#### - AROUND THE HORN -

- The Boilermakers are in the state of Florida for the first time since opening the 2013 season at the Big East/Big Ten Challenge in the Clearwater-St. Petersburg area. Purdue played 13 games in DeLand from 1993 to 1997, including winning two of three at Stetson during the opening weekend of the 1997 spring break trip. Four of the nine games on the 1994 season-opening spring break trip were played against Va Tech (two) and Stetson (two) in DeLand.
- The Boilermakers are 6-1 for the first time since 2012. Since 1965, Purdue's 2000 team is the only other to win six of its first seven games.
- Purdue won the Alamo Irish Classic last weekend in San Antonio thanks to a pair of last at-bat victories. The Boilermakers scored a combined six runs in the ninth inning in the comeback wins vs. Incarnate Word and Notre Dame. Purdue was down to its final out in the ninth inning of both games, but came up with a clutch hit to plate the game-tying run.

BIG TEN PITCHER OF THE WEEK April 24, 2017

- Third Team All-Big Ten in 2017, Purdue's first all-conference pitcher since 2012.
- Limited Minnesota to six singles over seven innings in the victory that clinched Purdue's Big Ten Tournament berth last season.
- Was Purdue's top pitcher after start of Big Ten play, working a team-high 63 innings with a 2.43 ERA and .224 average against from March 25 to May 19.
- Threw a complete game 2-hitter vs. Illinois, retiring 27 of 29 batters faced to win Big Ten Pitcher of the Week honors.
- Delivered a much-needed quality start in the game two win at Ohio State, retiring 13 of the first 14 batters & working 7 2/3 innings of one-run ball.
- Became Purdue's first left-hander to start on the mound since Jordan Minch made the last of his 25 career starts in May 2014.
- Appeared in 21 games, making 12 starts and recording 67 strikeouts in 70 innings pitched as a freshman at Coffeyville Community College in Kansas.

#### HEAD COACH MARK WASIKOWSKI

Mark Wasikowski, an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at the Universities of Oregon, Arizona, Florida as well as Southeast Missouri State during his career, was hired as the head coach of Purdue baseball in June 2016.

Wasikowski has played and coached in the College World Series. He helped lead teams to 14 NCAA Tournament appearances during a successful 20-year run as an assistant coach. He also won an NCAA championship as the starting third baseman and a captain on Pepperdine's 1992 College World Series team.

Wasikowski (pronounced WOZ-uh-COW-ski) played for and worked under three-time national Coach of the Year Andy Lopez for a combined 18 years. He was part of Lopez's coaching staffs at both Florida (1999-2001) and Arizona (2002-11) before joining George Horton's staff at Oregon in the summer of 2011, spending five seasons with Horton in Eugene. Wasikowski was an assistant coach on Arizona's 2004 College World Series team, the same year that Horton led Cal State Fullerton to the national title.

Wasikowski led the Boilermakers to a 19-win improvement in his first season. It ranked as the greatest turnaround in program history and tops nationally entering the week of the conference tournaments around the country. Purdue returned to the Big Ten Tournament for the first time since 2012 after winning 10 more games in league play. Wasikowski's team joined the 2007 Boilermakers as the only Big Ten teams since 1988 to post a 10-win improvement in conference play.

Purdue posted a pair of seven-game win streaks in 2017 and recorded 10-plus victories in both March and April. The Boilermakers won seven weekend series after having only six such successful weekends from 2013 to 2016. Purdue was 8-3 in one-run games after having a 2-13 record in similar contests the year before. The Boilermakers' 18 true road wins were tied with Minnesota for the most in the Big Ten.

Wasikowski is the 20th head coach in Purdue's 129-year history, but only the Boilermakers' fourth full-time skipper since 1978.

Wasikowski has coached 120 players that have been selected in the Major League Baseball Draft, a list highlighted by 29 big leaguers. During his 10 seasons at Arizona, Wasikowski coached 59 Major League Baseball draft picks and 22 future big leaguers. As the recruiting coordinator, he assembled the Wildcats' 2012 national championship team, leaving for Oregon before the start of the 2011-12 school year. Oregon was one of only three teams nationally to win 40-plus games every year from 2012 to 2014. During his five seasons in Eugene, the Ducks had 23 players drafted.

Wasikowski was a two-time All-West Coast Conference honoree at Pepperdine after spending his first two collegiate seasons at Hawaii and Rancho Santiago Junior College. He was selected by the Milwaukee Brewers in the 1993 MLB Draft, but opted to remain at Pepperdine to finish his bachelor's degree in business administration while serving as a student assistant under Lopez during the 1994 season. He also has a master's of business administration from Southeast Missouri.

Wasikowski was inducted into the Pepperdine Athletics Hall of Fame along with all of his teammates from the 1992 national championship team. He led the Waves in doubles as a junior and hits as a senior, guiding Pepperdine back to the NCAA Tournament in 1993.

Wasikowski and his wife, Lori Jo, are the parents of two daughters, Joelle and Kelsey.

As a player, I left Arizona much better than when I arrived. He was very good at the mental part of the game and pushing us to get to places we didn't know we could go. I still talk to Waz about once every three months. He is very loyal, and I would trust his character to run my program."

