

THE OPENING TIP

- Purdue looks for its first tournament title since Nov. 2016 when it faces Clemson on Thanksgiving night in the championship game of the Space Coast Challenge in Melbourne, Fla. Tip is scheduled for 8:30 p.m. ET, on CBS Sports Network.
- This marks the first of two trips to the Sunshine State during the first month of the season as the Boilermakers will travel to Miami for the ACC / Big Ten Challenge on Dec. 8. It also marks the second straight year that Purdue has played its multi-team event in Florida after it played in the Emerald Coast Classic (Destin) last year, falling to Florida State in the title game.

NOTES FROM LAST NIGHT

- Purdue opened the season with a 77-64 win over Liberty in the Space Coast Challenge ... the Boilermakers have now won eight straight season openers and are now 15-1 under Matt Painter in season openers.
- Thursday's game pits the last two Team USA representatives in the World University Games. Purdue won the silver medal in Taipei during the 2017 World University Games, while Clemson won the gold medal in the 2019 World University Games in Italy.
- Purdue improved to 20-5 in regular-season tournament since the 2014 Maui Invitational ... Purdue is looking for its first tournament title since the 2016 Cancun Challenge.
- · Purdue improved to 25-1 all-time under Matt Painter against teams with zero victories, having won 15 straight games against winless teams.
- Head coach Matt Painter won his 338th game in the Big Ten, moving past Thad Matta for eighth on the Big Ten's all-time wins list (Matta has 337).
- Purdue's 58.5 (31-of-53) field goal percentage was the second highest in a season opener under Matt Painter (.590 vs. SIU Edwardsville; Nov. 10, 2017).
- Purdue shot 50.0 (9-of-18) from long distance in a season opener for the second time under Painter (.500 vs. Northern Illinois; Nov. 11, 2011).
- Purdue's freshmen scored 44 of Purdue's 77 points in the win over Liberty (Edey 19; Ivey 12; Newman 10; Gillis 3) ... the 44 points are the most scored by a freshman class in a game since the freshman class scored 46 against Western Illinois on March 20, 2013.
- Zach Edey scored 19 points on 9-of-10 shooting with five rebounds in just 15 minutes of action ... a year ago, there were four games nationally where a player had at least 19 points and five rebounds in 15 minutes or less. Edey's 15 minutes were the fewest minutes for nine or more made field goals in a game for a Big Ten player in at least the last 25 years.

HEAD COACH MATT PAINTER

- ▶ Record at Purdue: 338-174 (.660) / 16th year | Career Record: 363-179 (.670) / 17th year
- With five Sweet 16 appearances, 11 NCAA Tournament berths, three Big Ten regular-season championships, a Big Ten Tournament title, an Elite Eight and an international gold medal on his résumé, 16th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest young minds in all of college
- He was voted by his peers as the NABC National Coach of the Year after leading a team that started with a 6-5 record to the 2019 Elite Eight.
- Painter was named the 2019 Big Ten Coach of the Year and has led Purdue to three straight Sweet 16 appearances.
- Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in October of 2018, agreeing to a two-year extension that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2023-24 season. The deal features five, one-year extensions that go into effect through the 2028-29 season. Following the 2029 season, Painter will still only be 58 years old.
- Painter enters the 2020-21 season third on the school's all-time wins list (337) behind legendary mentors, Gene Keady and Ward "Piggy" Lambert, both of whom have been inducted into the College Basketball Hall of Fame.
- Has averaged almost 23 wins a season in his 15 years at Purdue. If you don't include the first transitional year (9-19 record), the average balloons to 24.0 wins per year over the last 14 seasons.
- Has won at least 25 games in nine of his 16 seasons as a collegiate head coach.
- · Painter's four Big Ten Coach of the Year honors are the third most in league history (Gene Keady 7; Bobby Knight 5; Bo Ryan 4).
- Painter has averaged 11.1 wins per year in conference play, the fifth-best average in Big Ten Conference history.
- Is one of just four active coaches to have won a Big Ten championship.
- Painter's 11 NCAA Tournaments in the last 14 years are the eighth most in the country.
- Purdue's five Sweet 16 appearances in the last 12 years are the ninth most nationally.
- · Coach Painter's 12 NCAA Tournaments are the most for a coach nationally under the age of 55 (as of April 1, 2021 Painter is 50 years old).
- Purdue has finished first or second in Big Ten play in seven of Painter's last 13 years.
- · Has had 63 Academic All-Big Ten honorees in his 15 previous years at Purdue.
