THE SCENE SETTER BETWEEN THE BOILERMAKERS AND THE SCARLET KNIGHTS

- The Purdue men's basketball team returns home to see the Paint Crew for the first time since Dec. 6, when it hosts Rutgers on Tuesday. It begins a two-game homestand, the Boilermakers' second-to-last multiple-game homestand of the season.
- The contest will be televised on BTN with **Dave Revsine** and **Robbie Hummel** calling the action courtside, while on the radio waves, the contest will be available on the Purdue Radio Network and Tuneln.com with **Larry Clisby**, **Rob Blackman** and **Ralph Taylor** on the call, beginning with the Purdue Basketball pregame show at 6 p.m.
- Live stats will be provided on PurdueSports.com, and Twitter updates will be available on Purdue's official account (@BoilerBall).

THE MAIN TALKING POINTS

- 1) Purdue won its first road game of the season on Friday, defeating Wisconsin 84-80 in overtime. According to the NET rankings at the time of game, the win is the fourth-best road win of the season nationally.
- 2) Purdue has played the second-most difficult schedule in America, according to KenPom, having played eight top-40 foes.
- 3) Purdue is looking to start 4-2 in Big Ten play for the fourth straight year.
- 4) Purdue has scored at least 80 points in four of its last six games, averaging 79.5 points per game during that span.
- 5) Purdue continues to excel on the offensive end, ranking fifth nationally in offensive efficiency. Purdue and Duke are the only teams to rank in the top 10 in offensive efficiency in 2017-18 and 2018-19. Purdue finished last year second behind Villanova.
- 6) Under **Matt Painter**, Purdue has been one of the best offensive teams in America. The Boilermakers have ranked in the nation's top 25 in offensive efficiency in six of the last nine seasons (lone years not in top 25: 2014-15, 2013-14, 2012-13).
- 7) Purdue has had seven straight games of posting 10 or fewer turnovers in a game, the first time in school history that has happened. Over the last seven games, Purdue owns a turnover margin of +4.86 and an assist / turnover ratio of 1.74 (101 / 58).
- 8) Over the last two games (both on the road), Purdue is just 29 of 52 (.558) from the free throw line. Purdue shoots 80.0 percent in Mackey Arena.
- 9) **Carsen Edwards** ranks fifth nationally in scoring (25.3 PPG). Since the 1992-93 season, just two other Big Ten players (Purdue's **Glenn Robinson** 2x, Michigan State's **Shawn Respert** 2x) have averaged at least 24.0 points per game in a season.
- 10) vs. Wisconsin, **Trevion Williams** became the first Purdue player since **JaJuan Johnson** (Nov. 21, 2010) to lead Purdue in rebounds, assists, steals and blocks. Over the last six games, he has 45 points, 39 rebounds, eight assists and six steals in 81 minutes (22.2 pts & 19.3 rebs per 40 minutes).

- Purdue owns an 11-1 record against the Scarlet Knights, including a 7-0 record during the Big Ten era.
- Of Purdue's seven wins during the Big Ten era, four of them have come by at least 10 points.
- Purdue's last two wins in Mackey Arena against Rutgers have come by a combined 50 points.

ONE OF THE NATION'S TOUGHEST SCHEDULES

- Purdue has played one of the nation's most-difficult schedules to date and could rise even higher thanks to the Big Ten slate.
- According to KenPom, Purdue's schedule currently ranks as the second-hardest nationally behind Kansas.
- In Big Ten play only, Purdue will face a team that was ranked at the time of the game or ranked in the Dec. 31, poll in eight of its first nine league games.
- Purdue has played 12 teams ranked in the KenPom top 100, matching Illinois and Oklahoma for the most top-100 foes in the country.
- The strength of schedule has helped Purdue to a No. 18 NET rating. The next closest six-loss team is Butler (10-7; 46th).
- During the Painter era, the highest that a schedule has ever been ranked (KenPom) is eighth in 2012; the lowest in 2008 (62nd).

