GAME NOTES

- This is the 40th season in Purdue Women's Basketball history. The Boilermakers are 779-422 all-time, including a 249-223 on the road.
- Purdue is 193-103 under head coach Sharon Versyp, who is in her ninth season with the Boilermakers. She has a career record of 310-168.
- Purdue is 364-192 all-time in Big Ten Conference play, including a 155-123 mark away from home.
- Versyp is 91-57 at Purdue in conference play and 100-64 for her career in Big Ten action.
- Purdue is 167-118 in February, including a 63-68 record on the road. The Boilermakers are 8-5 all-time on Feb. 14, including a 1-4 record away from home.
- Saturday marks the Boilermakers' first-ever game at Rutgers and their first-ever game in the state of New Jersey. It is the 37th state Purdue has played in.
- Purdue is 21-15 all-time in the 25th game of the season.
- Rutgers' 52.9 percent shooting percentage (36-68) was the best by an opponent against the Boilermakers this season.
- Purdue was outscored in the paint, 50-20, and 30-7 off of 22 Boilermakers turnovers.
- Rutgers tallied 26 fast-break points.

GAME PERFORMANCES/INDIVIDUAL HIGHS

- Sophomore Bridget Perry was the only Boilermaker in double figures, finishing with 13 points and four rebounds.
- In her last two games, Perry has made a combined 11-for-17 from the floor.
- Senior Whitney Bays had six points, 10 rebounds and three assists. Her 10 rebounds move her to seventh on the Purdue single-season record list with 269 this year.
- Freshman Erica Moore scored a career-best five points in a career-most 12 minutes of action, hitting two-of-three from the floor and adding a free throw, while grabbing a pair of rebounds.
