• Purdue closes out its season-long eight-game homestand with just the second four-game series in the history of Alexander Field, hosting South Dakota State for the Boilermakers' open weekend in Big Ten play. Purdue has not played a Monday home game since May 2010 vs. Michigan State.

• The Boilermakers won three of four vs. Cal State Northridge in the only other four-game series in the history of Alexander Field. The Boilermakers also won three of four at Minnesota in May 2021, their last four-game series played over four days. However, this weekend marks Purdue's 10th traditional four-game series since the start of the 2020 campaign.

• The Jackrabbits recently enjoyed an 11-game win streak from April 7-26, punctuated by a midweek win at Nebraska. SDSU was also very competitive in a three-game sweep at the hands of Iowa in mid-March, dropping the opener 5-4 and finale 5-3.

• Purdue is 10-8 in Big Ten play after six conference weekends, all of which have featured the series winner taking two of three. No sweeps for or against over six straight Big Ten weekends has not happened for the Boilers since 2007, meaning this is a first during the era of three-game conference weekends (since 2009).

HEAD COACH GREG GOFF

Greg Goff joined Purdue baseball as an assistant coach in July 2017 and was promoted to head coach in June 2019. The 2023 season is his 18th as a collegiate head coach.

Previously a head coach at four universities, Goff succeeded his friend and longtime colleague Mark Wasikowski, who returned to the University of Oregon as the Ducks' new head coach in June 2019.

Goff has previously served as the head coach at Campbell University (2008-14), Louisiana Tech University (2015-16) and the University of Alabama (2017) as well as Division II University of Montevallo (2004-07). He also helped lead the Boilermakers to a memorable 38-win season in 2018, punctuated by the program's third NCAA Regional bid in program history. Purdue finished second in the Big Ten standings and was also the runner-up at the Big Ten Tournament in Goff's first year with the program.

A national-best 15-0 start, program records for strikeouts and stolen bases, and a return to the Big Ten Tournament highlighted Purdue's resurgent and successful 2022 season. The Boilermakers raced out the best start in program history as the final unbeaten team nationally and recovered from a rough patch in April to return to the conference tournament, navigating a challenging back half of the league schedule. Purdue eclipsed its program benchmark in steals behind the first trio of Boilermakers ever with 20-plus steals each. Curtis Washington Jr. (31), Mike Bolton Jr. (28) and Evan Albrecht (22) teamed up to account for 81 of the 116 stolen bases (70%) as Purdue led the Big Ten and ranked sixth nationally in steals per game. CJ Valdez was a first-team All-Big Ten performer as a full-time DH; Cam Thompson also enjoyed a breakout season with 13 home runs and a 1.031 OPS.

Along with bringing an upbeat personality to the dugout and contagious energy to his role as the first-base coach, Goff helped numerous Boilermakers develop offensively in 2018 and 2019 as an assistant coach. He played a leading role in coaching the base running and outfield defense.

In his first two years at Purdue, Goff helped develop and organize new community events for the program like the Preseason Fan Fest and First Pitch Dinner. Both events have proved very popular and are well attended, helping generate preseason interest going into a campaign.

The Boilermakers also continue to expand their community outreach, exceeding 600 combined hours of service for the 2021-22 academic year. During the 2019 fall semester, over 40 players logged at least 10 hours of community service as Purdue completed over 450 hours of community outreach as a team.

Goff and his wife, Tina, are the parents of four daughters: Kara, Kiley, Kolby and Kenzie. Kara (Louisiana Tech & LSU) and Kiley (Maryland, active) both played collegiate softball.

SIX 40-WIN SEASONS

- As a head coach, Goff's teams have won over 40 games six times. Campbell was one of only eight Division I programs to win 40-plus games for three straight years from 2012 to 2014, posting 131 total victories during that span. The Camels enjoyed a historic 49-10 campaign in 2013.
- He also won 42 games in his final season at Louisiana Tech, helping lead the Bulldogs to an NCAA Regional bid.
- Montevallo was a DII College World Series qualifier in 2006 under his guidance. As an assistant coach at Delta State, the Statesmen also qualified for the DII College World Series in 1994 and 1996.

