GAME NOTES

- With the win, Purdue improves its record to 30-7 all time in season openers, 36-1 in home openers and extends its win streak to 22-consecutive season openers at Mackey Arena.
- With the win, Purdue has a school record streak of 10-consecutive season opening wins.
- Sharon Versyp is now 6-0 in season openers as Purdue's head coach.
- The Boilermakers are now 2-0 in meetings with the IUPUI Jaguars.
- Seniors Chelsea Jones and Brittany Rayburn, junior Sam Ostarello, and sophomores KK Houser and Courtney Moses started the game for the Boilermakers and together contributed 52 of Purdue's 75 points.
- The Boilermakers went on an 8-0 run spanning 2:29 minutes to break away from a tie at 13 with the Jaguars in the first half, at 21-13. Purdue led IUPUI 28-22 at the end of the half. Houser was the leading scorer at the half for Purdue with 10 points.
- In the second half, Purdue went on a 19-5 run that spanned 5:36 minutes and increased the Boilers' margin to 55-33.
- The Boilermakers held IUPUI's leading scorer from last season, Kerah Nelson to 3-for-13 from the field and just six points.
- All 12 of the Boilermakers on the active roster saw playing time with 10 of them scoring.
- The 30 point final margin was the largest lead by either team in the contest.

TEAM HIGHS AND LOWS

- Ostarello tied her career high with four blocks.
- Houser set a career high for steals with six and tied her career-high with a game-high 18 points. In addition, she set a career high with seven made field goals and tied her career high for field goal attempts with 14.
- Purdue outrebounded IUPUI 44 to 31.
- IUPUI put up 24 three-point attempts, hitting just four for 16.7 percent.
- The Boilermakers shot 50.0 percent from the field for the game, making 19 of 58 shots.
