THE SCENE SETTER

- The Purdue men's basketball team wraps up a brief two-game homestand Saturday as America's best rivalry takes center stage for the 208th time when Indiana visits Mackey Arena for a 2 p.m. ET, tip.
- The contest will be televised on FOX with **Gus Johnson**, **Jim Jackson** and **Andy Katz** calling the action courtside, while on the radio waves, the contest will be available on the Purdue Radio Network and TuneIn.com with **Larry Clisby**, **Rob Blackman** and **Ralph Taylor** on the call, beginning with the Purdue Basketball pregame show at 1 p.m.
- Live stats will be provided on PurdueSports.com, and Twitter updates will be available on Purdue's official account (@BoilerBall).

THE MAIN TALKING POINTS

- 1) Purdue is on a 10-game homecourt winning streak, winning the 10 games by an average of 19.9 points per game. Four of the wins (Penn State, Minnesota last year; Maryland, Rutgers) have come in Big Ten play and two more against teams ranked in the NET top 100 (Ball State, Belmont).
- 2) Purdue has played the fifth-most difficult schedule in America, according to KenPom, having played eight top-30 foes.
- 3) Purdue is looking to start 5-2 in Big Ten play for the fourth straight year.
- 4) With the Paint Crew in attendance, Purdue has won 48 of its last 50 games (losses to Villanova in Nov. 2016, and Ohio State in Feb. 2018).
- 5) Purdue continues to excel on the offensive end, ranking sixth nationally in offensive efficiency. Purdue and Duke are the only teams to rank in the top 10 in offensive efficiency in 2017-18 and 2018-19. Purdue finished last year second behind Villanova.
- 6) Under **Matt Painter**, Purdue has been one of the best offensive teams in America. The Boilermakers have ranked in the nation's top 25 in offensive efficiency in six of the last nine seasons (lone years not in top 25: 2014-15, 2013-14, 2012-13).
- 7) Purdue has had eight straight games of posting 10 or fewer turnovers in a game, the first time in school history that has happened. Over the last eight games, Purdue owns a turnover margin of +5.63 and an assist / turnover ratio of 1.83 (121 / 66).
- 8) **Carsen Edwards** ranks fourth nationally in scoring (24.9 PPG). Since the 1992-93 season, just two other Big Ten players (Purdue's **Glenn Robinson 2x**, Michigan State's **Shawn Respert 2x**) have averaged at least 24.0 points per game in a season.
- 9) Purdue has won nine straight home games against in-state foes, with just one game being decided by single digits. Its last loss came on Jan. 30, 2013.
- 10) vs. Wisconsin, **Trevion Williams** became the first Purdue player since **JaJuan Johnson** (Nov. 21, 2010) to lead Purdue in rebounds, assists, steals and blocks. Over the last six games, he has 45 points, 39 rebounds, eight assists and six steals in 81 minutes (22.2 pts & 19.3 rebs per 40 minutes).

THE SERIES

- One of America's fiercest college basketball rivalries, Purdue and Indiana will meet for the 208th time, the most among all Big Ten teams.
- The two teams have combined for 43 Big Ten Championships in the last 98 seasons. The teams have shared titles four times, meaning in 39 of the 98 seasons, Purdue or Indiana has won the Big Ten regular-season title.
- Purdue leads the Big Ten with 23 Big Ten titles, while Indiana is right behind with 22 (all-time).
- In 21 games during the **Matt Painter** era, Indiana has scored 70 points just 10 times, including just twice in the last seven games. On the flipside, Purdue has scored 70-plus five times in last seven games.

A CLOSER LOOK AT AMERICA'S BEST RIVALRY

- Purdue leads the all-time series with Indiana by a 118-89 margin, but the series has been close the last 60-ish years.
- Over the last 110 games, both teams have won 55 games each, with Indiana outscoring the Boilermakers by 52 total points.
- Over the last 118 games, both teams have won 59 games each, with Indiana outscoring Purdue by 107 points.
- Purdue is 6-1 in the last seven games against Indiana. A win Saturday would give either team a 7-1 stretch in an eight-game span for the first time since March 11, 1972, to Feb. 16, 1976, when Indiana went 7-1 against Purdue.

WHO KNOWS WHO?

- Purdue's **Ryan Cline** and Indiana's **Zach McRoberts** were teammates at Carmel High School, where the duo won state titles in 2012 and 2013.
- Indiana senior **Quentin Taylor** played with 2018 Purdue grad **P.J. Thompson** at Brebeuf Jesuit High School.
- Indiana freshman **Rob Phinisee** is from Lafayette. His brother, Charles, and mother, Tanika, are Purdue graduates.
- **Carsen Edwards** and **Romeo Langford** were teammates for Team USA in the FIBA U19 World Cup in Egypt in July 2017.

- Indiana will be the seventh ranked team that Purdue has faced this year. There are currently three more ranked teams on the schedule.

ONE OF THE NATION'S TOUGHEST SCHEDULES

- Purdue has played one of the nation's most-difficult schedules to date and could rise even higher thanks to a rigorous Big Ten slate.
- Purdue's schedule currently ranks as the sixth-hardest nationally behind Kansas, Oklahoma, Penn State, Creighton and Illinois.

