

PURDUE FOOTBALL

Final Score: Nebraska 25, Purdue 24 / Attendance: 41,411

TEAM NOTES

- The game was Purdue's third night game.
- Nebraska's sack on David Blough in the first quarter snapped a streak of 59 straight rushes without a negative carry for the Boilermakers.
- Purdue led 14-6 at the half.
- Gelen Robinson forced a fumble, though Purdue did not recover. It was the first time this year that an opponent fumbled and the Boilermakers did not recover (Purdue recovered the previous nine).
- The Boilermakers did not have a turnover, while also not coming up with a takeaway.
- The defense allowed two touchdowns, the fourth game in a row allowing the opponent to only reach the end zone twice.
- The defense allowed just two tackles for loss for the second game in a row.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

• David Blough, Jr., QB

- --Made his 24th career start and first since the Minnesota game.
- --Finished 16 for 28 passing for 164 yards and a touchdown.
- --Also rushed seven times for 33 yards and a score.

• Gelen Robinson, Sr., DT

- --Had three tackles for loss, including a sack, on Nebraska's first two drives. That tied his career high for a single game.
- --Had five tackles, including 4.0 for loss and 2.0 sacks, in the first half.
- --Finished with nine tackles, including 5.5 for loss and the two sacks.
- --His 5.5 tackles for loss are the fifth most in a single game in school history.
- --Also forced a fumble.
- --Now has 29.5 career tackles for loss, which ranks 17th in school history.

• Richie Worship, So., RB

--Had career highs in attempts and yards with 18 carries for 89 yards and a touchdown.

• Jackson Anthrop, Fr., WR

- --Hauled in his fifth touchdown reception of the season on a 14-yard strike from David Blough.
- --Finished with a team-high six receptions for 55 yards.

• Richie Worship, So., RB

--Had career highs in attempts and yards with 18 carries for 89 yards and a touchdown.

• Ja'Whaun Bentley, Sr., LB

--Finished with a team-high nine tackles, including 0.5 for loss.

• Markus Bailey, So., LB

- -- Had five tackles, including a sack.
- --Now has 4.0 sacks on the season to lead the team.
