THE SCENE SETTER BETWEEN THE BOILERMAKERS AND THE VIKINGS

• The No. 18-ranked Purdue men's basketball team begins its non-conference stretch run Saturday as Cleveland State visits Mackey Arena for a noon tip ... the game will be streamed online on ESPN3 with **Zach Zaidman** and **Homer Drew** on the call ... on the radio dial, the game will be available on the Purdue Sports Network and **Tuneln.com** as **Larry Clisby**, **Rob Blackman** and **Ralph Taylor** provide brilliant commentary, beginning with the Purdue Basketball pregame show one hour before tip ... live stats will be available at StatBroadcast.com.

#BOILERNOTES

- Purdue is ranked No. 18 in the Associated Press top-25 poll, down three spots from last week ... the Boilermakers have been ranked in the AP Top 25 in each of the last 24 polls, the eighth-longest active streak nationally ... Purdue is ranked 19th in the coaches poll, down three from last week.
- Purdue's two losses have come by teams ranked first (Villanova) and seventh (Louisville on the road) in the latest **KenPom.com** rankings.
- Purdue ranks fifth nationally in effective field goal percentage (.602) ... among NCAA ranks, Purdue is 11th nationally in field goal percentage (.507).
- The Boilermakers now rank second nationally in 3-point percentage (.448) and fifth in 3-pointers made per game (11.0) ... over the last six games, Purdue is shooting 77-of-154 (.500) from long distance during that span ... during that span, Purdue has recorded the second (Auburn), fourth (Morehead State) and fourth-highest (Arizona State) 3-point, single-game totals in school history.
- Purdue ranks fifth nationally in assists at 20.4 assists per game and has had 53 assists over its last two games.
- Purdue has recorded assists on 69.7 percent of its made field goals, ranking third nationally in assist rate (A / FGM).
- Purdue has been outrebounded already twice this year (Georgia State, Louisville) ... a year ago, Purdue was the last team nationally to be outrebounded, coming Feb. 13, against Michigan.
- Purdue has five players averaging in double figures and two more that average at least 7.8 points per game ... already twice this year, Purdue has had six players reach double figures in a game (Auburn, Arizona State).
- Purdue's 33-point margin of victory in Tuesday's win over Arizona State was the largest margin in Jimmy V Classic history (since 1995).
- Purdue's 33-point margin of victory was the largest margin over a major, non-conference team since beating SEC-member Ole Miss 61-25 on Jan. 4, 1934 ... the 26-point halftime margin (47-21) was tied for the 24th-largest lead in Purdue history and tied for fifth against major-conference foes.
- Purdue has scored over 90 points in three of its last five games, the first time it has done that since Dec. 18, 2000, to Jan. 3, 2001 (three straight).

- Purdue improved to 7-2 with a 97-64 win over Arizona State in the Jimmy V Classic ... Purdue is now 4-2 all-time against the Sun Devils ... Purdue is now 13-9 all-time in Madison Square Garden ... the win snapped a three-game losing streak in the facility, dating to the 2008 NIT Season Tipoff ... Purdue is now 35-31 vs. the Pac 12.
- Purdue won its 83rd straight game when scoring 90 or more points.
- Purdue went 15-of-27 from long distance, its second straight game of making at least 15 3-pointers ... over the last six games, Purdue is 77-of-154 (.500) from 3-point range ... the 15 3-pointers tied for the fourth most in a game in school history.
- Purdue shot 59.4 percent from the field, the fourth time in nine games that Purdue has shot over 55.0 percent from the field.
- Purdue recorded 26 assists on 38 made field goals in the win over Arizona State ... over the last two games, Purdue has 53 assists.
- The Boilermakers had six players in double figures for the second time this year (Auburn).
- Purdue's 33-point margin was its largest over a power, non-conference team since a 95-53 win over Utah on Dec. 17, 1988 ... Utah, however, wasn't a member of a power conference at that time.
- Purdue had six players make at least one 3-pointer.
- The Purdue bench scored a season-high 46 points.

