Noteworthy: On this date in 2007, the Boilermakers defeated Central Michigan 45-22 at Ross-Ade Stadium. Purdue racked up 583 yards of total offense, the sixth-greatest output under head coach Joe Tiller. Curtis Painter completed 29 of 39 passes for 360 yards with three touchdowns, while Kory Sheets rushed for 144 yards and two touchdowns. The Boilermakers and the Chippewas subsequently would meet in the 2007 Motor City Bowl (a 51-48 Purdue win) and again Sept. 20, 2008 (a 32-25 Purdue victory in which Tiller passed Jack Mollenkopf to become the school's all-time winningest coach).

Noteworthy: The Boilermakers' victory at Missouri last season was their most resounding on the road since a 47-13 win at Central Florida on Sept. 4, 1999. The three points surrendered were the fewest since a 59-0 win over Southeast Missouri on Sept. 17, 2011; the fewest to an FBS opponent since a 37-3 win over Illinois on Nov. 12, 2005; and the fewest on the road since a 48-3 win at Illinois on Oct. 25, 1997.

Purdue Against the Southeastern Conference

The Boilermakers are 2-4 against Southeastern Conference opponents (1-2 in the regular season and 1-2 in bowl games). The only SEC school to play previously at Ross-Ade Stadium was Vanderbilt on Sept. 27, 1941, and the Commodores won 3-0. Purdue and Vanderbilt are scheduled to play Sept. 7, 2019, in West Lafayette and Sept. 8, 2029, in Nashville, Tennessee.

Ground Game

The Boilermakers are averaging a FBS-best 8.1 yards per carry through the first two games. Purdue's 271.5 yards per game ranks 24th among all FBS schools. Individually, fifth-year senior D.J. Knox checks in 23rd nationally and third in the Big Ten with 229 total rushing yards and 24th nationally and fifth in the Big Ten with an average of 114.5 yards rushing per game ... Knox's 8.2 yards per carry average is 13th nationally and first in the Big Ten ... The Boilermakers' 341 rushing yards against Eastern Michigan last Saturday were their most since amassing 349 at Illinois on Oct. 4, 2014.

Sparks Will Fly

What happens when one brother knows where he's going and the other doesn't? Football fans will learn the answer to that question Saturday when Purdue wide receiver Jared Sparks lines up against Missouri cornerback and younger brother, Adam. Jared enters the contest with seven receptions for 87 yards, while Adam has five tackles, including one for loss, on the year.

Repressing the Run

The Boilermakers limited Eastern Michigan to 69 rushing yards, the sixth time a Purdue team has kept an opponent under 100 yards in 15 games under head coach Jeff Brohm.

It Doesn't Happen Very Often

When D.J. Knox (152) and Markell Jones (109) both topped the century mark in rushing yards against Eastern Michigan last weekend it was the first time a pair of Boilermakers went for 100-plus yards in the same game since 2002 (Brandon Jones, 131, and Joey Harris, 102). It was merely the 27th time in school history that the feat has been accomplished and only the fifth time in the last 35 years. It was the fifth time Jones rushed for over 100 yards in a game in his career and the third, and also a career-high, for Knox.

We Want Moore

True freshman Rondale Moore became a household name when he electrified the nation with a record-breaking performance in his collegiate debut against Northwestern on Aug. 30. With a (still) FBS-best 313 all-purpose yards against the Wildcats (79 rushing, 109 receiving, 125 kickoff return), Moore eclipsed Otis Armstrong's single game school record of 312 yards set Nov. 25, 1972. Moore had a huge first half, racking up 302 all-purpose yards in the initial 30 minutes. That alone would have placed him third in the Purdue record book. With the Boilermakers trailing 14-0 in the first 10 minutes of the opening quarter, Moore hauled in a 32-yard touchdown reception from Elijah Sindelar and ripped off a 76-yard scoring run to even the score before the quarter ended.

More on Moore

Rondale Moore is the first freshman (true or redshirt) in school history to make his Boilermaker debut with a 100-yard receiving game. Moore hauled in a game-high 11 receptions for 109 yards and a touchdown in his first collegiate game against Northwestern ... His reception total was the highest by any player in the Big Ten on the opening week of college football and his yardage tally was second to only Ohio State's Terry McLaurin's 121 vs. Oregon State ... Moore's 76-yard touchdown rush in the first quarter against Northwestern was the longest run by a Boilermaker since Akeem Hunt went 82 yards to the house at Indiana on Nov. 29, 2014 ... It is also the longest rush by a Big Ten player through the first two weeks of the season ... Moore's average of seven receptions per game is tied for 19th in the FBS and tied for second in the Big Ten ... Moore ranks seventh in the FBS and second in the Big Ten with an average of 188 all-purpose yards per game.

Don't Blink

Freshman Rondale Moore has held the football 25 times in his two-game collegiate career and is averaging a little over 15 yards per touch. He has caught a team-high 14 passes for 125 yards, four carries for 128 yards, six kick returns for 123 yards and a punt return for no gain entering the Missouri game.

Higgins Comes Through

Junior defensive end Kai Higgins had his finest day in a Purdue uniform against Eastern Michigan with two tackles, including a sack, a pass breakup and an interception.

Behind Enemy Lines

Sophomore linebacker Cornel Jones has played in the opposition's backfield more often than not this season. Through the first two games, Jones has tallied a FBS-best 6.5 tackles for loss, including 2.5 sacks.
