GAMEDAY STORYLINES

► **SCENE SETTER:** The 20th-ranked Purdue Boilermakers put their perfect road record on the line on Sunday when it hits the highways for a 6 p.m. ET / 5 p.m. CT tilt against Illinois in the State Farm Center in Champaign, Illinois. **Jeff Levering** and **Jon Crispin** will handle the call for the Big Ten Network, while **Larry Clisby** and **Rob Blackman** will have the call on the radio dial for the Purdue Radio Network. Live stats will be provided on StatBroadcast.com and as always, Twitter updates will be available on Purdue basketball's official account (@BoilerBall).

► **ROAD WARRIORS:** Since the start of the 2007-08 season, Purdue owns a 43-43 (.500) record in "true" road games, having defeated Pittsburgh (72-59) and Wisconsin (61-55) in its lone road games this year. A win over Illinois would give Purdue a 2-0 record in Big Ten road games for the first time since the 2010-11 season and just the third time in the last 18 years (2010-11; 1999-00). Through Thursday's games, the Boilermakers are 1-of-14 teams nationally to be undefeated through two road games during the 2015-16 season.

► **NATION'S BEST DEFENSE:** Purdue has proven through the season's first two months to boast the nation's best defense, leading the country in field goal percentage defense (.350), while ranking seventh in scoring defense (59.8), ninth in rebound margin (+11.1), 12th in blocked shots per game (5.9) and 16th in 3-point percentage defense (.294). According to KenPom.com, Purdue leads the country in adjusted defensive efficiency (87.4), effective field goal percentage (.395) and 2-point percentage defense (.375). The school record for field goal percentage defense is 33.1 percent set way back in 1952-53, and the lowest since the 1986-87 season (shot clock era) is 39.1 percent in 2008-09.

► **BENCH PRODUCTION:** Purdue's bench production has been sensational this year, as the group has outscored the opposing bench by 341 points, an average of 21.3 points per game. The Boilermaker reserves are averaging 35.4 points per game while shooting 47.6 percent from the field and 37.2 percent from 3-point range. Already five times this year, Purdue's bench has outscored its starters, including in two of the three Big Ten games this year.

► **POLL POSITION:** The Boilermakers entered this week ranked No. 20 in the AP Top 25 poll. It marks the 317th week (ninth straight) that Purdue has been ranked in the AP poll and with its No. 9 ranking on Dec. 14, Purdue has been ranked in the top 10 in 116 weeks all-time.

► **RED-HOT HALF:** Purdue started very slow but finished with a flurry in its win over Michigan on Thursday night. The Boilermakers opened the game 3-of-15 (.200) from the field, but finished by making 27 of its last 39 shots (.692) and eight of its last 14 3-pointers (.571). Purdue then shot 76.2 percent in the second half, the 12th-best performance in a half in school history, the highest since Nov. 14, 1997, vs. LIU Brooklyn and the highest against a Big Ten opponent since Jan. 27, 1990, vs. Iowa. The Boilermakers were 9-of-11 from inside the 3-point line in the second half and one of the misses was an **A.J. Hammons** dunk attempt. Lastly, with Michigan still within 66-60 with 5:20 to play, Purdue scored on its last nine possessions.

► **YOUTHFUL EXPERIENCE:** Among Purdue's top 10 players (averaging 13.0 minutes or more), head coach **Matt Painter** has six freshmen or sophomores in the rotation. The result is the fifth-least experienced team in the Big Ten according to **Ken Pomeroy**, ranking ahead of Minnesota, Wisconsin, Rutgers and Ohio State in that order. Purdue's underclassmen have accounted for 64.7 percent of its scoring (818-of-1,264 points).

► **THE LAST GO-AROUND:** However, to go where Purdue wants to go this year it will need its seniors to play well. Over the last six games, Purdue's senior class has scored at least 30 points in four of them, including a season-high 43 points (14-of-24 FGs) in the win over Michigan. In the season's first 10 games, the group did not reach 30 points once (high was 29 points against New Mexico).

