>> QUICK HITS

» Indiana State travels to West Lafayette Friday night for a matchup with the seventh-ranked Purdue Boilermakers at 8:30 p.m. ET. The game will air on Big Ten Network as well as on the radio on 105.5 The Legend in the Wabash Valley and on GoSycamores.com/Listen worldwide free-of-charge.

» For the first time in 12 years, the Indiana State basketball team will open the year under new leadership as first-year head coach Josh Schertz takes over the reins of the program. Schertz takes over after a 13-year run at NCAA Division II Lincoln Memorial University where he had a career record of 337-69 (.831) en route to four national coach of the year honors. Schertz led the Railsplitters to 10 NCAA Division II Tournament appearances, won 14 total conference championships and three Southeast Regional titles, and had five seasons of 30-or-more victories.

» Schertz announced prior to the opener that senior guard Tyreke Key will miss the 2021-22 season due to season-ending shoulder surgery. Key is a three-time All-MVC award winner and was named First Team All-MVC in the preseason.

» Indiana State is coming off an 81-77 victory on the road at Green Bay. Four Sycamores scored in double-figures while Kailex Stephens led the way with 16 points and 13 rebounds in his first action as a Sycamore. Six of the eight that saw action made their ISU debut.

» ISU is 14-46 against ranked opponents since the 1977 season. The Trees last win over a ranked foe came in 2016 against #15 Butler in Hulman Center. ISU's last road win over a ranked team came in 2013 against #21 Notre Dame.

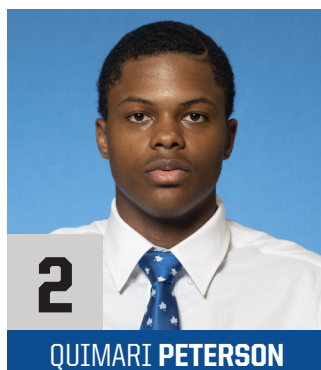

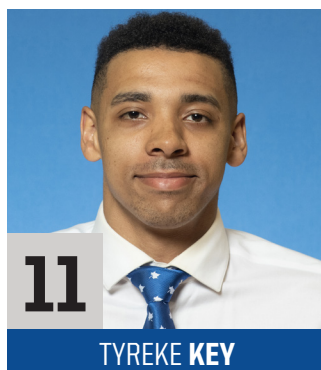

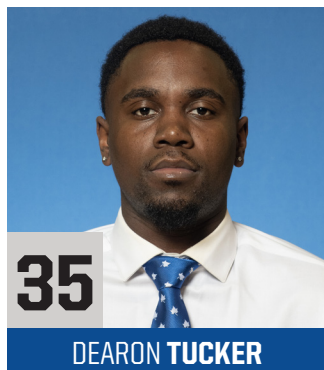

>> TEAM NOTES

OUT OF THE GATE FAST

» Xavier Bledson made his Division I debut at Green Bay after transferring to Indiana State from Lincoln Memorial. The guard played all 40 minutes for the Sycamores after averaging just over 19 minutes a game at LMU a year ago. He was one of just seven players to play 40 or more minutes during opening night of college basketball. Bledson filled up the stats sheet with 15 points, five rebounds, two assists and a steal in his debut.

BACKCOURT RETURNERS

» Neese and Larry each started 21 games for the Sycamores in 2020-21. A Cloverdale, Indiana native, Neese shot 41.2 percent from the field, 39.1 percent from behind the arc and 81.6 percent from the free-throw line while scoring in double-digits in 10 games. Larry was steady at the point guard position, averaging four points, 1.6 assists and 1.1 steals per game. The only other returning for ISU that saw game action was walk-on Sam Mervis. Returning forwards Kailex Stephens and Nick Hittle each missed the year with injuries.

LET IT FLY

» Indiana State went 4-of-12 from the three-point line against Loyola in the MVC semifinal, putting the Sycamores' streak of games with at least one three-point make at 399.

HULMAN CENTER UPDATES

» A \$50 million and nearly two-year renovation project added several updates to the building including a new exterior facade and a glass entrance at the south end that adds square footage and event/meeting space. Light through the glass changes the feel of the building. Previously, the bowl was closed off. From the outside and upon entering, people will be able to glimpse the bowl and the building's high-energy events.

» A new multi-purpose suite overlooking a new court as well as an open-faced area on the south end of the arena are immediately noticeable. Fans will enjoy new restrooms and concession stands while walking the new concourse area, while instantly noticing the new lighting for the court and an improved sound system.

