GAME NOTES

- Purdue improved to 784-427 all-time and 420-231 in non-conference play
- The Boilermakers are 98-28 all-time in November, including a 19-12 mark on neutral floors and a 5-1 record on Nov. 27
- Head coach Sharon Versyp earned her 315th career win (315-173) and 198th (198-108) at Purdue
- The Boilermakers are 4-0 for the 16th time in school history and the sixth time under Versyp
- Purdue improved to 84-39 all-time in regular-season tournaments and 23-9 under Versyp
- The Boilermakers have held all four opponents to 52 points or fewer, with LSU scoring an opponent's best Friday night
- Purdue shot a season-best from the field for the second straight game, converting 45.6 percent from the floor (26-57), including a scorching 72.7 percent (8-11) in the fourth quarter
- The Boilermakers matched their season-best rebounding margin, grabbing 11 more rebounds than LSU (41-30)
- Purdue had a season-low 10 turnovers, including just four in the second half and one in the fourth quarter
- LSU shot just 22.2 percent from 3-point range (2-9) and 36.4 percent from the free throw line (4-11), both the lowest by a Purdue opponent on the season
- The Boilermakers scored 41 of their 69 points outside the paint

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- April Wilson scored a career-high 23 points, hitting 8-of-16 from the field and 3-of-7 from behind the arc
- Wilson added six rebounds, five assists and a steal
- Ashley Morrissette scored a season-best 15 points and grabbed a season-high five rebounds
- Bridget Perry was just shy of a double-double with 10 points and seven rebounds
- Nora Kiesler blocked a career-high three shots and secured four rebounds
- Dominique McBryde had four points and five rebounds
- Andreona Keys had nine points, three rebounds and two assists with zero turnovers in 34 minutes
