

THE OPENING TIP

- · Purdue wraps up its home non-conference schedule Saturday with a 7:30 p.m. ET, tilt against in-state rival Indiana State. Purdue is lookng to improve to 2-O against in-state foes after defeating Valparaiso 68-61 last Friday in Mackey Arena.
- · Purdue is looking to bounce back from a disappointing result Tuesday in the ACC / Big Ten Challenge. The Boilermakers led 32-14 at halftime, but Miami outscored Purdue 44-22 in the second half to defeat the Boilermakers 58-54. Purdue owns a 3-0 record against all teams outside the ACC and welcomed back Eric Hunter Jr., in the loss to Miami, Hunter Jr., scored 11 points in 27 minutes of action.

THE KEY TALKING POINTS

- 1) Purdue has won six straight home games against non-conference teams by a combined 190 points (31.6 points per game). Included in that total is a 69-40 win over defending National Champion Virginia last December.
- 2) Purdue has held four of five opponents to seven or fewer offensive rebounds. The Boilermakers rank 26th nationally in defensive rebound percentage. Purdue has held its opponents to just 32 offensive rebounds and 21 second-chance points in five games this year.
- 3) According to KenPom.com, Purdue ranks 287th in experience (1.02 years). Purdue is the least-experienced team in the Big Ten by a wide margin. 4) Purdue has made 23-of-55 (.418) of its 3-point tries at Mackey Arena this season. Away from Mackey Arena, Purdue is just 22-of-64 (.344) from long range. Purdue is averaging 80.5 points per game at home, but just 67.0 points per game away from Mackey Arena.
- 5) Miami's 14 first-half points on Tuesday tied for the fewest ever allowed in a half in the ACC / Big Ten Challenge. In last year's meeting with Virginia, Purdue held the Cavaliers to 17 points. In the last two first halves of the Challenge, Purdue allowed 31 points and 12-of-44 (.273) field goals.
- 6) Zach Edey (14.0 PPG) and Brandon Newman (11.0 PPG) rank 2nd and 5th among Big Ten freshmen in scoring average. Jaden Ivey is also 4th. 7) Purdue is 14-2 against in-state foes since the start of the 2016-17 season. The lone losses have come in the last two Crossroads Classics (2018 vs. Notre Dame: 2019 vs. Butler).
- 8) Purdue is 43-1 since the start of the 2017-18 season when shooting at least 48 percent from the field (Virginia; 2019 Elite Eight).
- 9) Purdue has won 102 straight games when scoring at least 90 points, spanning over 33 years (last loss: Nov. 24, 1987, to Iowa State).
- 10) Sasha Stefanovic has made at least four 3-pointers nine times during his career. Purdue is 7-2 when he reaches that mark.
- 11) When Eric Hunter Jr. leads the team in assists during his career, Purdue is 10-3.

ABOUT THE BOILERMAKERS

- · Purdue enters the contest with a 3-2 record with both losses coming to ACC opponents (Clemson, Miami) in the state of Florida.
- The Boilermakers suffocated the Hurricanes in the first half of Tuesday night's ACC / Big Ten Challenge game, jumping out to a 32-14 halftime lead. However, Miami outscored the Boilermakers 44-22 in the second half as Purdue went cold and Miami rallied for a 58-54 victory.
- Despite the loss, Purdue still owns the Big Ten's best record in the ACC / Big Ten Challenge with an 11-9 record, Penn State also has an 11-9 record. while Nebraska (5-5) and Minnesota (11-11) are the only other teams with at least a .500 mark in the event.
- The Boilermakers have yet to play a game this year with its full arsenal as Eric Hunter Jr., missed the first four games of the season and Jaden Ivey has missed the last four games. Ivey is questionable for tonight's game vs. Indiana State.