» One of the major parts of the update to Hulman Center was new utility systems, which will make the facility more comfortable while replacing unreliable and inefficient equipment, much of which dated to 1973.

» ISU recently announced a \$2 million a new scoring, message, and video boards at the Hulman Center, a project that will culminate with the debut of a new center-hung scoreboard over midcourt in the arena. The project has been made possible entirely through private funding thanks to a \$2 million gift from the Hulman-George family.

AGAINST PURDUE

» Friday's game against the Boilermakers will mark the 35th meeting all-time between the programs with Purdue owning a 30-4 advantage in the series which dates to 1902. It will mark the second consecutive season that the programs have met after the Sycamores fell 80-68 to Purdue in 2020. It will also mark the third time in the last four meetings that Purdue has been nationally ranked during the matchup. The last win for the Sycamores in the series came in 2006 when ISU defeated Purdue, 89-70. Indiana State also won back-to-back games in 1977 and 1978.

BEACH BALLIN'

» Indiana State is one of eight programs that will compete in the third annual Myrtle Beach Invitational held November 18, 19 and 21 at the HTC Center on the campus of Coastal Carolina University in Conway, S.C.

» Owned and operated by ESPN Events, the tournament field will feature Old Dominion (Conference USA), Davidson (Atlantic 10), East Carolina (The American), New Mexico State (Western Athletic), Oklahoma (Big 12), Penn (Ivy) and Utah State (Mountain West).

» All games throughout the tournament will air on the ESPN Family of Networks with ISU's opener with Old Dominion slated to air on ESPNU.

INDIANA STATE WITH A PAIR OF TOP 10 CAREER SCORERS IN THEIR RESPECTIVE HIGH SCHOOL STATES

» A pair of Indiana State players in Tyreke Key and Cooper Neese are in the Top 10 in career scoring in both of their respective home states. Key finished his career at Clay County High School in Celina, Tenn., with 3,287 points scored which is 10th most in the history of the state of Tennessee. As a senior, he set the Tennessee High School record for most points scored in a season, breaking a 25-year old record held previously by Kentucky legend Tony Delk. Cooper Neese entered his Indiana State career having scored 2,496 career points at nearby Cloverdale High School which is seventh best in the Indiana High School Basketball history.

TWO TREES BACK AFTER INJURY

» Indiana State forward Kailex Stephens missed the 2020-21 season with an achilles tendon rupture. A transfer for the Sycamores, Stephens was named Second Team All-Panhandle Conference a year ago at JUCO powerhouse Tallahassee Community College. The 6-foot-7 forward played in 26 games, averaging eight points and 5.7 rebounds a game. Big man Nick Hittle will also look to make his ISU debut after missing last season with a stress fracture in his back. Hittle suffered an injury during the 2019 postseason after averaging 4.1 points and 4.1 rebounds for the Eagles as a junior. He tallied 5.4 points and 3.4 rebounds per game as a sophomore on the State Championship Team.

NEW FACES

» Eight new faces joined the Sycamores this season including three from Schertz' program Lincoln Memorial: Xavier Bledson, Cameron Henry and Simon Wilbar. Dearon Tucker (Oregon State), Zach Hobbs (Des Moines Area CC) and Micah Thomas (Northwest Florida State College) round out the transfers while Quimari Peterson (Gary, Ind./West Side HS) and Cameron Crawford (Hoover, Ala./Spain Park HS) enter as first-year freshmen.

THREE RAILSPLITTERS JOIN SCHERTZ AT ISU

» Three transfers are coming from Schertz' previous stop at Lincoln Memorial University. Guard Cameron Henry comes in with two years of eligibility remaining, while fellow guard Xavier Bledson has three to play, and forward Simon Wilbar will join the Sycamores with four seasons of eligibility remaining.

CAMERON HENRY

» Henry joins the Sycamores after a stellar three-year run at Lincoln Memorial. The guard averaged double-digits in all

three seasons in the blue and gray, culminating in a 15.1 point, 6.0 rebound, and 4.3 assists per game average during his final season in Harrogate. Henry showed a prolific ability to score from anywhere on the floor, averaging 39.2 percent from beyond the three-point line during his career while shooting 50.5 percent from the floor overall. During his time with the Railsplitters, Henry was named to the All-South Atlantic Conference Second Team in both 2021 and 2020. The guard was a D2CCA Southeast All-Region Secon Team member in 2020, a 2019 South Atlantic Conference All-Freshman Team member, and earned the SAC's Defensive Player of the Year award in 2020. As a prep player, Henry earned multiple all-conference, all-region, and all-state recognitions at Lloyd C. Bird high school and led the Skyhawks to the 2016-17 Virginia High School League Class 5A state title. Henry was ranked as a two-star recruit by Verbal Commits.