ENDED NCAA REGIONAL DROUGHTS AT CAMPBELL & LOUISIANA TECH

- In Goff's final season at Campbell (2014), the Camels qualified for their first NCAA Regional in 24 years. Two years later, he led Louisiana Tech to its first Regional bid in 29 years. The 2014 Camels and 2016 Bulldogs both won at least one game in their Regionals, with La Tech coming through the loser's bracket to reach a Regional final at Mississippi State.

HISTORY OF TURNAROUNDS

- Goff's teams have had a losing record only five times in his 14 years as a head coach. Four of those five seasons were his first at a respective university. He has led his teams to some impressive turnarounds.
- In just two seasons, Louisiana Tech went from 15-35 the year before Goff's arrival to 42-20 in 2016, ending a 29-year NCAA Regional drought in the process. At Campbell, he inherited a team that was 11-45 in 2007. But under Goff, the Camels posted a winning record (27-24) in his second season and won 40 games by his fifth year (2012).
- Purdue's win total also jumped from 29-27 in 2017 to 38-21 in Goff's first year on the staff in 2018.

COACHING HONORS

- Goff was named the South Central Region Coach of the Year by the American Baseball Coaches Association at both Louisiana Tech (2016) and Montevallo (2006). He was the 2013 Big South Coach of the Year at Campbell after leading his team to a school-record 49 wins and a conference title. Montevallo won a combined 100 games over his final two seasons, posting a new single-season record both years.

BEFORE BECOMING A HEAD COACH

- Goff has coached 10 future big leaguers and over 50 MLB Draft picks, highlighted by Cy Young award winner Brandon Webb while he was the pitching coach at Kentucky (2000-03). Longtime big leaguer and World Series champion Joe Blanton also pitched for Goff at Kentucky.
- Along with his years as the pitching coach at Kentucky, Goff served as an assistant at Southeast Missouri State (1998-99) and his alma mater Delta State (1994-97) before becoming a head coach for the first time in the summer of 2003 at Montevallo. It was at SEMO in the late 1990s where he first worked with Wasikowski. They helped lead the Redhawks to an NCAA Regional in 1998.

- Purdue's first sophomore to be the Opening Day starter since 2016.
- Pitched in a team-high 23 games in 2022 as Purdue's first freshman to lead the team in appearances since 2001.
- Averaged 10.16 strikeouts per nine innings, moving into ninth place on Purdue's single-season list (minimum 30 innings).
- Struck out five of the six batters he faced in the May 10 vs. Butler, posting the best clip (83%) of batters struck out with a minimum five Ks since 2005.
- Also fanned six of 12 batters faced in the game 2 win at Iowa, including four in a row.

STARTING ROTATION LEADING THE WAY IN BIG TEN PLAY

- The Boilermakers won four of their five Big Ten series in April and have avoided being swept over the first six weekends of league play thanks in part to the consistency of the starting rotation. **Khal Stephen, Jonathan Blackwell** and **Kyle Iwinski** are also a big reason why Purdue has already surpassed last year's win total in Big Ten play (9) with six conference games remaining.
- The unique conference-only 2021 season marked the last time the Boilermakers used the same three starting pitchers in the same 1-2-3 order over six consecutive weekends (the final six). But the final weekend of that season featured a suspended game and the game 2 starter took over and "started" when the game resumed Saturday. In 2018, Purdue used the same trio (in the same order) over the first six conference series but a Sunday game was rained out in weekend No. 3. In 2017, there was no cancellations and Purdue used the same trio (in the same order) over the first six weekends of Big Ten play. The 2009 season marked the last time only three pitchers started games in Big Ten play (and in the same 1-2-3 order), a feat this year's rotation has a chance to duplicate. BOILERMAKERS OUT TO REVERSE RECENT TRENDS VS. UPCOMING BIG TEN FOES (All Records as of April 20)

