#### GAME 15: The Facts

• Purdue begins the 2016 calendar year on Saturday looking to continue its impressive play when Iowa comes to Mackey Arena for the Boilermakers' Big Ten home opener.

• Tip will be at 6 p.m. ET on the Big Ten Network with **Kevin Kugler** and **Stephen Bardo** calling all the action court-side. On the radio dials, the game will be broadcast statewide on the 27-station Purdue Radio Network with **Larry Clisby**, **Rob Blackman** and **Ralph Taylor** on the call. Nationally, it will be broadcast on SIRIUS and XM Satellite Radio (Channel 84).

• Live stats will be provided via Gametracker on PurdueSports.com and as always, in-game updates will be available on Purdue Basketball's official Twitter page, @BoilerBall.

• Purdue enters Saturday's contest with Iowa with a 13-1 overall mark and 1-0 record in Big Ten play. Purdue's 13 victories are tied for the most in the nation with Big Ten Conference mates Michigan State and Northwestern.  
 • Purdue wrapped up the 2015 calendar year with a 25-9 record following its 61-55 win over Wisconsin on Tuesday. It comes on the heels of a 2014 calendar year in which Purdue went 14-18, signifying a significant turnaround.

• The Boilermakers entered this week ranked No. 14 in both the AP and USA Today Coaches Top 25 polls. It marks the 316th week that Purdue has been ranked in the AP poll and with its No. 9 ranking on Dec. 14, Purdue has been ranked in the top 10 in 116 weeks all-time.

• The first 2,000 fans through the Mackey Arena gates will receive a replica **Rick Mount** bobblehead, continuing the Purdue basketball bobblehead series. Mount joins Boilermaker legends **Joe Barry Carroll**, **John Wooden** and **Glenn "Big Dog" Robinson** to be immortalized in bobblehead form.

#### About the Hawkeyes

• Iowa enters Saturday's contest on a roll, winning seven of its last eight games which featured an 83-70 win over No. 1-ranked Michigan State on Tuesday night. The lone loss in that span was an 83-82 setback to No. 2-ranked Iowa State on Dec. 10.

• The Hawkeyes boast an explosive offense, averaging 82.6 points per game and shooting 40.0 percent from 3-point range. Iowa has scored at least 80 points in five of its last six games.

• The Hawkeyes have also won eight of their last 12 "true" road games and went 7-3 in road games a year ago.

• Iowa's three losses this year have come by a combined 12 points (Iowa State - 1; Dayton - 5; Notre Dame - 6).

• Leading the Hawkeyes is preseason All-Big Ten selection **Jarrold Uthoff** at 17.6 points per game. He is one of three players nationally with 225 points, 75 rebounds and 40 blocked shots.

• **Peter Jok** is averaging 13.8 points per game and **Mike Gesell**, who torched Michigan State for 25 points, is averaging 9.2 points and 6.7 assists per game from his point guard position.

#### A Win Would...

... improve Purdue to 14-1 overall, matching the best 15-game start in school history (set seven previous times).

... improve Purdue to 2-0 in Big Ten play for the second straight season and for the fourth time in 11 years under Painter.

... be the eighth straight win over Iowa at Mackey Arena.

... mark Purdue's 16th straight home win, which would tie for the fifth-longest streak in Mackey Arena history.

... be Purdue's seventh straight home win over a Big Ten opponent.

## PURDUE BASKETBALL HISTORY

- Purdue is in its 118th season of basketball, owning a 1,725-987 (.636) all-time record. The Boilermakers rank 19th all-time in victories (1,725) and their 63.6 winning percentage is 20th all-time.
- Purdue has had just two head coaches, **Gene Keady** and **Matt Painter**, since the start of the 1980-81 season, a span of 35 years.
- Since the **Ray Eddy** era began in 1950, Purdue has had just six head coaches in 66 years, and just eight head coaches in the last 99 years.

## PAINTER MOVING UP THE CHARTS

- Matt Painter** has moved into third place on the school's career games coached list and will lead his squad into his 352nd game on Saturday against Iowa.
- Painter owns a 225-126 (.641) record, the third-most wins for a head coach in school history.
- With the 13-1 start, Painter has moved into fifth place on the school's career winning percentage list with a .641 winning percentage.