XAVIER BLEDSO

» Bledson spent two seasons playing at LMU, utilizing a redshirt season between his first and second years in Harrogate. The Gainesville, Ga. native averaged 10.5 points, 5.1 assists, and 4.3 rebounds in 19.6 minutes per contest during the 2020-21 campaign, more than doubling his averages across the board from his first season with the Railsplitters. As a true freshman, Bledson played in 22 games, making three starts and averaging 2.6 points and 2.7 rebounds in 9.3 minutes per game. Prior to his college days, the guard played at Gainesville High School in Gainesville, Ga. He led the Red Elephants to the 2018 Georgia Class 6A state title game and was rated as a two-star shooting guard by Verbal Commits.

SIMON WILBAR

» After redshirting his true freshman campaign at Lincoln Memorial, Wilbar saw action in 12 games during the pandemic-shortened 2020-21 campaign. The big man averaged 2.8 points and 1.3 rebounds in just 4.6 minutes per game. Wilbar was also a two-star recruit per Verbal Commits out of high school, starring at Canterbury School in Cypress Lake, Fla. The forward led the Cougars to the Florida High School Athletic Association's Class 3A championship game as a junior and followed it up with a senior season that saw him average 16.4 points and 8.8 rebounds per game on the way to being named News-Press All-Area Second Team.

THE TRUE FRESHMEN

» Joining the team as true freshmen are Cameron Crawford (Hoover, Ala./Spain Park HS) and Quimari Peterson (Gary, Ind./West Side HS).

» A 6-foot-5 guard, Crawford averaged 15.4 points, 5.8 rebounds, 2.5 assists and 1.8 steals per game during his senior season at Spain Park High School while shooting 42 percent from behind the arc. He helped the Jaguars to a 27-8 record and the 7A Final Four, scoring 24 points and pulling down 12 rebounds in an Elite 8 victory. He earned several postseason honors including being named First Team All-Metro, First Team Shelby County Reporter, First Team All-Over The Mountain Journal as well as being named to the Second Team by the Alabama Sports Writers Association. The Hoover, Ala. native was also named the Shelby County Player of the Year.

» Peterson comes to Indiana State a 1,000-point scorer at West Side High School in northwest Indiana. The 6-foot-1 guard averaged 14 points, four rebounds, four assists and two steals per game his senior season and led West Side to a 22-5 record and the program's first sectional and regional title since 2004. He was named to the Indiana Basketball Coaches Association Senior Large School All-State team and earned 2021 Northwest Indiana Times Boys Basketball Player of the Year accolades. A Gary, Ind. native, Peterson was also named 2021 Post-Tribune Boys Basketball Player of the Year. Peterson also played for Chris Buggs - a 2007 graduate of Indiana State.

TRANSFER SHARPSHOOTER

» Zach Hobbs (Mesa, Ariz./Des Moines Area CC/Mesa HS) helped Des Moines Area Community College to a NJCAA Division II National Championship in 2021. The 6-foot-5 guard played in 26 games - starting in 25 - for the Bears and averaged 12.3 points per game while shooting 44.8 percent from the field and 44.1 percent from behind the arc. A native of Mesa, Ariz., Hobbs scored in double-digits in 18 games with a season-high 26 points coming in the NJCAA Tournament against Mott. To go along with his shooting totals, Hobbs averaged 5.3 rebounds, two assists and 0.8 steals per game. He scored in double figures in all four games of DMACC's championship run and earned All-Tournament Team. Hobbs also spent a season at Montana State as a freshman where he played in 10 games for the Bobcats.

TUCKER ADDS SIZE FOR SYCAMORES

» Dearon Tucker (Pronounced Dee-Aaron) (Dallas, Texas/Oregon State/Legacy Early College) played 29 games - starting six - as he helped Oregon State advanced to the Elite Eight of the 2021 NCAA Tournament. The 6-foot-10 forward averaged 2.7 points, 1.7 rebounds, 0.2 assists, 0.2 steals and 0.4 blocked shots in 9.6 minutes per game in a crowded big man rotation for the Beavers last season. The Dallas, Texas native had a breakout game against Wyoming with a career high with 16 points, four field goals made, eight free throws made and six rebounds. Over his 46-game career at OSU, Tucker pulled down 42 defensive rebounds and 18 offensive boards while blocking 16 shots.

