- AROUND THE HORN -

• Purdue enters the final weekend of the season having won 4-of-5 for the second time this year.
• The Boilers are in search of their first series win at Alexander Field since sweeping Southern Illinois in May 2013. Purdue has lost each of its 11 Big Ten home series since Alexander Field opened in 2013.
• The Boilers won 2-of-3 at Nebraska last weekend for its first Big Ten series win since sweeping PSU in Central Pennsylvania in March 2013. Purdue also won 2-of-3 at Nebraska in April 2012. Ohio State is the only other team to win two series in Lincoln since the Huskers joined the Big Ten in 2012.
• The Boilers snapped their 16-game Big Ten losing streak May 3 at Michigan St., ending the program's longest skid in conference play since 1976-77.
• Harry Shipley leads the Big Ten in hit by pitch (16) and defensive assists (178). Jack Picchiotti has thrown out a league-leading 18 base stealers. Kyle Johnson is batting .377 with 10 extra-base hits in Big Ten play.

- Joined the weekend rotation for the Iowa series and moved to Friday after injury to Mike Kornacker; returned to midweek starter in late April.
- Struck out nine over eight scoreless innings against Ball State, the most Ks by a Purdue pitcher since Brad Schreiber in 2013 at Penn State.
- Leads the team in strikeouts (51) & strikeouts per nine innings (7.7) after fanning 17 over 12 2/3 in midweek starts vs. Ball State & Illinois State.
- Compiled a 1.10 ERA over 16 1/3 innings in March, striking out 19.
- Started the 2015 home opener and led Purdue to a shutout win against Valparaiso with 5 1/3 scoreless innings.
- Retired 11 of the 13 batters he faced over four scoreless innings of relief in Purdue's 1-0 loss to Missouri in Corpus Christi.
- Ranked 86th among the Northwoods League's top prospects after a strong summer of 2014 pitching for the Kalamazoo Growlers in which he was 5-2 with 4 saves and a 3.60 ERA in 65 innings.
- Transfer from Indiana Wesleyan was not part of the official roster in 2014 while redshirting; joined the program in the fall of 2013.
- All-Midwest Collegiate Team honoree in 2013 after posting a 7-3 record with a 4.21 ERA, throwing 7 complete games and 72 2/3 innings.
- His parents are Purdue employees and his father is an alumnus.

- Led the way in Purdue's 2-1 pitcher's duel win in the middle game at Nebraska, inducing 13 ground ball outs over 7 innings of one-run ball.
- Put together his best start of 2015 against Maryland, taking a 3-1 lead into the 9th before Terps loaded the bases against him & went on to win.
- Started 2015 season opener but did not make another weekend start until Maryland; performed well in midweek starts vs. Louisville, IPFW & ISU.
- Closed 2014 strong with 7 innings of three-run ball vs. Iowa; did not issue a walk and induced 3 ground-ball double plays.
- Worked Purdue's first true complete game since February 2013 in tough-luck loss vs. OSU in April 2014, giving up runs in only one inning.
- Earned his first career Big Ten win with seven innings of three-hit ball vs. Michigan (April 2014).
- No. 4 LSU did not score while he was on the mound in first start of 2014.
- True walk-on has been a part of the program since the fall of 2011 but redshirted in 2012 after not making the official 35-man roster.
- Worked 4 1/3 innings of scoreless two-hit relief in his team debut, a 2013 midweek game vs. Indiana State.
- Helped Carroll High School win back-to-back 4A IHSAA state titles and was the winning pitcher in 2011 title game; all-conference & all-area honoree went 12-1 to tie the CHS wins record as a senior.

- Put together his best start as a Boiler in win vs. NIU, striking out career-high six over 7 innings; gave up just five hits & 1 earned run.
- Worked 1-2-3 frames in 1st & 4th innings at ASU, but couldn't come up with shutdown frames after Boilers scored multiple runs in 2nd & 3rd.

HEAD COACH DOUG SCHREIBER

Since Doug Schreiber was named Purdue's head baseball coach on May 29, 1998, the Boilermakers have become a major force in the Big Ten Conference and have made big strides on a national level.