- Following the resignation of **Bo Ryan** on Dec. 15, **Matt Painter** (age 45) is now the third-longest tenured coach in the Big Ten.
- Michigan State's **Tom Izzo** (21st year) and Ohio State's **Thad Matta** (12th year) are the only Big Ten coaches at their respective schools for a longer time than Painter.

- In just 10-plus years, Painter is one of 20 coaches in Big Ten history to record 100 career Big Ten wins. He is third among active coaches on the list.

## PURDUE LOOKING TO MATCH BEST START

- With a win over Iowa, Purdue can match its best 15-game start in school history (14-1).
- Purdue has started 14-1 seven previous times, including twice during the **Matt Painter** era (2010-11, 2009-10).
- Purdue's longest start without a second loss came in 1987-88, when the Boilermakers started the year 17-1.
- For future watch, Purdue's best 20-game start was 18-2 during the 1987-88 and 1937-38 seasons.

## TIGHT IN BIG TEN GAMES

- If last year's results are any indication, Purdue can expect more close games in Big Ten play. The Boilermakers have played 11 straight regular-season league games decided by 10 or fewer points.
- Following its win over Wisconsin, Purdue has played 12 straight Big Ten road games decided by 10 or fewer points, dating to a 19-point loss at Nebraska on Feb. 23, 2014.

## PURDUE DEFENSE TOUGH IN BIG TEN OPENER

- Wisconsin's 55 points against the Purdue defense were the fewest points Purdue allowed in a Big Ten opener since Jan. 8, 1949, when the Boilermakers held Iowa to 53 points.

■ **BOILERMAKERS HOT AT HOME**

- Purdue enters Saturday's game against Iowa having won 15 straight games at Mackey Arena.
- Since the start of last year, Purdue is now 23-3 at home and its 15-game winning streak is the 16th-longest streak in the country and the second-longest winning streak in the Big 10 (Maryland - 21).
- **Matt Painter** now owns five double-digit homecourt winning streaks in his 11 years at Purdue, and the current 15-game homecourt winning streak is tied for the sixth-longest streak in Mackey Arena.

■ **SHARING IS CARING**

- Purdue ranks 21st in the country in assists per game at 18.1 per contest. The Boilermakers have dished out at least 20 assists in a game six different times this year, including in three of the last six games.
- Purdue has assisted on 66.2 percent of its made field goals this year, a percentage that ranks 11th nationally in assist rate.
- The Boilermakers have seven players averaging at least 1.7 assists per game and six players averaging at least 2.0 assists per game.

■ **DEPTH SHOWCASE**

- Purdue's bench has outscored its counterparts in every game this year and by a combined total of 502-204 so far this year, an average of 35.9 to 14.6 per game.
- Purdue's bench has accounted for 45.1 percent of its scoring (502-of-1,114 points).
- The bench has outscored the starting five in four games this year (Old Dominion, Pittsburgh, New Mexico, Wisconsin).
- It's 44.6 percent of minutes played ranks fifth nationally behind Delaware State (51.1), Mississippi Valley State (49.1), Chicago State (46.3) and Arkansas-Pine Bluff (44.9).
- When you have a preseason All-Big Ten selection coming off the bench (**A.J. Hammons**), you know you have some depth.

■ **SUCCESS AT THE KOHL CENTER**

- With Purdue's win over Wisconsin on Tuesday night in the Kohl Center, Wisconsin now owns a 216-26 record at the Kohl Center, including a 106-15 record against Big Ten teams since the 2001-02 season, the building's first season.
- Purdue is the only team to have won four games at the Kohl Center, accounting for over a quarter of Big Ten wins in the facility (4-of-15).

■ **DEFENSE LIVES HERE**

- Purdue has returned to its roots in bolting out to a 13-1 start and a top-15 national ranking, winning with impressive defensive efforts, likely staking claim to being the top-defensive team in America.
- According to **Ken Pomeroy**, Purdue leads the country in adjusted defensive efficiency (86.5) as well as effective field goal percentage (.384). The Boilermakers are second nationally in 2-point field goal percentage defense (.370), trailing just San Diego State (.366).