BACKCOURT GETS DEPTH WITH THOMAS ADDITION

» Micah Thomas (Oklahoma City, Okla./Northwest Florida State College/Putnam City North HS) was the final signee in Schertz' offseason class. Thomas saw action in 21 games, starting in 20 games for the Raiders. He led the team with 13.3 points per game and 3.5 assists per game while grabbing 2.3 rebounds per contest. The 6-foot guard shot at a clip of 44.6 percent from the field, 34.7 percent from range and 86.3 percent from the charity stripe. An Oklahoma City native, Thomas scored in double-digits in 13 games while scoring 20 or more points in three outings. Thomas scored a season-high 29 points on 10-of-15 shooting during a 74-65 win over Florida Southwestern State. Thomas scored over 2,000 points, recorded 500 assists, and reached the state tournament all four years at Putnam City North High School. He was crowned State Tournament MVP

and State Champion in 2018 and led the Panthers 2019 team to a State Runner-Up highlighted by a career-high 44 points (13-of-19) in the semifinals round. Thomas earned accolades including the state of Oklahoma's highest honor as the Super 5 Player of the Year while also being tabbed as the Big 10 Player of the Year, Big All-City Player of the Year, and 6A All-State.

EXPERIENCE ON THE BENCH IN MATTHEW GRAVES

» Josh Schertz added one of the most experienced and well-known coaches in the state of Indiana to his bench in Associate Head Coach Matthew Graves. Graves returns to the Wabash Valley after nearly two decades in coaching, most recently at Xavier. One of Graves' best attributes is his experience in the head coaching chair, spending five years as the head coach at the University of South Alabama from 2013-2018.

» Graves spent nearly two decades making a name for himself at Butler, first as a student-athlete and then as an assistant coach. He began his coaching career as coordinator of basketball operations in 2001 under Todd Lickliter, and was promoted to associate head coach in 2010 by Brad Stevens. With Graves on staff, the Bulldogs made a national tournament in each of his last eight seasons and achieved eight straight seasons with 20-or-more wins. The highlight of his tenure at his alma mater came as appearances in back-to-back NCAA Tournament Championship games in 2010 and 2011.

FROM WESTPOINT TO TERRE HAUTE

» Zak Boisvert joined Schertz' staff after spending the previous five seasons as an assistant coach at Army where he played a key role in offensive strategy and player development. In 2019-20, the Black Knights led the Patriot League in assists per game, a mark that ranked them 12th in Division I. Army also sat atop the Patriot League rankings for field goal percentage at 47.1% and their two-point percentage mark was good enough for 12th nationally.

» Boisvert was key in the development of Tommy Funk, one of the best point guards to play for Army. Funk turned in a standout senior season in which he finished first on the team and third in the league in scoring with a career-best 17.5 points per game en route to being named First Team All-Patriot League, National Basketball Coaches Association (NABC) Third Team and Metropolitan Basketball Writers Association (MBWA) Third Team All-Met.

WILLIAMS BRINGS NBA EXPERIENCE TO ISU

» Bryston Williams brings over five years of experience from the NBA after serving as a player development coach during his time with the Pistons as well as a year as an assistant coach with the Memphis Hustle during the 2017-18 season and the Iowa Energy in 2016-17 – both G League affiliates of the Memphis Grizzlies.

» Williams comes to Terre Haute after spending the last three years as an assistant coach with the Detroit Pistons. His duties with the Pistons included developing the team's mechanical shooting program, pre and post practice workouts, film breakdown and post-game reports. Prior to moving to the NBA as an assistant, Williams spent two seasons as a graduate assistant at his alma mater, Northwest Missouri State University.

ROBBIE AVILA SIGNS NLI

» Indiana State head basketball coach Josh Schertz announced the addition of Robbie Avila as the 6-foot-8 forward officially signed his national letter of intent. One of the highest-rated commits for the Indiana State men's basketball program, Avila is rated as the sixth-best player in the state of Illinois and the 54th-best power forward nationally by 247Sports.com. Avila earned First team All-State accolades from the Champaign News-Gazette in 2021 after averaging 25.8 points, 11.5 rebounds and 3.7 assists per game while shooting 65 percent from the field.