► **SERIES HISTORY:** One of the most-competitive series in the Big Ten, Purdue leads the series with Illinois by a 98-86 margin. The 184 meetings are the sixth most in Big Ten history. Purdue is 24-22 all-time at the State Farm Center having won five-of-nine meetings there during the Painter era. The margin in total points scored between the two teams is six points in 184 meetings (Purdue -10,530; Illinois -10,524), a difference of .03 points per game.

■ PURDUE BASKETBALL HISTORY

- Purdue is in its 118th season of basketball, owning a 1,726-988 (.636) all-time record. The Boilermakers rank 19th all-time in victories (1,726) and their 63.6 winning percentage is 20th all-time.
- Purdue has had just two head coaches, **Gene Keady** and **Matt Painter**, since the start of the 1980-81 season, a span of 35 years.
- Since the **Ray Eddy** era began in 1950, Purdue has had just six head coaches in 66 years and just eight head coaches in the last 99 years.

■ PAINTER MOVING UP THE CHARTS

- Matt Painter** has moved into third place on the school's career games coached list and will lead his squad into his 354th Purdue game against Illinois on Sunday.
- Painter owns a 226-127 (.640) record, the third-most wins for a head coach in school history.
- With the 14-2 start, Painter has moved into fifth place on the school's career winning percentage list with a .640 winning percentage.

- Following the resignation of **Bo Ryan** on Dec. 15, **Matt Painter** (age 45) is now the third-longest tenured coach in the Big Ten.
- Michigan State's **Tom Izzo** (21st year) and Ohio State's **Thad Matta** (12th year) are the only Big Ten coaches at their respective schools for a longer time than Painter.
- In just 10-plus years, Painter is one of 20 coaches in Big Ten history to record 100 career Big Ten wins. He is third among active coaches on the list.

■ SLOW STARTING IN BIG TEN PLAY

- Despite all the success Purdue has had, the Boilermakers typically start slow in Big Ten play.
- During the Painter era, Purdue has started 2-1 or better just five times in his 11 years at Purdue.
- Purdue has been 3-1 or better just three times in Painter's previous 10 seasons in charge at Purdue.

■ MATCHING HOT STARTS

- Purdue is now 14-2 through 16 games for just the third time in the last 20 years (2015-16, 2010-11, 2009-10).
- A win over Illinois on Sunday would give Purdue a 15-2 record for just the second time in the last 22 years (since 1993-94).
- Just two Purdue teams (1987-88, 1937-38) have started a season 18-2 after 20 games.

■ TURNOVERS THE KEY

- Purdue has had an issue with turnovers in both of its losses coming to Butler and Iowa. If the Boilermakers can solve those issues, a special season could be on the horizon.
- In its two losses, Purdue combined for 32 turnovers, which turned into 43 points. The Boilermakers were outscored in the "points off turnovers" category by 23 points. Purdue lost the two games by a combined 13 points.
- Meanwhile, Purdue ranks 146th nationally in turnovers per game (12.8), 294th in turnover margin (-2.13) and 329th in turnovers forced (10.6).

■ DEFENSE WITHOUT FOULING

- Purdue's defensive footprint has been man-to-man pressure all over the floor. However, that has changed this year as Purdue just plays solid, positional defense that forces teams to take long jumpers. The result is that Purdue has played defense this year without fouling.
- Purdue ranks 38th nationally in personal fouls per game, averaging just 17.0 fouls per game. During Big Ten play, the number has dropped to 14.0 fouls per game.
- Purdue has yet to have a player foul out this year and on just nine occasions has a player recorded four fouls in a game.
- For the first time in 50 games playing together, **Isaac Haas** and **A.J. Hammons** both had zero fouls in a game, doing so against Michigan.
- Last year's team averaged 18.9 fouls per game and recorded 15 disqualifications.

■ TIGHT IN BIG TEN ROAD GAMES

- Following its six-point win over Wisconsin, Purdue has played 12 straight Big Ten road games decided by 10 or fewer points, dating to a 19-point loss at Nebraska on Feb. 23, 2014.

