– AROUND THE HORN –

• The Boilermakers head south on I-57 again for the third weekend of the season, making their first visit to Cape Girardeau since 2009. Southeast Missouri is the three-time defending Ohio Valley Conference regular-season champs. Purdue has not played an OVC team since sweeping a three-game series at Murray State in March 2012. A midweek win at Missouri State on the 2012 spring break trip was Purdue's last game in the Show Me State.

• The Boilermakers scored in only two of the 27 innings of their series at Little Rock. But they managed to score six times in the series opener to avoid being swept. Purdue enters the SEMO series having not scored in 22 consecutive innings.

• Head coach **Mark Wasikowski** returns to the university where his coaching career began. He was an assistant at SEMO from 1997 to 1998, helping the Redhawks win the 1998 OVC Tournament to qualify for an NCAA Regional. While working on his master's degree at SEMO, Wasikowski also met his wife Lori.

• Fifteen newcomers have made their Purdue debuts over the first two weekends. Among them, **Mike Madej**, **Evan Warden** and **Logan Poisall** have played in all seven games. **Dalton Parker** has earned a win and a save in his first two collegiate appearances.

• After leading Purdue to its first season-opening win since 2013 and becoming the team's first Big Ten Pitcher of the Week honoree since 2012, **Tanner Andrews** also won his season-opening start at Little Rock. In the process, he became the first Boilermaker to win his first two weekend starts since 2011.

- First pitcher to win each of his first two weekend starts since 2011.
- Struck out a career-high nine over seven innings of one-run ball while leading Purdue to its first season-opening win since 2013.
- Retired 21 of the 24 batters he faced and did not have to work from the stretch until there were two outs in the seventh inning.
- Purdue's first Big Ten Pitcher of the Week honoree since May 2012.
- Became the first Purdue pitcher to start consecutive season openers since Matt Bischoff started three straight from 2008 to 2010.
- Pitched in a team-high 21 games in 2016, starting the opener of each of the first five weekends.
- Also closed out 2016's season-ending shutout win vs. Cal State Northridge, working five innings of one-hit relief over two appearances in the series.
- A year ago, became Purdue's first non-freshman since 2011 to make his first start on a weekend, and did it in a season opener.
- Excelled as a reliever in 2016, compiling a 1.34 ERA and .168 batting average against over 14 appearances, surrendering only 24 hits while striking out 32 in 40 1/3 innings pitched.
- Pitched a career-high seven innings at ETSU and Penn State, working seven scoreless innings vs. PSU to allow Purdue to rally and force extra innings.
- Made five of his seven appearances in Big Ten play as a freshman in 2015 despite not making his collegiate debut until April 11.
- Team MVP in football, basketball and baseball each of his upperclassman years at Tippecanoe Valley High School; all-state defensive back & wide receiver, area player of the year and second team all-state performer in basketball.

- Bounced back from a tough season-opening outing with a quality start at Little Rock, losing a 2-0 pitcher's duel after surrendering just one run over six innings.
- Became Purdue's first left-hander to start on the mound since Jordan Minch made the last of his 25 career starts in May 2014.
- Only 12 of Purdue's 472 2/3 innings pitched (2.5 percent) last season were worked by left-handed pitchers.
- Appeared in 21 games, making 12 starts and recording 67 strikeouts in 70 innings pitched as a freshman at Coffeyville Community College in Kansas.
- Helped the Wisconsin Rapids Rafteries win the 2016 Northwoods League title, recording five wins and 55 strikeouts over 60 innings pitched; also worked 4 1/3 innings of one-run ball, striking out six, in his playoff start.
- His high school did not sponsor baseball so he ran track in the spring while also playing football and basketball.
- Played legion baseball in the summer, helping his team win the class C Nebraska state title in 2014.
- Also part of a Platte championship team in basketball.
- All A honor roll student and homecoming king.
- His mother Deb played volleyball at the University of Nebraska at Kearney.

- 2016 Academic All-Big Ten honoree pitched in a team-high 21 games.
- Was the first man out of the bullpen in the 2016 season opener at Georgia Tech, working 3 1/3 innings of one-run relief in his team debut.
- Retired all 12 batters he faced over four innings of perfect relief in the comeback win at Georgia State to close out the opening weekend of 2016.
- Made two appearances in the same weekend three other times but struggled in his only start, failing to make it through the first inning.
- Worked three innings of scoreless relief in the home midweek game vs. IPFW.
- Pitched in Big Ten games against Nebraska, Indiana, Maryland, Ohio State, Northwestern and Minnesota.
- Recorded 11 strikeouts over 8 2/3 innings in April and then finished the season strong with 6 2/3 innings of two-run ball over five appearances in May.
- Pitched in 12 games for Wabash Valley in 2016, earning three wins and a save while compiling 27 strikeouts and a 3.16 ERA in 31 1/3 innings.
- Started his college career at North Dakota State, pitching in five games in 2014 after redshirting the year prior; pitched in games against USC and Minnesota.
- Two-time all-conference honoree as an upperclassman and two-way player; went 5-1 with a 1.05 ERA and 50 strikeouts in 33 1/3 innings as a senior.
- Struck out 15 in an MSHSL playoff game in 2012.
- All-conference in basketball as a senior, averaging 19 points per game.