- In Big Ten play only, Purdue will face a team that was ranked at the time of the game or ranked in the Dec. 31, poll in eight of its first nine league games.
- Purdue has played 12 teams ranked in the KenPom top 100, posting a 6-6 overall record.
- The strength of schedule has helped Purdue to a No. 17 NET rating. The next closest six-loss team is Florida (9-7; 41st).
- During the Painter era, the highest that a schedule has ever been ranked (KenPom) is eighth in 2012; the lowest is 2008 (62nd).
- Starting with the Indiana game on Saturday, Purdue will face a top-50 opponent in eight of its next 10 games and in 10 of its last 14 games of the season.

BRUTAL SCHEDULE TO START THE BIG TEN

- Purdue easily owns the Big Ten's toughest schedule in conference play to date and the records bear that out.
- Taking out the Purdue results, Purdue's first five games of Big Ten play came to teams with a combined record of 21-3.
- Purdue's two losses have come on the road to teams (Michigan, Michigan State) that own a 12-0 Big Ten record (10-0 without Purdue wins) and a 32-2 (30-2) overall mark.
- Purdue's first three wins came against teams currently with a 13-7 Big Ten record (13-4 without Purdue losses) and a combined 41-12 (41-9) record.

EFFICIENT OFFENSE

- After ranking No. 2 in last year's offensive efficiency ratings via KenPom.com, Purdue has picked up where it left off last year, ranking sixth midway through this season.
- Purdue is one of five teams to rank in the top 25 of the offensive efficiency ratings in each year since 2015-16.

BOILERS TAKING CARE OF THE BALL

- Purdue has taken care of the ball this year, averaging just 10.8 turnovers per game, which would rank as the third-lowest average in school history (2012, 2011).
- However, over the last eight games, Purdue is averaging just 8.3 turnovers per game, while boasting an assist/turnover ratio of 1.83.
- Purdue is 22nd nationally in turnover percentage (15.7 percent) and 17th nationally in turnovers per game (10.8).

SHOOTING WINS

- Purdue is 141-15 under Painter when over 48.0 percent shooting, including 5-1 this season. The lone loss came to Virginia Tech (50.8 percent). It was Purdue's first loss when shooting 48-plus percent from the field since a Feb. 2017, loss to Michigan, a streak of 27 straight victories.

THE EXTRA POSSESSION GAME

- During the Painter era, Purdue is 109-9 when committing fewer turnovers and outrebounding its opponents in the same game.
- Since the start of the 2014-15 season, Purdue is 25-4 when that happens, having won 25 of its last 26 games when doing so (lone loss: Notre Dame).

THE LIMIT IS 60

- Purdue is 136-5 when under Painter when holding foes to 59 or fewer points. Three of the five losses came during the 2012-13 season.

USUALLY AUTOMATIC

- Purdue is 90-9 since the start of the 2014-15 season when attempting more free throws than its opponents.

SURGING FRESHMEN

- **Matt Painter** also really likes this freshman class, but it took a little bit of time to get them going. The group scored a season-high 39 points in the win over Rutgers, and has scored at least 23 points as a group in four of the last six games.

ROAD WARRIORS

- Since the start of the 2007-08 season, Purdue owns a 61-58 record, the third-most wins in the Big Ten during that span. Only four teams (Wisconsin, Michigan State, Ohio State, Purdue) have even won at least 40.0 percent of their road games during that span (not counting Maryland).
- Over the last 12 years, there have been just 10, 8-win road seasons by all the teams in the Big Ten (MSU - 3; Wisc. - 3; Purdue - 2; OSU - 1; Md. - 1).

HEAD COACH MATT PAINTER

► **Record at Purdue:** 306-155 (.664) / 14th year | **Career Record:** 332-160 (.675) / 15th year

- With four Sweet 16 appearances, 10 NCAA Tournament berths, two Big Ten regular-season championships, a Big Ten Tournament title and an international gold medal on his résumé, 14th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest young minds in all of college basketball.
- Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in October of 2018, agreeing to a two-year extension that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2023-24 season. The deal features five, one-year extensions that go into effect through the 2028-29 season. Following the 2029 season, Painter will still only be 58 years old.
- Painter entered the 2018-19 season third on the school's all-time wins list (295) behind legendary mentors, Gene Keady and Ward "Piggy" Lambert, both of whom have been inducted into the College Basketball Hall of Fame.
- Has averaged almost 23 wins a season in his 13 years at Purdue. If you don't include the first transitional year, the average balloons to 23.8 wins per year over the last 12 seasons.
- Has won at least 25 games in eight of his 14 seasons as a collegiate head coach.
- Painter's three Big Ten Coach of the Year honors are the fourth most in league history (Gene Keady - 7; Bobby Knight - 5; Bo Ryan - 4).
- Painter has averaged 10.9 wins per year in conference play, the fifth-best average in Big Ten Conference history.
- Is one of just three active coaches to have won a Big Ten championship.
- Painter's 10 NCAA Tournaments in the last 12 years are the ninth most in the country.
- Purdue's four Sweet 16 appearances in the last 10 years are the ninth most nationally.
