THE OPENING TIP

• Purdue (13-10, 6-6) looks to continue its momentum Saturday when it travels to Bloomington for a contest with Indiana (15-7, 5-6). **Bob Wischusen, Dick Vitale** and **Kris Budden** will handle the broadcast on ESPN, beginning at 2 p.m. ET. On the radio, **Rob Blackman** and **Larry Clisby** will have the call courtside on the Purdue Radio Network and Tuneln.com, beginning with the Purdue Basketball Pregame Show at 1 p.m. ET. Live stats will be available on PurdueSports.com.

• Purdue owns a 120-89 series lead against Indiana, the only Big Ten team with a winning record against the Hoosiers. Purdue has won five straight games and eight of the last nine against Indiana.

• When Purdue holds Indiana to 69 or fewer points during the **Matt Painter** era, the Boilermakers are 12-1 having won 12 straight games. When allowing 70 or more points, Purdue is 2-8.

• With eight regular-season games left, five of Purdue's eight opponents are either nationally-ranked or receiving votes. As it currently stands, six of the last eight opponents will be quad-1 opportunities.

• **SOMETHING TO WATCH:** Purdue has been outstanding at home during Big Ten play. The Boilermakers are 5-1 at home in league play but are just 1-5 away from Mackey Arena in league play.

• In Purdue victories, the Boilermakers have five players averaging at least 9.9 points per game and are shooting 48.3 percent from the field and 39.7 percent from long range. In Purdue losses, Purdue has only four players averaging at least 7.0 points per game and are shooting 35.5 percent from the field and 27.2 percent from long distance.

• Purdue is 12-0 this year and 32-1 since the start of last year when shooting a higher field goal percentage than its opponent. The lone loss came to Virginia in last year's Elite Eight. The Boilermakers are 1-10 when shooting a lower field goal percentage than its opponent (win vs. VCU).

• Since the 2014-15 season, Purdue is 27-9 (.750) during the month of February. Since the 2016-17 campaign, the Boilermakers are 19-5 (.792) during the month of February. The Boilermakers have won six straight games in the month by an average of 12.2 points per game.

• Purdue freshmen and sophomores have combined for 927 points this year (40.4 PPG), accounting for 58.6 percent of Purdue's scoring this year.

• Purdue is 8-1 when scoring at least 70 points this year (loss to Michigan), but is just 5-9 when being held under 70 points.

• Over the last two games, Purdue is shooting 53.8 percent from the field and 48.3 percent from 3-point range. The Boilermakers have six players averaging at least 9.5 points per game and boast an assist / turnover ratio of 2.11 (40 / 19).

• Purdue's four wins over AP Top 25 programs this year are tied for the third most in the country.

PAINTING NO. 500

• The Jan. 24 game vs. Wisconsin was the 500th game coached by head coach **Matt Painter** at Purdue, becoming the third Purdue mentor to reach that mark (**Ward "Piggy" Lambert**, **Gene Keady**). Only age 49, Painter is entering his prime as a basketball coach.

... 11 NCAA Tournaments as a Big Ten coach are the sixth most in league history.

... 334 career wins in the Big Ten are the 10th most in league history.

... 164 Big Ten Conference wins are the 10th most in league history.

... 4 Big Ten Coach of the Year honors are the third most in league history.

... his 359 wins are the second most nationally of any coach under the age of 50 (**Mick Cronin** - 377; age 48). They are the 10th most of any coach under the age of 55.

... of coaches under the age of 55 on the above-mentioned wins list, Painter is one of six to reach an Elite Eight and his five Sweet 16 appearances are the second most.

... Since 2015-16, just two league teams have won more than 63 league games (MSU and Purdue). No other team has more than 52.

... Since 2016-17, just two league teams have won more than 50 league games (MSU and Purdue). No other team has more than 42.

... Since 2017-18, just two league teams have won more than 37 league games (MSU and Purdue). No other team has more than 32.

THE DEFENSE OF MACKEY ARENA

• Since the 2014-15 season, Purdue has been almost unbeatable at Mackey Arena, posting an 87-9 record in the facility.

• Since the start of last year, Purdue has held 18 of 27 opponents at Mackey Arena under 40.0 percent shooting.

• Since the start of the 2014-15 season, Purdue has allowed just five opponents to shoot at least 50.0 percent from the field. Coincidentally, Purdue is 2-3 in those four games.

- With five Sweet 16 appearances, 11 NCAA Tournament berths, three Big Ten regular-season championships, a Big Ten Tournament title, an Elite Eight and an international gold medal on his résumé, 15th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest young minds in all of college basketball.
- He was voted by his peers as the NABC National Coach of the Year after leading a team that started with a 6-5 record to the 2019 Elite Eight.
- Painter was named the 2019 Big Ten Coach of the Year and has led Purdue to three straight Sweet 16 appearances.
- Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in October of 2018, agreeing to a two-year extension that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2023-24 season. The deal features five, one-year extensions that go into effect through the 2028-29 season. Following the 2029 season, Painter will still only be 58 years old.
- Painter enters the 2019-20 season third on the school's all-time wins list (321) behind legendary mentors, Gene Keady and Ward "Piggy" Lambert, both of whom have been inducted into the College Basketball Hall of Fame.
- Has averaged almost 23 wins a season in his 14 years at Purdue. If you don't include the first transitional year (9-19 record), the average balloons to 24.0 wins per year over the last 13 seasons.
- Has won at least 25 games in nine of his 15 seasons as a collegiate head coach.
- Painter's four Big Ten Coach of the Year honors are the third most in league history (Gene Keady - 7; Bobby Knight - 5; Bo Ryan - 4).
- Painter has averaged 11.3 wins per year in conference play, the fifth-best average in Big Ten Conference history.
- Is one of just two active coaches to have won a Big Ten championship.
- Painter's 11 NCAA Tournaments in the last 13 years are the eighth most in the country.
- Purdue's five Sweet 16 appearances in the last 11 years are the ninth most nationally.
- Through last year, Painter's 346 wins were the second most nationally for a coach nationally in under 15 years of coaching.
- Coach Painter's 12 NCAA Tournaments are the most for a coach nationally under the age of 55 (as of April 1, 2020 -- Painter is 49 years old).
- Has produced draft picks in each of the last four years, one of only four programs nationally that can say that.