HEAD COACH MARK WASIKOWSKI

Mark Wasikowski, an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at the Universities of Oregon, Arizona, Florida as well as Southeast Missouri State during his career, was hired as the head coach of Purdue baseball in June 2016.

Wasikowski has played and coached in the College World Series. He helped lead teams to 14 NCAA Tournament appearances during a successful 20-year run as an assistant coach. He also won an NCAA championship as the starting third baseman and a captain on Pepperdine's 1992 College World Series team.

Wasikowski (pronounced WOZ-uh-COW-ski) played for and worked under three-time national Coach of the Year Andy Lopez for a combined 18 years. He was part of Lopez's coaching staffs at both Florida (1999-2001) and Arizona (2002-11) before joining George Horton's staff at Oregon in the summer of 2011, spending five seasons with Horton in Eugene. Wasikowski was an assistant coach on Arizona's 2004 College World Series team, the same year that Horton led Cal State Fullerton to the national title.

Wasikowski has been an assistant coach on teams that have made 11 NCAA Regional appearances since 2003, including six straight seasons from 2010 to 2015. Oregon qualified for the NCAA Tournament in four of his five years, hosting two Regionals and a 2012 Super Regional. When Lopez took over the Arizona program in 2001 with Wasikowski by his side, the Wildcats had been to one Regional in the last nine years. During Wasikowski's 10 years as an assistant in Tucson, Arizona qualified for the postseason seven times.

Wasikowski is the 20th head coach in Purdue's 129-year history, but only the Boilermakers' fourth full-time skipper since 1978.

Wasikowski has coached 117 players that have been selected in the Major League Baseball Draft, a list highlighted by 28 big leaguers. During his 10 seasons at Arizona, Wasikowski coached 59 Major League Baseball draft picks and 22 future big leaguers. As the recruiting coordinator, he assembled the Wildcats' 2012 national championship team, leaving for Oregon before the start of the 2011-12 school year. Oregon was one of only three teams nationally to win 40-plus games every year from 2012 to 2014. During his five seasons in Eugene, the Ducks had 23 players drafted. Oregon also had a perfect 1,000 APR score as recently as 2015.

Wasikowski was a two-time All-West Coast Conference honoree at Pepperdine after spending his first two collegiate seasons at Hawaii and Rancho Santiago Junior College. He was selected by the Milwaukee Brewers in the 1993 MLB Draft, but opted to remain at Pepperdine to finish his bachelor's degree in business administration while serving as a student assistant under Lopez during the 1994 season. He also has a master's of business administration from Southeast Missouri.

Wasikowski was inducted into the Pepperdine Athletics Hall of Fame along with all of his teammates from the 1992 national championship team. He led the Waves in doubles as a junior and hits as a senior, guiding Pepperdine back to the NCAA Tournament in 1993.

Wasikowski and his wife, Lori Jo, are the parents of two daughters, Joelle and Kelsey.

Then when I got to school, he was more concerned with me as a person than he was with my performance. He stayed on me about school and put together a three-year graduation plan so I could be done with school if I signed after my junior year. As a player, I left Arizona much better than when I arrived. He was very good at the mental part of the game and pushing us to get to places we didn't know we could go. I still talk to Waz about once every three months. He is very loyal, and I would trust his character to run my program."

SHIPLEY, WARDEN ON BASE SAFELY IN EVERY GAME SO FAR

• Purdue's double play combination of **Harry Shipley** and **Evan Warden** have both reached base safely in every game this season. Shipley has been on safely in 12 straight games dating back to the end of last year. Together they've been hit by a pitch 10 times already. Shipley has already reached base safely 14 times over the first seven games. After starting the 2016 campaign mired in a 4-for-34 slump, it took him until game 13 to have been on base safely 14 times. Shipley had a 15-game reached base safely streak as a freshman in 2015.