BOILERMAKERS HITTING OFFENSIVE WOES

- Purdue has struggled on the offensive end the last two games after a strong offensive start in the first three games of the season.
- Over the last two games, Purdue is shooting just 35.1 percent from the field and 20.8 percent from 3-point range, making just 10-of-48 from long distance in that span.
- In two of the the last four halves, Purdue has scored under 25 points (23 in the first half vs. Valparaiso; 22 in the second half vs. Miami).
- In Purdue's two losses to Clemson and Miami, Purdue is shooting 47-of-118 (.398) from the field, 13-of-46 (.283) from long distance and have an assist-to-turnover ratio of 22 / 36 (0.61). If you take out Zach Edey's 11-of-13 (.846) from the field and 10-of-13 (.769) from the free throw line in those two games, the remainder of the Boilermakers are 36-of-105 (.343) from the field and just 7-of-8 (.875) from the free throw line.

FRESHMAN CLASS SHINING BRIGHT

- · Head coach Matt Painter has had a lot of great freshmen come through the ranks, but the performance by this group of freshmen in their first career games may be unmatched.
- The group scored 44 points in the season opener against Liberty, producing the most points for a freshman class at Purdue since March 20, 2013, vs. Western Illinois (46).

MORE ABOUT THE ROOKIES

- Through five games, Purdue's freshman class has accounted for 170 (34.0 PPG) of the team's 362 points (47.0 percent). It has accounted for over 50.0 percent of the team's scoring in three of Purdue's five games (Liberty, Clemson, Miami).
- The group has played 424 minutes (42.4 percent).
- The group has shot a combined 64-of-125 (.512) from the field. The remainder of the team is just 66-of-160 (.413) from the field.
- For future reference, the school record for points scored by a freshman class in a season is 1,267 points (37.3 PPG) by the 2007-08 freshman
- class (Hummel, Moore, Johnson, Martin).

EDEY AMONG THE NATIONAL LEADERS

- · Zach Edey has had a strong start to the season, which is somewhat surprising given his story.
- · He's played basketball for about three years after playing hockey and baseball in Canada and spending last year at powerhouse IMG Academy in Florida, averaging about five points per game.
- He was ranked No. 429 among high school seniors a year ago and the 94th-ranked center in America.
- Edey's 19 points in the season opener was the third most for a true freshman in the season opener in school history.

- · Edey's 49 points in the first three games of the year were the second most for a true freshman in school history behind Russell Cross' 78 (1980-81).
- · He ranks seventh nationally in field goal percentage (.765) and first among freshmen and among players that have played at least five games.
- He is second nationally in dunks (13) behind Memohis' Moussa Cisse (14). Half of Edey's 26 field goals have been dunks.
- There are just three players nationally that have scored at least 70 points in under 100 minutes (High Point's John-Michael Wright 72 in 100 minutes; Gonzaga's Drew Timme -- 70 in 96 minutes; Purdue's Zach Edey -- 70 in 79 minutes).
- · Edey is 14th nationally among all freshmen in scoring, but is the only player listed among the top 27 scorers to play under 20 minutes per game.
- In the Big Ten ranks, Edey is second among freshmen in scoring (14.0 PPG) behind Michigan's Hunter Dickinson (14.8 PPG), and leads all players in field goal percentage (.765).

