GAME NOTES

- This is the 40th season in Purdue Women's Basketball history. The Boilermakers are 779-425 all-time, including a 249-225 record on the road.
- Purdue is 193-106 under head coach Sharon Versyp, who is in her ninth season with the Boilermakers. She has a career record of 310-171.
- Purdue is 364-195 all-time in Big Ten Conference play, including a 155-125 mark on the road.
- Versyp is 91-60 at Purdue in conference play and 100-67 for her career in Big Ten action.
- Purdue is 167-122 in February, including a 63-70 record on the road. The Boilermakers are 6-3 all-time on Feb. 24, including a 3-1 record away from Mackey Arena.
- Purdue is 21-10 all-time in the 28th game of the season.
- Purdue still leads the all-time series against Michigan 50-18, including a 20-11 mark in Ann Arbor.
- Michigan shot 53.1 percent from the field (34-64), becoming the third team to top the 50 percent mark against the Boilermakers this season.
- The Boilermakers grabbed just 26 rebounds, their second-lowest this season, and matched their season-low with just seven offensive boards.
- Purdue shot a season-worst two-of-seven from the free throw line.

GAME PERFORMANCES/INDIVIDUAL HIGHS

- Junior April Wilson flirted with a triple-double, finishing with 16 points, eight assists, seven rebounds and a pair of steals. Her seven rebounds match her season-high.
- Wilson is 13th in Purdue history with 316 career assists.
- Sophomore Ashley Morrisette scored 12 points on six-of-11 shooting.
- Senior Liza Clemons blocked a pair of shots, moving her career total to 88 and matching Mary Jo Noon for 13th in school history in blocked shots.
