GAME 08: The Facts

• Purdue looks for just its fourth 8-0 start or better in school history on Saturday when traditional power New Mexico visits West Lafayette for the second meeting all-time between the two schools.

• The contest will be televised from Mackey Arena on the Big Ten Network at 2:15 p.m., with **Jeff Levering** and **Stephanie White** calling the action courtside.

• On the radio waves, **Larry Clisby**, **Rob Blackman** and **Ralph Taylor** will handle the call on the 27-station Purdue Sports Network. Coverage begins with the Purdue Basketball pregame show one hour before tip.

• Live stats will be available via Gametracker on PurdueSports.com. As always, Twitter updates will be provided on the official Purdue basketball account, @BoilerBall.

Scouting Purdue

• The No. 11-ranked Boilermakers won their seventh straight game to start the season and their seventh straight game in the B1G / ACC Challenge on Tuesday night, topping Pittsburgh 72-59 at the Petersen Events Center.

• The victory dropped Pittsburgh to 121-5 against non-conference foes in its home facility.

• **A.J. Hammons** recorded a double-double with 24 points and 12 rebounds and **Ryan Cline** made four second-half 3-pointers in a six-minute span to break open a tight game.

• Sophomore center **Isaac Haas** continues to lead the Boilermakers, averaging 13.7 points and 5.9 rebounds per game. Hammons follows at 12.2 points and 7.6 rebounds per game. **Rapheal Davis** (11.6) and **Vince Edwards** (10.3) also score in double figures.

• Purdue is outscoring foes by 25.1 points per game (82.7 to 57.6).

Scouting New Mexico

• Traditionally one of the top teams in the West, New Mexico enters Saturday's game with a 5-1 record and boasting an impressive three-headed attack at the top of the lineup.

• **Tim Williams** (17.5), Butler transfer **Elijah Brown** (17.3) and **Cullen Neal** (17.0) have combined to score 311 of the team's 492 points, accounting for 63.2 percent of the Lobos' scoring.

• New Mexico is shooting 48.0 percent from the field, 35.5 percent from 3-point range and 74.4 percent from the free throw line.

• The Lobos are outrebounding foes by 6.7 boards per game and average 12.8 turnovers per game.

The Coaches

• **Matt Painter** (Purdue, 1994) is in his 11th year at Purdue, owning a 219-125 record. Painter is one of six coaches in Big Ten history to win three Big Ten Coach of the Year awards and his 219 wins are the third most by a Purdue coach in school history.

• **Craig Neal** (Georgia Tech, 1987) is in his third year at New Mexico, owning a 47-24 record overall. He spent six seasons on **Steve Alford's** staff at UNM, before being elevated after Alford left for UCLA.

■ Painter Moving Up the Charts

• **Matt Painter** has moved into third place on the school's career games coached list, leading his squad into his 345th game in his 11th season on Saturday against New Mexico.

• Painter owns a 219-125 (.636) record, the third-most wins for a head coach in school history.

• With the 7-0 start, Painter has moved into fifth place on the school's career winning percentage list with a .636 winning percentage.

• Since the **Ray Eddy** era began in 1950, Purdue has had just six head coaches in 66 years, and just eight head coaches in the last 99 years.

■ Success in the Challenge

• Purdue has had tremendous success in the Big Ten / ACC Challenge, posting a 9-6 record after Tuesday's 72-59 win over Pittsburgh. It's the best mark of any team in the Big Ten excluding Maryland, which was 10-5 as a member of the ACC and is now 10-7 overall.

• The Boilermakers are 8-3 under **Matt Painter** in Big Ten / ACC Challenge games and are 3-4 on the road in the event.

■ Gameday Adjustments

• Last year, Purdue went 0-4 when being outscored in the paint. Already twice this year, Purdue has won three games when being outscored in the paint (Vermont, Florida, Pittsburgh).

■ Quick Starts Are the Key

• Since the 1950-51 season, Purdue has started 7-0 or better six times, including this season. In the previous five years that Purdue started 7-0 or better, the Boilermakers combined to post a 123-33 record (.788).
• In two of the seasons that Purdue started at least 7-0, that team set a school record for victories with 29 (1993-94, 2009-10).

• Purdue has now started 7-0 or better twice of **Matt Painter's** 11 seasons at Purdue.

• The Boilermakers have started 8-0 or better just three times in school history (1992-93, 1993-94, 2009-10).

■ Winning Margins

• Through games played on Thursday among teams that have played at least six games, Purdue and Villanova are the only teams in America to have won all of its games by 13 points or more.

