Tentative Race Times: 3:30P Women's 5K Open, 4:15P Men's 8K Open, 5:00P Women's 5K Championship, 5:45P Men's 8K Championship

Race Site: Directions to the Purdue University Cross Country Course and course maps can be found at <http://www.purduesports.com/facilities/varsity-xc-course.html>

Eligibility: Open to Indiana colleges and universities only. A maximum of nine runners per school may run in the championship races. All others (including non-Indiana universities) may run in the open race. Unattached and open runners may also run in the open race.

Entry Information: Entry will be handled on Direct Athletics (search for Indiana Intercollegiate Championships on website)

Entries will close on Friday, September 12 at 5:00pm

Entries for each race are unlimited, but each team will be able to run up to nine athletes per championship race.

Entry Fee USTFCCCA Members: \$100.00 per team (men's and women's teams are charged separately)

Non-USTFCCCA Members: \$150.00 per team (men's and women's teams are charged separately)

Packet Pickup: Packet pickup will take place at the course starting line from 1:00P to 3:00P.

Timing: Timing information will be provided within the final meet information packet to be sent out in September.

Results: Will be available after the completion of all races. Results will also be posted on the Purdue Sports website (www.purduesports.com) immediately after the meet. Please check this same website for updates and changes as the meet approaches. There will also be hard copies of the results available at the finish line after the completion of the awards ceremonies.

Awards & Scoring: Team awards will be given to the first place team in both the Big State and Little State divisions. Individual awards will be given to the top 10 finishers in the Big State, and to the 20 twenty finishers in the Little State. Though ran in one section per gender, scoring in the "Championship" sections will be done by their "Big" and "Little" state classification. All participating NCAA Division I schools will be scored to determine the "Big State" results. All non-NCAA Division I teams will be scored separately to determine the "Little State" score.