#### LAST WEEKEND'S HIGHLIGHTS

- Purdue's five-run ninth inning Feb. 25 vs. Notre Dame propelled the Boilermakers to thrilling 8-7 victory in the championship game of the Alamo Irish Classic. It was the program's largest last at-bat rally in a victory since scoring 10 times in the ninth inning of a May 2012 win at No. 14 UCLA. **Nick Dalesandro** drove in the game-tying run with a two-out infield single and he scored on the go-ahead tally on **Braden Giroux's** subsquent base hit.
- Coincidentally, that 2012 victory was also the Boilermakers' last against a nationally ranked opponent. Purdue had lost 41 straight games vs. ranked teams since. Notre Dame was ranked 30th by Collegiate Baseball entering the Alamo Irish Classic after winning two of three at LSU to begin the season.
- Jacson McGowan and Skyler Hunter were both 5-for-16 while hitting safely in all four gamesin San Antonio, extending their season-opening streaks to seven. The switch-hitting Hunter recorded hits from both sides of the plate Sunday, including a two-run double in the ninth inning.
- Nick Dalesandro finished the weekend a team-best 7-for-15 with three walks, four RBI and five runs scored. He delivered the walk-off single in the 10th inning Friday vs. Incarnate Word and hit a solo homer Sunday. The junior has reached base safely in every game this year.
- Bo Hofstra's streak of 18 consecutive batters retired to begin his college career ended when fellow freshman Ryan Cole connected for a two-run double to center field in the sixth inning. Hofstra was named Big Ten Pitcher of the Week after he retired all 11 batters he faced to close out the Saint Louis win.
- Mike Kornacker, Trevor Cheaney, Hofstra teamed up to retie 29 of the 31 batters they faced in the doubleheader sweep of Saint Louis and Incarnate Word. It marked the first time since the opening day of the 2012 season that Purdue defeated two different teams on the same day. Kornacker retired 12 of the 14 batters he faced over 4 1/3 innings of scoreless two-hit relief in his two appearances in San Antonio.
- Tanner Andrews struck out while surrendering just one earned run over seven innings in the first meeting with Notre Dame. He has 17 strikeouts over 13 2/3 innings in his first two starts of the season.

#### **BOILERMAKERS AIMING TO BUILDING ON 19-WIN TURNAROUND**

- A 19-win improvement and a return to the Big Ten Tournament for the first time since winning the event in 2012 highlighted Purdue's memorable turnaround campaign in 2017.
- Under first-year head coach Mark Wasikowski, the Boilermakers saw their record improve from 10-44 in 2016 to 29-27 this year. It was the best year-to-year improvement in program history. Entering the week of the conference tournaments around the country, the 19-win improvement was also tops nationally. Last year's team joined the 2007 Boilermakers as the only Big Ten teams since 1988 to win 10 more games in conference play than the year prior, improving from 2-22 to 12-12.
- Purdue posted a pair of seven-game win streaks, and recorded 10-plus victories in both March and April. The Boilermakers won seven weekend series after having only six such successful weekends from 2013 to 2016. The Boilermakers recorded series sweeps against Santa Clara and Illinois and avoided being swept until a mid-May series against nationally ranked Michigan.
- Purdue was 8-3 in one-run games after having a 2-13 record in similar contests the year before. The team's 18 true road wins were tied with Minnesota for the most in the Big Ten.

#### LEARNARD ON STOPPER OF THE YEAR WATCH LIST

- Preseason All-American Ross Learnard was included on the preseason watch list for the NCB-WA's Stopper of the Year Award.
- Learnard was one of 52 relievers nationally named to the preseason watch list. The left-hander was credited with six victories and four saves in 2017 while making a team-high 27 appearances on the mound. He was one of four Boilermakers to record at least one save as Purdue had 14 as a team. He was used as more of a super reliever than prototypical ninth-inning closer, taking the ball in high-leverage situations regardless of the inning. He worked more than one frame in 18 of his appearances.
- A consecutive scoreless innings streak of 35 2/3 from March 11 through May 14 allowed Learnard to eclipse Purdue's minimum 30 innings ERA record that had stood since 1965. His .196 batting average and .086 WHIP were equally outstanding after he surrendered just 30 hits and 10 walks in 46 1/3 innings.

#### 2017 INDIVIDUAL HIGHLIGHTS

- **Jacson McGowan** became the first Boilermaker since 2001 to lead the team in doubles (15), triples (3), home runs (8) and RBI (50). He improved his batting average from .218 on April 1 to .292 by season's end and was the first Boilermaker with 50 RBI since 2012.
- Nick Dalesandro ranked second on the team in batting average (.297), hits (63), RBI (42) and stolen bases (13). He has played in every game since the start of 2016.
- Skyler Hunter became the first freshman to lead the team in batting average (.323) since future big leaguer Kevin Plawecki in 2010.
- Harry Shipley's 24 stolen bases were the most by a Boilermaker since 2005. He needed less than three seasons to eclipse the program record for hit by pitch. Despite getting plunked 58 times in his career, the shortstop has missed just one game as a Boilermaker.
- Evan Warden led the team in OPS (.863) even tough he batted leadoff a team-high 32 times. He led the nation with 30 hit by pitch and led Purdue with 15 doubles and 50 runs scored.