• Through Thursday, Purdue joins Michigan State (8-0), Northern Illinois (7-0), South Carolina (7-0), Villanova (7-0) and Xavier (7-0) as teams with perfect marks through seven games.

■ Boilermakers Hot at Home

• Purdue enters Saturday's game against New Mexico having won 10 straight games at Mackey Arena. Purdue has won the 10 straight games by a combined 171 points (17.1 PPG).

• With nine non-conference home games on the slate, an undefeated non-conference schedule will give Purdue 15 straight home wins, which would tie for the sixth-longest home winning streak in Mackey Arena history.

• **Matt Painter** now owns five double-digit homecourt winning streaks in his 11 years at Purdue.

■ Win When Shooting More

• Purdue has won 23 straight games when shooting more free throws than its opponent, including four times this year.

■ Defense Lives Here

• Purdue ranks first nationally in field goal percentage and that comes even without the Big Ten's top defensive player in **Rapheal Davis** being in the lineup in each of the last two games.

• Purdue is also second in the country in 2-point percentage defense (.358) and fifth in the country in 3-point percentage defense (.244). Purdue and Oklahoma are the only teams in America to rank in the top 10 of both 2-point and 3-point percentage defense.

• Purdue has held four of its opponents under 30.0 percent shooting and in the first half, and four opponents have been held under 25.0 percent shooting from the field.

• Purdue is eighth in country in scoring defense (57.6), holding three of its foes to 55 points or less.

• In 2,367 games this year played by Division I teams (through Thursday), there have been seven games where a Division I team held another Division I team to 40 or fewer points. Purdue has done it twice.

■ The Word According to Ken Pomeroy

- We here at Purdue like to follow statistician **Ken Pomeroy** and his numbers paint a pretty picture for the Boilermakers.
- Purdue ranks 11th in adjusted offensive efficiency (113.8 / 100 possessions) and fourth in adjusted defensive efficiency (91.1).
- Purdue's effective field goal percentage defense is first nationally (36.1 percent). Oklahoma is second (37.5) and Vanderbilt is third (38.1).
- The teams listed in the top 15 of both categories are a who's-who of college basketball this season.

■ Large Margins

- The 28-point halftime lead (44-16) against North Carolina A&T was tied for the 16th-largest margin in school history.
- The 41-point victory (81-40) against North Carolina A&T was tied for the 15th-largest margin of victory in Mackey Arena history.
- Purdue has won its first seven games by 13 or more points for the first time in school history.

■ Sizzling From 20 Feet, 9 Inches

- A year after shooting just 32.7 percent from 3-point range and with many questions entering the season about perimeter play, Purdue has quieted those discussions at least for now.
- The Boilermakers connected on a school-record 18 3-pointers in the win over Vermont on November 15, one game after making 12 in the season opener against North Carolina A&T.
- The Boilermakers are shooting 39.2 percent (71-of-181) from 3-point range to rank 52nd nationally, one year after ranking 239th.
- In addition, Purdue ranks 22nd nationally in 3-pointers per game, making 10.1 trifectas per game.
- Seven different players have made at least two 3-pointers in a game this year (Cline, Davis, Edwards, Mathias, Stephens, Swanigan, Thompson). Four different players (Cline, Edwards, Mathias, Stephens) have made at least four trifectas in a game this year.
- Purdue has made at least 10 3-pointers in four games this year. The school record for most games with at least 10 3-pointers in a season was in 2011-12 (10 in 35 games).
- Purdue has outscored its foes by 114 points from beyond the arc.

■ Gimme All The Points

- Purdue is averaging 1.18 points per possession to rank 17th nationally, while defensively, the Boilermakers are allowing just 0.79 points per possession to rank second nationally.
- Purdue is one of five teams (Purdue, Louisville, West Virginia, Baylor, Vanderbilt) to rank in the top 20 nationally in points per possession on both sides of the ball.

■ Before the Calendar Turns

- With Saturday's win over Lehigh concluding the month of November, **Matt Painter** is now 37-1 (.974) at home during the month. The lone loss was on Nov. 9, 2012, to Bucknell (70-65).
- In December, Purdue is 36-5 (.878) at home under Coach Painter against non-conference opponents.
- Including December, the Boilermakers are 106-34 (.757) under **Matt Painter** before the calendar turns, including 73-6 (.924) against non-conference foes at home.