First Win at Green Bay, W 81-77 (11/9/21)

Four-time national coach of the year Josh Schertz was named Indiana State University's 26th head men's basketball coach by Director of Athletics Sherard Clinkscale Wednesday, March 17.

Schertz comes to Terre Haute after an exceptional 13-year tenure as head coach at NCAA Division II Lincoln Memorial University in Harrogate, Tennessee, where he had a career record of 337-69 (.831). Schertz led the Railsplitters to 10 NCAA Division II Tournament appearances, won 14 total conference championships and three Southeast Regional titles, and had five seasons of 30-or-more victories.

Lincoln Memorial was the second-winningest basketball program in Division II during the 2010s, going 272-50 for a .845 winning percentage. The Railsplitters were masterful at protecting their home court during the Schertz era, going 188-16 (.921) in Harrogate.

While under Schertz' leadership, LMU was a model of consistency, posting 11 consecutive 20-win seasons and making 10 trips to the NCAA Tournament. The Railsplitters became just the second team in the history of Division II basketball to post four consecutive 30-win seasons from 2014-18, while their streak of 95-straight weeks in the national poll was the second-longest of all time. LMU has finished the season ranked in the top two nationally for three years and has held the top spot in the country on 10 different occasions since 2012. During his tenure, the

Railsplitters have notched five 30-win seasons and claimed at least 25 wins nine times.

The 20-win seasons, South Atlantic Conference regular season and tournament championships, as well as the postseason wins, national ranking and NCAA Tournament appearances were all first-time occurrences for the LMU men's basketball program during its NCAA era. In the five seasons prior to coach Schertz' arrival, the Railsplitters had won only 39 games total after posting just seven winning seasons at the NCAA level.

Schertz' dedication to excellence in every area of the program has resulted not just in unparalleled success for his teams, but for individual players as well. His commitment to player development has resulted in a nation-leading nine All-Americans since 2011. LMU produced 17 professional players since 2011, the most among any Division II program during the timespan, to go along with five conference players of the year and 45 all-league selections.

In the classroom, the numbers were just as astounding as the focus on academics by Schertz' staff has led to the eight highest semester grade point averages in program history. Schertz has witnessed 34 of 37 seniors who have completed their playing eligibility at LMU graduate. Along with the 17 who have signed professional basketball contracts, 15 of Schertz' former players have received their master's degrees.

Prior to his time at Lincoln Memorial, Schertz spent five seasons at High Point University as the associate head coach. While there, the Panthers went 87-66 and set program records for wins, conference wins, road wins, and highest RPI ranking in a season.

Schertz spent the previous four seasons at Division II Queens University (N.C.) as well as Lynn University, serving as associate head coach and recruiting coordinator, respectively. While at Queens, the Royals went 49-14 and advanced to the university's first Final Four. During his time at Lynn, the Fighting Knights went 37-18 and his recruiting classes went on to set a school record 29 wins in a season and earn a Final Four appearance.

His coaching career began at his alma mater, Florida Atlantic University, where he spent one season working under head coach Kevin Billerman.

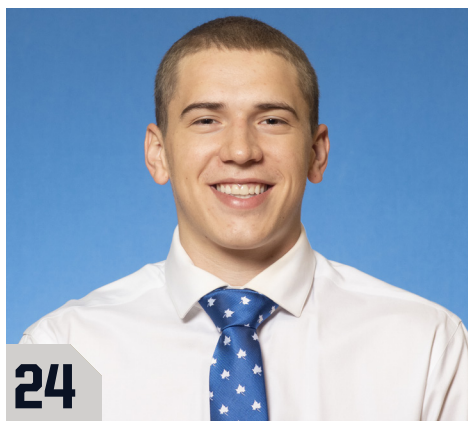

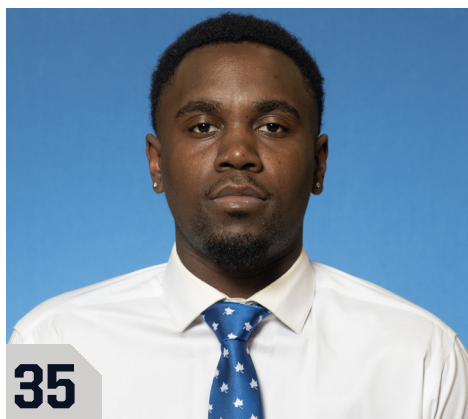
