THE OPENING TIP

- The No. 6-ranked Purdue Boilermakers look for a key Big Ten road win Thursday night when it visits Iowa to complete the home-and-home series with the Hawkeyes. It marks the first Big Ten opponent this season that Purdue will finish the series with and the Boilermakers are looking for the season sweep for the second time in three years after defeating Iowa 77-70 (without Keegan Murray) in early December.
- Purdue enters with a 16-3 mark, while Iowa is 14-5 overall. The Boilermakers are one game out of first in the loss column in the Big Ten race.
- The contest will be televised on FS1 with Kevin Kugler and Nick Bahe on the call. On the radio waves, Rob Blackman and Bobby Riddell will be courtside on the 22-station Purdue Radio Network and online on the Varsity Sports Network (app). Live stats will be provided on StatBroadcast.com and updates will be provided on Purdue's official Twitter account (@BoilerBall).

THE NOTES TO KNOW

- A win would give Matt Painter and Purdue his fourth 20-game start of 17-3 or better (2017-18, 2010-11, 2009-10), and the eighth since the 1979-80 season (also in 1986-87, 1987-88, 1989-90, 1993-94).
- With the win over Northwestern, Matt Painter tied Ward Lambert for second place on the Purdue career victories list, and fifth on the Big Ten list with 371 victories. Gene Keady is third on the Big Ten list (512), while Lou Henson (421) is fourth.
- Since Feb. 1, of last season, Purdue is the only team nationally without a double-digit loss. Purdue's six losses since Feb. 1, of last year have come by 1, 3, 9 (ot), 9 (ot), 2 and 5 points.
- Purdue has scored 90 or more points in nine games this season, the most in country (Gonzaga - 8).
- Purdue's seven wins by 25 or more points are tied for the third most in the country and the most in the Big Ten (Gonzaga, Kentucky - 10).
- Purdue's bench has scored at least 25 points in 16-of-19 games this season (Indiana State, Villanova, Indiana). It is outscoring the opposing bench by a 577-317 (30.4 to 16.7 per game) margin.
- Purdue leads the country in offensive efficiency (124.1) and has been held under 1.00 points / possession just once (Indiana - 0.98).
- Purdue has trailed by double-digits in just three games this year (Villanova, North Carolina State, Indiana) and won two of them.
- Zach Edey, Jaden Ivey and Trevion Williams were named to the Wooden Award midseason watch list. Purdue was the only school with three players named (Duke, Gonzaga, UCLA had two).

THE SERIES

- Friday's game marks the 171st all-time meeting between Purdue and Iowa, with the Boilermakers owning a 93-77 series advantage.
- Purdue has won two of the last three games against Iowa at Carver-Hawkeye Arena, including an 87-64 decision in 2018, in which Purdue set a Big Ten record with 20 3-pointers.
- Purdue has scored at least 70 points in eight of the last nine meetings. Purdue is unbeaten this year when scoring at least 70 points.
- In each of the last 13 meetings (including Thursday), at least one team has been ranked in the top 25 at the time of the meeting.

STREAKING IN THE TOP 10

- Purdue fell to No. 6 in the AP Top 25 poll released Monday, marking Purdue's 12th straight week of being ranked in the top seven.
- The 12-week stretch of being ranked in the top 10 is the second-longest streak in school history and the longest in over 30 years.
- Purdue, Gonzaga, UCLA, Baylor and Duke have all been ranked in the top 10 of every poll this season, with Purdue, Gonzaga and UCLA being in the top seven of every poll.

- Purdue will enter next season having won 14 straight games at Mackey Arena against non-conference opposition.
- With the Paint Crew in attendance, Purdue is 78-8 at Mackey Arena since the 2014-15 season.

- Purdue has won 49 straight games when shooting at least 50.0 percent from the field, 40.0 percent from 3-point range and 72.0 percent from the free throw line, last losing to Illinois on March 3, 2004 (81-79; ot).
- Coach Painter's teams at Purdue are 46-0 when reaching the three shooting levels.

HEAD COACH MATT PAINTER

- **Record at Purdue:** 371-187 (.665) / 17th year | **Career Record:** 396-192 (.673) / 18th year
- With five Sweet 16 appearances, 12 NCAA Tournament berths, three Big Ten regular-season championships, a Big Ten Tournament title, an Elite Eight and an international gold medal on his résumé, 17th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest young minds in all of college basketball.
 - He was voted by his peers as the NABC National Coach of the Year after leading a team that started with a 6-5 record to the 2019 Elite Eight.
 - Painter was named the 2019 Big Ten Coach of the Year and has led Purdue to six straight NCAA Tournaments – the seventh-longest active streak in America. Included in that stretch are Sweet 16 appearances (and beyond) in three of the last four tournaments.
 - Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in October of 2018, agreeing to a two-year extension that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2023-24 season. The deal features five, one-year extensions that go into effect through the 2028-29 season. Following the 2029 season, Painter will still only be 58 years old.
 - Painter enters the 2021-22 season third on the school's all-time wins list (355) behind legendary mentors, Gene Keady and Ward "Piggy" Lambert, both of whom have been inducted into the College Basketball Hall of Fame.
 - Has averaged almost 23 wins a season in his 16 years at Purdue. If you don't include the first transitional year (9-19 record), the average balloons to 24.0 wins per year over the last 15 seasons.
 - Has won at least 25 games in nine of his 17 seasons as a collegiate head coach.
 - Painter's four Big Ten Coach of the Year honors are the third most in league history (**Gene Keady - 7; Bobby Knight - 5; Bo Ryan - 4**).
 - Painter has averaged 11.3 wins per year in conference play, the fifth-best average in Big Ten Conference history.
 - Painter's 12 NCAA Tournament appearances in the last 14 events are the eighth most in the country.
 - Coach Painter's 13 NCAA Tournaments are the most for a coach nationally under the age of 55 (as of April 1, 2022 – Painter is 51 years old).
 - Purdue has finished first or second in Big Ten play in seven of Painter's last 14 years.
 - Has had 68 Academic All-Big Ten honorees in his 16 previous years at Purdue.
 - Lastly, the five winningest classes in school history have come during the Painter era (2019, 2018, 2012, 2011, 2010).
