

## **PURDUE BASKETBALL POSTGAME NOTES**

**Northwestern (18-6/8-5) at Purdue (10-14/3-10)**

**February 11, 2015 • Mackey Arena • West Lafayette, Ind. • Attendance: 5,929**

**Purdue Boilermakers 65, Northwestern Wildcats 73 (OT)**

### **GAME NOTES**

- This is the 40th season in Purdue Women's Basketball history. The Boilermakers are 779-421 all-time, including a 409-132 record at home.
- Purdue is 193-102 under head coach Sharon Versyp, who is in her ninth season with the Boilermakers. She has a career record of 310-167.
- Purdue is 364-191 all-time in Big Ten Conference play, including a 209-69 mark in Mackey Arena.
- Versyp is 91-56 at Purdue in conference play and 100-63 for her career in Big Ten action.
- Purdue is 167-118 in February, including a 99-46 record in Mackey Arena. The Boilermakers are 5-7 all-time on Feb. 11, including a 4-5 record at home.
- The Boilermakers are 499-193 in the state of Indiana.
- Purdue is 24-12 all-time in the 24th game of the season.
- The Boilermakers played in their fifth overtime game of the season, marking the most in a season in school history. They are 1-4 this year and 30-24 all-time.
- Northwestern broke a streak of 17 straight losses in Mackey Arena, dating to 1993. Purdue leads the all-time series 45-21.
- Purdue lost for just the third time this season when leading at the half.
- The Boilermakers had three players with double-doubles for the second time this season and the fourth time in school history.
- Purdue connected on just six of 24 shots in the second half (.250), after cashing in 16-of-33 in the first half (.485).

### **GAME PERFORMANCES/INDIVIDUAL HIGHS**

- Senior Whitney Bays broke the Boilermakers' single-season record with her 14<sup>th</sup> double-double of the season, finishing with 13 points and 11 rebounds.
- Sophomore Bridget Perry posted her second double-double of the season, scoring a team-high 19 points and grabbing 11 rebounds. She was six-of-nine from the floor and seven-of-eight from the free throw line.
- Senior Liza Clemons notched her third double-double of the season and fifth of her career with 10 points and a game-high 13 rebounds.

- Junior point guard April Wilson played just 22 minutes, exiting the game early in the second half with concussion symptoms. 12 of the Boilermakers' 20 turnovers came after her exit from the game.