- In the NCAA ranks, Purdue is the only school in the country to rank in the top 20 of four major defensive categories (FG percentage defense, scoring defense, rebound margin and 3-point percentage defense). In fact, Purdue ranks in the top 12 of all categories.

- Purdue leads the country in field goal percentage defense at 34.3 percent. Oklahoma is second at 35.6 percent.
- Over the last 34 games (26-8 record) dating to last year, Purdue has held foes to 37.2 percent shooting (725-of-1,951).

### ■ LIMITING CHANCES

- Opponents have scored just 89 second-chance points this year, an average of 6.4 per game.
- Foes have grabbed 146 offensive rebounds for those 89 points, an average of 0.61 points / possession.

### ■ NO BIG DEAL WHEN TRAILING AT HALFTIME

- Purdue trailed Vanderbilt at halftime, 26-23, last Tuesday marking the first time Purdue trailed at halftime this year. However, Purdue outscored the Commodores 45-29 in the second half to rally for the win and continue a theme from last year.
- Since the start of the 2014-15 season, Purdue is now 8-5 when trailing at halftime following its comeback win over Vandy.
- Prior to the start of last year, Purdue had been 26-79 under Painter when trailing at halftime.

### ■ RARE SELLOUT

- Purdue drew a sellout crowd of 14,846 fans against Vanderbilt, the first non-conference sellout since the Mackey Arena renovation was completed prior to the 2011-12 season.
- Purdue is averaging 13,012 fans through its nine home dates so far this year, which is over 2,500 more fans per game this year than through last year's non-conference slate (10,473 fans per game).

### ■ MAY I ASSIST YOU WITH THAT?

- Purdue has four players, all sophomores or younger, that have some impressive assist-to-turnover ratios. The quartet of **Vince Edwards**, **P.J. Thompson**, **Dakota Mathias** and **Ryan Cline** have combined for a 3.29 (135:41) assist-to-turnover ratio in 1,096 minutes, averaging a turnover every 26.7 minutes played between them.

- **A.J. Hammons** has come off the bench in all 12 of his appearances, but that hasn't stopped him from picking up two Big Ten Player of the Week honors (Dec. 7, Dec. 28). He is now on his way to a third after another dominating 24-point, 7-rebound showing in a road win at Wisconsin.
- Hammons has had four double-doubles in the last eight games, averaging 16.6 points, 8.9 rebounds and 2.9 blocks during that span, while shooting 54-of-84 (.643) from the field.

• With a pair of Sweet 16 appearances, six NCAA Tournament berths, Big Ten regular-season and tournament titles and an international gold medal on his résumé, 11th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest minds in all of college basketball.

• Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in March of 2011, agreeing to a new eight-year contract that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2018-19 season.

• Painter has averaged over 21 wins per season during his tenure at the helm of the Purdue program, including at least 20 victories in six of those seasons.

• Painter's tenure has seen Purdue basketball restore its status among the upper echelon of college basketball programs. The last eight years have seen six 20-win seasons and NCAA Tournament berths, two Sweet 16 appearances, a regular-season Big Ten title and a Big Ten Tournament crown.

• The three winningest classes in program history are the classes of 2011, 2012 and 2010, respectively, and five of the 10 winningest individual players Purdue has ever seen have come from the Painter ranks. Success, however, didn't happen overnight.

• Painter officially became the 18th head men's basketball coach in Purdue history on April 1, 2005, and immediately set about laying the groundwork for a dramatic reversal in the program's fortunes.

• The Boilermakers were at their best during the 2009 postseason run, rattling off double-digit victories over Penn State and Illinois to reach the Big Ten Tournament final, where they dispatched Ohio State, 65-61, to earn the first conference tournament crown in program history.

• Painter has also resurrected Mackey Arena as one of the country's best home-court advantages, piling up a 145-31 (.824) record at home over the last 11 seasons, including a remarkable 82-7 (.921) record against non-conference opponents.

• Painter has been named Big Ten Coach of the Year three times in the last six seasons, earning the consensus award in 2008 and 2011, and winning the coaches' vote in 2010. He is one of only six men to win the award more at least three times since its inception in 1974.

• Painter has seen a total of 21 players earn a combined 40 Academic All-Big Ten honors during his tenure as head coach. Painter has also mentored an Academic All-American, as Moore earned second-team honors during the 2009-10 season.