- **Maryland (April 21-23 in College Park):** The Terrapins have won 11 of the 15 meetings since joining the Big Ten, including five straight the last two years. Purdue's three-game sweep in College Park in April 2018 remains its only series victory vs. UMD. **Notable Results:** Purdue became the first visiting team to win on a Friday at Maryland since Michigan in May 2019 but lost the series after the Terrapins came back to win 6-5 in game 2 and 10-8 in the rubber game. It was a tight series, with only one run separating the teams (24-23 UMD) over the three games.
- **Rutgers (April 28-30 at Alexander Field):** The Scarlet Knights have won nine of the 16 meetings since joining the Big Ten in 2015, including five of the last seven since 2019. Purdue's three-game sweep at Alexander in April 2018 remains its only series victory vs. Rutgers. **Notable Results:** Purdue won two of three to claim its fourth series victory in five weekends in April. The Boilermakers had an opportunity to sweep a three-game series at home for the first time since May 2018 but could not make a 5-1 lead stand up as RU scored six times in the seventh inning to win 9-5.
- **Indiana (May 12-14 in Bloomington):** Since 2007, the Boilermakers have won 17 of the last 22 meetings with their rivals away from Bloomington. But IU has enjoyed a decided edge when it's the home team, winning 12 of the 14 meetings since Bart Kaufman Field opened in 2013 and 16 of 21 in Bloomington since 2007.
- **Nebraska (May 18-20 at Alexander Field):** The Huskers are one of two Big Ten that is unbeaten at Alexander Field, sweeping series in 2013 and 2016. Since Nebraska joined the Big Ten in 2012, both of Purdue series victories vs. the Huskers have come in Lincoln. Nebraska has won 10 of the last 11 meetings since 2016.

WEEKEND ROTATION HELPS PURDUE WIN 3 STRAIGHT SERIES OPENERS, POST 18 CONSECUTIVE SCORELESS INNINGS

- Starting pitching was a big reason why the Boilermakers were able to open Big Ten play at 7-5 despite a 10-13 overall record from March 10 to April 19. Purdue won the series opener of three consecutive Big Ten series (at MSU, vs NU, at MINN) and three straight series (vs NU, at MINN, vs PSU) for the first time since sweeping three straight series in 2018.
- **Khal Stephen, Jonathan Blackwell** and **Kyle Iwinski** teamed up to surrender just five runs on 14 hits over 19 1/3 innings vs. Northwestern. The trio's 14 strikeouts vs. two walks was among the most impressive accomplishments. They posted a combined 15 zeros.
- Stephen and Blackwell both kept Minnesota off the scoreboard in their outings in Minneapolis. Purdue won the series opener 3-0 and blanked the Gophers until the eighth inning in game 2. From the ninth inning April 4 vs. Evansville through the eighth inning April 8 at Minnesota, Purdue enjoyed a streak of 18 consecutive scoreless innings. It was the program's longest streak since a stretch of 22 straight vs. Valparaiso and Penn State in March 2019.
- The 2.33 ERA for the starting pitchers vs. Northwestern ranked as their second-best showing in a weekend series this season, trailing only the four-game set vs. Akron (2.08). It was Purdue's best starting pitcher ERA in a three-game series since 2022 vs. Illinois State (1.62) and the best mark in a three-game Big Ten series since 2018 vs. Michigan (1.65).
- Blackwell worked at least five innings in each of his first nine starts as a Boilermaker. The streak ended in his April 22 start at Maryland. It was a rare feat that had not been achieved by a Purdue pitcher since 2017 and done only twice before (Gareth Stroh in 2017, Jordan Minch in 2014) in the program's Alexander Field era (since 2013). Coincidentally, each of the last three pitchers to do it have been lefties.

LONG BALLS ADDING UP FOR JARVIS

- **Jake Jarvis** went deep twice in the game 2 win at Minnesota, posting his second multi-homer game of the season and connecting for his second grand slam. With eight homers for the season, the lefthanded slugger now shares the team lead with **Paul Toetz**. Jarvis has hit six homers in his last 12 starts since March 10. His eight homers overall are the most by a Purdue lefty since Kyle Wood connected for 12 as an All-Big Ten honoree in 2016.
- The Boilermakers have two players with at least eight home runs for the second year in a row. **Cam Thompson** (13) and Troy Viola (8) did it last year. The two players with eight-plus homers is a feat Purdue has now accomplished in consecutive years for the first time since 1998 and 1999. Two Boilermakers with 10-plus homers is also a rare feat, previously achieved only three times since 1990 – 1993 (Mike Biltimier, Alfredo Suarez), 2003 (Daniel Underwood, Nick McIntyre) and 2008 (Dan Black, Ryne White).

