

BOILERMAKER NOTES

- Purdue will be competing in its first Elite Eight since 2000 and looking for its first Final Four since 1980. Purdue made the Elite Eight in 1994 and 2000, losing those chances to make the Final Four in those years.
- Purdue's road to the regional final has been strictly chalk (Seeds: 14, 6, 2, 1).
- Purdue's 99 points vs. Tennessee were the most in an NCAA Tournament game since March 19, 1988, a 100-73 win over Memphis.
- Purdue is 20-4 in its last 24 games since Dec. 16, falling to Michigan State, Maryland and Minnesota twice.
- Purdue is 3-0 in overtime games this year, outscoring opponents 41-23 in the extra session.
- Purdue is now one of six teams to win at least 26 games in each of the last four seasons (Villanova, Kansas, North Carolina, Gonzaga, Kentucky, Purdue).
- Purdue became the first team in NCAA Tournament history with 15+ 3-pointers in consecutive games. The Boilermakers made 16 vs. Villanova and 15 vs. Tennessee.
- Purdue is 31-of-61 from 3-point range in the last two games and 40-of-91 (.440) from 3-point range in the NCAA Tournament.
- Purdue's senior class continues to set the school record for most wins by a senior class, now with 109. Previous record was 107 by Class of 2011.
- But now Purdue's junior class has 83 wins, tying the 3-year span of 2016-17-18 for the most wins in a three-year span in school history.
- Purdue's sophomores own a 56-16 record, needing one win to tie the school record for most victories in a two-year span (57 in 2017-18).
- Purdue has won 98 straight games when scoring at least 90 points, dating to Nov. 24, 1987, a 104-96 loss to Iowa State.
- Purdue has trailed for a total of 8 minutes and 22 seconds during this year's NCAA Tournament, out of a total of 125 minutes.
- Purdue is 2-0 this year when allowing teams to score 90 points (90 vs. Penn State, 94 vs. Tennessee). Purdue was 1-9 under Painter before this year when allowing 90 or more points.
- Purdue is now 7-1 when foes have just 0-9 turnovers. Purdue is 19-8 when foes have 10 or more turnovers.
- Purdue is 10-2 this year and has won nine straight games when committing MORE turnovers than its opponent.
- Purdue has won eight straight games on games played on Saturday.
- Purdue is 20-0 this year and has won 26 straight games when shooting better than its opponent.
- Purdue is 17-2 when attempting more free throws than its opponent.
- The 27 3-pointers (15 by Purdue; 12 by Tennessee) were the most combined 3-pointers in a regional round game.
- **Ryan Cline** made his last eight shots of the game, scoring 22 points in the second half and overtime, en route to a career-high 27 points on 10-of-13 shooting and 7-of-10 from 3-point range.
- **Carsen Edwards** and **Ryan Cline** combined for 56 points, the most by a Purdue duo in an NCAA Tournament game since Glenn Robinson and Cuonzo Martin combined for 73 points in a win over Kansas in 1994.
- Purdue is 0-3 against the ACC this year, falling to Virginia Tech (89-83), Florida State (73-72) and Notre Dame (88-80).
- **Aaron Wheeler** is 7-of-9 from the field and 4-of-5 from 3-point range in the NCAA Tournament, scoring 18 points in 31 NCAA Tournament minutes.
- **Eric Hunter Jr.**, has eight assists against one turnover in 57 minutes during the NCAA Tournament this year.
- **Carsen Edwards** has sat for a total of 38 seconds during this year's NCAA Tournament (last 38 seconds vs. Villanova).
- **Carsen Edwards** became the first player since Steph Curry in 2008 to score at least 25 points in four straight NCAA Tournament games (30 vs. Texas Tech last year; 26 vs. Old Dominion, 42 vs. Villanova, 29 vs. Tennessee).
- **Carsen Edwards** became Purdue's all-time leading scorer in NCAA Tournament play with 182 points in nine games. He passed JaJuan Johnson, Brian Cardinal and Joe Barry Carroll on the list (161 points).
- **Carsen Edwards** set the Big Ten record for most 3-pointers in a season (125), surpassing Penn State's Shep Garner (120 in 2018).
- **Carsen Edwards** is the NCAA Tournament's leading scorer this year with 97 points in three games.
- **Carsen Edwards** last four NCAA Tournament games by points: 30 vs. Texas Tech, 26 vs. Old Dominion; 42 vs. Villanova; 29 vs. Tennessee. He is averaging 31.8 points per game during that span.
- **Carsen Edwards'** 26, 20-point games are the fifth most nationally.
- **Carsen Edwards** (125) and **Ryan Cline** (109) have combined for 234 3-pointers, the second most by a duo nationally.
- **Carsen Edwards** needs 22 points for 1,900 in his career.
- **Ryan Cline** is averaging 14.7 points and 4.0 assists per game in the NCAA Tournament. Cline is 11-of-18 (.611) from long distance in the last two games.
- **Ryan Cline** has 22 assists vs. two turnovers in the last five games (165 minutes played).
- **Ryan Cline** is Purdue's all-time leader in career assist / turnover ratio (278 assists / 94 turnovers; 2.97 ratio).
- **Ryan Cline** has 15 games this year of four or more 3-pointers (12-3 record; eight straight wins).
- In two career games at the KFCYum! Center, **Ryan Cline** is 10-of-13 from 3-point range. He made four 3-pointers in the final five minutes against Tennessee, all of them pulled Purdue out of a deficit.
- **Ryan Cline** has scored 36 points in 52 minutes in two games at the KFC Yum! Center.
- Purdue is 10-2 this year when **Nojel Eastern** scores in double figures. The Boilermakers are 10-1 when Eastern has at least 10 points and five rebounds in the same game.
- **Grady Eifert** leads the country in offensive rating (144.6 -- we don't know how it is calculated).
- **Grady Eifert** is averaging 6.0 PPG, 8.0 RPG, 3.0 APG in the last two NCAA Tournament games.
- **Matt Haarms** is averaging 13.8 PPG, 5.8 RPG, 2.0 BPG and 1.6 APG in the last five games, shooting 30-of-43 (.698) from the field during that span.
- **Matt Haarms** has blocked a shot in 23 straight games, now with 71 blocked shots on the season.
- When **Matt Haarms** scores in double figures this season, Purdue is 17-2 with losses to Texas and Minnesota (Big Ten Tournament).