■ 59 OR FEWER

- Purdue ranks seventh nationally in scoring defense (59.8 points per game) and has held 9-of-16 opponents to 59 or fewer points. Seven of the last 11 opponents (Youngstown State, Butler, Iowa, Michigan) have been held to 59 or fewer points.

■ DEFENSIVE SCHOOL RECORDS IN SIGHT

- Since the 1951-52 season, the school record for defensive scoring average is 59.8 points per game set during the 2008-09 season. This year's team is holding foes to 58.4 points per game.
- With Purdue holding foes to 34.8 percent shooting, Purdue is on pace to record the lowest field goal percentage defense since the 1952-53 season (.330) and the second-lowest number in school history. The best mark since the 1986-87 season (shot clock era) is 39.1 percent during the 2008-09 season.

■ THE LEADER IN DEFENSIVE EFFICIENCY

- Purdue currently leads the country in in adjusted defensive efficiency (points allowed per 100 possessions) at 87.4. Valparaiso is second at 89.2.

■ DEFENSE LIVES HERE

- Purdue has returned to its roots in bolting out to a 14-2 start and a top-20 national ranking, winning with impressive defensive efforts, likely staking claim to being the top-defensive team in America.
- According to **Ken Pomeroy**, Purdue leads the country in effective field goal percentage (.395) and 2-point field goal percentage defense (.375).
- In the NCAA ranks, Purdue is the only school in the country to rank in the top 20 of four major defensive categories (FG percentage defense, scoring defense, rebound margin and 3-point percentage defense). In fact, Purdue ranks in the top 16 of all categories.
- Purdue leads the country in field goal percentage defense at 35.0 percent. Michigan State is second at 35.8 percent.

• Purdue saw its 15-game home winning streak come to an end on Saturday against Iowa. It marked Purdue's first loss since a 69-60 setback to Maryland on Jan. 10, 2015.

• Since the start of last year, Purdue is now 24-4 at home and its 15-game winning streak was the 15th-longest streak in the country.

• **Matt Painter** now owns five double-digit homecourt winning streaks in his 11 years at Purdue.

• With a pair of Sweet 16 appearances, six NCAA Tournament berths, Big Ten regular-season and tournament titles and an international gold medal on his résumé, 11th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest minds in all of college basketball.

• Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in March of 2011, agreeing to a new eight-year contract that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2018-19 season.

• Painter has averaged over 21 wins per season during his tenure at the helm of the Purdue program, including at least 20 victories in six of those seasons.

• Painter's tenure has seen Purdue basketball restore its status among the upper echelon of college basketball programs. The last eight years have seen six 20-win seasons and NCAA Tournament berths, two Sweet 16 appearances, a regular-season Big Ten title and a Big Ten Tournament crown.

• The three winningest classes in program history are the classes of 2011, 2012 and 2010, respectively, and five of the 10 winningest individual players Purdue has ever seen have come from the Painter ranks. Success, however, didn't happen overnight.

• Painter officially became the 18th head men's basketball coach in Purdue history on April 1, 2005, and immediately set about laying the groundwork for a dramatic reversal in the program's fortunes.

• The Boilermakers were at their best during the 2009 postseason run, rattling off double-digit victories over Penn State and Illinois to reach the Big Ten Tournament final, where they dispatched Ohio State, 65-61, to earn the first conference tournament crown in program history.

• Painter has also resurrected Mackey Arena as one of the country's best home-court advantages, piling up a 147-32 (.821) record at home over the last 11 seasons, including a remarkable 82-7 (.921) record against non-conference opponents.

• Painter has been named Big Ten Coach of the Year three times in the last six seasons, earning the consensus award in 2008 and 2011, and winning the coaches' vote in 2010. He is one of only six men to win the award more at least three times since its inception in 1974.

• Painter has seen a total of 21 players earn a combined 40 Academic All-Big Ten honors during his tenure as head coach. Painter has also mentored an Academic All-American, as Moore earned second-team honors during the 2009-10 season.