SERIES HISTORY

- Purdue and Cleveland State will meet for the first time on Saturday ... among Purdue's first 10 games of the season, five of them are first-time opponents ... Purdue owns a 40-3 record all-time against the Horizon League, including a 6-0 record under Matt Painter ... among teams with at least 10 meetings, Purdue's two winningest series (by percentage) are against Horizon League teams (Detroit 16-1; Valparaiso 15-1) ... Purdue is looking to move above .500 against Ohio schools, currently with a 112-112 record ... Cleveland State will be the 12th school from Ohio that Purdue has faced.

BOILERMAKER RECORDS

- Purdue is 276-37 (.882) all-time against non-conference foes in Mackey Arena, including a 271-29 (.903) record vs. unranked, non-conference foes.
- **Matt Painter** is 86-8 (.915) at Mackey Arena against non-conference opposition.
- Purdue is 27-2 in its last 29 games at Mackey Arena with losses to Maryland (Jan. 2015) and Iowa (Jan. 2016).
- Since the start of the 2015-16 season, Purdue is 33-11 (.750) in all games played, including 18-4 (.818) vs. non-conference foes.
- Purdue needs to win 17 more games this year to have 50 wins in back-to-back seasons for just the eighth time in school history.

SIZZLING FROM DEEP

- The story of Purdue's offensive resurgence lately has been the Boilermakers' success from beyond the 3-point line. Through Wednesday's games, here is where Purdue ranks nationally and in the Big Ten in the major 3-point categories.

- Over the last six games, Purdue is shooting 77-of-154 (.500) from 3-point range ... prior to the Cancun Challenge (just three games), Purdue was shooting 32.8 percent from long distance.
- Over the last six games, Purdue has posted three of the top six single-game 3-pointers made totals in school history.

BIG TEN SUCCESS UNDER PAINTER

- Since the 2006-07 season, the Purdue basketball team under **Matt Painter** has been one of the most-successful teams in the Big Ten.

SHARP-SHOOTING

- Purdue has shot over 55.0 percent from the field in back-to-back games and in four-of-nine games overall this year.
- The Boilermakers rank fifth nationally in effective field goal percentage (.602) and 11th nationally in field goal percentage (.507).
- Dating to last year, Purdue has shot over 50.0 percent from the floor in 10 of its last 17 games.
- Purdue is 102-13 under **Matt Painter** when shooting 48.0 percent or better from the floor.
- Purdue has already had eight 20-point performances by four different players this year ... Purdue had 13, 20-point showings all of last year.

WE CAN PLAY FAST TOO

- Two games that pundits targeted where the Boilermakers could have trouble because of pace and athleticism were against Auburn and Arizona State. The Boilermakers passed those tests impressively.
- Purdue averaged 96.5 points per game in the two games, shooting 72-of-120 (.600) from the field and 32-of-53 (.604) from 3-point range.

LIMIT TURNOVERS AND THE SKY IS THE LIMIT

- Purdue has been restrained early in the season by turnovers, ranking 263rd nationally, and 13th in the Big Ten, in turnovers per game ... the Boilermakers are 257th nationally in turnover margin, while ranking 11th in the Big Ten.
- Purdue has had at least 15 turnovers in five games this year, including four of the last five outings ... foes have scored almost 25 percent (146-of-594) of its points directly off Purdue turnovers ... contrast that to Purdue, which has scored just 18.0 percent of its points (137-of-760) off opponents' mistakes.

EFFICIENCY NUMBERS

- According to **Ken Pomeroy**, Purdue ranks 14th nationally in offensive efficiency and 18th in defensive efficiency.
- Purdue is 1-of-10 teams nationally to rank in the top 20 of both categories.

- When Purdue holds foes to 59 or fewer points under Painter, the Boilermakers are 118-4 ... three of the losses (Eastern Michigan, Iowa, Nebraska) came during the 2012-13 season.

SHARING IS CARING

- The Boilermakers have recorded at least 20 assists in 6-of-9 games this year, ranking fifth nationally in assists per game (19.8).

- Eight of Purdue's nine regulars average at least 1.0 assist per game ... during the last two games, six different players have had at least three assists in a game.