BRUTAL SCHEDULE TO START THE BIG TEN

- Purdue easily owns the Big Ten's toughest schedule in conference play to date and the records bear that out.
- Taking out the Purdue results, Purdue's first five games of Big Ten play have come to teams with a combined record of 21-3.
- Purdue's two losses have come on the road to teams (Michigan, Michigan State) that own a 12-0 Big Ten record (10-0 without Purdue wins) and a 32-2 (30-2) overall mark.
- Purdue's three wins have come to teams with a 11-6 Big Ten record (11-3 without Purdue losses) and a combined 39-11 (39-8) record.

EFFICIENT OFFENSE

- After ranking No. 2 in last year's offensive efficiency ratings via KenPom.com, Purdue has picked up where it left off last year, ranking fifth midway through this season.
- Purdue is one of five teams to rank in the top 25 of the offensive efficiency ratings in each year since 2015-16.

BOILERS TAKING CARE OF THE BALL

- Purdue has taken care of the ball this year, averaging just 10.9 turnovers per game, which would rank as the fourth-lowest average in school history.
- However, over the last seven games, Purdue is averaging just 8.3 turnovers per game, while boasting an assist/turnover ratio of 1.74.
- Purdue is 23rd nationally in turnover percentage (16.0 percent) and 22nd nationally in turnovers per game (10.9).

SHOOTING WINS

- Purdue is 140-15 under Painter when over 48.0 percent shooting, including 4-1 this season. The lone loss came to Virginia Tech (50.8 percent). It was Purdue's first loss when shooting 48-plus percent from the field since a Feb. 2017, loss to Michigan, a streak of 27 straight victories.

NO SUCH THING AS PURE MICHIGAN

- The two Michigan schools have not been kind to Purdue this season and even further back. The Boilermakers have lost four straight games to Michigan and Michigan State.
- Since Feb. 1, 2018, Purdue is 0-4 against the Michigan schools, but 18-7 against all other schools.
- It should be noted that none of the four games vs. the Michigan schools were played in Mackey Arena (three on road; one neutral).

THE EXTRA POSSESSION GAME

- During the Painter era, Purdue is 107-9 when committing fewer turnovers and outrebounding its opponents in the same game.
- Since the start of the 2014-15 season, Purdue is 24-4 when that happens, having won 24 of its last 25 games when doing so (lone loss: Notre Dame).

THE LIMIT IS 60

- Purdue is 135-5 when under Painter when holding foes to 59 or fewer points. Three of the five losses came during the 2012-13 season.

ROAD WARRIORS

- Since the start of the 2007-08 season, Purdue owns a 61-57 record, the third-most wins in the Big Ten during that span. Only four teams (Wisconsin, Michigan State, Ohio State, Purdue) have even won at least 40.0 percent of their road games during that span (not counting Maryland).
- Over the last 12 years, there have been just 10, 8-win road seasons by all the teams in the Big Ten (MSU - 3; Wisc. - 3; Purdue - 2; OSU - 1; Md. - 1).

HEAD COACH MATT PAINTER

► **Record at Purdue:** 305-155 (.663) / 14th year | **Career Record:** 330-160 (.673) / 15th year

- With four Sweet 16 appearances, 10 NCAA Tournament berths, two Big Ten regular-season championships, a Big Ten Tournament title and an international gold medal on his résumé, 14th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest young minds in all of college basketball.
- Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in October of 2018, agreeing to a two-year extension that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2023-24 season. The deal features five, one-year extensions that go into effect through the 2028-29 season. Following the 2029 season, Painter will still only be 58 years old.
- Painter entered the 2018-19 season third on the school's all-time wins list (295) behind legendary mentors, Gene Keady and Ward "Piggy" Lambert, both of whom have been inducted into the College Basketball Hall of Fame.
- Has averaged almost 23 wins a season in his 13 years at Purdue. If you don't include the first transitional year, the average balloons to 23.8 wins per year over the last 12 seasons.
- Has won at least 25 games in eight of his 14 seasons as a collegiate head coach.
- Painter's three Big Ten Coach of the Year honors are the fourth most in league history (Gene Keady - 7; Bobby Knight - 5; Bo Ryan - 4).
- Painter has averaged 10.9 wins per year in conference play, the fifth-best average in Big Ten Conference history.
- Is one of just three active coaches to have won a Big Ten championship.
- Painter's 10 NCAA Tournaments in the last 12 years are the ninth most in the country.