Currently in his 17th season as the leader of the program, Schreiber is the program's all-time leader in overall wins and Big Ten wins. He eclipsed Dave Alexander's record for games coached (792 over 14 seasons) during the second weekend of the 2013 season. Schreiber played for Alexander at Purdue from 1983-86.

Purdue unveiled its new Alexander Field stadium and facilities during the 2012-13 school year, but the first two seasons at the new ballpark turned out to be rebuilding years for the Boilermakers after losing 15 seniors and three junior MLB draftees from the 2012 Big Ten championship team. As of July 2014, 10 members of the 2012 championship team had signed with MLB organizations at some point in their post-college careers.

In the five seasons between 2008 and 2012, Purdue went 172-110 overall (.610) and 75-51 in Big Ten play (.595). Both records represented the best marks in the league. The Boilermakers were the only conference team to qualify for the Big Ten Tournament each of those five seasons, the longest such streak in program history. Purdue has won at least one game at the Big Ten Tournament in eight of its nine appearances under Schreiber.

After playing six NCAA Regional qualifiers throughout the season, including four opponents that were among the 16 Regional hosts, Purdue's strength of schedule in 2014 ranked among the Top 25 nationally for much of the year, including as high as No. 2 in the country for much of non-conference play. The Boilermakers' eight extra-inning affairs were the most in Schreiber's tenure as well as the most in the Big Ten. Purdue also played in 17 one-run games, but managed just a 5-12 record in those contests.

During its historic 2012 season, Purdue won a program-record 45 games, captured a pair of Big Ten titles, earned the right to host an NCAA Regional and closed out Lambert Field in thrilling fashion. Schreiber was named the Big Ten Coach of the Year after leading the Boilers to the most wins by a Big Ten team since 2008. He won his 400th and program-record 408th career games at Lambert in the spring of 2012. His 408th victory as the leader of the program, April 15 in the finale of a series sweep of Illinois, made him Purdue's all-time wins leader.

The Boilermakers began the 2012 season 14-1, won 10 consecutive games twice, posted their 20th win before April 1 for the first time, reached the 30-win mark at the earliest date (April 20) in program history and won their first Big Ten title since 1909.

Headlined by Kevin Plawecki's selection 35th overall by the New York Mets, Purdue had a program-record seven players picked in the 2012 Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft. Juniors Plawecki, Cameron Perkins and Nick Wittgren were each selected in the first 10 rounds to give the Boilers three players drafted in the first 300 picks for the first time. Six times since 2006 multiple Boilers have been selected in the same draft. Highlighted by Big Ten Player and Pitcher of the Year honors for Plawecki and Joe Haase, Purdue had a program-high eight all-conference honorees in 2012.

Schreiber has coached 62 All-Big Ten Conference selections, including 22 who were named to the conference's First Team, and has had players selected in the MLB First-Year Player Draft on 32 occasions.

Prior to becoming the head coach at Purdue, Schreiber spent four seasons (1995-98) as the top assistant coach and recruiting coordinator under Pat Murphy at Arizona State University. Schreiber helped guide Arizona State to the College World Series and the national championship game in 1998. A year earlier, the Sun Devils finished as regional runners-up to Miami, and were two outs away from going to the College World Series. All four of Schreiber's recruiting classes at ASU were nationally ranked, including the 1995 class which was ranked No. 1 in the country and the 1996 class, which was tabbed the third best in the nation.

Before going to ASU, Schreiber served as an assistant coach for Murphy at the University of Notre Dame in 1994. That season, the Fighting Irish finished 46-16 and ended the season just two wins shy of Omaha.

Schreiber began his coaching career as a graduate assistant under Pat Quinn at Ball State University for two seasons (1991-92) and spent one year (1993) as an assistant at Butler University.

A native of LaPorte, Ind., Schreiber was a four-year starter (1983-86) at second base for the Boilermakers. During his career, Purdue posted a 120-112-2 mark and established a school-record 37 victories his senior season when he was a Second Team All-Big Ten selection. Schreiber still ranks among Purdue's career leaders in a variety of categories, including first all-time in walks (132), tied for first in games played (226), sixth in runs scored (159) and tied for eight in triples (9). He earned his Bachelor of Arts degree in communications and has completed some course work towards a master's in education.