NO RIM PROTECTOR

- Purdue ranks 320th (out of 347 teams) in blocked shots per game (1.4 per game) ... in the last four years with **A.J. Hammons** roaming the paint, Purdue ranked 59th, 29th, 17th and 41st nationally in blocked shots.

BENCH PRODUCTION

- Over the last five games, Purdue's bench is averaging 29.6 points and shooting 47.5 percent from 3-point range (28-of-59) ... in the first four games, the group averaged 15.5 points per game, while shooting 37.5 percent from the field and 19.2 percent from long distance.

THE GAME OF RUNS

- Purdue has had nine runs of 10 points or longer this year, compared to one by its opponents (Auburn).

MAKING MORE THAN OPPONENTS SHOOT

- Purdue has made 133 free throws this season, while opponents have shot just 120 ... Purdue is outscoring opponents by an average of 5.2 points per game from the free throw line ... the last time that Purdue made more free throws than opponents have shot for an entire season came in the 1997-98 campaign (made 657; opponents shot 572).
- Morehead State had zero free throw attempts on Saturday, the first time in school history that a foe had zero attempts ... since the 2010-11 season, it has happened just 16 times in Division I play and three times by a Big Ten team.

JUNIORS LEAD THE WAY

- Head coach **Matt Painter** knew that the junior class would be key in its resurgence and through nine games, the class has not disappointed.
- The group has scored a combined 440 points (48.9 points per game), accounting for 57.9 percent of the team's scoring.
- Over the last two games, the group is averaging 57.0 points per game, scoring 52 points vs. Morehead State and 62 vs. Arizona State.

FRESHMEN EARNS STARTS AT PURDUE

- With **Carsen Edwards** starting each of the last two games, head coach **Matt Painter** has had a freshman in the starting lineup in 133 of the last 144 games, dating to the start of the 2012-13 season.

MOST CONSECUTIVE WEEKS IN AP RANKINGS

- Purdue has been ranked in 24 consecutive polls, now the eighth-longest active streak in America ... Purdue was 1-of-11 teams nationally to be ranked in all 19 Associated Press polls a year ago.
- The school record for most consecutive weeks ranked is 64 from the 13th poll of the 2007-08 season to the final poll of the 2010-11 campaign.

•	With a pair of Sweet 16 appearances, eight NCAA Tournament berths, Big Ten regular-season and tournament titles and an international gold medal on his résumé, 12th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest minds in all of college basketball.
•	Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in March of 2011, agreeing to a new eight-year contract that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2018-19 season. He then followed that up in August of 2016, signing a three-year extension good through the 2021-22 year.
•	Painter has averaged over 21 wins per season during his tenure at the helm of the Purdue program, including at least 20 victories in eight seasons.
•	Painter's tenure has seen Purdue basketball restore its status among the upper echelon of college basketball programs. The last eight years have seen six 20-win seasons and NCAA Tournament berths, two Sweet 16 appearances, a regular-season Big Ten title and a Big Ten Tournament crown.
•	The three winningest classes in program history are the classes of 2011, 2012 and 2010, respectively, and five of the 10 winningest individual players Purdue has ever seen have come from the Painter ranks. Success, however, didn't happen overnight.
•	Painter officially became the 18th head men's basketball coach in Purdue history on April 1, 2005, and immediately set about laying the ground-work for a dramatic reversal in the program's fortunes.
•	The Boilermakers were at their best during the 2009 postseason run, rattling off double-digit victories over Penn State and Illinois to reach the Big Ten Tournament final, where they dispatched Ohio State, 65-61, to earn the first conference tournament crown in program history.
•	Painter has been named Big Ten Coach of the Year three times in the last six seasons, earning the consensus award in 2008 and 2011, and winning the coaches' vote in 2010. He is one of only six men to win the award more at least three times since its inception in 1974.
•	Painter has seen a total of 24 players earn a combined 44 Academic All-Big Ten honors during his tenure as head coach. Painter has also mentored an Academic All-American, as Moore earned second-team honors during the 2009-10 season.