■ Notes From the Lead

- Purdue has trailed in just four of its seven games this year and for a grand total of 8 minutes, 44 seconds. Over the last six games (240 minutes), Purdue has trailed for a total of 3 minutes, 3 seconds.
- Purdue's largest deficit of the season has been four points, which came when North Carolina A&T took a 4-0 lead two minutes into the season opener.
- When the Boilermakers trailed Pittsburgh for 47 seconds in the second half on Tuesday night, it marked the first time all season Purdue trailed in the second half.

■ Purdue Shows off Its Depth

- In Tuesday's win over Pittsburgh, the Boilermakers' bench erupted for 44 of the team's 72 points.
- For the season, Purdue has outscored the opposition 249-104 for the season, an average of 20.7 points per game.
- Purdue's bench has played 43.5 percent of its minutes, a number that ranks sixth nationally, and first among power-conference schools (Vanderbilt is next at 41.3 percent).

■ Better From the Line

- After starting the season 38-of-59 (.644) from the free throw line in the first two games, Purdue has turned it around at the charity stripe.
- The Boilermakers are 76-of-97 (.784) from the free throw line during the last five games.
- Opponents have shot 116 free throws on the season, while Purdue has made 114 free throws.
- Purdue ranks 70th nationally in free throw percentage, a significant improvement over the last four years where the Boilermakers ranked 275th (2012), 291st (2013), 261st (2014) and 213th (2015).

■ Hammons Flexes Muscles, Inside and Out

- **A.J. Hammons** had a monster game off the bench with 24 points and 12 rebounds in Tuesday's win over Pittsburgh, giving the Boilermakers an incredible two-headed monster at the center position.
- Hammons now has 16 career double-doubles, good for 15th on the career list (tied with **George Faerber**; 1969-71).
- Hammons' double-doubles have come against an impressive list of teams, 13 of which have come against Big Ten opposition and 15 against power-conference schools.

■ The Swiss Army Knife

- **Vince Edwards** has done a little bit of everything for Purdue this year.
- Edwards is fourth on the team in scoring (10.3 PPG), fourth in rebounding (5.4), first in assists (26), third in blocks (4), fourth in 3-pointers made (10) and fourth in field goal percentage (.542).
- Edwards narrowly missed the school's first triple double in almost 40 years (Joe Barry Carroll vs. Arizona; Dec. 10, 1977) with nine points, 10 rebounds and seven assists against Lehigh last Saturday night.
- Over the last three games, Edwards is averaging 10.7 points, 5.7 rebounds and 5.3 assists against just two turnovers. He is shooting 12-of-21 (.571) from the floor and 4-of-10 (.400) from 3-point range in that span.

• With a pair of Sweet 16 appearances, six NCAA Tournament berths, Big Ten regular-season and tournament titles and an international gold medal on his résumé, 11th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest minds in all of college basketball.

• Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in March of 2011, agreeing to a new eight-year contract that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2018-19 season.

• Painter has averaged over 21 wins per season during his tenure at the helm of the Purdue program, including at least 20 victories in six of those seasons.

• Painter's tenure has seen Purdue basketball restore its status among the upper echelon of college basketball programs. The last eight years have seen six 20-win seasons and NCAA Tournament berths, two Sweet 16 appearances, a regular-season Big Ten title and a Big Ten Tournament crown.

• The three winningest classes in program history are the classes of 2011, 2012 and 2010, respectively, and five of the 10 winningest individual players Purdue has ever seen have come from the Painter ranks. Success, however, didn't happen overnight.

• Painter officially became the 18th head men's basketball coach in Purdue history on April 1, 2005, and immediately set about laying the groundwork for a dramatic reversal in the program's fortunes.

• The Boilermakers were at their best during the 2009 postseason run, rattling off double-digit victories over Penn State and Illinois to reach the Big Ten Tournament final, where they dispatched Ohio State, 65-61, to earn the first conference tournament crown in program history.

• Painter has also resurrected Mackey Arena as one of the country's best home-court advantages, piling up a 141-31 (.820) record at home over the last nine seasons, including a remarkable 77-7 (.917) record against non-conference opponents.

• Painter has been named Big Ten Coach of the Year three times in the last six seasons, earning the consensus award in 2008 and 2011, and winning the coaches' vote in 2010. He is one of only six men to win the award more at least three times since its inception in 1974.

• Painter has seen a total of 21 players earn a combined 40 Academic All-Big Ten honors during his tenure as head coach. Painter has also mentored an Academic All-American, as Moore earned second-team honors during the 2009-10 season.