COOK'S HISTORIC DEFENSIVE VERSATILITY DEMONSTRATED OVER 8-GAME STRETCH

- **Lukas Cook** is the first Boilermaker since at least the start of the 2001 season to start games at all four infield positions in a season. Remarkably, he did it in the span of just eight games from March 28 to April 9.
- Cook made his first start as a Boilermaker on March 28 at Indiana State, starting the game at second base and later moving to third base to begin the bottom of the fourth inning. Then in the span of just two weeks, he made his first five starts as a Boilermaker at five different positions. He was the designated hitter April 2 vs. Northwestern, first baseman April 4 vs. Evansville, third baseman April 8 at Minnesota and shortstop April 9 at Minnesota.
- Last season, **Cam Thompson** was the only Boilermaker to make multiple starts at two different field positions (excluding DH) – 37 at first base and 13 in right field. As an All-Big Ten at-large selection in 2019, Cole McKenzie was the last Boilermaker to make starts at four different field positions – all three outfield spots plus first base. Three players – Ryan Howe, Tyler Powers and Owen Jansen – also started games at three infield positions that season. Howe went on to start games at all four infield positions over the course of his career (2019-22).
- Before settling in as an All-Big Ten catcher as a junior in 2018, Nick Dalesandro was among the program's most versatile players in the field across his underclassman years. He started games at pitcher, catcher and all three outfield positions in 2016. The following year, it was catcher and all three outfield spots. Teammate Cody Strong made starts at four positions in 2016 (2B, 3B, LF, RF). Including DH, Jack Pichiotti made starts at five positions (C, 3B, LF, RF, DH) in 2015.

WALK-OFF EXCITEMENT RETURNS WITH COOK'S HEROICS

- **Lukas Cook's** walk-off home run in the 10th inning April 2 vs. Northwestern was the latest entry in the many chapters of walk-off thrillers the Boilermakers have authored in recent years. Cook joined **Evan Albrecht** (2), **Cam Thompson** (2), **CJ Valdez**, **Jake Stadler** and **Jake Parr** among active Boilermakers with a walk-off RBI. Thompson hit a walk-off home run vs. Longwood in March of last season and Purdue now has a walk-off homer in three straight years after going without one from 2007 to 2020.

Purdue has now won the rubber game of a traditional three-game Big Ten series at home in consecutive years after going 11 seasons without such a win from 2010 to 2021. The program had lost 13 consecutive (traditional) Big Ten rubber games at home during that stretch. A rubber game win vs. Illinois at Lambert Field on the final day of the 2009 regular season stood as the program's last such win at home for the longest time.

ELITE STRETCH ON THE MOUND TO OPEN BIG TEN PLAY

• **Khal Stephen, Aaron Suval** and **Jonathan Blackwell** teamed up for 13 innings of one-run ball over the first half of the Michigan State series, accounting for a combined 12 zeros from the third inning of game 1 through the sixth inning of game 2. Considering it came on the road against a potent lineup that scored 16 runs over the final 10 innings of the series, it certainly ranks as Purdue's finest stretch of the season on the mound.

• Friday in East Lansing, the Boilermakers overcame a four-run deficit of its own for the first time since an 11-inning win vs. Longwood in the finale of the eight-game North Carolina road trip last season. Purdue did it in conference play for the first time since the 2021 season finale vs. Minnesota.

• The 13 innings of one-run ball is a feat the Boilermakers have now accomplished five times under head coach Greg Goff (2020-present). Purdue did it twice last year and also achieved a stretch of 15 innings of one-run ball vs. Michigan State in 2021. **Calvin Schapira** led the way in 2021 with eight innings of one-run ball in a 2-1 pitcher's duel Purdue won on an 11th-inning walk-off in Champaign.

• In the Akron series the first weekend of March, **Kyle Iwinski's** seven-inning complete-game shutout buoyed a stretch in which Purdue had 10 consecutive scoreless innings and allowed just two runs over 14 frames.
