100 in defensive turnover percentage. In the Big Ten, there are just four teams in the top 75 (UCLA, Iowa, Nebraska, Michigan).

- With 16 NCAA Tournament berths, seven Sweet 16 appearances, five Big Ten regular-season championships, two Big Ten Tournament titles, two Elite Eight appearances, a trip to the Final Four, an appearance in a National Championship game and an international gold medal on his résumé, 20th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest young minds in all of college basketball.
- Painter was named the 2019 and 2024 Big Ten Coach of the Year and has led Purdue to nine straight NCAA Tournaments – the fourth-longest active streak in America. Included in that stretch are Sweet 16 appearances (and beyond) in five of the last seven tournaments.
- Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in October of 2018, agreeing to a two-year extension that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2023-24 season. The deal features five, one-year extensions that go into effect through the 2028-29 season. Following the 2029 season, Painter will still only be 58 years old.
- Painter will enter the 2024-25 season second on the school's all-time wins list (447) behind legendary mentor **Gene Keady** and ahead of **Ward "Piggy" Lambert**, both of whom have been inducted into the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame.
- Has averaged over 23 wins a season in his 19 years at Purdue. If you don't include the first transitional year (9-19 record), the average balloons to 24.3 wins per year over the last 18 seasons.
- Has won at least 25 games in 12 of his 20 seasons as a collegiate head coach.
- Painter has averaged 11.9 wins per year in conference play, the third-best average in Big Ten Conference history.
- He was voted by his peers as the NABC National Coach of the Year after leading a team that started with a 6-5 record to the 2019 Elite Eight.
- Coach Painter's 16 NCAA Tournaments are the most for a coach nationally under the age of 55 (as of April 1, 2024 – Painter is 53 years old).
- Purdue has finished first, second or third in Big Ten play in 11 of the last 17 years, including in eight of the last 10 years.