FOUR TIMES SWEET 16

- Purdue is one of four schools nationally to advance to three straight Sweet 16s, joining Kentucky, Gonzaga and Michigan on the list.

HEAD COACH MATT PAINTER

- **Record at Purdue:** 321-158 (.670) / 14th year | **Career Record:** 346-163 (.680) / 15th year
- With five Sweet 16 appearances, 11 NCAA Tournament berths, three Big Ten regular-season championships, a Big Ten Tournament title and an international gold medal on his résumé, 14th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest young minds in all of college basketball.
- Painter was named the 2019 Big Ten Coach of the Year and has led Purdue to three straight Sweet 16 appearances. Painter was one of seven semifinalists for the Naismith National Coach of the Year.
- Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in October of 2018, agreeing to a two-year extension that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2023-24 season. The deal features five, one-year extensions that go into effect through the 2028-29 season. Following the 2029 season, Painter will still only be 58 years old.
- Painter entered the 2018-19 season third on the school's all-time wins list (295) behind legendary mentors, Gene Keady and Ward "Piggy" Lambert, both of whom have been inducted into the College Basketball Hall of Fame.
- Has averaged almost 23 wins a season in his 14 years at Purdue. If you don't include the first transitional year (9-19 record), the average balloons to 23.9 wins per year over the last 13 seasons.
- Has won at least 25 games in eight of his 14 seasons as a collegiate head coach.
- Painter's four Big Ten Coach of the Year honors are the third most in league history (Gene Keady - 7; Bobby Knight - 5; Bo Ryan - 4).
- Painter has averaged 11.3 wins per year in conference play, the fifth-best average in Big Ten Conference history.
- Is one of just three active coaches to have won a Big Ten championship.
- Painter's 11 NCAA Tournaments in the last 13 years are the eighth most in the country.
- Purdue's five Sweet 16 appearances in the last 11 years are the ninth most nationally.
- Painter's 345 wins are the second most nationally for a coach nationally in under 15 years of coaching.
- Coach Painter's 12 NCAA Tournaments are the most for a coach nationally under the age of 55 (as of April 1, 2019 -- Painter is 48 years old).
- Has produced draft picks in each of the last three years, one of only six programs nationally that can say that.
- Purdue is one of five teams to have a Naismith position award finalist in each of the last four years.
- Purdue has finished first or second in Big Ten play in seven of Painter's last 12 years.
- Has had 58 Academic All-Big Ten honorees in his 14 previous years at Purdue.
- Lastly, the five winningest classes in school history have come during the Painter era (2019, 2018, 2012, 2011, 2010).