BOILER NOTES

- Purdue rallied from 11 down at halftime last Friday night to defeat Valparaiso 68-61 for its second straight victory. It was Purdue's largest comeback since a 13-point, second-half rally against Minnesota on Feb. 2, 2019.
- · It marked the 17th time under Painter that Purdue has rallied from at least 11 points down for the victory.
- ·Purdue has had at least 11 offensive rebounds in each of the last four games.
- · Purdue has shot 11 or fewer free throws in four of five games this season. The only game Purdue shot more than 11 free throws was vs. Oakland [37].
- · Purdue is 113-13 since the start of the 2014-15 season when attempting more free throws than its opponents.
- · Purdue is 156-7 when under Painter when holding foes to 59 or fewer points. Three of the seven losses came during the 2012-13 season. One of the losses came to Miami on Tuesday in the ACC / Big Ten Challenge. The Boilermakers are 12-55 when scoring 59 or fewer points.
- Purdue's favorite day of the week to play is Friday, posting a 35-12 under Painter mark on the calendar day.
- Purdue has won 102 straight games and is 40-0 under Coach Painter when scoring 90 or more points.
- Purdue hasn't lost when scoring 90 points since Nov. 24, 1987 (104-96 vs. Iowa State), a span of 12,073 days.
- · Purdue is 123-12 under Painter when scoring at least 80 points, including 37-2 (losses to Notre Dame and Virginia Tech in 2018-19 season) since the start of 2017-18.
- Purdue is 35-5 since the start of the 2017-18 season when making 10 or more 3-pointers in a game. Under Painter, Purdue is 80-17 overall, having won six straight games.
- Purdue is 129-13 under Painter when winning the rebound and turnover battles in the same game.
- Purdue is 158-16 under Painter when shooting at least 48 percent from the field. Since the start of the 2017-18 season, Purdue is 43-1 when doing so, losing to Virginia in the 2019 Elite Eight. Purdue has won nine straight games when shooting at least 48 percent from the field.
- Purdue has won 11 straight games when wearing its gold uniforms, dating to a New Year's Day loss vs. Minnesota in 2017.
- Among Power-6 (Big Ten, ACC, SEC, PAC-12, Big East, Big 12) programs, Purdue has the fifth-best home ► HOME WINNING PCT. LAST 6 YEARS. winning percentage since the start of the 2014-15 season.
- Purdue has held three straight teams to 0.88 points / possession or less (Oakland 0.78; Valparaiso - N 88 · Miami - N 88)
- Purdue has 16 dunks this season in just five games (3.2 per game), Last year, in 31 games, it finished with 45 dunks (1.45 per game).
- In research done by Kansas State SID Tom Gilbert, Purdue will field one of the nation's youngest rosters during the 2020-21 season.
- Purdue is among the cream of the crop in the Big Ten, posting the Big Ten's second-best record over the last six years (Michigan State 81-31; Purdue 78-34; Wisconsin 75-37; Maryland 72-40).
- The Boilermakers will have 10 underclassmen (sophomore or younger), will have the fewest amount of upperclassmen (5) in the Big Ten and will be the only league team to have fewer than two seniors on its roster, sporting a grand total of ZERO seniors on its roster. The only high-major programs with zero seniors on its rosters are Auburn and Florida.
- Purdue is the only Big Ten school and one of four schools nationally (Kansas, Duke, Gonzaga) to rank in KenPom.com's final top 25 in each of the
- Sasha Stefanovic is one of three players in America to have at least 16 assists and 16 made 3-pointers so far this year.
- Currently, Trevion Williams (10.0 PPG, 10.0 RPG) is one of 18 players nationally that have played at least four games this year and average a double-double. He joins Iowa's Luka Garza (29.5 PPG, 10.8 RPG) and Michigan State's Joey Hauser (14.0 PPG, 10.0 RPG) from the Big Ten.
- Purdue boasts three of the top five freshmen scorers in the league (Zach Edey 2nd; Jaden Ivey - 4th; Brandon Newman - 5th). To be fair, Ivey has played only one game, but his return
- Zach Edey ranks 16th nationally in fouls drawn / 40 minutes (9.0).
- With a 20-point, 7-assist, 0-turnover performance against Oakland, Stefanovic became just the second Boilermaker since the 2010-11 season to reach those marks in a single game, joining Carsen Edwards (vs. Iowa; Jan. 20, 2018) in that club. He is one of four players nationally to accomplish that feat this year.
- Since the start of the 2015-16 season, 28 of Purdue's 128 wins have come by 30 or more points, the third-highest total nationally (Gonzaga - 52; Duke - 30; Purdue - 28).
- Since the start of the 2015-16 season, 45 of Purdue's 128 wins have come by 20 or more points, the fifth-most nationally (Gonzaga - 86; Duke - 55; Villanova - 53; Purdue & Michigan State - 52)
- With the addition of freshman Zach Edey to the roster, Purdue has had a 7-footer on the roster for nine straight years. If Edey stays all four years, that streak will extend to 12 years.
- Florida State is the only program in America to have a longer 7-footer streak, as this will mark the 14th straight year with a 7-footer for the Seminoles.
- Purdue has had a player that stands 7-foot, 2-inches or taller on its roster for a nation's-best seven straight years, including this season.
- Purdue is one of four schools nationally to advance to three straight Sweet 16s, joining
- Kentucky, Gonzaga and Michigan on the list. Matt Painter is climbing all the charts in Big Ten play, moving up the list in overall wins and