FRESHMEN MAKE EARLY CONTRIBUTIONS

- **Mike Madej**, **Dalton Parker**, **Bryce Bonner** and **Skyler Hunter** have enjoyed the most early success among Purdue's freshman class. Madej already has a team-high three multi-RBI games and also scored twice in the season-opening win. He hit the first of Purdue's three home runs in the first inning of the game two win at Texas State, becoming the first freshman to connect for the Boilermakers' first homer of a season since Cameron Perkins in 2010. In the series-opening win at Little Rock, he had a two-run double in Purdue's four-run fifth inning that was the difference in the game.
- Parker has worked 8 2/3 innings of scoreless three-hit ball over his first two collegiate appearances, retiring 26 of 31 batters faced in the process to emerge as the early ERA leader in the Big Ten. He's the only qualifying pitcher in the conference that has yet to allow a run. The right-hander worked five scoreless at Texas State to earn the win and closed out the Little Rock win with 3 2/3 innings to earn the save.
- Bonner has reached base safely in all five games he has played. He made the most of his nine plate appearances while starting the final two games of the Texas State series. He had four hits, three walks and a sac fly, doing something productive in eight of his nine trips to the dish. He had three hits and four RBI in his collegiate debut.
- Hunter was the only Boilermaker to hit safely in all four games of the Texas State series. He has reached base safely in all five games in which he has batted.

POISALL ENJOYS EMOTIONAL WEEK, MEMORABLE DEBUT

- **Logan Poisall** doubled and homered in his first two at-bats as a Boilermaker during the season-opening weekend. Those were the high points of an emotional roller coaster of a week for the JUCO transfer from California. He learned of the passing of his father Jack on Thursday (Feb. 16) and did not arrive at Texas State's Bobcat Ballpark until the fourth inning of the season opener. He was featured by D1Baseball.com and MLB Network the week of Feb. 20, attending the services for his father in Fresno before flying to Little Rock to rejoin the team Feb. 23.
- Poisall started the final three games of the series at third base, finishing the weekend 4-for-12 with the two extra-base hits, two walks and four runs scored. He likely would have been the starting third baseman on opening day, but was not permitted to travel with the team because his eligibility was not officially verified until the team bus had already left for the Indianapolis airport. Players must be officially eligible to play in order to be allowed to travel with the team. Poisall learned his father passed away while the team flight he was originally scheduled to be on was in the air.
- After he was cleared to play by the NCAA, Poisall flew from Indianapolis to Charlotte to San Antonio on Friday. Director of operations John Madia picked him up at the San Antonio airport and they arrived at Bobcat Ballpark in San Marcos in the top of the fourth inning. Purdue's dugout erupted with joy when Poisall finally rejoined his teammates. The Boilermakers entered the top of the fourth with a 4-0 lead and blew the game open with a four-run frame, winning their first game under new head coach **Mark Wasikowski** 9-3. Poisall led off the eighth inning with his pinch-hit double down the left field line. He was one of three Boilermakers to go deep in the first inning of the Feb. 18 doubleheader.

McGOWAN DRIVES IN A RUN IN EACH OF FIRST FIVE GAMES THAT PURDUE SCORED

- It took a shutout of the Boilermakers to end **Jacson McGowan's** five-game RBI streak to begin the season. It was the longest RBI streak by a Boilermaker since Kyle Wood drove in a run in seven straight games during his memorable March power surge last season. Tyler Spillner (2010) was the last Purdue player to drive in a run in each of the first five games of the season that he started, pinch hitting in the season opener before moving into the starting lineup. Otherwise, a five-game RBI streak to begin a season had not been accomplished by a Boilermaker since at least the 2005 campaign.

ANDREWS NAMED BIG TEN PITCHER OF THE WEEK

- **Tanner Andrews** dominated Texas State at Bobcat Ballpark in the season opener, surrendering only one walk and two hits over seven innings of one-run ball to win Big Ten Pitcher of the Week honors. He struck out a career-high nine. It was the longest opening day start by a Purdue pitcher since Jay Buente worked eight innings of one-run ball, striking out 11, in 2006 at Louisiana-Lafayette. Buente was drafted later that year and went on to make it to the big leagues with the Marlins.
- Andrews was Purdue's first Big Ten Pitcher of the Week honoree since Joe Haase was recognized for a complete-game shutout of Michigan in May 2012. That was the opening game of the final series in the history of Lambert Field, a memorable weekend highlighted by the Boilermakers clinching the Big Ten title the following day.
- A junior right-hander, Andrews retired 21 of the 24 batters he faced in San Marcos, including the first 10 in a row and 20 of the first 21. The only run he allowed came on a solo homer in the fourth inning. He did not have to pitch from the stretch until there were two outs in the seventh inning. Sixty of the 91 pitches he threw were strikes.
- Andrews posted a game score of 77 in his gem. Only one outing was better by a Purdue pitcher in all of 2016, Matt Frawley's game score of 86 in his final start as a Boilermaker. Frawley struck out eight over 8 1/3 innings of two-hit shutout ball in a 10-inning vs. Cal State Northridge.
- Andrews became the first Purdue pitcher to make consecutive opening day starts since Matt Bischoff started three straight from 2008 to 2010. Andrews posted the best opening day performance by a Boilermaker on the mound since Matt Morgan beat No. 9 Connecticut in the 2011 season opener, working 5 2/3 shutout innings that night in Florida. Buente had a game score of 80 in 2006 and Morgan 66 in 2011.
