- Purdue is averaging 100.7 points per game through three contests, ranking 17th nationally. Among teams that have played at least three games, Purdue leads the country in scoring.
- Purdue has scored at least 50 points in five of six halves this year.
- The 105 points against SIU-Edwardsville were the fourth most in a season opener in school history and the seventh most by a team on opening night (among Division I teams).
- Purdue's 111 points against Chicago State were the 17th most in a game in school history and the most since Dec. 22, 1997, against Florida A&M (118).
- Purdue's 111 points against Chicago State are tied for the secondmost nationally this year (Virginia Tech 132 vs. the Citadel).
- Purdue's 59 points in the first half against Chicago State were the fourth most in a half during the **Matt Painter** era.

▶ Centers of Attention

- Purdue's two primary centers, Isaac Haas and Matt Haarms, have been outstanding so far this season. The duo is averaging a combined 24.3 points, 11.0 rebounds, 4.3 blocks and 1.3 assists in 38.0 minutes per game, while shooting 25-of-38 (.658) from the field.
- Haarms is the only player in the country to have at least 25 points, 15 rebounds and eight blocked shots already this year.

▶ As Far as the Seniors Can Take Them

- Purdue's senior class has had a remarkable career so far and would love nothing more to repeat as Big Ten champions.

November Reign

- · Purdue has dominated the opposition at home during the month of November, going 42-2 (.955) under head coach Matt Painter. The lone setbacks were on Nov. 9, 2012, to Bucknell (70-65), and Nov. 14, 2017, to defending national champion Villanova (79-76). Ironically, Villanova's head coach Jay Wright graduated from Bucknell.
- Going back further, Purdue is 77-8 (.906) all-time at Mackey Arena during the month of November.
- Painter owns a 59-15 (.797) record during the month of November.

▶ Big Margins at Home

• Purdue has won nine straight home games by an average of 25.2 points per game with all of them coming by double-digits. Its closest games during the streak was 11 points twice (Wisconsin, Indiana).

▶ Boilers Hot at Home

- Purdue will enter Saturday's Fairfield game having won nine straight games at Mackey Arena, the sixth-longest streak during the Painter era.
- With eight non-conference home games on the slate, an undefeated non-conference schedule will give Purdue 15 straight home wins, which would be the fifth-longest home winning streak in Mackey Arena history.

- With a trio of Sweet 16 appearances, nine NCAA Tournament berths, Big Ten regular-season and tournament titles and an international gold medal
 on his résumé, 13th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest minds in all of college basketball.
- Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in March of 2011, agreeing to a new eight-year contract that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2018-19 season. He then followed that up in August of 2016, signing a three-year extension good through the 2021-22 year.
- Painter has averaged over 22 wins per season during his tenure at the helm of the Purdue program, including at least 25 victories in six seasons.
- Painter's tenure has seen Purdue basketball restore its status among the upper echelon of college basketball programs. The last 10 years have seen six 25-win seasons and eight NCAA Tournament berths, three Sweet 16 appearances, two regular-season Big Ten titles and a Big Ten Tournament crown.
- The three winningest classes in program history are the classes of 2011, 2012 and 2010, respectively, and five of the 10 winningest individual players Purdue has ever seen have come from the Painter ranks. Success, however, didn't happen overnight.
- Painter officially became the 18th head men's basketball coach in Purdue history on April 1, 2005, and immediately set about laying the groundwork for a dramatic reversal in the program's fortunes.
- The Boilermakers were at their best during the 2009 postseason run, rattling off double-digit victories over Penn State and Illinois to reach the Big Ten Tournament final, where they dispatched Ohio State, 65-61, to earn the first conference tournament crown in program history.
- Painter has been named Big Ten Coach of the Year three times, earning the consensus award in 2008 and 2011, and winning the coaches' vote in 2010. He is one of only six men to win the award more at least three times since its inception in 1974.
- Painter has seen a total of 26 players earn a combined 49 Academic All-Big Ten honors during his tenure as head coach. Painter has also mentored
